

NORSE NOTES

- Northern Kentucky will see one senior suit up in the black and gold during the 2023-24 season in Kennedy Igo, a guard from Mount Sterling, Ky. --"The best way to describe Kennedy is tough. She's one of the fiercest competitors I've watched play the game in a while," Coach Volz discussed.

 "Not only can she impact the game on the offensive end with her scoring"
- Davis, a junior guard from Detroit, Michigan, was named to the Horizon All-League Third Team during the 2022-23 campaign after averaging 13.4 points per game as the second Northern Kentucky leading scorer. Kailee was lights out from beyond the arc last season, shooting 35 percent overall from three-point range.
- Davis ranked fifth overall in the Horizon League last year in assist/turnover ratio at 1.43 and was sixth in the conference in assists with 87 total. Davis also ranked seventh in the Horizon League in three-pointers made per game at 1.81.
- "Going to take a lot of luck and remaining healthy to get back to the title game. Green Bay will be very good, YSU has a lot of experience and CSU is good no matter what." Camryn Volz said.

HEAD COACH - CAMRYN VOLZ

Camryn Volz (Whitaker) was named the fifth head coach of the Northern Kentucky University women's basketball program by Director of Athletics Ken Bothof on May 6, 2016. Whitaker has been a part of four consecutive coaching staffs that have made NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Elite Eight and Sweet Sixteen in the last two seasons.

In her first season, the Norse went 9-22, including 5-11 in the Horizon League. The Norse were third in the Horizon League in sccoring defense, holding opponents to 63.8 points per game. Following the regular season, senior Rebecca Lyttle was named to the All-Horizon League Defensive Team for her relentless effort under the basket.

NKU posted a 9-22 record in 2017-18 as well, but the team showed marked improvement that was highlighted by possibly the biggest upset in women's college basketball that year when the Norse upended No. 19/20 Green Bay on Dec. 30. Kailey Coffey earned all-freshman team honors after leading the Norse in rebounds and ranking second on the team in scoring.

The Norse recorded the highest conference finish since moving to the Horizon League in the 2018-19 campaign, going 10-8 to finish fifth in the Horizon League. Ally Niece was named to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team and NKU finished the year with an 11-18 mark.

NKU continued to improve under Whitaker's fourth year at the helm, recording the first 20-win season of the Division I era and advancing to the semifinals of the Horizon League Championship. Niece and Molly Glick were both named to the All-Horizon League Second Team and Ivy Turner earned all-freshman distinction. Niece also claimed all-tournament honors.

Whitaker joined the Norse after spending one season at Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to a 25-8 overall record and the team's seventh consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament, resulting in a Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2016.

Whitaker spent the previous three seasons at Dayton, where she was primarily responsible for the guards and recruiting. During her tenure, the Flyers amassed 78 wins to just 17 losses, claiming the Atlantic 10 regular-season championship in 2013 and 2014 and advancing to the program's first-ever Elite Eight appearance in 2015.

A native of Cynthiana, Kentucky, Whitaker played her prep ball at Harrison County High School, where she garnered

USA Today honorable mention and second-team All-Kentucky honors.

Following high school, Whitaker played five seasons at Western Kentucky University, leading the Hilltoppers to 97 wins and postseason berths in each of her seasons. Whitaker helped the team to the 2003 Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship and an NCAA Tournament bid, and stands third on WKU's all-time assist chart. Whitaker returned to her alma mater for the 2011-12 season as an assistant coach.

She started her coaching career in 2006 at Austin Peay, where she spent two seasons before joining the staff at Missouri State in 2009. She helped guide the Lady Bears to a pair of WNIT appearances, including a third-round trip in 2010. Missouri State amassed 46 wins over her two seasons in Springfield.


