The Omaha men's basketball team meets South Dakota for a neutral-site matchup this Thursday, Feb. 7 at the Sanford Pentagon at 7 p.m. in Sioux Falls, S.D. Jay Elsen and Brad Newitt will have the call on YurView Cox Channel 1013, ESPN+ and Midco, and Gary Sharp will have the radio call on 1180 Zone 2. Links to live video, audio and stats will be available on OMavs.com.

Quick Hits

- Omaha sits in second place in the Summit League standings, behind only South Dakota State's 9-1 mark.
- The Mavericks' 6-1 start to league play before a loss at South Dakota State on Jan. 26 matched its previous best set by the 2015-16 team.
- Omaha has won 10 of its last 12 games. It won five straight decisions on the road from Dec. 15 - Jan. 24, the most since seven straight from Jan. 2 - Feb. 19, 2011.
- The Mavericks have outrebounded six of their last seven opponents.
- Omaha is the only team in the league to have all five starters averaging double figures: Zach Jackson (18.0 ppg), JT Gibson (14.4 ppg), Mitch Hahn (12.1 ppg), KJ Robinson (11.3 ppg) at Matt Pile (10.4 ppg).
- Omaha is one of three league teams -- with South Dakota State and Purdue Fort Wayne -- with at least two players in the conference's top 10 for scoring. Jackson is fourth, and Gibson is ninth.
- The Mavericks, who rank 18th nationally and lead the Summit League for fewest turnovers per game, have had single-digit turnovers in nine of the last 13 games.
- Omaha is two wins shy of two century marks: its 100th win since gaining membership in the Summit League in 2012-13 and Derrin Hansen's 100th career conference win since taking the reins of the Maverick program in 2005-06.
- The Mavericks were picked eighth in the 2018-19 Summit League's Preseason Poll, and Jackson was a first-team Preseason All-Summit selection.

Scouting the South Dakota Coyotes

South Dakota is 9-13 (3-6 Summit League) on the season after their second straight loss, 102-71 at Purdue Fort Wayne last Wednesday. Stanley Umude scored 32 points on 10-of-16 shooting, and Triston Simpson added 14 points with five assists and seven rebounds.

USD, which finished 26-9 (11-3 Summit League) a year ago, was voted second in the Summit League's preseason poll. Trey Burch-Manning was named to the Preseason All-Summit First Team, and Tyler Hagedorn was a second-team selection.

Head coach Todd Lee is 9-13 in his first season at South Dakota and carries a career mark of 163-94 over nine years.

All-Time Against South Dakota

Thursday marks the 93rd meeting between Omaha and South Dakota, and the Coyotes lead the all-time series 47-45. In the Mavericks' Division I era, the series is tied 7-7. The two teams have met on a neutral floor once as members of the Summit League, with an 87-73 win for South Dakota on March 3, 2018 in the quarterfinals of the Summit League Tournament in Sioux Falls, S.D.

Omaha and USD met earlier this season on Jan. 20 at Baxter Arena, where the Mavericks won 75-68. Zach Jackson led all scorers with 21 points, and Matt Pile had a double-double on 12 points and 14 rebounds.

Last Time Out: Mavericks Top North Dakota at Home, 90-72

Omaha got back to its winning ways Sunday afternoon, picking up a 90-72 win over North Dakota at Baxter Arena. All five starters scored in double figures for the third time this year, led by a game-high 22 points from Zach Jackson.

The senior hit 9-of-12 from the field and 4-of-5 from the line, adding a team-high five rebounds, two assists and two steals. JT Gibson joined him with 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting and a pair of threes alongside five boards and a game-high four steals.

Mitch Hahn and KJ Robinson followed with 16 points apiece. Robinson shot 6-of-9 with two 3-pointers and collected three rebounds, a team-best four assists and three steals. Hahn finished 7-of-11 from the floor and grabbed four boards with a steal.

Matt Pile rounded it out with 12 points, five rebounds, a steal and two blocks.

Omaha shot .565 (39-of-69) to North Dakota's .456 (26-of-57), despite hitting just four 3-pointers for the day. The Mavericks won the rebounding battle 31-29 and had a 52-26 advantage in the paint. They also committed a season-low six turnovers while forcing 16, collecting 28 points off miscues.

