NIU Leads Series 1-0

First Meeting: Nov. 15, 2022 (DeKalb, Ill.) NIU 61, Southern Indiana 53



Setting the Scene... NIU wraps up its season-opening three-game road swing Thursday night with its first trip to Southern Indiana.

Catch The Game... Thursday's game will be broadcast on WDKB 94-9 FM, the Varsity Network and NIU Huskies apps with Mike Haase providing the play-by-play. The game will also be televised on ESPN+.

Last Time Out... NIU got off to a fast start on Sunday at Western Illinois but could not keep up with the Leathernecks' hot shooting from the field in a 95-62 loss at Western Hall. Jayden Marable led the Huskies with 16 points, three assists and three steals. Freshman **Shannon Blacher** added 10 points off the bench. The Leathernecks shot 53.8 percent from the field and was 9-for-16 from the three-point line. NIU shot 36.1 percent from the field.

All-Time vs. Southern Indiana... NIU won the lone meeting between the Huskies and Screaming Eagles on Nov. 15, 2022 61-53 at the NIU Convocation Center. The Huskies led by two at halftime and outscored Southern Indiana 21-6 in the third quarter to take a 48-31 lead. Chelby Koker and A'Jah Davis each scored a team-high 15 points with Davis adding a game-high nine rebounds. NIU outrebounded Southern Indiana 37-29.

Scouting Southern Indiana... Picked to finish sixth in its second season in the Ohio Valley Conference, the Screaming Eagles moved to 2-0 on the year on Sunday with an 86-38 victory over Oakland City. Southern Indiana raced out to a 45-19 halftime lead, shooting 63 percent from the field. Meredith Raley and Addy Blackwell each had a team-high 13 points. Raley, along with senior forward Madison Webb, lead Southern Indiana in scoring at 11 points per game. The Screaming Eagles are averaging 76.5 points per game to start the year, allowing only 50.5 points per game.

Notes

Three Is A Magic Number... NIU is third in the nation in three-point attempts to start the year at 33.5 per game. In two games, the Huskies have taken 67 three-pointers which accounts for 52 percent of their total field goal attempts for the season. Seven of the 11 Huskies that have seen playing time have made a three this year. Last season NIU was third in the MAC in threes per game (8.1), fourth in attempts (23.9/game) and fifth in three-point field goal percentage at 33.8 percent.

Marable Making Plays... Senior guard Jayden Marable filled up the box score last Sunday at Western Illlinois with 16 points, three assists, three steals and two rebounds in 31 minutes. It was her second straight double-figure scoring effort to start the season. She had 10 points, six assists and six rebounds in the opener at Arkansas State last Thursday. This is the second straight season Marable has had back-to-back double figure scoring performances to start the year.

Stonebraker Double-Doubles Up...Senior forward Brooke Stonebraker is averaging 9.5 points and a team-high 8.0 rebounds per game to start the year, playing 29 minutes per game. She made her first career start last Thursday at Arkansas State and set career-highs with 11 points and 14 rebounds in a career-high 36 minutes. Her 14 rebounds were a game-high, with six coming on the offensive glass. Stonebraker was 5-for-6 at the free throw line. Her previous career-highs were 10 points last season against North Dakota in the WBI and four rebounds. She had played double digit minutes in a game twice all of last season.

A Lift From The Bench.. After getting just six bench points in the season opener at Arkansas State on Nov. 9, the Huskies' reserves put up 23 points last Sunday at Western Illinois. Freshman guard **Shannon Blacher** had 10 points off the bench against the Leathernecks, adding three rebounds and an assist. Junior guard **Moriah Prewitt** tied career-highs of six points, three rebounds and two assists in 21 minutes. NIU was second in the MAC last season in bench points per game, averaging 21.9 per contest.

Drake's Debut In Starting Five... Senior guard **Kortney Drake** made her first career start last Sunday at Western Illinois. In 20 minutes, Drake scored a career-high nine points and two rebounds. In two games this season Drake is averaging 6.0 points per game and shooting 33.3 percent from the three-point line.

