

NIU Leads Series 3-2



All-Time at Michigan State: 1-1



Setting the Scene... NIU plays its final non-conference game of the regular season on Sunday when it travels to Michigan State to face the Spartans.

Catch The Game... Sunday's game will be broadcast on WLBK 98.9 FM and 1360 AM, as well as on the new NIU Huskies mobile app and the TuneIn app, with Andy Garcia providing the play-by-play. The game will also be broadcast on BTN+.

Last Time Out... Chelby Koker scored a career-high 28 points Thursday night against Ohio, but a 27-19 third quarter helped propel the Bobcats to a 77-67 win. Koker made a career-high six threes and dished out a career-high eight assists. A'Jah Davis and Janae Poisson each scored 12 points. Ohio scored 19 points off 18 NIU turnovers. The Huskies held a 48-35 advantage on the glass.

All-Time vs. Michigan State... NIU holds a 3-2 edge in the all-time series with Michigan State. The two teams last met in Cancun, Mexico in 2007 with the Spartans earning a 67-40 win. The Huskies' last win over Michigan State came in DeKalb on Nov. 24, 1991 in a 58-55 victory. NIU's last win over a Big Ten program came on Dec. 17, 2011 when the Huskies went to Indiana and won 60-59.

Scouting Michigan State... The Spartans are 5-0 on the year after defeating Central Michigan 79-70 on Friday. Nia Clouden led Michigan State with 21 points, six assists and three steals. Alyza Winston added 19 points. The Spartans held the Chippewas to 2-for-14 from the field in the fourth quarter and outscored Central Michigan 19-8. Clouden leads the Spartans in scoring at 19.4 points per game. Michigan State is averaging 81 points per game while allowing 61.8 per game. The Spartans also have a +9.0 turnover margin.

Notes

Making Threes... The Huskies lead the MAC in three-pointers per game at 11.5. NIU was 12-for-32 from the three-point line against Ohio Wednesday night, with Chelby Koker and Janae Poisson combining to go 10-for-20. It was the fourth time in the last five games that NIU made at least 10 threes in a game this season. The Huskies had double-digit threes in a game six times all last season. NIU is fourth in the country in three-pointers per game, behind Florida Gulf Coast, New Mexico and national leaders Abilene Christian. As a team, NIU is second in the MAC in three-point field goal percentage at 37.3 percent.

Koker On A Tear... Sophomore guard Chelby Koker scored over 20 points for the fourth time this season Wednesday night, putting up a career-high 28 points with a career-high six made three-pointers. She also added eight rebounds and a career-high eight assists. Koker scored 15 of the Huskies' 17 points in the final quarter against Ohio. She is tied for fifth in the MAC in scoring and rebounding with 21.2 points and 7.8 rebounds per game. Koker is also 25-for-26 at the free throw line to start the season.

Poisson Is On... Redshirt-Junior guard **Janae Poisson** has been instant offense off the bench through six games this season for the Huskies. Poisson has made 21 threes in six games which puts her eighth in the country in three-pointers made. She is shooting 50 percent from long distance and is 22nd in the country with 3.5 three-pointers per game. Poisson made four threes against Ohio marking the fourth time this season she's made four three-pointers in a game. She is NIU's second-leading scorer at 12.8 points per game.

Brandon On The Glass... Junior forward **Mikayla Brandon** had double-digit rebounds for the second straight game Wednesday night against Ohio with 10. Brandon had her first career double-double on Dec. 13 at Bradley with career-highs of 13 points and 14 rebounds. In the last four games, Brandon is averaging 7.5 points and 8.8 rebounds per game. Brandon is tied for ninth in the MAC in rebounds with 7.3 per game.

Cleaning Up On The Glass... NIU is third in the MAC in rebounding, averaging 41.3 boards per game. The Huskies have had at least 40 rebounds in each of the last four games after grabbing a season-high 48 rebounds against Ohio Wednesday night. NIU outrebounded the Bobcats by 13 in that game. In two MAC games this season, the Huskies have a rebound margin of +14.5. For the season, NIU is fourth in the MAC in rebound margin at +3.2. The Huskies have five players averaging at least four rebounds per game - Chelby Koker (7.8), Mikayla Brandon (7.3), A'Jah Davis (6.5), Emily Meinert (4.8) and Riley Blackwell (4.0).

