NEVADA OPENS SEASON AT TEXAS STATE TOURNAMENT

Coming off its second Mountain West regular season championship in four years, Nevada will begin its season this Friday, Feb. 15 against No. 24 Missouri State at the Texas State Tournament ... Played in San Marcos, Texas, the Pack will also face the hosting Bobcats on Saturday and finish the weekend against the Utah Utes Sunday morning ... Nevada will wrap up its first slate of games on Tuesday afternoon, with a contest at UC Davis at 2:30 p.m. ... Alex Margulies will have the radio call for the Wolf Pack for the games played Friday through Sunday, and can be heard on 94.1 FM/1450 AM on Friday and Sunday, with Saturday's broadcast being internet only ... Doug

Greenwald, the voice of the Nevada women's basketball team will have the call over the radio for Tuesday's contest against the Aggies ... Live stats for all four games will be available at nevadawolfpack.com/baseball ... A stream for every game played in the Texas State Tournament will be available on the Texas State Bobcat's website ... Nevada returns three All-Conference players from last season in Joshua Zamora, Jake Jackson and Kaleb Foster, all of which also were named to the MW All-Conference Preseason team ... Zamora enters his second season after being named the MW Freshman of the Year when he hit a conference-best .427 in MW play and totaled a team-high nine home runs on the season ... Jackson, after being named second-team All-MW after leading the conference with six MW victories, will return for the Pack this season ... On Friday against No. 24 ranked Missouri State, junior Ryan Anderson will earn the start for the Wolf Pack ... He finished with a 3-1 record last season and three saves after being used in a multitude of roles by the Wolf Pack ... Some notable freshmen joined Nevada this season, including Julian Boyd and Owen Sharts who were both selected in the 2018 MLB draft ... Boyd was taken by the Chicago Cubs in the 26th round and Sharts was selected by the Texas Rangers in the 32nd round ... Following his third consecutive season reaching the conference tournament, head coach T.J. Bruce was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year after posting a league-best 20-9 record in conference play.

HEAD COACH T.J. BRUCE



University of Nevada head baseball coach T.J. Bruce enters his fourth season leading the Wolf Pack baseball program in 2018-19. Bruce was hired by Nevada on June 26, 2015 and arrived on the Nevada campus as one of the top assistant coaches in the nation after spending five seasons at UCLA where he helped the Bruins to four postseason appearances and a 2013 College World Series

All-American honors by the American Baseball Coaches Association. Fennell was later signed by the Chicago Cubs. These were the first All-Americans for the Nevada baseball program since 2015.

In 2017 Nevada went 19-36 and finished fourth in the MW with a 13-16 record. The Pack won two-of-three games at New Mexico, the regular season champions, the final weekend to secure the last spot in the conference tournament. The team was involved in several close games going 6-10 in one-run contests. The difficult non-conference schedule included a three-game series at No. 6 Clemson where Nevada won the middle game 7-5 and dropped the other two games in hard fought battles.

"We found a person of great character in T.J., who fits our community and is a great person and family man," said athletics director Doug Knuth. "He has an outstanding baseball background and has an incredible recruiting reputation."

Bruce has established himself as one of the top recruiters in the nation as Collegiate Baseball ranked the Wolf Pack's 2016 class 35th in the country. It was the first nationally ranked recruiting class in school history. D1Baseball.com ranked Bruce as one of the top 10 head coaches in recruiting.

Since taking the head coaching position at Nevada, Bruce and the Wolf Pack have won more conference games than any other program in the Mountain West, boasting a 53-35 record.

2018 was Bruce's best season since taking over the program, posting a 29-24 record and guiding the Wolf Pack to its second Mountain West regular-season championship in the past four years. Nevada finished with a 20-9 record in conference play and 18-4 at home in Peccole Park's 30th season.

Following the regular season, Nevada swept the top honors in the conference, beginning with outfielder Grant Fennell being named the Tony Gwynn Mountain West Player of the Year. Third baseman Joshua Zamora was named the Freshman of the Year, and Bruce took home his first ever Coach of the Year honors.

