This Week: NM State heads north for the Rio Grande Rivalry series against New Mexico on Tuesday, Nov. 20. The meeting in Albuquerque concludes the road trip for the Aggies before hosting the annual Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic in Las Cruces, N.M. Welcoming George Mason, Drake and UC Irvine, NM State first faces George Mason on Friday afternoon. The winner of the Drake/UCI meeting will determine who the Aggies play on the final day of the Classic on Saturday evening.

THE LOOKS

Looking Ahead: Looking past the holiday weekend, NM State hosts I-10 rival UTEP on Nov. 28 at the Pan American Center. After the meeting with UTEP, the Aggies hit the road to meet Southern Utah on Dec. 1, before making the short drive to El Paso to rekindle the battle with the Miners.

Looking Back: Two exciting matchups opened the season for the Aggies. NM State thrilled the crowd with an overtime win versus Loyola Marymount 77-76. Kelsie Rozendaal made her senior debut with a season high 22 points and collected her first double double with 11 rebounds, another career-high. Two days later, the Aggies made a late comeback attempt against UC Santa Barbara that fell short in a 43-41 loss in California. A slow start in the first half proved troublesome for the Aggies, who came up with 16 points and 16 rebound in the second half alone.

Trakh Signs Five to NLI: Head coach Mark Trakh announces that five high school players have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Aggies in the fall of 2013. Trakh is in his second season with NM State and has led the Aggies to a 1-0 start to the 2012-13 season.

Joining the Aggies in 2013 are Tamera Williams of Centennial High School (Las Vegas, Nev.), Brianna Freeman of Harker Heights High School (Killeen, Texas), Vanessa Garner of Archbishop Mitty High School (Milpitas, Calif.), Moriah Mack of Reagan High School (San Antonio, Texas), and Brandee Walton of St. Mary's High School (Phoenix, Az.)

AGGIE COUNTRY

About the Aggies: NM State returns six from the 2011-12 team, including Kelsie Rozendaal, who finished the season with a .526 shooting percentage. Rozendaal was third on the team with 108 total rebounds and second with a .778 free throw percentage on the year. Senior Jasmine Rutledge also returns for the Aggies after averaging 5.7 points per game with 4.1 rebounds. Rutledge saw action in each of the Aggies 30 games last season and started in half of those.

Chrissy Fletcher and Camila Rosen also return to the hardwood as two of the Aggies starters. Fletcher went 4-for-4 at the free throw line against UTEP (11/16) while earning her second straight academic All-WAC honor. Rosen picked up 32 steals as a junior and earned a season-high 13 points against Boise State (1/7).

Gilbreath joins the Aggie squad as a transfer from USC. The former Trojan played in each of USC's 30 games last season, starting 17 contests and averaging 3.9 points per game. She led the team in free throw percentage at 83 percent (24-of-29) and averaged 2.6 rebounds per game. Gilbreath sat out three seasons with the Trojans due to knee injuries.

Along with Gilbreath, Trakh added six other newcomers to the roster. Las Cruces native, Elena Holguin, comes in after redshirting her freshman season. Three-point threat, Alexis Nelson, also joins the Aggies after breaking the single-season record for three pointers with 60 during her senior campaign at Aurora High School in Aurora, Ill.

NM State also brings in University of San Diego transfer, Denesia Williamson. The sophomore started one game and participated in 16 while averaging 12 minutes per game last season. The 5-6 guard averaged 5.1 points, 1.4 assists and 1.1 rebounds per game with the Toreros. Abby Scott (Madras, Ore.), Sasha Weber (Lacey, Wash.) and Shay Young (San Diego, Calif.) round out the newcomers for NM State.

Heartbreak in California: The New Mexico State Aggies made a bold comeback in the second half of play, but fell 43-41 to UC Santa Barbara on Nov. 14, at the Thunderdome in Santa Barbara, Calif.

The Aggies had a slow start in the first half, scoring just 14 points before leaving the hardwood. Sophomore Daneisia Williamson led the Aggies with six points in the opening half, while senior Kelsie Rozendaal collected three rebounds. Williams finished the road opener with nine points and one assist.

