- NKU is 6-5 on the season, with additional wins over Marshal, Evansville and Fort Wayne.
- Redshirt-senior libero Lauren Hurley broke the NKU D I-era single-match record for digs against Morehead State (31).
- Hurley also posted the first back-to-back 30-dig matches in at least a decade.
- Senior middle blocker Keely Creamer paces the offense with 2.87 kills per set and .79 blocks per set.
- Creamer recently notched her 1,000th career kill in the match against Arizona.
- Redshirt-senior Taylor Snyder leads the offense with 9.38 assists per set. She is fourth on NKU's all-time career list with 3,864 assists.
- Freshman Shelby Olsen made her career debut at setter at the Eagle Challenge, averaging 11.25 assists per set.
- Olsen continued to run the offense and has averaged 9.30 assists per set for the last six
- At the start of August, NKU was granted active status as a Division I institution by the NCAA. The transition process began Dec. 8, 2011.
- The 2016 campaign marks the start of Liz Hart's seventh year at the helm of the Norse volleyball program.
- The HL Preseason Coaches Poll tabbed the Norse to finish fourth in the League.

NORSE NOTES

THIS WEEK IN NORSE VOLLEYBALL: After starting the 2016 slate with four road tournaments, the Norse kick off Horizon League play this weekend in Wisconsin, playing at Milwaukee and Green Bay. The match against the Panthers is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT/8 p.m. ET on Friday, Sept. 23, and will be broadcast live on WatchESPN and the ESPN app with Matt Schroeder on the call. The Norse then head to Green Bay on Saturday, Sept. 24, for an afternoon tilt with the Phoneix at 2 p.m. CT/3 p.m. ET.

LAST TIME OUT: NKU lost consecutive matches for the first time this year at the Butler Invitational, unable to come away with a win in any of the three matches. The host Bulldogs swept the Norse, 25-22, 25-18, 25-15, before Pac-12 foe Arizona also downed NKU in three, 25-14, 25-18, 25-13. NKU went five sets against Loyola Chicago, but came up short of a victory in the 25-21, 18-25, 25-21, 22-25, 15-6 setback. Sophomore outside hitter Haley Libs led the team with 2.09 kills per set, while senior middle hitter Keely Creamer averaged 1.82 kills per set. Redshirt-senior libero Lauren Hurley led the back row with 3.64 digs per set, while Libs also had a strong defensive outing with 2.82 digs/set to go with a double-double against Loyola that was highlighted by a career-high 16 digs.

INDIVIDUAL HONORS IN 2016: Redshirt-senior setter Taylor Snyder and Creamer were named to the all-tournament team at the Indiana Invitational, Aug. 26-27. Creamer hit .448 off 31 kills to go with 11 blocks to earn the honor, while Snyder paced the team with 90 assists, 24 digs and 15 kills between the three matches.

Hurley earned all-tournament honors in Bowling Green after averaging 4.67 digs per set and controlling the Norse reception line to keep the team in system off the serve.

At the Eagle Challenge, Hurley was named the tournament MVP after averaging 7.08 digs per set in the Norse's wins over Ball State, App State and Morehead State. Simpson and Libs were also named to the all-tournament team.

Hurley was also honored as the Horizon League Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 12. At NKU's final preseason tournament of the year, Creamer earned all-tournament honors at the Butler Invitational.

CREAMER JOINS THE 1,000-KILL CLUB: Going into the Butler Invitational, Creamer needed just nine kills to notch her 1,000th career kill. She accomplished the feat with her third kill against Pac-12 opponent Arizona. Creamer currently leads all current Norse in career kills with 1,011 and is also the season leader for kills per set at 2.87 after posting 112 in the first 11 matches.

HURLEY BECOMING A DEFENSIVE DYNAMO: Lauren Hurley just stepped into the libero role this season, but the redshirt-senior has taken little time in becoming one of the Horizon League's and the nation's top defenders. Hurley currently sits at second in the Horizon League with a 4.77 digs/set average, behind only Wright State's Jessie Thornton. She also sits just outside the national top 50, ranking 52nd in the nation.

