## STARTING FIVE:

1. NCCU begins its 91st season with close to 1300 victories.
2. LeVelle Moton moved up to second in wins at NCCU passing John McLendon last season.
3. NCCU will face programs from over 10 different conferences, including the ACC, SEC, and Big 12.
4. The Eagles are 33-2 at home in non-conference games since 2016.
5. NCCU doesn't have any returning starters from the 2022-23 season.

## KNOCKING ON THE DOOR

NCCU's head coach LeVelle Moton is two wins away from becoming the all-time winningest coach in the history of the program. Floyd Brown currently holds the record of 251 wins from his 18 seasons coached at North Carolina Central University from 1952-1970. Brown also holds the record for most games coaches at 445, which will also be broken later this season by Moton. He climbed to second place over John McLendon last season.

## 100-POINT CLUB

There are three Eagles who have already made the 100-point club this season. Fred Cleveland Jr., Ja'Darius Harris and Po'Boigh King have all scored over 100 points through eight games.

## EAGLE'S ELEVEN

NCCU has brought in 11 new players for the 2023-24 season, and only one is a freshman. The 10 transfers range from different states, countries, and conferences, with two flying into the nest from the same previous school. Six players transferred in from junior colleges, and the remaining four are coming in from Division I programs. Junior Keishon Porter is the only new face whose played for both NJCAA and Division I level schools.

## THE EAGLE-AGGIE CLASSIC

On Tuesday, Dec. 12, the Eagle-Aggie Classic will take place after a two-season absence. The rivalry game existed for years due to both team belonging to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. Once North Carolina A&T exited the MEAC in 2021, so did the match-up. The game will now be played this season in Greensboro, N.C. against new N.C. A&T head coach Monte Ross. LeVelle Moton leads the series 13-11 since becoming the NCCU head coach in 2009.

## LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

The Eagles have are in the top-three in six different categories in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. What do these statistical ranks all have in common... DEFENSE. NCCU leads the MEAC in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.310) just outside the top-100 in the nation (112th). They are second in steals per game (9.36), turnover margin (+3.45), opponent field goal percentage (.440) and opponents points per game (71.3) in the MEAC.

## EAGLE OFFENSE

During the 2022-23 season, the Eagles were second in the MEAC in offense, averaging 75.6 points per game, only 0.2 shy of first with Norfolk State. Below are the games where NCCU won while scoring over that average last season.

## MOTON SITS AMONG NCCU TOP 5 IN WINS

Head coach LeVelle Moton celebrated his 100th victory against S.C. State on Jan. 10, 2015, becoming the fifth coach in NCCU men's basketball history to reach the 100-win milestone. He then went on to win his 200th game on Dec. 9, 2021 against Carver to become the third head coach to reach 200 wins in program history. During the 2022-23 season, Moton rose to second in wins against Coppin State on Feb. 13, 2023 at 240 wins. Here is a list of the coaches with the most wins in program history:

## 20-WIN SEASONS

Head Coach LeVelle Moton joined rare company during the 2016-17 season as just the third coach to have four 20-win seasons along with coach John B. McLendon and Gregory Jackson. During the 2014-15 season, NCCU earned a third consecutive 20-win season, something that has not happened for the Eagles since 1990 under the direction of head coach Michael Bernard. McLendon was the only other coach to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons from 1948-51. Here's a look at all 19 of NCCU's 20-win seasons.

## LEVELLE MOTON HEAD COACH ♦ 15TH SEASON



On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

In 2019, the Eagles accomplished something that had not been done before in school history as it clinched a third-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance by winning the MEAC Tournament for a third-straight year. Moton was named Most Outstanding Coach of the tournament as the Eagles took down both top seeds of Norfolk State and North Carolina A&T on the way to the title. The Eagles achieved another top-three regular season finish and stayed true to their defensive principles as they finished second in the league by holding opponents to just 67.4 points per game and had a positive scoring margin of 4.8 points per game. They also led the league by holding opponents to just 30.7 rebounds per game and outrebounded the opposition by 6.6 boards per contest.

In 2018, the Eagles caught fire in Norfolk and went on a run to win back-to-back MEAC Tournament championships for the first time in program history, earning consecutive berths into the NCAA Tournament for the first time as well. Moton was named MEAC Tournament Most Outstanding Coach as the Eagles won four games in six days, winning the conference tourney for the first time as a six-seed. NCCU again topped the MEAC defensively, allowing just 65.1 points per game, 33.3 rebounds per game, and 41.7 percent of field goal attempts.

During the 2016-17 season Moton led the Eagles to a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark, and he joined rare company with John B. McLendon as the only coaches with four 20-win seasons at NCCU. NCCU captured its third MEAC regular-season championship and second MEAC Tournament championship within a four year span to make its second Division-I NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles also made history with their first win over an SEC opponent with a wire-to-wire 62-52 win at Missouri. NCCU went on a 13-game win streak during conference play, the second-longest win streak in the Division I era. The Eagles continued to pride itself on defense by being second in the nation in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made attempts. NCCU was also top-10 in field goal percentage defense (39.1), top-25 in scoring defense (63.4 points per game) and top-15 in scoring margin (11.7 points per game).

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14-seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

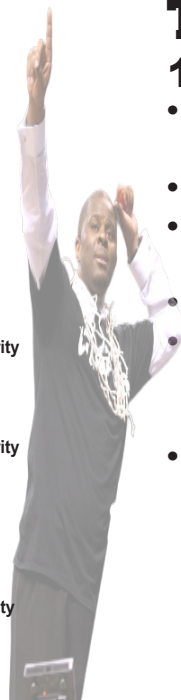
He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.