Scoring Notables

- Over the last five games, Zach Jackson has averaged 19.0 points per game and has at least 20 points in four of them: 22 at Western Illinois (Jan. 17), 21 vs. South Dakota (Jan. 20), 25 at Purdue Fort Wayne (Jan. 24) and 22 vs. North Dakota (Feb. 3).
- Over the last five games, Mitch Hahn (10), Zach Jackson (nine), JT Gibson (11) and KJ Robinson (11) have combined for 41 of Omaha's 43 threes.
- Five Mavericks have made at least four triples in a single game this season: Gibson (eight times), Jackson and Hahn (three times each), KJ Robinson (twice) and Ayo Akinwale (once).
- Omaha has had five double-figure scorers seven times, most recently vs. North Dakota State (Jan. 2). All five starters have scored in double figures on three occasions.
- The Mavericks have shot .500 or better as a team on nine occasions, including seven of the last 11 games. They are undefeated when shooting at least .500.

Threes, Please

Omaha ranks 18th nationally with a .390 shooting percentage from distance and 68th nationally as a team with 200 3-pointers made. JT Gibson has been a major factor from long range, and the junior is 65th in the country for 3-point percentage (.401).

The Mavericks have 10 games with double-digit triples this season.

League Leaders

Through the first half of league play, Omaha ranks in the top third of the Summit League for scoring (third at 84.4), field goal percentage (third at .498), field goals made per game (third at 31.8), 3-point percentage (second at .410), free throw percentage (.765), offensive rebounds per game (second at 9.2), steals per game (third at 6.8) and fewest turnovers per game (second at 9.4).

Mavericks by Month

Omaha went 5-1 in the month of January, shooting .484 from the field and .411 from three while averaging 82.5 points per game. The charge was led by the starting five: Zach Jackson (17.3 ppg), Mitch Hahn (16.7 ppg/9.8 rpg), JT Gibson (13.0 ppg), Matt Pile (11.5 ppg/9.3 ppg) and KJ Robinson (12.5 ppg).

Action Jackson

Over 22 games in his senior campaign, Zach Jackson has a team-best 18.0 points with 3.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 0.9 steals per game. He ranks 101st nationally for scoring and 109th for total points (395), is the fourth-best scorer in the Summit League and also ranks third among league players for free throws made (85). Jackson had 10 straight games in double figures from Nov. 6 to Dec. 8, and he had another nine-game streak from Dec. 19 to Jan. 24.

JT's Junior Year

JT Gibson has scored in double figures in all but two games this season, including his current 10-game streak in place since Dec. 21. He has scored 15 or more points in a night on nine occasions, highlighted by a career-high 22 points with three rebounds, three assists and a steal vs. Denver (Dec. 28), followed by 21 points, three boards, a career-high eight assists and three steals vs. Oral Roberts (Dec. 30).

Gibson has eight games with four or more 3-pointers, led by a five-triple efforts at Oregon (Dec. 8) and vs. Denver (Dec. 28). He ranks fourth in the Summit League for 3-pointers made (55) and fifth for steals (27). In league play, he has averaged 15.7 points per game.

Gibson, who has scored in 54 straight contests, is Omaha's active career leader for threes made and assists (155).

JT for Three

JT Gibson is the only Omaha player to hit a three in all 22 games this season. The streak is the longest of his career,

surpassing his previous best of 19 straight games from Nov. 20, 2017 to Jan. 25, 2018.

With a team-high 57 treys, he ranks fifth among Summit League players. The Brooklyn Park, Minn., native broke into Omaha's top 15 for career triples Dec. 6 at Seattle and now ranks 11th (149).

Milestones in the Making for Jackson

Zach Jackson came into his final season on the brink of with two major milestones. Nov. 9 at Minnesota, he became the 39th 1,000-point scorer in program history and last Saturday moved up to a tie for seventh all-time for scoring with 1,387 points. He needs 71 points to pass Phil Cartwright (1988-92), whose 1,457 points occupy the sixth spot.

Jackson also has 480 rebounds over his career, needing 20 to become the 12th player in school history with at least 1,000 points and 500 boards.

On Jan. 2, Jackson joined the top 20 in school history for career field goals and is now 11th with 467 made. He moved into 20th for career steals (101) last Sunday vs. North Dakota.

Feelin' Hahn, Hahn, Hahn

Mitch Hahn has been a major factor in Omaha's success of late, as the senior has averaged 16.2 points, 7.7 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game with .525 shooting over the last 12 games. He has scored in double figures in each one, marking the longest double-figure streak of any Maverick this season. The numbers are up from his previous 10 games, during which he had 7.2 points, 4.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game and shot .308 from the floor and .229 from three.

The Fremont, Neb., native also owns three games with at least three 3-pointers, hitting three apiece against Minnesota (Nov. 6) and Northern Arizona (Nov. 14) and a season-best four at Idaho (Dec. 15) and vs. North Dakota State (Jan. 2). He has four double-doubles on the year: at Rice (Dec. 21) with 18 points/11 rebounds, at North Dakota (Jan. 10) with 17 points and 11 rebounds, at Purdue Fort Wayne (Jan. 24) with 23 points/15 rebounds and at South Dakota State (Jan. 26) with 14 points/15 rebounds.