Handle With Care...Senior guard **Jayden Marable** had a 2.0 assist-turn-over ratio last season, starting 32 of the 33 games she played. Marable led the team in minutes with 31.2 per game and was second in assists, averaging 2.7 per game. In two games this season Marable has a 1.5 assist-turnover ratio.

Hunter's Career Day... Redshirt-Senior guard **Grace Hunter** tied her career-high in points in last Thursday's season opener with 19 at Arkansas State. She also tied her career-highs for three-pointers made with five, as well as assists with four. Hunter also played a career-high 34 minutes, surpassing her previous high of 31 set at Michigan State in 2020. She scored in double figures twice last season, scoring a season-high 18 against North Dakota in the WBI.

Nickel And Dimes... Junior guard Laura Nickel had 10 points and six rebounds in the season opener at Arkansas State. She made the final basket of each of the first two quarters against the Red Wolves, beating the second quarter buzzer to put NIU up 33-31 at halftime. Nickel played in all 33 games last season as a sophomore, averaging 5.7 points and 3.4 rebounds per game. She scored in double figures four times with a ca-

reer-high 14 points coming against Eastern Michigan on March 1.

Drive For 75... NIU was 8-1 last season when scoring over 75 points, winning 12 straight games in which it scored over 75 before a 102-99 overtime loss to North Dakota in the WBI. The Huskies averaged 8.1 three-pointers per game last season, going 10-3 in games where they made at least nine threes. NIU was also 10-3 last season when having a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.

Chelby Koker Named To Preseason All-MAC Team... Chelby Koker was named to the Preseason All-MAC First Team on Nov. 2. Last season, Koker became the third Huskie in program history to earn three All-MAC postseason honors with her selection to the All-MAC Second Team. Koker averaged 15.4 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game while shooting a team-best 37.6 percent from the three-point arc last year. Koker eclipsed 1,500 career points last season and is NIU's all-time leader in free throw percentage (85.6%). She is in the top-10 all-time in NIU history in points per game (15.0), three-pointers made (199) and three-point percentage (36.2)

Huskies Get It Done In The Classroom...

The NIU women's basketball team had the third-highest cumulative team grade point average in NCAA Division I last year. The Huskies had a team GPA of 3.778, behind only Albany (3.791) and Robert Morris (3.801) for the top GPA in Division I. It was the third straight year NIU was in the top-10 of the WBCA Academic Top 25 Honor Roll and fifth consecutive appearance.

Road Warriors... For the second time in five seasons, NIU is playing seven of its first eight games away from DeKalb to start the year. The Huskies play their first three games on the road this season before their home opener against Lindenwood on Nov. 21. NIU then heads to Puerto Rico for two games Thanksgiving weekend before going to Wisconsin and SIUE.

Carlsen In Charge... This season marks head coach Lisa Carlsen's ninth at the helm of the NIU women's basketball program. Carlsen is second all-time at NIU with 119 wins and is one of three coaches in program history to be coach for at least

eight seasons. Carlsen won her 300th game as a head coach last season in NIU's 85-81 win at Bowling Green on Feb. 15, 2023.

Last Meeting vs. Southern Indiana

NIU 61, Southern Indiana 53 November 15, 2022 | DeKalb, III.

The NIU women's basketball team rode a 21-6 third quarter Tuesday morning to a 61-53 victory over the Southern Indiana Screaming Eagles at the NIU Convocation Center.

The win is NIU's seventh in a row at the Convocation Center. Senior forward A'Jah Davis and senior guard Chelby Koker each led the Huskies with a game-high 15 points. Davis had a game-high nine rebounds, one shy of a double-double, while Koker added a game-high five assists. Emma Carter chipped in a season-high 10 points.

NIU (2-1) led 27-25 at halftime but got out to a fast start in the third. Sparked by back-to-back threes from Carter and another triple from Janae Poisson, the Huskies opened the quarter on a 13-2 run over the first 4:41. Carter had eight points in the run as two Davis free throws put NIU ahead 40-27 with 4:22 to play.

