• First year head coach Steve Alford's debut is Tuesday night when Utah comes to Lawlor Events Center for a 7:30 p.m. tip • Nevada will be seeking its school record 19th consecutive home win at Lawlor Events Center • Alford begins his 29th season as a college head coach and is 13 wins from 600 in his career • Alford holds a 9-8 advantage in 17 games versus Utah • The Wolf Pack welcome back three senior guards who have played in the Silver & Blue; Jazz Johnson, Lindsey Drew and Nisré Zouzoua.

NEVADA SEEKS RECORD 19TH CONSECUTIVE HOME WIN

Nevada has won its last 18 games at Lawlor Events Center which ties the school record and is the fifth longest active streak in NCAA. The Pack went 15-0 at home last season plus the final three of 2017-18 has the Pack's home win streak at 18 games. The first 18-game streak was from 2003-04 to the 2004-05 season. The 2003-04 team also posted a perfect 15-0 home record. The last loss was on Feb. 7, 2018 to UNLV.

In the last three seasons the Pack has gone 15-0 (2018-19), 14-1 (2017-18) and 13-1 (2016-17) for an overall record of 42-2

NOTES

- ▶ Nevada returns just two players in Jazz Johnson and Nizré Zouzoua, from its 2018-19 NCAA Tournament and Mountain West regular season championship team.
- ▶ First-year head coach Steve Alford is 13 wins from 600 in his college coach career. Alford is 587-298 in 28 years.
- ▶ Senior guard Lindsey Drew returns from an achilles injury that cost him all last season and he also had surgery on both hips. He has played in 99 game at Nevada and started 93.
- ▶ Nevada has won its last 18 homes games which is tied for the longest home streak in school history and is the fifth longest active streak in NCAA I.
- ▶ Redshirt freshman K.J. Hymes was selected by the Mountain West media as the preseason Freshman of the Year.
- ▶ Nevada has won the last three Mountain West regular season titles. The 2017 and 2018 titles were outright while the 2019 title was shared with Utah State. Nevada and BYU are the only MW schools to win back-to-back outright titles. The Pack, SDSU and BYU are the only schools to win three in a row with one being shared.
- ▶ The Pack was picked fourth in the preseason media poll.
- ▶ Associate head coach Craig Neal was on coach Alford's staff at Iowa and New Mexico. Neal and Alford have been friends since third grade.
- ▶ Five members of the staff have ties to the state of Indiana. Alford, Kory Barnett, and Bil Duany played at Indiana. Neal is from Indiana and Kory Alford is the oldest son of coach Alford.
- ▶ Nevada has two 1,000 point scorers on the squad in Johnson (1,102) and Zouzoua (1,052)
- ▶ Nevada has won 20 or more games in 12 of the last 16 seasons.
- ▶ In the last four seasons the Pack has won 110 games including tying the school record with 29 wins each of the last two years. The 29 wins has been accomplished three times at Nevada.
- ▶ Nevada was ranked in the top 25 all last season reaching as high as number 5.
- ▶ The Pack will host two Pac-12 opponents in Utah on Nov. 5 and USC on Nov. 16.
- ▶ Nevada won both its exhibition games 81-52 over Cal Sate East Bay and 86-55 over Colorado Christian.
- ▶ Four Pack players averaged double figures in the two exhibition games led by junior Jalen Harris' 23.5 points per game. Harris redshirted last season after transferring from Louisiana Tech. He scored 21 vs. CSEB and 26 in the win over CCU.
- ▶ Nizré Zouzoua averaged 14 points, Jazz Johnson 12 and Boston College graduate transfer John Carlos Reyes 10.5
- ▶ Freshman Zane Meeks posted a double-double in the win over CSEB with 10 points and 14 rebounds.

PACK SETS SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORD

With nine sold-out crowds last season the Nevada men's basketball team set a school records for average attendance (10,878) and total attendance (163,169).

The UNLV crowd was the largest last season and the eighth crowd over 11,000 fans a year ago.

The top three season, in terms of per-game attendance, have come the past three seasons. The Wolf Pack broke the per-game attendance record two years ago in 2016-17 when an average of 8,923 fans came to 14 home dates that season. That eclipsed the mark of 8,903 set in 2006-07 during the senior season of Nick Fazekas, whose No. 22 was officially retired last season.

Nevada broke the per-game record again in 2017-18, averaging more than 9,000 fans per game for the first time in school history. Nevada shattered the mark in 2018-19 as it is averaged 10,878 fans.



