2004 NORTH EAST COLLEGIATE VOLLEYBALL ASSOCIATION WEEK TEN TOP 10 POLL

March 29, 2004

JERSEY CITY, NJ...Rivier College of Nashua, NH remains as the number one ranked team for the eighth straight week in the 10th NECVA poll of the 2004 season. The Raiders received all first place votes cast. Stevens Tech, which held the No. 1 spot the first two weeks of the season, remains in second for an eighth week. Eastern Mennonite, which upset Stevens Tech, climbs from sixth into a tie for third with D'Youville. NYC also moves up one spot after defeating Medaille, which falls from third to fifth. Endicott and SUNY-New Paltz each climb a spot. Mount St. Vincent falls from fifth to eighth after losing to both Stevens and New Paltz. Philadelphia Biblical and Emmanuel, both of which received votes in week nine, moved into ninth and 10th places, respectively, while idle Ramapo dropped out of the Top 10, as did Hunter College, despite winning its seventh straight match and the CUNYAC title.

ABOUT THE NECVA:

The North East Collegiate Volleyball Association, the largest Division III men's volleyball conference in the United States, celebrates its 10th anniversary during the 2004 season. Founded in 1995 as the Metro Conference, it became known as the NECVA in 1998. Currently comprised of 32 colleges and universities stretching from New Hampshire to Virginia, M.I.T. and SUNY-New Paltz joined the league this year to reach the current membership figure.

The league is divided into four smaller divisions: CUNY (8), Metro (7), New England (10), and Western (7). Each week, coaches from the four divisions nominate athletes and then vote for the divisional Player and Rookie of the Week awards. The conference sports information office then selects the NECVA Player and Rookie honors from each of these four divisional winners.

The NECVA holds an annual 12-team conference tournament each April with the top three schools in each division earning berths. The NECVA champion receives one of four automatic bids to the Molten Division III Final Four in April.

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

NECVA CONFERENCE

MIKE LaROCCO • SUNY NEW PALTZ
JR • OH • Hauppauge, NY/Smithtown HS

Mike LaRocco is the NECVA Conference Player of the Week after leading the Hawks to a pair of key Metro Division sweeps and the No. 7 seed in the upcoming NECVA Tournament. He also has been tabbed as the Sports Imports/AVCA Division III Men's National Player of the Week. New Paltz (15-7) picked up sweeps of NJCU and Mount St. Vincent. In the win over the Gothic Knights, he hit .381 with 10 kills (10-2-21) and nine digs. He improved his numbers in the victory over #14-ranked CMSV, posting a line of 14-1-21 for a .619 percentage with six digs, as NP avenged a January 3-0 loss to the Dolphins.

KEN McNEELEY • NEWBURY COLLEGE
FR • MH • Forest Hill, MD/Fallston HS

Ken McNeeley is the NECVA Conference Rookie of the Week for the second time this season after leading Newbury, once the program with the longest losing streak in the league, to a solid 13-12 record and 8-10 in the difficult New England Division. One major reason for the Nighthawks turnaround has been the emergence of 6-foot-6 McNeeley. In a 1-1 week for Newbury, he averaged 5.00 kills and 2.00 blocks per game while hitting .346. He had 23 kills (23-4-36) and hit .528 with eight rejections in a win over Wentworth, and added 17 kills and eight blocks in a loss to Lasell.

CUNYAC DIVISION

NEIL HONG • HUNTER COLLEGE
SR • S/OH • Honolulu, HI/Kalaheo

Hunter College won its second straight CUNYAC Championship behind senior Neil Hong, who was named Tournament MVP. The 6-0 setter is the NECVA CUNYAC Division Player of the Week for a second straight week. In three tournament contests for the Hawks, Hong recorded 88 assists, including 26 in the title match against York. He hit .522 for the tournament and averaged 9.78 assists per game. Hunter has now won 36 straight CUNYAC matches.

RYAN IMBESI • HUNTER COLLEGE
FR • L/OH • East Moriches, NY/Westhampton Beach HS

The clutch serving and superb back row defense of 5-foot-8 Ryan Imbesi helped lead Hunter to its second straight CUNYAC Championship. In three CUNYAC Tournament matches, he notched 12 aces and 23 digs, including three aces and 10 digs in the title match against York. In the quarterfinals, he served seven aces against NYCCT. He averaged 1.33 aces and 2.56 digs per game, and leads the Hawks with 267 digs this year.

METRO DIVISION

Russell Butts of Mount St. Vincent takes home NECVA Metro Rookie of the Week honors after contributing 1.67 kills and 0.78 blocks per game with a .414 hitting percentage. The sophomore is in his first season of collegiate volleyball. He had a line of 7-1-9 for a .667 percentage with three blocks in a loss to Stevens, and hit .385 (6-1-13) against New Paltz. He added four blocks in a sweep of Yeshiva. CMSV (19-6) is the No. 10 seed in the NECVA Tournament.