A'Jah Davis vs. The MAC... In two MAC games this season, sophomore forward **A'Jah Davis** is averaging 11.5 points and 10 rebounds per game, shooting almost 58 percent from the field. Davis had 12 points and nine rebounds against Ohio Wednesday night. She had 11 points and 11 rebounds in her first start of the season against Toledo on Dec. 10. In four games this season, Davis is averaging 7.3 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.

The Bench Is Deep... NIU's bench is averaging 23.8 points per game. **Janae Poisson** and **Riley Blackwell** combined for 20 of 29 bench points at Bradley on Dec. 13. The Huskies' reserves outscored Ohio's bench 19-10 Wednesday night. Poisson is averaging 12.8 points per game off the bench this season.

Dropping Dimes... NIU has assisted on 56.4 percent of its made baskets so far this season. The Huskies had 17 assists on Wednesday night, one shy of the season-high of 18 set at Eastern Illinois on Dec. 4. **Chelby Koker** set a career-high for assists in each of the last two games with seven at Bradley and eight against Ohio.

NIU Sets Single-Game Three-Point Record... On Dec. 4, NIU set a program single-game record with 18 made three-pointers in an 82-72 win at Eastern Illinois. The previous record was 15, set most recently on Jan. 22, 2020 against Ohio. The Huskies bounced back from an 0-for-8 start from long distance in the first quarter to make three straight to end the period. In the third quarter, NIU made six consecutive threes to close the quarter and take an eight-point lead. The Huskies finished the game 18-for-36 from long distance, marking the seventh time since the start of the 2017-18 season NIU had 10 threes in a game and shot 50 percent or better from the three-point line.

Hunter Couldn't Miss... Grace Hunter had a shooting day that had not been seen by a NIU women's basketball player in over four years in the win at Eastern Illinois on December 4. Hunter was a perfect 5-for-5 from the three-point line against the Panthers, leading NIU with 17 points. The last time a Huskie was 5-for-5 from long distance was Nov. 26, 2016 when Janae Poisson made all five of her three-point attempts against Illinois State at the Convocation Center.

80 Is Enough, Most Of The Time...

Since the start of the 2017-18 season, the Huskies are 28-5 when scoring 80 or more points. The Huskies reached 80 points six times in the 2019-20 campaign, going 5-1 in those games. NIU had a 16-game winning streak in games in which it scored at least 80 points snapped on February 19 in a 97-89 loss at Ball State. NIU's 89 points that night are the most the Huskies have scored in a regulation loss since a 109-94 loss to Central Michigan on February 8, 2017.

NIU suffered its first loss of the 2007-08 season on Nov. 21, 2007 in a 67-40 loss to Michigan State in Cancun, Mexico.

The Huskies were held to 23.1 percent shooting from the field in the first half, and 1-for-12 from the three-point line, and fell behind 31-16.

Kylie York made four threes on her way to a team-high 14 points. Shan Welton and Becky Smith each added eight points.

Head Coach • Sixth Season • 79-82 at NIU (263-245 Overall)

Head Coach Lisa Carlsen enters her sixth season in charge of the NIU women's basketball program in 2020-21

With 18 seasons of coaching under her belt, Carlsen has an overall head coaching record of 261-241 with a 77-78 record at Northern Illinois University. Instilling a fast-paced style of play and working hard to engage the community, it's fan base and alumnae, Carlsen has made an immediate impact on the program.

NIU posted an 11-19 record in 2019, showing a flair for the dramatic with four wins coming in overtime. Redshirt-senior forward Courtney Woods led NIU with 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game on her way to her second career All-MAC First Team selection. Woods finished her career as NIU's second-leading all-time career scorer with 2,216 career points and the program's all-time leader in three-pointers made (323) and career games played (130).

The Huskies posted a 19-13 record in 2018, going 10-8 in the Mid-American Conference. NIU made the Convocation Center one of the toughest places to play in the MAC with a 13-3 record on the home floor. Senior Mikayla Voigt earned Second Team All-MAC and Co-SIDA Academic All-American honors after leading NIU with 19.5 points per game and 98 made three-pointers. On Dec. 8, 2018 Voigt set NIU and MAC single-game records with 52 points and 11 made three-pointers in an 86-61 win over Western Illinois. NIU reached the MAC Tournament quarterfinals after a 70-69 win over Western Michigan in the first round at the Convocation Center. Down by one point with less than 10 seconds to play, Voigt made the game-winning layup that put the Huskies past the Broncos.