2019-20 SEASON OUTLOOK

REVIEW

Nevada reached the NCAA Tournament for the third consecutive time in 2019 and won its third consecutive Mountain West regular season title. The Wolf Pack joined SDSU (2014, 2015 (shared), 2016) and BYU (2007, 2008, 2009 (shared)) as the only schools to win three in a row. The Pack and BYU are the only MW schools to have won back-to-back outright titles. The Pack's 2019 title was shared with Utah State.

Seniors Jordan Caroline and Caleb Martin were named to the All-Mountain West first-team while Cody Martin was a third-team selection. Caleb Martin earned preseason and postseason All-America honors.

The Pack posted a 29-5 record equaling the 2006-07 and 2017-18 teams for the most wins in school history. Nevada ended the year on an 18-game home win streak that equals the longest in school history.

With nine sold-out crowds last season the Nevada men's basketball team set a school record for average attendance (10,878) and total attendance (163,169).

PREVIEW

The 2019-20 season will mark the first for head coach Steve Alford as he was named the 19th coach in the history of the program on April 11, 2019. Alford, a highly successful coach with 11 NCAA Tournament berths and four Sweet 16 appearances, signed a 10-year deal to lead Nevada. Having posted a 587-298 record, he is just 13 wins from 600 in his college coaching career that is in its 29th season.

Alford is no stranger to the Mountain West having coached New Mexico to four MW regular season titles and two MW tournament championships with six postseason appearances in his six seasons in Albuquerque. With Alford now coaching the Wolf Pack, seven of the last 11 Mountain West championships have been won by Nevada, or Nevada's current coach.

Nevada does not return a starter from last season and welcomes back just three players who have worn the Silver & Blue. Despite the lack of experience the MW media picked the Wolf Pack to finish fourth.

BACKCOURT

The backcourt returns the bulk of the experience in seniors Lindsey Drew, Jazz Johnson and Nizré Zouzoua. Junior Jalen Harris, along with freshmen Kane Milling and Gabe Bansuelo round out the backcourt for this season. Transfers Desmond Cambridge (Brown) and Khristion Courseault (Pasadena City College) will redshirt this season.

Drew missed last season after recovering from a torn achilles that occurred his junior year at Boise State. A 2017-18 All-MW defensive team selection he has started 99 games during his Pack career. His career average is 6.4 points and 3.9 assists per game.

The 2019 MW Sixth Man of the Year, Johnson averaged 11 points per game last season for the 29-5 Wolf Pack. He scored in double figures in 20-of-33 games and netted a career-high 27 at Air Force. In the AFA game he connected on 7-of-10 shots from behind the arc. In 20-of-33 games he made a 3-pointer and three or more in 12 contests. He has scored 1,102 career points in 98 college games which includes 740 points in two seasons at Portland.

Zouzoua appeared in 21 games off the bench his junior year for the Pack and scored in nine of those contests. In the opening win over BYU he scored a season-high five points off the bench. A 1,000 point scorer he netted 1,025 in two seasons at Bryant and currently has 1,052 in 83 games. His career average is 12.7 points per game.

Last season Harris redshirted at Nevada after transferring from Louisiana Tech where he was a Conference USA all-freshman team selection in 2017. A very athletic player he averaged 12.2 points in 38 games at LTU. From the field he connected on 35.4 percent of his shots from behind the arc.

From Nantes, France Milling is a combination guard who has the range to hit shots from behind the arc. He was one of the first recruits for coach Alford. As a senior at CSP Limoges he averaged 14.4 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.2 steals in 32 games. He connected on 32.9 percent of his 3-pointers and was good on 38 percent of his shots from the floor.

Bansuelo is a walk-on that played locally at Bishop Manogue High School in Reno. Twice he was an All-Sierra League selection, earned all-region honors and was third-team all-state selection during his prep career for the Miners. BMHS won two Sierra League titles and the 2019 4A Regional Championship. As a senior he averaged 16 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.9 steals.

FRONT COURT

Nevada welcomes back redshirt freshman K.J. Hymes and the remainder of the frontcourt is comprised of newcomers. Transfers John Carlos Reyes, Robby Robinson, Zachary Williams and freshman Zane Meeks will join Hymes in the frontcourt. Oregon State transfer Warren Washington will sit out this season and redshirt under NCAA transfer rules.

Hymes worked hard in the offseason and was named the 2019-20 MW preseason freshman of the year. His senior year at Hillcrest Prep in Phoenix he posted a double-double averaging 12.1 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. Another skilled big man he can step back and hit the 3-pointer.