NEW ENGLAND DIVISION

ANDY CHACE • RIVIER COLLEGE
SO • MH • East Providence, RI/East Providence HS

Rivier finished a perfect season in New England division play at 18-0 and earned the No. 1 seed in this weekend's NECVA Tournament behind the play of Andy Chace. The 6-foot-6 middle hitter is NE Player of the Week after averaging 3.82 kills with a ridiculous .707 hitting percentage. He also averaged 1.00 blocks and 0.45 aces per game. His line for the week was 42-1-58. He had 15 kills (15-0-18) and four blocks against JWU, and was 11-0-15 in a huge win over Endicott. The Raiders have won four consecutive New England titles.

KEN McNEELEY • NEWBURY COLLEGE

Newbury, once a losing program, is no longer, after finishing the year at 13-12 and 8-10 in the difficult New England Division. 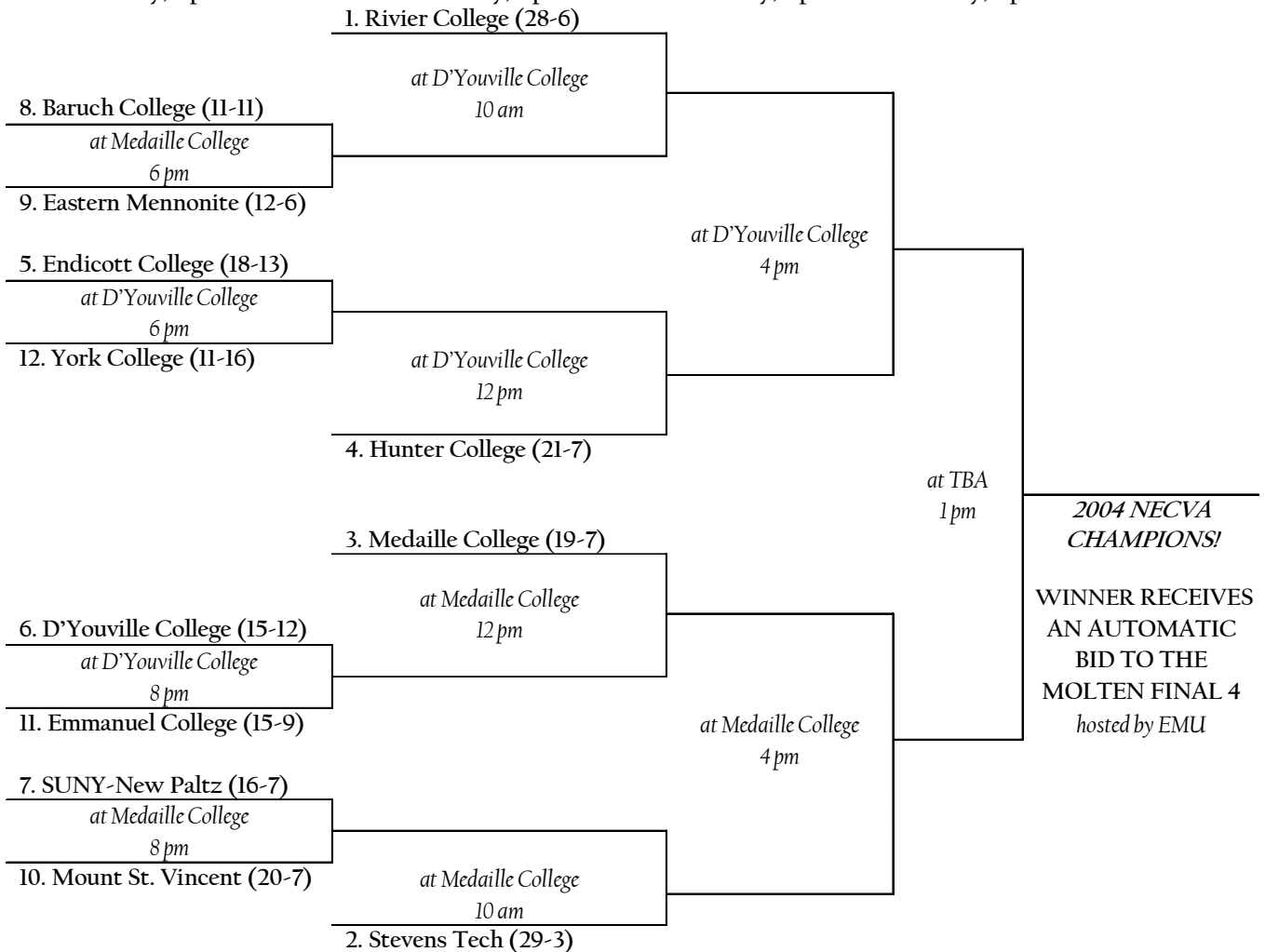