In the second half, Rozendaal opened with a first minute layup, giving the Aggies some energy. Stefanie Gilbreath came up with two free shots for NM State followed by one from Rozendaal in the middle of the half. Back-to-back baskets by Gilbreath and freshman Shay Young halfway through the second period, gave the Aggies the momentum they needed to drive the score. A shot by Jasmine Rutledge out of a timeout closed the gap for the Aggies to 34-25 with less than 10 minutes to go.

That flow continued for NM State as the Aggies worked for 16 points and 16 rebounds in the second half alone. The team also compiled three assists and collected their only three-point shot of the game.

Gilbreath notched 11 points on the night with four boards. Rozendaal worked to go 4-5 in the second half. She combined for five boards and one assist. She earned 10 total points in the game.

As a team, Aggie defense proved strong against the Gouchos as they collected three shot clock violations in their home opener. NM State also caused eight turnovers on the night.

Thriller on Opening Night: The New Mexico State women's basketball team thrilled the crowd with an overtime victory over the Lions of Loyola Marymount, 77-76, on Nov. 12, at the Pan American Center.



Sophomore transfer Danesia Williamson locked the score at 69-69 with less than 30 seconds to play in the game. The 5-6 guard notched 19 points on the night. She paved the way for senior Kelsie Rozendaal to give the Aggies the 77-76 advantage with two free shots in the final five seconds of overtime. Rozendaal's shots at the line earned her a career-high 22 points, while shooting 8-13 in the season opener. She also notched her first double-double of the year with 11 rebounds.

Williamson and Rozendaal were accompanied by senior Stefanie Gilbreath and junior Jasmine Rutledge in double-digit points. Gilbreath and Rutledge each earned 12 points on the evening with Gilbreath going 5-6 at the line and Rutledge collecting eight boards.

Williamson started things off early with a three-pointer and three buckets in the first four minutes of play. She managed nine points in the first half alone. She was 4-5 from the line and helped the Aggies to an overall 42.3 shooting percentage in the first 20 minutes of play.

Loyola Marymount went on an eight point run in the middle of the half, giving the Lions their first lead of the half 22-21. After trading shots back and forth, a deep pass by Sasha Weber to Rutledge gave the Aggies the lead once again 28-27 with 3:53 left in the first half. Two free shots made by sophomore Simone Ruedin tied the score for NM State at 30 with less than three minutes to play in the half. LMU answered back with seven straight late in the half to gain a 37-30 lead and close out the half. Ruedin earned three steals on the game, a career high for the sophomore.

Big Night for Rozendaal: Senior Kelsie Rozendaal opened her final season in Crimson and White with an outstanding career-high 22 points. She also earned her first double-double of the season with 11 rebounds and not a single turnover.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENTS

About New Mexico: The Lobos open the 2012 season with a 3-0 record after beating Northern Arizona (68-57), Texas Tech (65-61) and Houston Baptist (63-46). New Mexico is led by Caroline Durbin. The senior guard is averaging 14.7 points per game with a three-game total of 44. With a .429 field goal percentage, Durbin has already collected 17 rebounds with three steals and seven assists.

Series History Versus the Lobos:

This November's competition the in-state rivals marks the 67th time the teams have met on the hardwood. The Lobos lead the series 42-25 with the last meeting coming on Dec. 30, 2011. The last time the Aggies beat their northern rival was Dec. 2, 2007. The Lobos have taken each of the last seven games. Last season, NM State fell with a one-point margin in both the meetings.

Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving

Classic: NM State is 8-2 all-time in the holiday tournament and is fighting for its fifth tournament title. The Aggies lost each of their two games during the 2011 Classic, but claimed the title in the previous eight holiday tournaments.

About George Mason: The Patriots open the season 2-1 with their lone loss coming at Oakland to tip off the season. George Mason finished the 2011-12 season 15-16 overall and ended seventh in the Colonial Athletic Conference. This season, the team's biggest asset is Janaa Pickard. The junior forward has compiled 37 points this season (12.3 avg) with seven blocked shots. The Patriot has tallied 21 rebounds and is 8-11 from the line going into the weekend.

Series History Versus the Patriots:

The meeting during the 2012 Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic is the first time the teams have met in program history.