Reyes is a graduate transfer from Boston College where he played in 91 games and started eight. The 6-10 big man will be



asked to rebound, defend and block shots in his final year of college basketball.

A transfer from San Diego City College Robinson averaged a double-double in his freshman season scoring 15.3 points and grabbing 10 rebounds per game. The 6-8 forward was a first-team All-Pacific Coast Conference selection and posted 15 double-doubles on the year.

The 6-10 Meeks comes to the Pack after playing last season at Brewster Academy in Wolfeboro, N.H. where he helped the squad to the 2019 National Prep Championship. He averaged 9.8 points for a squad that posted a 34-7 record. An outstanding outside shooter he made 84 3-pointers and shot 44.6 percent from behind the arc. At Brewster Academy he earned first-team All-Lakes Region and was an honorable mention New England Preparatory School Athletic Council selection.

Williams, a walk-on, played his prep basketball at Reno's Galena High School. Last season he averaged 9.9 points in 24 minutes per game at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix, Ariz. In 16 games he reached double figures and had three games of 20 or more points with a season-high of 21. As a freshman he played at Feather River Community College and appeared in 29 games.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

Nevada will once again play a very difficult non-conference schedule in 2019-20. The Pack starts the season with four home games which includes hosting a pair of Pac-12 opponents, Utah on Nov. 5 to start the season and USC on Nov. 16. In between those Pac-12 games Nevada takes on Loyola Marymount and Texas-Arlington.

A four-game road trip starts with a game at Davidson on Nov. 19. The next three games are at the Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands. The Pack begins play with Fordham on Nov. 22 then faces either Grand Canyon or Valparaiso on Nov. 23 or 24. The final game is Nov. 25 versus a team from the other half of the bracket that includes Cincinnati, Illinois State, Bowling Green or Western Kentucky.

Back at Lawlor Events Center on Dec. 4 the Pack squares off against Santa Clara. A road trip to Air Force to begin MW play is set for Dec. 7 followed by a game at BYU on Dec. 10. The final home non-conference game of the season is Dec. 18 against Texas Southern. Nevada closes out non-conference play with a neutral site game versus Saint Mary's at the Al Attles Classic in the new home of the Golden State Warriors, the Chase Center in San Francisco on Dec. 21.

THE MOUNTAIN WEST SCHEDULE

The 2019-20 season will be the eighth for the University of Nevada in the Mountain West. Last season the Wolf Pack became just the third school to win three consecutive MW titles and will look to make it four in a row this season.

The schedule features home-and-home series for eight of the conference matchups, while the Pack will only play Fresno State in Reno and at Utah State in Logan, Utah once. The Pack and Aggies shared the MW regular season title last year. USU was picked by the media to win the regular season title this year and Nevada is picked fourth.

The MW schedule will start a week earlier this season with the Pack playing at Air Force on Dec. 7. In January Nevada hosts Colorado State, Boise State, Wyoming, intrastate rival UNLV and New Mexico. The Rebels are at LEC on Jan. 14. The first month of the 2020 has Nevada on the road at San José State, Utah State, San Diego State, and Colorado State.

In February Air Force, San José State, Fresno State and San Diego State visit the Biggest Little City. The Pack will travel to Boise State, UNLV, New Mexico, and Wyoming. The road contest with the Rebels is slated for Feb. 12 in Las Vegas.

The MW Championship is Mar. 4-7 in Las Vegas at the Thomas & Mack Center on the UNLV campus. All 11 Mountain West teams will participate in the tournament.

On April 11, 2019 University of Nevada director of athletics Doug Knuth announced the hiring of Steve Alford as the head coach of the nationally ranked Wolf Pack men's basketball program.

Alford, a highly successful coach with 11 NCAA Tournament berths and four Sweet 16 appearances, signed a 10-year deal to lead Nevada.

"There is no better coach than Steve Alford to continue the rise of Nevada basketball and we are excited for the next chapter," Knuth said. "To get a leader of Coach Alford's caliber is a testament to the support of our community and our University. There is a great tradition of Wolf Pack basketball and the future is even brighter."

Alford becomes the 19th coach in the history of the Nevada program. Alford has a career record of 587-298 (.663) in 28 seasons as a collegiate head coach and is 509-269 in 24 seasons as a Division I head coach. With Division I stops at Missouri State, Iowa, New Mexico and UCLA, his teams have averaged 21 wins per year with only two losing seasons.

