Entry Information:

All University of Nevada meets are by invitation only. Please fill out the [Nevada Intent to Compete Form](#) found [Here](#) by October 30, 2025. Meets may have limited field size.

Athletes Eligible to Compete:

- No High School athletes allowed to compete
- NCAA, NAIA, NJCAA, eligible collegiate student-athletes
- Unattached, redshirt, or post- collegiate (must request invitation to register through DirectAthletics



Facility:

- New 200-meter World Athletics certified Mondo surface with new World Athletics certified equipment by UCS and Gill Athletics.
- The oval has six 42" lanes while the sprint straight has eight 48" lanes.
- The PV (2 Pits), LJ/TJ (2 runways) are contested from a raised runway 12" off the track and 56" wide.
- The Pole Vault runways are 140" in length, while the Long Jump runways are 150" in length with an 8' take-off board.
- In the Triple Jump, the take-off boards are at 11 meters (36'1") and 13 meters (42'6").
- Dedicated Mondo warm-up area with eight 48" wide by 55m long lanes. Also includes 60m hurdle marks.
- 20' by 71' (1,420 sq ft) clerking area on Mondo surface
- Mondo rubber access paths connecting the track oval, clerking area and warmup area
- More than 12,000 square feet of team staging area

1. Entry Procedure

- The ONLY method for ALL entries is online through DirectAthletics.
- You MUST double check entries per TFRRS and World Athletics.
- Collegiate coaches can only enter eligible NCAA/NAIA/NJCAA athletes on their roster.
All others must use an individual online entry process.



- Once final registration is complete, a listing of entries will be available at our Home Meet Information Page

2. Collegiate Entry Fee:

- Entry fee should be paid online through DirectAthletics before entries close.
- Entry fee is \$50 per athlete per event before cap.
- Team entry fee is \$800 per team per gender (\$1600 for both men's and women's teams)
- Some events, surcharge on number of entries above cap
- All entry fees are for entry only. No refunds are possible.

3. Surcharge Entry Fee:

- Surcharge Fees will be applied to: 60m, 60mH, 200m, 400m, LJ, PV, SP, & WT, Combined Events
- In these events, teams are allowed 3 entries per event, per gender
- Additional entries in these events are \$25 per athlete

4. Unattached Entry Fee:

- \$50 per athlete per event. Entry MUST be paid by credit card while registering on Direct Athletics. Entry marks will be verified and false submissions will be adjusted.

5. Entry Marks/Seeding:

- All top entry performances will be verified with TFRRS for accuracy. Performances that cannot be verified will be moved to slower sections or subject to non-acceptance into the meet.
- In all meets, sections/flights/heats will be assigned based on entry performance.
- Seed times must be 2026, 2025, 2024 TFRRS/World athletic results



- Based on final field size, meet management will determine appropriate starting heights and minimum marks for jumping and throwing events.

6. Check – In Procedure

- **Running Events:** Check-in no later than **20 minutes** before the start time of the event or risk being scratched. Please report back to the clerk's area to enter the track **5 minutes** prior to the start of your event.
- **Field Events:** Shoe check no later than 1hr before event, athletes may check in during flight specific warm up.

Warm up begins:

- -Pole Vault: 90 Minutes before start time
- -High Jump: 60 Minutes before start time, No marks after 30min to start of event
- -LJ/TJ: 30 Minutes before start time Flight specific warm up
- -Weight Throw/Shot Put: 30 minutes flight specific warm up

7. Advancement:

- In Field Events that dictate, top 9 marks advance to finals
- Tentatively, In the 60m Heat #'s will be determined after entries close to determine advancement to finals
- Tentatively, In the 60m hurdles, Heat #'s will be determined after entries close to determine advancement to finals



8. Meet Time Schedules:

9. Packet Pick-Up:

- Meet packet/information will be available at TBA.
- Each team will receive separate wristbands for coaches and athletes. There will be a one credential for media and athletic training per team. More can be requested.

10. Results:

- Live results will be provided by Record Timing.
- Results will be updated at the conclusion of each event at [Nevada Home Meet Information](#) and the complete results packet will be available at the same page once the [Nevada Home Meet Information](#) concludes.

11. Spike Requirement:

- **World Athletics spike/shoes guidelines will be used for all meets. In accordance with these guidelines a random spikes/shoe check of 5-10% of entries will take place at the clerk of course.**
- **If an athletes shoe does not meet the World Athletics shoe/spike requirement any and all marks achieved in that shoe will be invalid and will be disqualified.**
- In all events, except the High Jump, 1/4" pyramid spikes must be used. For the High Jump 3/8" pyramid spikes may be worn. **All participants will have the spike length checked and only approved spikes will be allowed to compete.**
- Absolutely no needle or christmas tree spikes are allowed.
- Any spiked shoe with permanent non-compliant spikes will not be allowed.
- Please note Mondo has not made any updates to their spike policy all spikes must be as listed above. Per RSCVA.

12. Practice Availability:

- Thursday before the meet **9am to 5pm**
- On Friday **8am to 12:00pm. Priority will be given to competition.**
- During the Combined Events competition, the Track oval will be open when multi event is not competing on the oval. Parts of the oval will be unavailable during the multi competition. Please avoid any and all coned off areas during the Combined Events

13. Outside Food:

15. Team Camp

- The main team area will be in rooms F1-F8. Please note that no tape is allowed on the walls. Please avoid using the stands for team camp area. We have supplied chairs for you and your team.

16. Pole Vault Poles:

- The Reno Sparks Convention Center does NOT accept deliveries so if you plan on sending poles in advance, you MUST send them to your team hotel. We will have a pole storage available at the venue during the competition, location is TBA

17. Implement Weigh-In:

- All throwing implements must be weighed no later than 90min before the start of the event.
- Thursday: TBA
- Friday: 7:30am – 10:00am and Noon-2:00pm
- Saturday: 7:30am-11:00am and Noon-2:00pm

These will be the only times to weigh in unless otherwise stated in meet information.



18. Sports Medicine:
