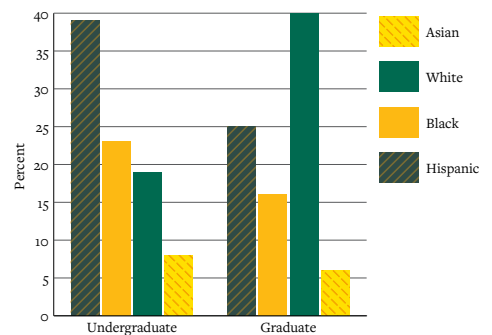

ONE-YEAR RETENTION RATE

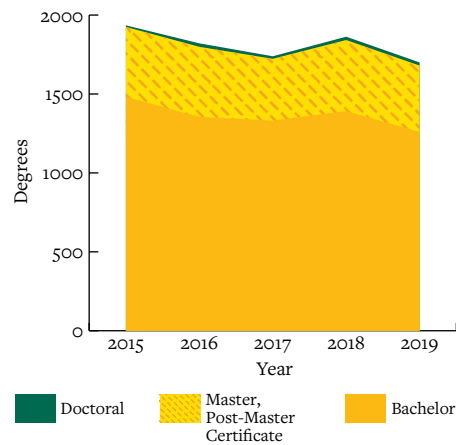

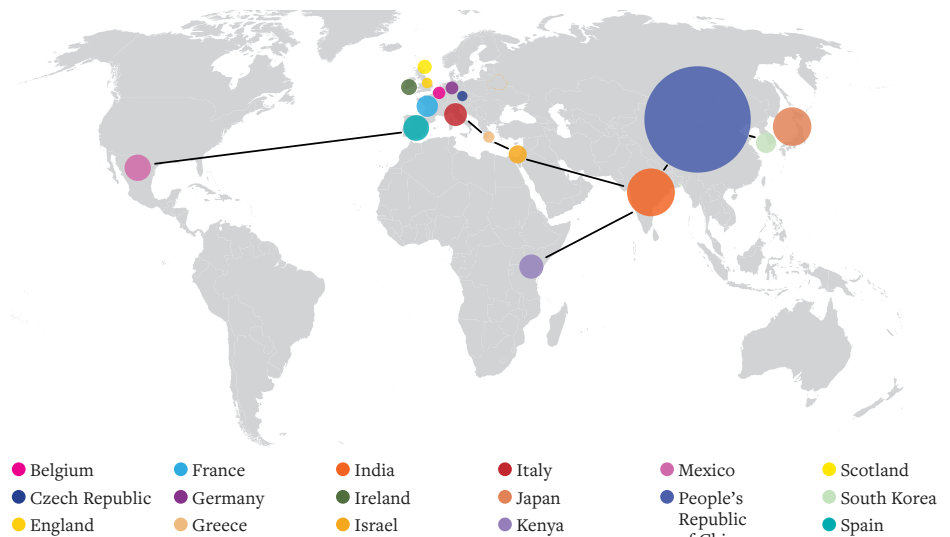
