The Basics

Omaha heads to Tulsa, Oklahoma for its lone game of the week vs. Oral Roberts. The Mavericks were supposed to play Kansas City to open the week, but the game was ruled a no contest due to COVID-19 issues within the UMKC program. Tipoff between the Mavericks and Golden Eagles is set for 7 p.m. on Jan. 1.

Omaha is coming off its first league win vs. Western Illinois last week. It snapped an 11-game skid for the Mavericks and ended a six-game win streak for the Leathernecks. ORU is coming off a dominating win vs. Denver and can be just the second team in the league to reach three wins Saturday.

Quick Hits

- The Mavericks snapped an 11-game losing streak vs. Western Illinois last week with an 84-78 win. It also ended a six-game win streak for the Leathernecks.
- Four players put up double-figure scoring efforts led by Felix Lemetti who scored 22. It was just one point shy of his career-high and marked the fifth consecutive game with at least 10 points for the junior guard.
- Frankie Fidler poured in a career-high 19 points. He finished 10-for-10 at the foul line. Darrius Hughes added 12 points, while Nick Ferrarini scored 10 in his first game back from injury.
- Omaha dropped a close battle with St. Thomas in the league opener last week. Once down 29 points, the Mavericks rallied to get within five of the Tommies in the second half. The comeback fell short, 80-73.

- Three players scored double-figures for Omaha. Marco Smith set a new career-high with 19 points to lead the team. Fidler added another 18 points, while Felix Lemetti scored 16.
- Lemetti scored a career-high 23 points at UNLV earlier in December. He was 7-of-10 from three-point range. The seven made threes ties second in the single-game record for most threes in a game.
- Hughes scored double-figure in four straight games. Most recently, Hughes scored 10 at UNLV on 5-of-7 from the field. Prior to the road trip, he recorded a career-high 19 points vs. A&M - Corpus Christi, 15 points vs. Drake, and 12 vs. Eastern Washington.
- Omaha has used eight starting lineups this season. Felix Lemetti is the lone player to start every game this year. The lineup of Lemetti, Smith, Fidler, Dylan Brougham, and Akol Arop led Omaha to their second win of the season vs. Western Illinois. It marked Arop's first career start for the Mavericks.
- Omaha ranks fourth in the league with 2.8 blocks per game. Dylan Brougham leads the Mavericks with 0.7 blocks per game, which is tied eighth in the league. He notched a career-high four blocks at Montana.
- Luedtke opened the season with three straight games in double-figure that continued his streak from last season. He recorded double-figures in the final two games of 2020-21 and opened 2021-22 with three more. He scored 10 points in back-to-back games vs. Hastings and at Ball State. He then poured in a then career-high 16 points at Kansas State. added five boards, two assists, and two steals.

- The Mavericks opened the season on Nov. 9 with a 67-57 win over the visiting Hasting Broncos.
- Frankie Fidler led the Mavericks with 15 points in his career-debut. Kyle Luedtke and Marco Smith added 10 points off the bench.
- Omaha was tabbed eighth in the Summit League Preseason Poll. The Mavericks finished last season 5-20 overall with a 3-11 league finish. They earned the eighth seed in the Summit League Tournament last spring and fell to No. 1 South Dakota State in the opening round of action.
- The Mavericks return eight letterwinners and two starters from last season's squad. Returning from the starting lineup is sophomore guard La'Mel Robinson and senior forward Wanjang Tut.
- Tut started all 20 games that he appeared in last season. He averaged 8.8 ppg, 4.4 rpg, 0.6 spg, and 0.6 bpg. Tut recorded six double-figure scoring performances including two 20+ point games. He put on a season-best all around performance at Wyoming last year with 27 points on 10-of-17 shooting with nine rebounds, four blocks, and an assist. His four blocks matched his career-high.
- Robinson suffered an injury prior to the season tipping off, and he will be out for the remainder of 2021-22 action.
- Head coach Derrin Hansen enters his 17th season at the helm. He has a 250-246 career record leading the Mavericks.
- The 2021-22 season is the 109th overall in program history and the 11th of the Mavericks' Division I era. All-time, the program is 1,204-1,333.

