## QUICK HITS (140 CHARACTERS OR FEWER)

- At the start of August, NKU was granted active status as a Division I institution by the NCAA. The transition process began Dec. 8, 2011.
- The 2016 campaign marks the start of Liz Hart's seventh year at the helm of the Norse volleyball program.
- Hart started as an assistant coach at NKU after ending her career as the all-time leader in kills and NKU's only three-time All-American.
- NKU returns four starters from the 2015 season, including Horizon League Freshman of the Year, Haley Libs.
- Libs led the team with 404 kills, good for sixth in the League, behind a .244 clip. She added 195 digs and 39 blocks as a freshman.
- Senior Taylor Snyder returns as the Norse setter, who was fifth in the HL with 1,167 assists.
- Snyder's 3,714 career assists rank fourth in NKU laurels, and she needs 1,406 this season to overtake Jenna Schreiber's record of 5,120.
- Senior Keely Creamer squeaked into the record books at the end of 2015, as she has the 10th-most career block assists with 233.
- NKU spent its first season in the Horizon League in 2015, posting an 8-8 record.
- The Norse advanced to the semifinals of the HL Championship, falling in five to eventual champion Cleveland State.
- The HL Preseason Coaches Poll tabbed the Norse to finish fourth in the League.
- NKU will face five opponents who finished in the top-100 of the 2015 RPI.

# NORSE NOTES

**CONTINUING TRADITION:** The 2016 season marks the 41st year of volleyball at Northern Kentucky University, which saw immense success at the Division II level prior to making the transition to Division I in 2012. Head coach Liz Hart, an NKU alumna with an illustrious career, starts her seventh season at the helm of the program. Hart and her staff have led NKU to one of the most successful Division I transitions, posting a winning record of 70-53 (.569).

**OFFICIAL DIVISION I STATUS:** NKU Athletics announced on Aug. 9 that the NCAA Board granted the department active status as a Division I institution. With active Division I status, NKU is now able to compete for NCAA Championship berths for the first time since the Norse started the four-year reclassification period.

**NEAR THE TOP OF THE HORIZON:** The Norse were picked to finish fourth in the Horizon League, according to a preseason poll of the League's nine head coaches. Reigning champion Cleveland State earned top honors with four first-place votes, followed closely by Valparaiso, also with four first-place votes. Oakland received one first-place vote, which put the Golden Grizzlies in third.

**THE 2016 NORSE LINEUP:** NKU returns four of its starters from the 2015 season, including 2015 Horizon League Freshman of the Year, Haley Libs. The Floyds Knobs, Ind., native put up 404 kills on a .244 hitting percentage and also recorded 10 double-doubles in her rookie campaign. Opposite Libs in the lineup is Tristen Simpson, who averaged 2.00 kills per set last season and was also a force at the net with 45 total blocks. Leading the offense will be Taylor Snyder, who is chasing the NKU all-time assists record with the current fourth-most dishes in program history at 3,714. Opposite NKU's setter is Kelly Turner, who was able to put up eight double-digit kill matches as a freshman and will be transferring to the right pin. Keely Creamer returns to the middle after another dominant season and will add a balance of offense and defense with her hitting and blocking abilities. New additions to the Norse lineup will include Lauren Hurley assuming the role of libero after the departure of NKU's fifth-best defensive performer, Mel Stewart, and Georgia Childers making her first start in the middle opposite Creamer. NKU welcomes three freshmen in 2016: Laura Crawford (OH), Shelby Olsen (S) and Jaden Thiem (DS).

**OPENING WEEKEND:** NKU kicks off the 2016 season at the Indiana Invitational in Bloomington, Ind. The Norse will face the host Hoosiers first on Friday, Aug. 26 at 7 p.m. ET before taking on two on Saturday. NKU will take on Marshall at 10 a.m. and will cap off the tournament against Evansville at 5 p.m.