After a Meredith Raley layup made the score 40-29, Poisson and Koker combined to score the next seven NIU points to give the Huskies their largest lead of the game, 47-29, at the 2:16 mark. For the quarter, NIU outscored the Screaming Eagles 21-6 and held the visitors to 3-for-13 from the field to take a 48-31 lead oping into the fourth.

Southern Indiana rallied back in the final quarter, starting out on a 12-0 run capped by an Ashlynn Brown three-pointer that cut the deficit to five, 48-43, with 6:54 to go. Koker responded for the Huskies with two straight threes to get the lead back up to 11, 54-43, with under six minutes to go. The Screaming Eagles only got as close as five points the rest of the way as NIU hung on for its second straight win, 61-53.

The Huskies opened the game on a 7-2 run, capped off by a Jayden Marable layup at the 8:05 mark. Southern Indiana tied the game at nine on a Raley three, but NIU took the lead back with an 8-2 run to close the quarter with a Koker layup that made the score 17-11. NIU led by seven early in the second before a Southern Indiana 7-0 run tied the game at 18 with 5:07 to play until halftime. The two teams traded baskets until the final minute, when baskets from Davis and Laura Nickel gave NIU a 27-23 lead. Vanessa Shafford then beat the buzzer with a floater in the lane to make the score 27-25 going into the locker room.

NIU shot 41.7 percent from the field for the game, holding Southern Indiana to 35.7 percent. The Huskies were 14-for-18 from the free throw line and held a 37-29 edge on the glass. Raley led the Screaming Eagles with 15 points as Brown added 10.

Head Coach • Ninth Season • 119-124 at NIU (303-287 Overall)

Head Coach Lisa Carlsen is in her ninth season in charge of the NIU women's basketball program.

With over 20 seasons of coaching under her belt, Carlsen has an overall head coaching record of 303-285. Instilling a fast-paced style of play and working hard to engage the community, it's fan base and alumnae, Carlsen has made a big impact on the program.

Carlsen's teams have been recognized as one of the tops in the nation in the classroom. This past season, NIU posted the third-highest team grade point average in the nation at 3.778 for its highest ranking in the WBCA Academic Top 25. In 2022, the Huskies had the ninth-highest team cumulative GPA in Division I at 3.681. It was the fourth consecutive year NIU was on the WBCA Academic Top 25 Honor Roll, and the second in the top-10. NIU was seventh in the nation in team GPA in 2021.

The Huskies played in a national postseason tournament for the first time in six seasons in 2022-23, earning a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational in Lexington, Ky. Three Huskies earned postseason accolades from the MAC. Janae Poisson was named the MAC Sixth Player of the Year for the second time in three seasons, becoming the second student-athlete to earn the honor twice. A'Jah Davis earned a spot on the All-MAC First Team for the second consecutive season while Chelby Koker was placed on the All-MAC Second Team. The Huskies also had a program-record nine selections to the Academic All-MAC Team with Koker, Davis, Jayden Marable and Laura Nickel earning Academic All-District honors from College Sports Communicators.

NIU went back to the MAC Tournament in 2022 and finished with a 14-15 record. The Huskies had three All-MAC selections for the first time in program history in First Team forward A'Jah Davis and honorable mention guards Janae Poisson and Chelby Koker. Davis set NIU single-season records in with 338 rebounds and 23 double-doubles. NIU was the fourth seed in Cleveland that year, winning five of its last seven regular season games for its highest finish in the league since 2017.

The Huskies reached the MAC Tournament quarterfinals in 2021, posting a record of 14-15. Led by MAC Sixth Woman of the Year Janae Poisson and All-MAC Second Team selection Chelby Koker, the Huskies went 12-12 with a 10-8 conference record. NIU led the MAC in three-point shooting at 37.5% and were second in threes per game with 9.0. On Dec. 4, 2019 the Huskies made a single-game program record 18 three-pointers in a win at Eastern Illinois.