About Drake: Drake comes into the Thanksgiving weekend with a split 1-1 record. The Bulldogs lost in their home opener to South Dakota 74-69, but re-

gained traction with a 71-61 win over Illinois at Chicago on Sunday. A clear leader on the court for the Bulldogs is Kyndal Clark. Clark is averaging 21.5 points in her first two games of the season and is maintaining a .333 field goal percentage. She had 12 total rebounds, eight of those on the defensive side of the ball. Clark has six three's on her stat sheet with five assists. Carly Grenfell is also someone to watch on Drake's roster. Grenfell is averaging 15 points per game and leads the team with a .579 shooting average.

Series History Versus the Bulldogs:

The meeting during the 2012 Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic is the first time the teams have met in program history.

About UC Irvine: Starting the season 0-2, the Anteaters are led by Jasmine Bernard. Bernard had a team-high .458 field goal percentage (11-24), while averaging 11 points per game. She has three steals on the season with four rebounds. Camille Buckley is not far behind, as she is averaging nine points a game and leads the team with 10 offensive rebounds, 16 total in her two games.

Series History Versus the

Anteaters: The last time the teams faces was Nov. 14, 2008. As of that game, the Aggies hold a 16-10 record over the Anteaters. The Aggies earned a home-opening win over UCI 78-55. The game also marked the last time before this season that the Aggies have opened at home with a win.

Aggie Returners Earn Academic

All-WAC: The 2011-12 Academic All-WAC women's basketball was announced in the spring. To be eligible, a student-athlete must have completed at least one academic year, have at least a 3.00 cumulative grade point average and have participated in at least 50 percent of the team's contests. Fresh Faces for Trakh: Head coach Mark Trakh brings on a slew of newcomers for the 2012-13 campaign. Among the new Aggies are transfers Stefanie Gilbreath and Denesia Williamson. Gilbreath joins the Aggie squad after spending four seasons with USC. Gilbreath sat out three seasons with the Trojans due to knee injuries, but played in each of USC's 30 games in 2011-12. Williamson wears the Crimson after one season with University of San Diego. The 5-6 guard averaged 5.1 points, 1.4 assists and 1.1 rebounds per game with the Toreros.

Along with the two transfers, Trakh also adds five other players to the roster. Las Cruces native, Elena Holguin, comes in after redshirting her freshman season. Three-point threat, Alexis Nelson, joins the Aggies after breaking the single-season record for three pointers with 60 during her senior campaign at Aurora High School in Aurora, Ill. Abby Scott (Madras, Ore.), Sasha Weber (Lacey, Wash.) and Shay Young (San Diego, Calif.) round out the newcomers for NM State.

Last Season: Under the helm of first-year head coach, Mark Trakh, the Aggies finished the 2011-12 season with a 6-24 overall season record. This left NM State with a 3-11 Western Athletics Conference record. The Aggies made an appearance at the WAC Championships at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas, Nev. (3/7). The Aggies were seeded eighth in the tournament but were quickly booted out by No. 1 66-58 State.

Senior guard Tabitha Wampler was the most recent Aggie to join the 1,000 Point Club with a career 1,254 points (2008-12). She joins former teammates Danisha Corbett and Madison Spence along with Aggie great Anita Maxwell (2,601) and Andrea Kabwasa (1,788).

Another highlight for the Aggies in 2011-12 was coach Trakh coaching his 500th game of his career as a Division I head coach. In his 17th year on the sidelines, the floor general notched the milestone against Hawai'i in Las Cruces Feb. 16.

Preseason Accolades: The Western Athletic Conference coaches and media picked NM State to finish eighth and ninth in their respective preseason polls, and senior guard Stefanie Gilbreath was named an All-WAC preseason pick.

The Aggies were picked sixth in last season's preseason polls. NM State finished 6-24 overall and 3-11 in the conference to place in eighth. The eighth place rank gave the Aggies a tough battle against top-ranked Fresno State in the 2012 WAC Championships. The Bulldogs defeated the Aggies 66-58, knocking NM State out of the tournament.

Reigning first team All-WAC honoree Christensen was voted Preseason Player of the Year and is the on the preseason All-WAC first team. Joining her on the first team are Alyssa Charlston of Idaho, Louisiana Tech's Whitney Frazier, Diamond Ford of Texas State and Seattle U's Kacie Sowell.