# NORTHERN KENTUCKY

## VOLLEYBALL

**SCOUTING INDIANA:** The Hoosiers return four starters while losing two along with their libero from the 2015 season, but bring in six fresh faces for the 2016 season. Megan Tallman returns for her senior season after compiling 1,060 assists last year, good for ninth in the Big Ten. On the left pin, Allison Hammond is the top kills returner after averaging 2.76 kills per set and was strong behind the line with 27 aces. Indiana went 16-16 last year, posting a 6-14 record in the B1G. The Hoosiers had a powerful offense, putting up 13.05 k/s while holding opponents to 11.87, but hitting errors and a slight disadvantage at the net proved to be a factor in IU's overall record.

NKU holds the advantage in the all-time series with the Hoosiers, 5-3, but the two teams have not squared off on the court in more than three decades. The last time NKU played IU, the Norse came away with a 15-12, 15-13, 15-9 win in Highland Heights on Sept. 19, 1981. NKU has only played in Bloomington twice, dropping a 15-6, 15-10 decision on Nov. 7, 1980, before bouncing back the next day with a 15-11, 7-15, 16-14 win.

**SCOUTING MARSHALL:** The Thundering Herd is led by All-Conference USA First Team honoree Ally Kiekoover, who posted 329 kills at a blistering .402 clip in the middle. Excluding the loss of Lauren Legge in the middle, Marshall returns its entire starting lineup. Cassie Weaver doubled up with Kiekoover to form a powerful offensive tandem with her 387 kills on the left wing with assists dished out by Kayla Simmons, who averaged 9.34 assists a set. In the back row, libero Allie Kellerman returns after scooping up 555 digs. Marshall finished with a 16-14 record last year, including 7-9 in C-USA action. The Thundering Herd was solid across the board with respect to its opponents, averaging 12.37 k/s, 15.20 digs/set and 1.67 blocks/set.

In the all-time series, NKU has gone a perfect 4-0 against the Thundering Herd. Three of the wins have been in neutral territory, with the last matchup coming well before the start of the rally scoring era. The Norse secured a clear 15-6, 15-3, 15-2 victory on Nov. 6, 1982, keeping the streak of not having dropped a set to Marshall in the history of the two programs afloat.

**SCOUTING EVANSVILLE:** The Purple Aces continue to rebuild under fourth-year head coach Manolo Concepcion. Evansville lost its leading attacking pair in Miranda Genesis and Stephanie Cerino along with its starting setter in Lorena Marquez, but the team brings in four new players to help fill in the holes. The lineup is also a sizable one, as five members of the team are 6-foot-2 or taller. Evansville went 8-24 last year and struggled in the Missouri Valley Conference with just two wins. Termination was the primary setback, with the team posting a .168 hitting percentage on 1,348 kills.

Evansville is the only program that the Norse will face this weekend that has a series history with NKU in recent years. NKU leads in the all-time series, 7-2, including an undefeated 5-0 mark during the Liz Hart era. The majority of the matches have been played on neutral ground, with the last neutral match on Sept. 7, 2013, when NKU won in four, 25-23, 20-25, 25-17, 25-17. When the two met last season in Evansville, NKU swept the Purple Aces in three hard-fought sets, 25-23, 25-20, 27-25.

**NORSE SMARTS:** NKU Volleyball was honored for its work off the court as a recipient of the AVCA Team Academic Award. The Norse boasted a 3.58 cumulative grade point average for the 2015-16 school year, which is no surprise as academic excellence has become the norm for the program with four consecutive years above a 3.50 GPA.

**NATIONAL EXPOSURE FOR HOME SLATE:** Seven of volleyball's home matches have been selected as a part of NKU's fall broadcast partnership with ESPN3. Broadcast dates include matches against: Cleveland State (Sept. 30, 6 p.m.), Oakland (Oct. 1, 4 p.m.), Valparaiso (Oct. 7, 7 p.m.), UIC (Oct. 15, 4 p.m.), Wright State (Oct. 23, 4 p.m.), Green Bay (Nov. 4, 6 p.m.) and Milwaukee (Nov. 5, 4 p.m.).

**VOLLEYBALL GETS FRESH DIGS:** Preseason reporting on Aug. 9 was a special one for the Norse, as the volleyball team was among the first to view the newly-renovated locker room. The remodel had been in the planning stages since November 2015, and included gutting the old 700 sq. ft. facility and replacing flooring, ceilings, lockers, showers and the bathroom. It also features new furniture and a television in the remodeled player lounge for both relaxation and match analysis.