Scouting the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles

The Golden Eagles are 8-6 overall and 2-1 in league play heading into Saturday's meeting. They split the opening weekend with an 82-73 win vs. South Dakota and an 82-76 loss to South Dakota State. ORU rebounded earlier this week with a 17-point win vs. Denver.

Oral Roberts is third in the league averaging 80.9 points per game. The Golden Eagles and Summit League are led by Max Abmas who pours in 21.3 points per game. He's notched double-figures in all but one game this season, including a season-high 38 points vs. Tulsa. Abmas recorded another 30-point performance vs. South Dakota with 32 points with five three-pointers.

Oral Roberts is coached by Paul Mills. He has led the Golden Eagles for the last five seasons and compiled an overall record of 65-73 at the helm.

All-Time Against Oral Roberts

Oral Roberts leads the all-time series 13-4. Devin Evans scored eight points in the first game, while Sam'i Roe added 10 points in the second. He was one of five Mavericks that scored at least 10 points.

Last Time Out

Omaha snapped an 11-game losing streak with an 84-78 win over Western Illinois. It also ended a six-game win streak for the Leathernecks. Four players scored double-figures led by Felix Lemetti who finished with 22 on the night.

Lemetti kicked off the first half with three free throws for the first points of the game which sparked a 10-0 Omaha run. Colton Sandage completed a three-point play to get the Leathernecks on the board, and Western Illinois began to chip away at the lead to get within two on a Tamell Pearson jumper with 14 left to play.

With under ten minutes in the first, WIU put the pressure on taking its only lead of the game on a jumper from Massner. Hughes swung the lead back in Omaha's favor with a layup at the 8:46 mark. The Leathernecks tied it 23-23 but seven straight Maverick points recaptured the lead for the remainder of the game. Omaha led 40-34 at the halftime break.

Lemetti came out of the break scoring four quick points helping Omaha to a 10-point lead. A free throw from Fidler at 16:53 and jumper from Smith at the 15:22 mark gave Omaha their largest lead of the game at 13 points.

The Leathernecks used a 10-2 run cutting the lead to four with 13:02 left to play. Fidler stepped up and hit a three on Omaha's next possession. The Omaha lead stayed in the single digits as the Leathernecks got within four again just three minutes later on a Barisic layup. The teams traded baskets for the remainder of the half with the Mavericks taking an 85-78 win on a Lemetti free throw for the final point of the game.

Hughes Hot Hand

Darius Hughes is on a strung together a four-game double figure scoring streak and has filled an offensive void the Mavericks have been looking for all season. Hughes sparked the streak with 12 points on 4-of-7 shooting vs. Eastern Washington. He then matched his previous career-high with 15 points vs. Drake on 7-of-10 from the field. Hughes surpassed both those totals with a career and game-high 19 points vs. A&M - Corpus Christi. He was 6-of-9 from the field and 7-of-11 from the foul line. Most recently, Hughes scored 10 points at UNLV. He was 5-of-7 from the field. He fell short of his fifth straight game vs. St. Thomas with nine points.

Hughes is shooting 51.4 percent through the first half of the season. It ranks sixth in the Summit League individual players.

Doubling Down

Omaha has had at least three Mavericks score double-figures in the last six games. Four was the magic number in Omaha's win vs. Western Illinois last week. Felix Lemetti led the squad with 22 points. It marked his fifth straight game with at least 10. Frankie Fidler hit a career-high with 19 points. Darius Hughes and Nick Ferrarini added 12 and 10 points, respectively.

The Mavericks nearly overcame a 29-point deficit vs. St. Thomas earlier this week behind career-highs from Marco Smith and Fidler. Smith scored 19 with Fidler right behind at 18. Lemetti added another 16 points in the loss.

At UNLV, Lemetti scored 20 to lead Omaha, while Ferrarini scored 12 points. Hughes wrapped up the double-figure scoring efforts with 10 points for his fourth straight game.