-- The 2012-13 season marks the 40th season of Aggie women's basketball. The first season was 1973-74.

-- This season also marks 25 years since the Aggies last NCAA tournament appearance. The 1987-88 team was the last in program history to receive an NCAA berth.

Potential Aggie Milestones:

-- Head coach Mark Trakh needs just four more victories to reach No. 300 in his career as a Division I head coach—this could happen as early as Nov. 28, when the Aggies face I-10 rival UTEP at the Pan American Center.

-- With 11 victories during the 2012-13 season, NM State will reach its 600th win in program history. Currently, the Aggies are 589-524 all-time.

Aggies Host 16 Games This Season: The Aggies' 17 home games at

the Pan American Center is the fifth time in six seasons NM State plays host to more than 15 contests. Along with this year's ledger, here are the prior four season slates with 16-plus games in Las Cruces including a school-record 18 games last year in 2009-10.

Aggies slated for 29 games in 2012-13 season

Trakh's squad is set to host 16 regular-season games at the Pan American Center for the third straight season - matching the third-most amount of home contests in the NM State record books. It marks the 14th season that the Crimson and White play host to 15 or more opponents in the regular season. In those previous 13 seasons, NM State averaged 18 wins per year.

With five new squads joining the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) schedule this season, the conference slate grows to 18 games. Each squad will play home-and-home contests with the other nine teams. New schools on the Aggies' conference schedule this year include Denver, Seattle, Texas State, UT Arlington and UTSA. NM State's travel partner in 2012-13 will be the Pioneers of Denver.

The Aggies' upcoming non-conference ledger consists of seven home matchups and four road contests. Prior to the WAC schedule, NM State tips against four opponents with 2012 postseason credentials.

NM State's 29-game, regular-season schedule kicks off in Las Cruces Monday, Nov. 12 against Loyola Marymount. The Aggies' first road contest occurs at 2012 NCAA Tournament team UCSB (Nov. 14) in Santa Barbara, Calif., NM State knocked off the Gauchos at home last season 52-51.

In-state rival New Mexico is on the Aggie docket for a pair of home-and-home contests in 2012-13. NM State travels to Albuquerque on Nov. 20 and completes the Rio Grande Rivalry against the Lobos at the Pan American Center on Dec. 18.



New Mexico State looks for its fifth Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic title in six seasons on Nov. 23-24. Joining the Aggies in the two-day holiday tourney is 2012 Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) selection Drake along with UC Irvine and George Mason. NM State and GMU will battle in game two of the tourney Nov. 23. Rival UTEP also advanced to the post-season as an NCAA qualifier last season. The Aggies and Miners play twice in the first month of the season. NM State travels to El Paso on Nov. 28 then hosts UTEP a week later in Las Cruces Dec. 5.

Rounding out the non-conference slate, the Aggies travel to Southern Utah on Dec. 1 and later hosts 2012 WNIT opponent UMKC (Dec. 21). NM State breaks away from conference play when it entertains CSU Bakersfield Feb. 23.

NM State opens WAC competition with four of its first six games at home in 2012-13. The Aggies open the conference schedule at home against UT Arlington on Dec. 29 before a New Year's Eve battle against traditional power Louisiana Tech Dec. 31.

The Aggies kick off 2013 with their first conference road trip to UTSA Jan. 3 before visiting Texas State for a game two days later. NM State returns home to face 2012 Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) selection Seattle on Jan. 10 and Idaho Jan. 12.

On Jan. 17, another 2012 WNIT participant in Utah State hosts NM State. The Aggies then travel to San Jose State Jan. 19 and make a visit to Denver a week later to complete the first half of the WAC slate.

The Crimson and White hosts Texas State Jan. 31 and UTSA Feb. 3 before making road trips to Idaho (Feb. 7) and Seattle (Feb. 9). SJSU invades the Pan Am on Valentine's Day a couple days before Utah State pays a visit to the Mesilla Valley Feb. 16.

After stepping out of conference to play Bakersfield, NM State hosts Den-

ver for its final home game on Senior Day, March 2. The Aggies close out the regular season on the road at LA Tech (March 7) and at UTA (March 9).

The 2013 WAC Tournament will be held at a neutral site in Las Vegas for the third year in a row. The Orleans Arena will play host to both the men's and women's conference basketball tournaments March 12-16. All 10 teams will take part in the conference tourney.