# LIZ HART

Head Coach  
Seventh season

Entering her seventh season at the helm of Northern Kentucky University volleyball, Liz Hart coaches a volleyball team that is On The Rise.

Since the program's move to Division I, Hart has orchestrated one of the most successful starts for a transitioning team in NCAA history. The Norse have posted a .569 winning percentage over the last three seasons, including a 25-7 mark in 2012, the best record for a reclassifying school in NCAA history. Hart enters this season with a 110-69 coaching record.

In 2013, NKU picked up marquee wins against Syracuse, Cincinnati and Navy before the team found itself eligible for conference postseason play in 2014. The Norse advanced to the semifinals of the Atlantic Sun Conference Championship and finished the season ranked No. 110 in the RPI among 334 Division I institutions.

2014 marked the first year that the Norse competed in a conference tournament, advancing to the semifinals of the Atlantic Sun Championship. NKU finished with a 19-11 overall record and went 7-7 in the A-Sun, while three Norse were named All-A-Sun performers. Jenna Ruble was named to the A-Sun First Team, and both Taylor Snyder and Keely Creamer picked up second-team honors.

The 2015 saw another landmark, as the Norse were honored with the first conference individual honor of the Division I era when Haley Libs was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Year. After moving from the A-Sun to the Horizon League, the Norse went 14-16 on the season, including 8-8 in League play.

As the Norse are in the second year of Horizon League competition and the first year of full Division I postseason Eligibility, Hart looks to push the Norse even further.

"We use the competitive cauldron to increase competition level amongst the players and get them competing at their highest level every practice," says Hart. The cauldron ranks each player on a variety of axes each practice, forcing each player to be at her best every moment in practice and on the game court.

The expectation of excellence continues not only on the court, but off as well. NKU's volleyball teams have maintained above a 3.50 grade point average over the last four years and have earned the AVCA's Team Academic Award in three recent seasons.

Hart's players log numerous community service hours, aiding local elementary schools and retirement homes, as well as the Ronald McDonald House in Cincinnati, Ohio. In addition, Norse volleyball players represent the program and the university on leadership boards of university, local, conference, regional and national scope.

"We want our players to graduate and leave our program with self-confidence and have the leadership skills to tackle the next part of their lives," added Hart. "We're bringing in student-athletes who are driven, believe in our vision and will help to build on the success of our alumnae."

Hart herself is one of those alumnae, having spent her playing career representing the Black and Gold. During her playing career, Hart was named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Freshman of the Year in 2004, and in 2008 was named an NCAA Top 30 Woman of the Year recipient as well as the GLVC Player of the Year, Great Lakes Region Player of the Year, GLVC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and a First Team All-America selection from the AVCA. In addition, Hart was twice named an honorable mention All-American during her sophomore and junior years.

She stands as NKU's all-time kills leader with 1,850, ranks seventh at NKU with 1,191 career digs and second in block assists with 291.

Hart resides in Cincinnati with her husband, A.J., and their son, James, and daughter, Ellie.



# JASON RUPPELT

Jason Ruppelt was named the assistant coach for NKU volleyball on Feb. 23, 2015. He joined the Norse with eight years of coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently as the volunteer assistant coach at the University of Louisville.

Ruppelt's primary responsibilities with the Cardinals included video breakdown, assisting with scouting reports and on-court training. During his first season, the Cardinals captured the American Athletic Conference championship with a perfect 18-0 league record. Additionally, Ruppelt was a head coach with the Under-15 team at Kentucky Indiana Volleyball Academy, widely respected as one of the top volleyball clubs in the nation.

A 2010 graduate of South Dakota State University, Ruppelt spent seven years working with the Jackrabbits' volleyball program, first as a student assistant and manager where he worked as a practice player and helped with camps. Upon attaining his Bachelor of Science in Mathematics, Ruppelt continued with SDSU as a graduate assistant coach. He worked as the team's video coordinator and managed the team's academics, helping SDSU to a team GPA of 3.63 in the final year of his tenure.

Ruppelt is currently pursuing a Master of Education in Administration of Student Affairs from South Dakota State University.
