## THE COACHES

Nebraska Wesleyan's **Brian Keller** is currently in his 27th season at the helm of his alma mater (NWU '83). The winningest coach in NWU football history, Keller has compiled an **125-134 (.482)** record leading the NWU football program.

Keller still holds the distinction of the longest tenured head coach among all American Rivers Conference programs.

**Matt Jeter** is in his 7th season as the head coach of the Storm. Jeter is currently **21-37 (.362)** during his tenure. He was also named American Rivers Conference Coach of the Year in 2018. His team had the best scoring defence in the conference in 2018.

## THE NWU-SIMPSON SERIES

This will be the 19th meeting between these two football programs. Nebraska Wesleyan leads the series 10-6-2.

## NWU LOOKS TO BOUNCE BACK OFFENSIVELY

The P-Wolves are looking to bounce back after a heartbreaking overtime loss to Mayville State and tough games against Dubuque, Loras, and Central. The P-Wolves have had a positive start offensively to the season scoring a total of 144 points in the first four games of the season, but were held to just 25 total points against Central, Wartburg, and Buena Vista. NWU is looking to get back to their scoring ways against Simpson.

## NWU AGAINST CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

Since joining the American Rivers Conference in 2016, Nebraska Wesleyan has played a total of 46 A-R-C football games, posting an overall record of 10-36 (.217).

## PRAIRIE WOLVES AWAY RECORD

During head coach Brian Keller's tenure, the Prairie Wolves have posted a 65-71 home record. In 2021, NWU finished 2-3 in away games.

## FOUR PLAYERS NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

NWU players selected four players during fall camp to represent them as team captains for the 2022 season. This year's captains include **Spencer Brooks, Jacob Gramann, Tad Naiberk, and Carter Terry.**

## RECEIVER ROOM HAS BIG SHOES TO FILL

Nebraska Wesleyan's wide receiver unit has a lot of potential, but not a ton of big catch experience. NWU's top three receivers in 2021 were lost to graduation and the transfer portal, which means the young receiver corps has to step up in a big way in 2022. Less than 30

percent of the receptions caught in 2021 were from returners.

To make up those extra receptions and yards, NWU will likely turn to guys like Trace Leners, Matt Zarybnicky, and Issac Dannehl, who each had at least 15 receptions in 2021.

## KYES & BRINKER AMONG THE CONFERENCE BEST DUOS

Nebraska Wesleyan returned two of its top defensive linebackers last season. Senior Caleb Kyes and Junior Max Brinker both look to bounce back from injuries that kept them out of games last season.

Through seven games, Kyes leads the Prairie Wolves with 60 tackles on the season, including a season-high 11 tackles on the road earlier this season against Loras College.

Brinker is third on the Prairie Wolves defense recording 43 tackles. He notched six tackles last Saturday on the road against Wartburg.

## TERRY AMONG THE NATION'S LEADERS

Carter Terry, has made a name for himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the nation. In seven games this season, Terry has passed for 1862 yards (266 yards per game).

The Grand Island, Nebraska, native is now eighth all-time in completions (344), passing yards (4,518), and touchdowns (43) at Nebraska Wesleyan.

Additionally, his throwing yards per game (266.0) and completions per game (19.8) rank him in the top 50 among all NCAA Division III quarterbacks.

## SIEMS AND MYERS AMONG TOP RECEIVERS IN A-R-C

Through the first seven games of the season, Siems and Myers have combined for 755 yards on just 35 receptions between the two of them.

Siems ranks thirteenth in the conference for receiving yards, followed by teammate Myers who sits in fourteenth.

## PRAIRIE WOLVES HIT 300-100-100 COMBO VS. DUBUQUE

Against the University of Dubuque, the offensive performance of Nebraska Wesleyan achieved a remarkable milestone. In the same game, the Prairie Wolves had a 300-yard passer, a 100-yard rusher, and a 100-yard receiver.

While Trace Leners and Trystin Meyers both had 100 yards receiving, quarterback Carter Terry and running back Meyers were responsible for the passing and rushing performances.