In a transitional season, the Aggies completed the 2011-12 campaign at 6-24 in Trakh's first year on the NM State sideline. The Aggies finished the season on a strong note pushing top-seeded Fresno State to the final minute at the 2012 WAC Tournament before the Bulldogs escaped with an eight-point victory.

NM State returns seven players from a year ago but loses the services of Aggie 1,000-point club member Tabytha Wampler and fellow departed seniors Erica Sanchez and Kaitlyn Soto. Trakh and his staff added six new commitments including former high school All-American and USC transfer Stefanie Gilbreath.

Gilbreath, a 6-1 guard originally from Katy, Texas, joined fellow spring signees Danesia Williamson, a 5-6 guard from San Diego and Alexis Nelson, a 5-7 guard from Aurora, Illinois. They followed fall signees Abby Scott, a 6-1 guard from Madras, Ore., Sasha Weber, a 6-0 guard from Lacey, Wash., and Shay Young, a 6-0 guard from San Diego.

Mark Trakh begins his second year as the head of the NM State womens basketball program. Last year, Trakh coaches the Aggies to a 6-24 record overall and coached senior Tabitha Wampler to the 1,000 Point Club (1,254).

New Mexico State athletic director Dr. McKinley Boston announced the hiring of Mark Trakh as the new head coach of the Aggie women's basketball program on Friday, April 8, 2011.

Trakh (pronounced TRACK), 56, becomes the 10th head coach in NM State history and has nearly 30 years of head coaching experience, including 16 at the NCAA Division I level at both Southern California and Pepperdine.

Trakh served as the head coach at USC from 2004-09, where he compiled a 90-64 overall record. In his first two seasons, he guided the Women of Troy to their first NCAA appearances in seven years, as the team advanced to the second round in both 2005 and 2006. The Trojans finished in the top half of the Pac-10 all five years and were the conference tournament runner-up in 2009 and regular season runner-up in 2005.

Trakh coached four all-Pac-10 performers at USC, including two-time first-team honoree Eshaya Murphy, who was later tabbed in the second round of the WNBA Draft in 2007. In all, his players made various all-Pac-10 teams 20 times and also excelled in the classroom, garnering a spot on the conference all-academic squad on 14 occasions.

On the recruiting trail, Trakh helped the Trojans sign four classes ranked in the top 12 nationally, including the No. 1 class in 2006, according to USA Today and All Star Girls Report. Trakh successfully recruited 10 Street & Smith All-Americans, seven McDonald's All-Americans, three Parade All-Americans and the 2006 National Player of the Year.

Before accepting the position at USC, Trakh had a highly successful 11-year tenure as head coach at Pepperdine from 1993-2004. Under his direction, the Waves posted six consecutive 20-win seasons from 1997-2003, made six straight postseason appearances and claimed four West Coast Conference titles. Trakh was twice named the league's coach of the year in both 1999 and 2002, and ended his tenure with a 199-123 overall record and a 99-55 mark in the WCC.

The Waves had two WCC Players of the Year in Rasheeda Clark (2000) and Tamara McDonald (2002), with Clark going on to become the school's first ever WNBA Draft pick. Trakh coached 10 first-team all-conference players at Pepperdine and his student-athletes posted an impressive 100 percent graduation rate during his stay in Malibu.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Trakh had a Hall of Fame career as the head girls' coach at Brea Olinda High School in Brea, Calif., from 1981-93. He helped lead the Ladycats to national prominence with a 354-45 overall record, highlighted by four state titles (1989, 1991, 1992 and 1993), six CIF Southern Section championships and 12 Orange

League Crowns. In his final five campaigns, Brea Olinda posted an amazing 161-8 record and did not lose more than two games in any single season.

Among his standouts at Brea Olinda were current Long Beach State head coach Jody (Anton) Wynn and current Hawai'i associate coach Da Houli. Trakh, a California State High School Coach of the Year, is a member of both the City of Brea Athletic Hall of Fame as well as the Southern California High School Basketball Coaches' Hall of Fame.

A 1981 graduate of Long Beach State, the Wanque, N.J., native earned his bachelor's degree in journalism and also has his teaching credential.