Against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Hughes put up a career-high 19 points on 6-of-9 from the field. Lemetti added 11 points, while Akol Arop scored a career-high 10 points.

Four players put up 10 or more points vs. Drake on Dec. 8. Hughes led the way with 15 points, while Lemetti added 14. Off the bench, Ferrarini scored 12 points, while Isaiah Poor Bear-Chandler netted a career-high 10 points.

Another four scored double-figures vs. Eastern Washington. Ferrarini scored a career-high 23 points off the bench. He was 8-of-14 from the field with three three-pointers. Hughes and Frankie Fidler scored 12 apiece, and Marco Smith scored a personal best 11 points.

Blocks on the Leaderboards

Omaha is fourth in the Summit League with 2.8 blocks per game, while Dylan Brougham ranks individually at eighth with 0.8 bpg.

The Mavericks tallied a season-high five blocks at Montana. They've posted two other games with four this season. Brougham notched a career-high four blocks at Kansas State. He tallied another two vs. SIUE and has two more games with one block each. Brougham's four blocks at Kansas State is also a Summit League single-game high.

Long Range Lemetti

Felix Lemetti poured in a career-high 23 points at UNLV earlier this month. All of his field goals came from beyond the arc as he finished 7-of-10 from three-point range. Lemetti's previous high was 14 points set earlier this season vs. Drake. He's currently on a five-game double-figure scoring streak.

Lemetti is averaging 2.5 made three-pointers per game this season. He ranks seventh in the league with those makes.

He's shooting 40.2 percent from the arc, which ranks fifth among league players. Lemetti has connected on at least one shot from long range in every game this season. He is currently on a seven-game streak of making at least two per game, which includes six at UNLV and four vs. Drake and St. Thomas.

Making the Start

Omaha has tried seven starting lineups over the first 12 games as the Mavericks battle injuries and minute restrictions. Felix Lemetti is the only Maverick to make every start this year.

The Mavericks tipped the season off with Frankie Fidler and Isaiah Poor Bear-Chandler in the starting rotation, but injuries have kept them both out of the starting five in recent games.

Ferrarini Career Night

Senior Guard Nick Ferrarini tallied a career-high 23 points vs. Eastern Washington last weekend. It surpassed his previous high of 15 points. He was 8-of-14 from the field with three three-pointers. He also finished 4-of-6 from the foul line. His career night led him to take over as the team's top scorer. He's averaging 9.6 ppg while shooting 35 percent from the field and 31 percent from long range. Ferrarini is the only Maverick to score 20+ this season and only one of three active Mavericks to do it in their career.

Long Range Success

Omaha has three games this season on the Summit League game-high chart for three-point field goal percentage. The Mavericks shot 47 percent from long range hitting seven total threes. Omaha most recently shot 45 percent vs. SIUE knocking down 10. The Mavericks tallied a season-high 10 made three-pointers at K-State for 41 percent from the arc, which also lands on the league charts.

Bench Production

The Mavericks have relied heavily on the bench this season for their offensive production. They've outscored the opponent's bench seven times this season. The largest margin was vs. Eastern Washington when the Omaha bench went for 44 points (+27). Omaha's bench also outscored SIUE's by 20 points. They went for 38 of the team's total.

Texas Tech, Purdue, and Texas A&M - Corpus Christi are the only teams whose bench has outscored the Mavericks.

Key Returners

- The Mavericks return eight letterwinners and two starters from last season's squad. Returning from the lineup is sophomore guard La'Mel Robinson and senior forward Wanjang Tut.
- Robinson averaged 9.3 ppg, 2.3 rpg, 1.2 apg, and 1.0 spg over 24 games last season. He made 11 starts and scored double-figures in 11 games last year. He posted a career-high 23 points at South Dakota on Jan. 30 finishing 9-of-14 from the floor with three 3-pointers.
- Robinson suffered a torn ACL prior to the season tipping off. He had surgery in November and will miss the remainder of 2021-22 action.
- Tut started all 20 games that he appeared in last season. He averaged 8.8 ppg, 4.4 rpg, 0.6

spg, and 0.6 bpg. Tut recorded six double-figure scoring performances including two 20+ point games. He put on a season-best all around performance at Wyoming last year with 27 points on 10-of-17 shooting with nine rebounds, four blocks, and an assist. His four blocks matched his career-high.