NIU posted an 11-19 record in 2019, showing a flair for the dramatic with four wins coming in overtime. Redshirt-senior forward Courtney Woods led NIU with 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game on her way to her second career All-MAC First Team selection. Woods finished her career as NIU's second-leading all-time career scorer with 2,216 career points and the program's all-time leader in three-pointers made (323) and career games played (130).

The Huskies posted a 19-13 record in 2018, going 10-8 in the Mid-American Conference. NIU made the Convocation Center one of the toughest places to play in the MAC with a 13-3 record on the home floor. Senior Mikayla Voigt earned Second Team All-MAC and Co-SIDA Academic All-American honors after leading NIU with 19.5 points per game and 98 made three-pointers On Dec. 8, 2018 Voigt set NIU and MAC single-game records with 52 points and 11 made three-pointers in

an 86-61 win over Western Illinois. NIU reached the MAC Tournament quarterfinals after a 70-69 win over Western Michigan in the first round at the Convocation Center. Down by one point with less than 10 seconds to play, Voigt made the game-winning layup that put the Huskies past the Broncos.

Led by the Mid-American Conference's leading scorer in First-Team All-MAC selection Courtney Woods and Honorable Mention selection Kelly Smith, NIU finished the 2017-18 season with a 15-15 record. That marked the first time since the 2000 and 2001 seasons that the Huskies had back-to-back seasons with a .500 win percentage or better. Woods, Smith, and Mikayla Voigt all scored their 1,000th career point during the year. Voigt was later named to the 2017-18 CoSIDA Academic All-District® Second-Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America.

After a first season that resulted in bumps and bruises from adopting a new style of play, the Huskies found their stride in Carlsen's second season in 2016 as they advanced to the Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship and made its first postseason berth since 1995 with an at-large bid to Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT). The MAC placed an NCAA-best six teams in the tournament.

Finishing with a 21-12 record, NIU went 12-6 in the MAC to earn a first round bye in the MAC Tournament. Going a respectable 7-4 in non-conference play, the Huskies won eight of their first nine conference games as the team rallied behind Paulina Castro, who was diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma around Christmas.

Led by Ally Lehman, who was named First Team All-MAC and was second in MAC Player of the Year voting, NIU would overcome double-digit deficits six times during the season and finish fifth in the NCAA in scoring at 85.1 points per game.

In the team's postseason run, the Huskies found themselves trailing defending MAC Champion Ohio by 22 points in the second quarter. NIU slowly chipped away at the Bobcats and completed the largest comeback in NCAA Postseason history to advance to its first MAC Tournament Semifinal since 2007 with a 72-71 win.

NIU broke several records during the course of the season as Courtney Woods became just the sixth player in MAC history to reach the century mark in made three-pointers (105) and Lehman set the program's record for assists in a season (214) and in a career (538). With two triple-doubles during the season, she fell just 10 rebounds shy of becoming just the fourth player Division I basketball history to record 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds and 500 assists in a career.

In her first season with the Huskies, NIU overcame three double-digit deficits in a game and recorded victories, the most since the 2005-06 season, and four different players averaged 10.0 or points per game, the first time since the 1989-90 season the program achieved that feat.

Northern Illinois University's fast-paced offense scored 80-or-more points six times last season with a season-best 92 points against Miami (Ohio) at home. The team finished second in the Mid-American Conference in assists (14.7/G) and rebounds (41.4/G) last season.

In eight seasons at Lewis, Carlsen guided the Flyers to a 148-89 record, four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and two Great Lakes Valley Conference

(GLVC) championships.

"When we began the search for our next head women's basketball coach at NIU, we were looking for someone who was the right fit to lead the resurgence of our program," said Frazier. "Lisa Carlsen has a proven record of success, an understanding of the educational mission of our university and the integrity and values to get the job done here at NIU. I have no doubt that Lisa is the right person at the right time to lead our student-athletes and compete for championships in the years to come."

In 2014-15, Lewis posted a 31-3 record and reached the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. Carlsen was honored as the 2015 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II National Coach of the Year. The Flyers started the season on a 23-game winning streak and spent five weeks ranked number one in the nation.