"To be able to continue my career in a tight-knit community that has demonstrated its support for the basketball program is exactly the opportunity that Tanya and I were looking for, and we are thrilled to be in Northern Nevada," Alford said. "I can't wait to get to work as we look to build off the established tradition and momentum of this great program. I want this to be the last stop of my coaching career."

Alford is no stranger to the Mountain West having coached New Mexico to four MW regular season titles and two MW tournament championships with six postseason appearances in his six seasons in Albuquerque. With Alford now coaching the Wolf Pack, seven of the last 11 Mountain West championships have been won by Nevada, or Nevada's current coach.

Alford joins the Wolf Pack after five plus seasons at UCLA where he led the Bruins to four NCAA Tournament appearances advancing to the Sweet 16 three times in a four-year span in 2014, 2015 and 2017. The Bruins won the 2014 Pac-12 Tournament. During his tenure at UCLA he posted a record of 124-63.

He inherits a Nevada team that finished 23rd in the final USA Today Coaches poll after posting a 29-5 record. The 29 wins tied the school record that has been accomplished three times, twice in each of the last two seasons. The Pack has won the last three Mountain West regular season titles.

Nevada will be Alford's fifth Division I head coaching job after making stops at Missouri State (1995-1999), Iowa (1999-2007), New Mexico (2007-2013) and UCLA (2013-2018). He began his collegiate coaching career at Division III Manchester College (1991-1995) and led the team to a runner-up finish in 1995 as the squad ended the year 31-1. The only loss came in the NCAA Division III title game.

In each of his previous coaching jobs he led his team's to NCAA Tournament victories. In 14 seasons his squads advanced to the NCAA Tournament, 11 at the Division I level and three at Division III. In addition to leading UCLA to three Sweet 16 appearances he guided Missouri State to its first Sweet 16 in 1999. Seven times he led squads to the National Invitation Tournament.

A proven winner Alford's teams have won eight conference tournaments, the Big 10 twice (2001, 2006), the Mountain West twice (2012, 2013), Pac-12 (2014) and the Indiana Collegiate Conference (1993, 1994, 1995) three times during his time at Manchester.

No stranger to the MW, Alford led New Mexico to four regular season and two tournament titles in six seasons as the Lobos head coach. In 2009, 2010 and 2013 he was named the MW Coach of the Year. He posted a record of 155-52 at UNM and was 68-26 in conference play. Three of his UNM players; JR Giddens (2008), Darrington Hobson (2010) and Kendal Williams (2013) were named MW Player of the Year. The Lobos 30 wins in 2012 and 29 in 2013 are the two highest win totals in program history. The 2012 and 2013 team secured No. 3 seeds in the NCAA Tournament which tied UNM's record for highest seeded team.

In 15 seasons he had led his teams to 20 or more wins and three times 30 or more victories. His 2016-17 UCLA squad posted a 31-5 record with the 28 regular season victories tying the Bruins record for wins.



During his time at UCLA he coached 11 NBA draft selections, seven were chosen in the first round. In 2015 (Kevon Looney), 2014 (Zach Lavine, Jordan Adams, Kyle Anderson), 2017 (Lonzo Ball, TJ Leaf) and 2018 (Aaron Holiday) were all first round selections. While at UNM, JR Giddens and Tony Snell were first round NBA selections.

At Manchester College he earned conference coach of the year honors three times. The 1994-95 team was inducted into the school's hall of fame and in 1999 Alford was inducted into the Manchester Hall of Fame.

As a college senior Alford led Indiana to the 1987 NCAA Championship. The 1983 Indiana Mr. Basketball was a two-time consensus NCAA first-team All-America selection in 1986 and 1987. A three-time first-team Big 10 selection, he was the conference MVP his senior year. He ended his college career as the leading scorer at Indiana and currently ranks second. He played for Hall of Fame coach Bob Knight at Indiana. In 1984 Alford earned an Olympic gold medal playing for the United States in Los Angeles for a team coached by Knight. It was the last United States' amateur team to win Olympic Gold.

In 1997 he was inducted into the Indiana University Hall of Fame and in 2001 was one of 15 players named to Indiana's All-Century team.

Following his career at Indiana he was selected 26th overall in 1987 NBA Draft by the Dallas Mavericks. He played four years from 1987-1991 in the NBA for Dallas and Golden State.

He is married to the former Tanya Frost. The couple has two sons Kory and Bryce and a daughter Kayla.