- Junior guard Nick Ferrarini also returns to the court for the Mavericks. He made four starts over 13 appearances. Ferrarini averaged 5.9 ppg, 2.2 rpg, and 1.4 apg. He shot 34.7 percent from the field and 33.3 percent from three-point range.
- Marco Smith, Sam'i Roe, Kyle Luedtke, Devin Evans, Darrius Hughes, Dylan Brougham, and Grant Frickenstein all lace up for another season with Omaha.

Fresh Faces

- In the off-season, Omaha added four new faces to the 2021-22 roster. Isaiah Poor Bear-Chandler, Felix Lemetti, and Akol Arop transferred into the program, while Frankie Fidler joins as the lone true freshman on the roster.
- Poor Bear-Chandler began his collegiate career with three seasons at Wichita State. He was the first man off the bench in 15 of the 18 games he saw action in as a junior. He averaged 12.0 minutes per game and contributed 3.0 ppg and 2.3 rpg.
- Lemetti played his freshman season at Fairfield and averaged 5.3 ppg, 1.1 rpg, and 1.0 apg in 2019-20. He then transferred to Salt Lake Community College and earned All-Region 18 honorable mention honors while averaging 9.9 ppg and 3.0 apg. He helped his team to a 20-5 finish on the year and qualified for the national tournament.
- Arop returned to his hometown after playing his first two seasons at Nebraska. As a true freshman, Arop saw 21 games off the bench. He used a redshirt season in 2020-21 after undergoing surgery.
- Fidler was a three-year letter winner at Bellevue West. He led the team his senior season with 21.2 ppg and 6.3 rpg. He shot 53 percent from the field and 40 percent from long range. He posted three 30-point performances in his senior campaign. He was named First Team All-Nebraska by the World Herald and was a First Team Super State pick by the Lincoln Journal Star.
- In his junior season, Fidler helped the Thunderbirds to a 2020 Class A state championship and a 24-3 overall record. He averaged 12.3 ppg, 6.2 rpg, and 2.0 apg.

2021-22 Summit League Preseason Poll

Omaha men's basketball was tabbed eighth in the 2021-22 Summit League Preseason Poll, the league announced in mid-October. The preseason poll and awards were tallied in a vote of the league's head coaches, sports information staff, and media.

South Dakota State is the preseason favorite collecting 23 of the 36 first-place votes. North Dakota State sits second with seven votes, while Oral Roberts was picked third with six first-place votes.

South Dakota, Western Illinois, Kansas City, and North Dakota sit fourth, fifth, sixth, and seventh, respectively. Denver and St. Thomas sit below Omaha at ninth and tenth. The Mavericks did not have any representation on the Summit League Preseason Team.

Derrin Hansen is in his 17th season at the helm of the Omaha men's basketball program. The 21st head coach in UNO history, he ranks second all-time in school history for career victories and has led the program to two Division I postseason appearances with the 2016 CBI and the 2014 CIT. Hansen was named the 2019 Summit League Coach of the Year and NABC District 12 Coach of the Year.

Omaha has had five seasons with full Division I postseason eligibility, delivering three top-third finishes in the Summit League regular-season standings. In 2018-19, the Mavericks were 21-11 (13-3 Summit League) and finished as runner-up in both the regular-season and at the Summit League Championship. Zach Jackson and Mitch Hahn both earned first-team All-Summit honors.

Before Omaha's move to NCAA Division I in 2011-12, Hansen guided the Mavericks to two Division II Tournament appearances and conference championships in the MIAA (2010) and the NCC (2008). He has coached five players to all-region plaudits, and one All-America honorable mention. Fourteen of his players have won a combined 23 all-conference awards, with 14 All-Summit, eight All-MIAA and four All-NCC.