In her outing at the Eagle Challenge, Hurley improved on her career high in digs in each match, amassing 24 against Ball State before posting NKU's first consecutive 30-dig matches in at least a decade with 30 against App State and an NKU Division I-era single-match-record 31 in the win over Morehead State. To date, she has the only consecutive 30-dig performances in four-set matches this season in the nation.

SCOUTING MILWAUKEE: The Panthers have posted an identical preseason record as the Norse, going 6-5 in the first 11 outings. Milwaukee's big hitter is 6-foot-4 outside hitter Caitlin Schultz, who averages 3.25 kills per set at a .228 clip. At the net, middles Jess Kalous and Bridget Wallenberger are combining to average nearly two blocks per set, while Myanna Ruiz holds down the back row with 4.37 digs per set. The offense is run through Jenn Dore, who dishes out 9.63 assists per set. Milwaukee most recently dropped a match to Marquette in three sets on Sept. 17, 25-21, 25-19, 25-21

NKÚ is still searching for the first win in program history against the Panthers in a series that began just last season. Milwaukee swept the Norse in Cream City on Oct. 3, and the Norse fell just short to the Panthers in Highland Heights in a five-setter on Oct. 30.

SCOUTING GREEN BAY: Green Bay has posted an 8-4 record in a tough preseason slate that included two nationally-ranked opponents. The team nearly squeaked out a win against No. 17 Ohio State but ultimately fell in five sets, and also had an impressive outing in the most recent match against No. 2 Minnesota. Though Green Bay was swept by the Golden Gophers, each set was within five points. Middle blocker Lydia DeWeese leads the team with 2.93 kills per set and boasts the second-highest hitting percentage in the League at a .387 clip. She is also the League leader in blocks with 1.59 rejections a game, a number that ranks ninth in the nation. Austyn Everingham leads the back row with 4.37 digs per set, while Maddie Yoss sits at third in the HL with 10.43 assists a set.

NKU has won all five meetings against the Phoenix in the all-time series, which began in 1985 and was recently renewed last season when the Norse joined the Horizon League. Head coach Liz Hart holds a 3-0 record against the Phoenix, with two five-setters during the regular season before a four-set win in the 2015 Horizon League Tournament on Nov. 20, 2015.

NKU AGAINST NON-CONFERENCE OPPONENTS: The Norse have faced eleven opponents from nine different conferences this season, with wins over teams from Conference USA, the Mid-American Conference, Missouri Valley Conference, the Ohio Valley Conference, the Summit Conference and the Sun Belt Conference. Losses have come against teams from the Big Ten, Pac-12, Big East, Missouri Valley and Mid-American Conference.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE FOR HOME SLATE: Seven of volleyball's home matches have been selected as a part of NKU's fall broadcast partnership with ESPN3. Broadcast dates include matches against: Cleveland State (Sept. 30, 6 p.m.), Oakland (Oct. 1, 4 p.m.), Valparaiso (Oct. 7, 7 p.m.), UIC (Oct. 15, 4 p.m.), Wright State (Oct. 23, 4 p.m.), Green Bay (Nov. 4, 6 p.m.) and Milwaukee (Nov. 5, 4 p.m.).

OFFICIAL DIVISION I STATUS: NKU Athletics announced on Aug. 9 that the NCAA Board granted the department active status as a Division I institution. With active Division I status, NKU is now able to compete for NCAA Championship berths for the first time since the Norse started the four-year reclassification period.

NEAR THE TOP OF THE HORIZON: The Norse were picked to finish fourth in the Horizon League, according to a preseason poll of the League's nine head coaches. Reigning champion Cleveland State earned top honors with four first-place votes, followed closely by Valparaiso, also with four first-place votes. Oakland received one first-place vote, which put the Golden Grizzlies in third.

NORSE SMARTS: NKU Volleyball was honored for its work off the court as a recipient of the AVCA Team Academic Award. The Norse boasted a 3.58 cumulative grade point average for the 2015-16 school year, which is no surprise as academic excellence has become the norm for the program with four consecutive years above a 3.50 GPA.