The Pile Driver

Matt Pile is shooting at a .595 clip in his sophomore campaign, ranking second among Summit League players. He also ranks third for offensive rebounds (59) and fifth for rebounds per game (7.3) and total rebounds (161). In league-only games, he is first for offensive boards (33).

The Goddard, Kan., native has scored in double digits 13 times this year. He delivered back-to-back double-doubles vs. North Dakota State (Jan. 2) with 19 points/12 rebounds and at North Dakota (Jan. 10) with a career-best 20 points/10 rebounds. Over the last 13 games, Pile has six double-doubles and has averaged 11.2 points, 7.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists per contest.

Just a year and a half into his career, Pile's is Omaha's active career leader in for blocks (51). He joined the top 15 in school history with a season-best four-block performance Jan. 20 vs. South Dakota.

Here's to You, Mr. Robinson

KJ Robinson returned to the Mavericks' starting five Dec. 6 at Seattle, playing his first game since Nov. 20. He hit five 3-pointers en route to 17 points that night and has since averaged 11.9 points, 2.1 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game in the 14-game stretch. Robinson put up a season-best 23-point performance Jan. 26 at South Dakota State, canning four triples and adding five rebounds and four steals.

With a 2.8 assist-to-turnover ratio this year, he ranks 31st nationally.

A native of Blue Springs, Mo., Robinson had a career performance vs. Tennessee Tech last season, going off for a career-high 25 points while hitting seven 3-pointers and adding five rebounds, five assists and a block. It was the most threes in a game by any Maverick since Marcus Tyus had eight at South Dakota State (Jan. 7, 2017).

The Evolution of Zach Jackson

Zach Jackson has been a four-year starter, averaging 12.0 points and 4.1 rebounds per game for his career. The Wichita, Kan., native has scored in 69 straight contests dating back to Jan. 7, 2017 and has 71 consecutive starts since Dec. 29, 2016.

From his freshman campaign to his junior year, Jackson evolved into an all-league player and last year became the sixth Maverick in the Division I era to score 500+ points in a single season.

Ayo!

Ayo Akinwale made his first start of the season Nov. 24 vs. Montana State, and the Papillion-LaVista product came to play. Akinwale had a perfect shooting day, finishing 8-of-8 from the field, including 4-of-4 from deep, en route to a career-high 20 points. He also had four rebounds, a season-high six assists and a career-high-tying three steals.

Akinwale's sophomore campaign has him at 5.5 points, 2.0 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.1 steals per game over 19.1 minutes per contest.

Checking In for Omaha: Zach Thornhill

Redshirt freshman Zach Thornhill, who battled injuries for the last year and a half, made his collegiate debut at Idaho (Dec. 15). The Lenexa, Kan., native has averaged 10.3 minutes per game off the bench with 3.0 points and 1.7 rebounds per contest.

Down But Not Out

Omaha overcame a 17-point deficit to win Jan. 24 at Purdue Fort Wayne, marking the third time this season the Mavericks have worked past a double-digit deficit. The previous two were a 14-point comeback at North Dakota (Jan. 10) and a 15-point comeback at Bethune Cookman (Nov. 20).

Double the Trouble, Double the Fun

Matt Pile (20 points/10 rebounds) and Mitch Hahn (17 points/11 rebounds) both had double-doubles at North Dakota (Jan. 10). It marked the first time this season Omaha has had two double-doubles in the same game.

Noting the Schedule

Over the regular season in 2018-19, Omaha will play in 14 states with competition from eight other Division I conferences. The schedule has three opponents from the Pac-12 and the Big Sky and one each from the Big 12, Big Ten, Big West, Conference USA, MEAC and WAC. Arizona State and defending Summit League champion South Dakota State both reached the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

Omaha plays 17 of its 29 games on the road this season, including a challenging five-game road stretch from Nov. 26 to Dec. 15 with visits to Iowa State, Arizona State, Seattle, Oregon and Idaho. By Dec. 6, Omaha had played in all four time zones in the contiguous United States.

Challenging Foes

During the 2017-18 non-conference slate, Omaha faced three teams (Oklahoma, Kansas and Louisville) with NCAA Final Four appearances on their resumes in the last decade. This season, one opponent has a recent Final Four to its credit: Oregon in 2017.