In MW play, Bruce led Nevada to a conference-best .338 team batting average and ranked third in the league with a 5.71 team ERA. Six members of the Pack were award All-MW honors including Fennell, Zamora, Mark Nowaczewski and Kaleb Foster on the first team. Designated hitter Mike Echavia and freshman pitcher Jake Jackson were named to the second team.

Zamora and Jackson were each named freshmen All-Americans by Collegiate Baseball, while Fennell was award third-team

Four members of the 2017 team earned MW honors led by first-team junior pitcher Mark Nowaczewski. Nowaczewski led the team with six wins and was named the MW Pitcher of the Week three times. Senior shortstop Justin Bridgman, senior pitcher Trevor Charpie and junior utility player Grant Fennell were selected to the second team. Bridgman and junior infielder Jordan Pearce were both selected in the MLB Draft.

Bridgman was taken by Tampa in the 28th round while Pearce was chosen by Detroit in the 21st round. Charpie signed as free agent with Tampa. Junior outfielder Michael Echavia was selected to the American Baseball Coaches Association All-Region second team. Echavia was named to the MW All-Tournament team and was selected as the MW Player of the Week after batting .600 with eight RBI in the final series of the season at UNM.

The Pack was also well represented on the academic All-MW team with 11 selections. Three members of the squad were named MW Scholar Athletes.

In his first season in 2016 the Pack posted a 37-24 overall record with a 20-10 mark in MW play, taking a title fight into the last week of the season before finishing tied for second. Nevada's record in its final 24 games were a testament to Bruce's work with the team and vast improvement, as the Pack posted a 20-4 record in that span. Bruce and the Pack capped the 2016 season by advancing to the MW tournament finals for the first time in program history. Nevada won a program-record four tournament games, which included a 25-6 rout of top-seeded Fresno State.

Bruce and his wife, Heather have two daughters; Rhowan (9) and Harloe (7), and two sons, Jaxon (5) and Nash (3).

2019 NEVADA BASEBALL OUTLOOK

In the past three seasons with the Wolf Pack, Bruce has accumulated the most MW victories among other MW schools with 53. He finished with an 18-4 record last season at the newly renovated Don Weir Field at Peccole Park.

As the reigning Mountain West regular-season champions, Nevada will host the Mountain West tournament in Reno in 2019. This will be the first time the Pack has hosted the tournament since 2015.

The Pack will welcome 13 newcomers this season, including freshman pitcher Owen Sharts. As one of the most highly touted players coming out of high school, the Simi Valley, Calif. native was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the 32nd round but decided to play at Nevada. Four of the newcomers for Nevada will be transfers, with three of them being right-handed pitchers.

Of those newcomers, four transfers will be on the Wolf Pack roster in 2019. Three right-handed pitchers, all from California, will look to make an immediate impact for Nevada in Josh Congress, Ben Purcell and Shane Gustafson. The only position player to transfer to the Pack will be Wyatt Tilley, a middle infielder from the College of the Sequoias.

PITCHING

Nevada lost its Friday pitcher in Mark Nowaczewski, but returns two of its starters who are ready to step up for the Wolf Pack. Jake Jackson, after being named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball last season will look to continue his strong start to his collegiate CAREER at Nevada.

Dalton Gomez moved up from being a weekday starter to the Pack's Sunday pitcher in 2018, after posting a 5.07 ERA for Nevada and a 3-3 record. The Pack will look to lean on one of their young newcomers to fill one of the gaps for the starters, including Owen Sharts, who was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the 2018 MLB Draft.

The Pack will have a lot of veterans at its disposal out of the bullpen, including fifth-year senior Cooper Powell who totaled 29 innings for Nevada in 2018. Jordan Jackson had a breakout year in his first season, earning three wins in 20 appearances with 26.1 innings pitched.

Ryan Anderson accumulated three saves for the Pack last season and made two starts while striking out 41 batters. Bradley Bonnenfant came out late in the season for the Pack, but came one of the most reliable arms for Nevada as he finished with a 2.79 ERA in 10 appearances as a set-up man.