LIZ HART

Head Coach Seventh season

Entering her seventh season at the helm of Northern Kentucky University volleyball, Liz Hart coaches a volleyball team that is On The Rise.

Since the program's move to Division I, Hart has orchestrated one of the most successful starts for a transitioning team in



In 2013, NKU picked up marquee wins against Syracuse, Cincinnati and Navy before the team found itself eligible for conference postseason play in 2014. The Norse advanced to the semifinals of the Atlantic Sun Conference Championship and finished the season ranked No. 110 in the RPI among 334 Division I institutions.

2014 marked the first year that the Norse competed in a conference tournament, advancing to the semifinals of the Atlantic Sun Championship. NKU finished with a 19-11 overall record and went 7-7 in the A-Sun, while three Norse were named All-A-Sun performers. Jenna Ruble was named to the A-Sun First Team, and both Taylor Snyder and Keely Creamer picked up second-team honors.

The 2015 saw another landmark, as the Norse were honored with the first conference individual honor of the Division I era when Haley Libs was named the Horizon League Freshman of the Year. After moving from the A-Sun to the Horizon League, the Norse went 14-16 on the season, including 8-8 in League play.

As the Norse are in the second year of Horizon League competition and the first year of full Division I postseason Eligibility, Hart looks to push the Norse even further.

"We use the competitive cauldron to increase competition level amongst the players and get them competing at their highest level every practice," says Hart. The cauldron ranks each player on a variety of axes each practice, forcing each player to be at her best every moment in practice and on the game court.

The expectation of excellence continues not only on the court, but off as well. NKU's volleyball teams have maintained abvoe a 3.50 grade point average over the last four years and have earned the AVCA's Team Academic Award in three reecent seasons.

Hart's players log numerous community service hours, aiding local elementary schools and retirement homes, as well as the Ronald McDonald House in Cincinnati, Ohio. In addition, Norse volleyball players represent the program and the university on leadership boards of university, local, conference, regional and national scope.

"We want our players to graduate and leave our program with self-confidence and have the leadership skills to tackle the next part of their lives," added Hart. "We're bringing in student-athletes who are driven, believe in our vision and will help to build on the success of our alumnae."

Hart herself is one of those alumnae, having spent her playing career representing the Black and Gold. During her playing career, Hart was named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Freshman of the Year in 2004, and in 2008 was named an NCAA Top 30 Woman of the Year recipient as well as the GLVC Player of the Year, Great Lakes Region Player of the Year, GLVC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and a First Team All-America selection from the AVCA. In addition, Hart was twice named an honorable mention All-American during her sophomore and junior years.

She stands as NKU's all-time kills leader with 1,850, ranks seventh at NKU with 1,191 career digs and second in block assists with 291.

Hart resides in Cincinnati with her husband, A.J., and their son, James, and daughter, Ellie.



JASON RUPPELT

Assistant Coach Second season

Jason Ruppelt was named the assistant coach for NKU volleyball on Feb. 23, 2015. He joined the Norse with eight years of coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently as the volunteer assistant coach at the University of Louisville.

Ruppelt's primary responsibilities with the Cardinals included video breakdown, assisting with scouting reports and on-court training. During his first season, the Cardinals captured the American Athletic Conference championship with a perfect 18-0 league record. Additionally, Ruppelt was a head coach with the Under-15 team at Kentucky Indiana Volleyball Academy, widely respected as one of the top volleyball clubs in the nation.

A 2010 graduate of South Dakota State University, Ruppelt spent seven years working with the Jackrabbits' volleyball program, first as a student assistant and manager where he worked as a practice player and helped with camps. Upon attaining his Bachelor of Science in Mathematics, Ruppelt continued with SDSU as a graduate assistant coach. He worked as the team's video coordinator and managed the team's academics, helping SDSU to a team GPA of 3.63 in the final year of his tenure.

Ruppelt is currently pursuing a Master of Education in Administration of Student Affairs from South Dakota State University.