Eight Maverick opponents have earned at least one NCAA Tournament berth over the last five years: Oregon (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017), Iowa State (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017), South Dakota State (2016, 2017, 2018), North Dakota State (2014, 2015), Arizona State (2014, 2018), Colorado (2014, 2016), Minnesota (2017) and North Dakota (2017).

Going Streaking

Omaha has had 12 streaks with at least three wins in the Division I era, its longest lasting six games.

Head Coach Derrin Hansen is in his 14th season at the helm of the Omaha men's basketball program in 2018-19. The 21st head coach in UNO history, he ranks second all-time in school history for career victories and has led the program to two Division I postseason appearances with the 2016 CBI and the 2014 CIT.

Omaha has enjoyed three seasons with full Division I postseason eligibility, delivering back-to-back third-place finishes in the Summit League standings. In 2016-17, the Mavericks were 18-14 (9-7 Summit League) and finished as runner-up at the Summit League Championship. Tra-Deon Hollins earned his second straight first-team All-Summit and league Defensive Player of the Year awards, and Marcus Tyus (second-team All-Summit), Tre'Shawn Thurman (All-Summit Honorable Mention) and Mitch Hahn (Summit League All-Newcomer Team) also added to the haul.

Before Omaha's move to NCAA Division I in 2011-12, Hansen guided the Mavericks to two Division II Tournament appearances and conference championships in the MIAA (2010) and the NCC (2008). He has coached five players to all-region plaudits, and one All-America honorable mention. Thirteen of his players have won a combined 21 all-conference awards, with 12 All-Summit, eight All-MIAA and four All-NCC.

high jump champion and a seven-time All-American at K-State and was recently inducted into the school's hall of fame. His father, Jeff, ran three years at Wichita State.

- Mitch Hahn's father, Dave, played basketball at Kearney State College, now known as the University of Nebraska Kearney. His older brother, Michael, played baseball at UNK, and his young brother, Matt, plays basketball at Morningside College.
- JT Gibson's father, Daryl, played basketball at Fort Valley State. His older brother, Teddy, played at Waldorf College.
- Elishja Duplechan has a twin brother, Isaiah, who plays basketball at Solano Community College.
- Zach Thornhill's father, Mike, played basketball at Quincy.
- Kyle Luedtke's father, Josh, played football at UNO.

What Makes Up the Mavericks

- UNO returns 67 percent of its offensive production from last season, as this year's returners accounted for 1,599 of the Mavericks' 2,373 points. The returners are also credited for 60 percent (623) of last season's 1,043 rebounds.
- Seniors Zach Jackson and Mitch Hahn are UNO's leading returning scorers after averaging 17.6 and 11.7 points per game, respectively.
- Junior Brett Barney totes previous Division I experience, having spent the last three seasons at Wichita State. Redshirt freshman Logan Strom, who will sit out this season due to NCAA transfer rules, also spent a year at UC Davis.
- Jackson played the most minutes in 2017-18 of any returner on this year's roster, averaging 31.8 minutes per game.
- UNO's 2018-19 roster has two seniors, three juniors, three sophomores, five redshirt freshmen and one true freshman.
- The Mavericks hail from six different states. Six are from Nebraska, and four are Kansas natives, while California, Florida, Minnesota and Missouri are all represented once on the roster.

PROmaha

Nine former Mavericks have gone on to play professionally in the last four years: Mike Rostampour (Slovakia/Canada/Mexico/El Salvador), CJ Carter (Macedonia), Devin Patterson (Lithuania) and Tim Smallwood (Italy), Randy Reed II (Tunisia/Saudi Arabia), Tra-Deon Hollins (Poland/NBA G League), Marcus Tyus (Slovakia/Sweden), Alex Welhouse (Spain) and Daniel Norl (United Kingdom).

Carter and Rostampour, both 2014-15 graduates, won league championships with their respective clubs in 2015-16. Carter's MZT Skopje Aerodrom team captured the Prva Liga title, while Rostampour's BC Prievizda squad won the Slovak Extraliga crown. Rostampour also played for the Cape Breton Highlanders in the National Basketball League of Canada (2017), Caballeros de Culiacan of CIBACOPA and San Salvador BC of the FIBA Americas League (2017-18) and most recently rejoined BC Prievizda for 2018-19.

Three members of the 2015-16 class signed professional contracts following graduation. Patterson joined BC Šiauliai, which plays in the Lithuanian Basketball League and Baltic Basketball League, while Reed signed with Jeunesse Sportive d'El Mensah in Tunisia's Ligue 1 and later Al Ittihad in the Saudi Premier League. Smallwood played with Manerbio GoodBook in Italy's Serie C Gold league.