Led by the Mid-American Conference's leading scorer in First-Team All-MAC selection Courtney Woods and Honorable Mention selection Kelly Smith, NIU finished the 2017-18 season with a 15-15 record. That marked the first time since the 2000 and 2001 seasons that the Huskies had back-to-back seasons with a .500 win percentage or better. Woods, Smith, and Mikayla Voigt all scored their 1,000th career point during the year. Voigt was later named to the 2017-18 CoSIDA Academic All-District® Second-Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America

After a first season that resulted in bumps and bruises from adopting a new style of play, the Huskies found their stride in Carlsen's second season as they advanced to the Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship and made its first postseason berth since 1995 with an at-large bid to Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT). The MAC placed an NCAA-best six teams in the tournament.

Finishing with a 21-12 record, NIU went 12-6 in the MAC to earn a first round bye in the MAC Tournament. Going a respectable 7-4 in non-conference play, the Huskies won eight of their first nine conference games as the team rallied behind Paulina Castro, who was diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma around Christmas.

Led by Ally Lehman, who was named First Team All-MAC and was second in MAC Player of the Year voting, NIU would overcome double-digit deficits six times during the season and finish fifth in the NCAA in scoring at 85.1 points per game.

In the team's postseason run, the Huskies found themselves trailing defending MAC Champion Ohio by 22 points in the second quarter. NIU slowly chipped away at the Bobcats and completed the largest comeback in NCAA Postseason history to advance to its first MAC Tournament Semifinal since 2007 with a 72-71 win.

NIU broke several records during the course of the season as Courtney Woods became just the sixth player in MAC history to reach the century mark in made three-pointers (105) and Lehman set the program's record for assists in a season (214) and in a career (538). With two triple-doubles during the season, she fell just 10 rebounds shy of becoming just the fourth player Division I basketball history to record 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds and 500 assists in a career.

In her first season with the Huskies, NIU overcame three double-digit deficits in a game and recorded 11 victories, the most since the 2005-06 season, and four different players averaged 10.0 or points per game, the first time since the 1989-90 season the program achieved that feat.

Northern Illinois University's fast-paced offense scored 80-or-more points six times that season with a season-best 92 points against Miami (Ohio) at home. The team finished second in the Mid-American Conference in assists (14.7/G) and rebounds (41.4/G) that season.

In eight seasons at Lewis, Carlsen guided the Flyers to a 148-89 record, four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and two Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) championships.

In 2014-15, Lewis posted a 31-3 record and reached the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. Carlsen was honored as the 2015 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II National Coach of the Year. The Flyers started the season on a 23-game winning streak and spent five weeks ranked number one in the nation. Along with earning national coach of the year honors, Carlsen was also named GLVC Coach of the Year, Illinois Basketball Coaches Association (IBCA) Women's Collegiate Coach of the Year and WBCA Region IV Division II Coach of the Year.

Her final season at Lewis was the culmination of an outstanding three-year period during which Carlsen guided the Flyers to a 78-15 mark and three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Carlsen led the Flyers to the best turnaround in the nation in Division II during the 2012-13 campaign, recording a 24-6 mark. Lewis won the GLVC East Division and Tournament championships and earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Carlsen was named the GLVC Coach of the Year and was also the IBCA Women's Collegiate Coach of the Year.

In 2013-14, Lewis went 23-6 and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Carlsen was named the 2014 IBCA Women's Collegiate Co-Coach of the Year and the WBCA Region IV Division II Coach of the Year.

During her tenure with the Flyers, Carlsen mentored two All-Americans, two conference players of the year, four all-region honorees and 10 all-conference award winners. In eight seasons at Lewis, Carlsen's program had a 100 percent graduation rate; she also served as the Senior Woman Administrator at Lewis from 2007-13.

A native of Earling, Iowa, Carlsen began her basketball coaching career at Nebraska Omaha as an assistant in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Carlsen was promoted to head coach at Nebraska Omaha prior to the 2000-01 season and led the Mavericks to postseason play in 2003, re-

cording the program's best finish since the 1991-92 season. In 12 seasons combined between Lewis and Nebraska Omaha, Carlsen has a career record of 184-163.

Following her tenure at Nebraska Omaha, Carlsen spent three seasons as the associate head coach at Winona State, helping guide the Warriors to a 12-win improvement before taking the reins at Lewis prior to the 2007-08 season.

A 1992 graduate of Northwest Missouri State, Carlsen was a four-time all-conference basketball honoree while also earning all-conference and all-region honors as a softball player. During her senior year, Carlsen was named the 1992 Champion NCAA Female Athlete of the Year. She went on to earn her master's degree from Nebraska Omaha in 1994.