INFIELD

Nevada returns sophomore third baseman Joshua Zamora this season, who was named the MW Freshman of the Year last season after batting .355 on the year with 33 RBI, and a team-high nine home runs. Another standout on Nevada's roster is first baseman Dillan Shrum, who was named the No. 62 ranked draft-eligible hitter for 2019 by D1 Baseball. In 2018, Shrum batted .312 with two home runs and a team-high 19 doubles.

Zamora and Shrum were both recognized by D1 Baseball leading up to the season, as Zamora was listed as the No. 15 third baseman in the nation and Shrum was named the No. 29 first baseman.

On the middle infield, Nevada will have options with Keaton Smith, Jaylon McLaughlin, Tyler Bosetti and junior transfer Wyatt Tilley from College of the Sequoias. Smith played in 42 contests last season and smacked three home runs, while Bosetti hit .271 as a freshman with a .794 OPS. McLaughlin is entering his third season, and totaled eight RBI in 2018 with a .252 batting average.

OUTFIELD

Nevada lost two of its starting outfielders to eligibility, including reigning Tony Gwynn Mountain West Player of the Year Grant Fennell. Redshirt senior Weston Hatten is the only returning starter from last year's outfield core, but redshirt junior Daniel Perry is transitioning to outfielder for 2019. Perry played second base for the Pack in 2019, but flashed some big-play ability on defense as he patrolled right field in the MW Tournament in 2018.

The Wolf Pack will boast multiple players who are ready to step in and patrol the outfield, including redshirt sophomore Otis Statum Jr., who was forced to sit out last season following surgery on his shoulder. Three freshmen in Sawyer Jaksick, Julian Boyd and Nick Seamons are also ready to compete for time in their first season.

CATCHERS

A plethora of catchers will be at Bruce's disposal this season, led by 2018 first team All-MW selection Kaleb Foster, who slashed .310 last season with six home runs last season. He will go to work along with junior Marco Valenzuela, who hit .163 last year with nine RBI.

There will be tons of depth at catcher, with Josh Prizina available after redshirting his freshman season. Matt Clayton from Yuba City, Calif. will also look for innings behind the dish for the Pack in his freshman season.

FIRST IS THE WORST, SECOND IS THE BEST?

After winning the Mountain West regular season championship in 2018, Nevada is slated to finish second in the conference this season after receiving two first place votes. The Wolf Pack finished just three points behind San Diego State, who won the MW Tournament a year ago.

THREE CHEERS FOR PRESEASON HONORS

Nevada had three players honored as members of the Mountain West Preseason All-Conference team, as sophomores Jake Jackson and Joshua Zamora were recognized along with senior Kaleb Foster. All three earned All-Mountain West selections following the 2018 season, with Zamora taking home the MW Freshman of the Year award.

Zamora posted one of the best freshman seasons in Nevada history, batting .427 in MW play en route to being named the MW Freshman of the Year in 2018. He smacked a team-high nine home runs last season while finishing with a .355 batting average. He was named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball and D1 Baseball.

Jackson was also named a Freshman All-American last season by Collegiate Baseball, after leading the Mountain West with six wins in conference play and totaling a team-high 77 strikeouts in his first season. He made 15 starts on the year, recording eight wins and a save in 84.2 innings pitched on his way to being named second-team All-MW.

Foster had a breakout year for Nevada as a junior, being named first-team All-MW after batting .378 in conference action, with four of his six home runs coming against MW opponents. He set a career-high in appearances with 39 and totaled 20 RBI on 40 hits.

HOME IS WHERE THE CHAMPIONSHIP IS

Following its second MW regular season championship in four years, Nevada will host the MW championship at Don Weir Field at Peccole Park this season. Nevada last hosted the tournament in 2015, the first year that the Wolf Pack won the MW conference.

KING OF THE MOUNTAIN (WEST)

Entering his fourth season at the helm of the Nevada baseball team, head coach T.J. Bruce has reached the conference tournament all three seasons he has played in the conference. His 53 MW victories the past three seasons are the most by any coach in the conference over that span, and he enters 2019 as the reigning Mountain West Coach of the Year. Bruce was named a top-10 coach under the age of 40 by Baseball America this offseason.