Hollins joined AZS Koszalin in Poland's Polska Liga Koszykówki in July, then returned to the United States and was the first-round draft pick of the Fort Wayne Mad Ants in the NBA G League in 2017. Tyus signed with MBK Baník Handlová in the Slovak Extraliga in 2017 and joined Boras in the Swedish Basketligan in 2018, and Welhouse, who completed his Maverick career in 2012-13, was added to the roster for Club Baloncesto Villarrobledo in Spain's Liga EBA in 2017.

Daniel Norl, a member of the 2017-18 class, signed with Cheshire of the British Basketball League after graduation.

Fresh Faces

Omaha's roster features seven newcomers this season, with one true freshman, five redshirt freshmen, a sophomore and a junior.

Brett Barney joins the Mavericks after three seasons at Wichita State, where he was a member of three straight Shocker teams that made NCAA Tournament appearances, as well as back-to-back MVC regular-season and conference tournament championship squads.

Fellow Division I transfer Logan Strom began his collegiate career with a redshirt season at UC Davis. At Norfolk High School, Strom was a two-time all-state selection and averaged 16.8 points, 9.1 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while leading his team to the 2017 Class A state championship. Strom received a combined 26 Division I football and basketball scholarship offers out of high school.

Elishja Duplechan played the 2017-18 season at Yuba Community College, where he helped his team to a conference title, a record of 25-6 and a berth in the California State Championships Elite Eight. He averaged 18.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 5.2 assists per game and was a first-team All-California JUCO selection.

Kyle Luedtke is a local product from Creighton Prep, where he played for his father, Josh Luedtke. An all-state selection as a senior, Kyle Luedtke averaged 13.9 points and 3.6 rebounds per game and helped the Junior Jays to the

2018 Class A state championship with a 26-1 record.

Wanjiang Tut, who redshirted last season, previously spent 2016-17 at The Skill Factory Prep. At Omaha Burke High School, he was a four-year letterwinner and an honorable mention all-state pick, and he averaged 12.5 points, 10.1 rebounds, 2.8 blocks and 1.4 assists per game. Tut also played for the South Sudan National Team.

Zach Thornhill, who redshirted last season, was a two-time all-state pick at St. James Academy, where he helped his team advance to a sub-state final. He averaged 20.6 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game.

Evan Tricker redshirted in 2017-18 after a year at DME Academy, where he averaged 14.1 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. As a prep player at First Baptist Academy, he averaged 10.6 points, 8.4 rebounds and 3.1 blocks per game, and he also played for Montverde Academy in the summer of his sophomore year in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

Hayden Miller, who also redshirted last season, was a two-time Class D1 first-team all-state honoree at Lourdes Central Catholic High School and captain of the Nebraska Class D1 all-state squad two straight years while helping his team to back-to-back state championships as a junior and senior.

Championship Pedigree

Before becoming Mavericks, seven players on Omaha's roster made appearances in state championship games with their high school programs. Senior Zach Jackson won a Kansas state title with Wichita East in 2015, and junior KJ Robinson captured one in Missouri with Blue Springs South in 2016. Redshirt freshman Hayden Miller won back-to-back state championships at Lourdes Central Catholic in 2016 and 2017. Logan Strom was part of a Nebraska state championship squad at Norfolk in 2017, and Kyle Luedtke won a Nebraska state title at Creighton Prep in 2018.

Junior JT Gibson, from Champlin Park in Minnesota, appeared in a state championship contest in 2015, and sophomore Ayo Akinwale's Papillion-La Vista team played in the Nebraska state title game in 2017.

Hansen Inks Hughes, Robinson for 2019-20

Head coach Derrin Hansen announced Nov. 20 that Darrius Hughes and Lamel Robinson have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Omaha men's basketball program in 2019-20.

Hughes, a 6-6, 235-pound guard, has been a three-year letterwinner for Coach Pete Campbell at Rockhurst High School, where he ranks as the No. 7 player in the state of Missouri according to PrepHoops.com. As a junior, Hughes averaged 12.0 points per game and earned all-district accolades en route to a 21-3 team record and a district title.

Robinson, a 6-0, 160-pound guard, has been a three-year letterwinner for Coach Daniel Parra at Park Hill South High School. A two-time first-team all-state selection and a three-time all-conference and all-district honoree, he averaged 23.8 points per game as a junior and 21.3 points per game as a sophomore.

Hughes and Robinson both play AAU ball for the Team Rush program and Coach Victor Williams, who also coached Maverick guard KJ Robinson.

Home Sweet Homaha

Omaha played 12 games at home in 2017-18, and eight of its nine wins came at Baxter Arena. This season, the Mavericks are 7-2 at home. They average 84.9 points per game and have an average margin of victory of 16.6 points.
