THE LOOKS

Looking Ahead: NM State wraps up the regular season with two games on the road before heading into the WAC tournament. The Aggies face La Tech on Thursday, March 7, in Ruston, La., before making the final trip of the season to UT Arlington on Saturday, March 9.

Looking Back: The Aggies continue on a three-game winning streak after

an 87-81 win over future conference opponent CSU Bakersfield on Saturday, Feb. 23. The Aggies worked for a season high 50.8 shooting percentage in the 600th win in NM State program history. Once again, four Aggies had double digit shooting games with sophomore Danesia Williamson besting her career high with 27 points in the win. Senior Camila Rosen broke out with her career best 19 points and six steals with nine boards. NM State shot a stellar 55.6 percent from the field in the first half (15-27) and tallied 13 points off Roadrunner turnovers.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENTS

About Denver: With a WAC record of 7-8, including a win over the Aggies, Denver matches NM State's 12-14 overall record this season. The team averages 66.6 points a game with Morgan Van Roper-Rose leading the way with 13.3. per contest. Maiya Michel is the defender to watch with 9.9 rebounds a game.

Series History versus the Pioneers: The NM State Aggies are 5-6 all-time against the Denver Pioneers. In the first meeting this season, Denver beat the Aggies 67-58.

AGGIE COUNTRY

About the Aggies: NM State continues on its three-game win streak after beating non-conference opponent CSU Bakersfield on Saturday, Feb. 23. The



team is 12-14 on the season and 5-10 going into the week. The team is on top with a pair of WAC Player of the Week honors from Danesia Williamson and Camila Rosen in the last two weeks. NM State was on a nine-game losing skid before collecting its two biggest wins over the season against SJSU and Utah State on Feb. 14 and 16, respectively. In the win over conference leader Utah State, NM State boasted a season-high 106 points.

Road to Vegas: NM State is on a three-game winning streak and sits eighth in the WAC going into the final two weeks of play. With a 5-10 WAC record, the Aggies have a .462 winning percentage on the season and .333 in league play.

Weekly Standouts

WAC Player of the Week: senior guard Camila Rosen was named Western Athletic Conference Player of the Week for the week of Feb. 18-24. This is Rosen's first WAC Player of the Week honor and the team's second in consecutive weeks.

The Berkeley, Calif. native scored a career-high 19 points to go along with nine rebounds, a career-best six steals and two assists in an 87-81 win over CSU Bakersfield, the 600th victory in program history. She shot 66.7 percent from the floor (8-of-12) and 75 percent from beyond the three-point line (3-of-4) to lead the Aggies to their highest field goal percentage of the season with 50.8 percent on the game. Prior to the win over CSUB, Rosen averaged 3.5 points per game with 5.1 rebounds and 1.3 steals on the season.

Numbers in the WAC:

Aggies rank second in the WAC conference for scoring defense with an average of 63.6 points per game. NMSU's Stefanie Gilbreath ranks 3rd in the WAC for 18.7 points per game

slightly following Ta' Rea Cunnigan and Diamond Ford.

Kelsie Rozendaal ranks 8th in the WAC conference for offensive rebounds with 3.79 average per game along with Camila Rosen who ranks 8th with an average of 2.80.

Big Milestones: With a win over CSU Bakersfield on Saturday, NM State earned its 600th victory in program history. With the current 12-14 record, the Aggies sit at 600-538 all-time.

Coach Trakh picked up his 300th career win as a Division I head coach on Saturday, Dec. 1, against Southern Utah. The Aggies pulled off a last minute 70-68 defeat over the Thunderbirds, help-

ing Trakh to earn the milestone victory. Trakh holds a 307-225 career record.

Rivalry Rundown

UNM: The Lobos swept the Rio Grande Rivalry Series this season with a 60-37 win over the Aggies at The Pit on Nov. 20 and a 60-44 victory in Las Cruces on Dec. 18. In game one, the Aggies had trouble making shots, but kept the stats similar to the Lobos. The Aggies collected 44 rebounds on the evening with six assists and two blocks. The Lobos were quite similar to NM State with 43 boards, but tallied 16 assists on the evening. Game two finished in similar fashion with the Lobos claiming a 60-44 victory over NM State at the Pan Am on Dec. 18. The loss at home marked the first of the 2012-13 season. Sasha Weber led the Aggies with 10 points and three rebounds on the evening. The Aggies shot 30.4 percent from the floor but tallied eight steals as a team with 27 rebounds. Those stats were not enough to hold off the Lobos who finished the game shooting 47.5 percent from the field and picking up 42 rebounds on the night.

UTEP: NM State took game one of the Battle of I-10 rivalry series with a late game battle to a 69-68 win over the Miners. UTEP maintained the lead throughout most of the game, gaining as much as a 15 point lead in the first half, but Stefanie Gilbreath finished her first Battle of I-10 game with a stellar 22 points to collect a regular-season career high. She went 5-for-8 on three pointers and picking up eight rebounds to match her career-high. Sophomore Danesia Williamson also picked up a career-high with 23 points on the game with a solid 10-of-12 at the line. Game two was set to a different tune with the Miners running away early with the 66-44 win over NM State in El Paso. The Aggies struggled on offense, scoring just 14 points in the first half of play. The second half was a bit more positive as Williamson collected 13 points in the half with two field goals and one three pointer. She was 6-for-6 at the line with four rebounds. Jasmine Rutledge finished the game with 11 points on the evening and compiled nine points at the line to mark a new career best



for the junior.

Tournament Champs: The New Mexico State Aggies claimed the Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic tournament title with a stellar 50-44 win over UC Irvine on Saturday evening at the Pan American Center. The previous night, the Aggies claimed a 55-52 win over the Patriots of George Mason. With the 2-0 record on the tournament, NM State's Kelsie Rozendaal and Sasha Weber were named to the All-Tournament team. Rozendaal was also selected tournament MVP for her work on the hardwood.

Trakh Signs Five to NLI: Head coach Mark Trakh announces that five high school players have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Aggies in the fall of 2013. Trakh is in his second season with NM State and has led the Aggies to a 1-0 start to the 2012-13 season. Joining the Aggies in 2013 are Tamera Williams of Centennial High School (Las Vegas, Nev.), Brianna Freeman of Harker Heights High School (Killeen, Texas), Vanessa Garner of Archbishop Mitty High School (Milpitas, Calif.), Moriah Mack of Reagan High School (San Antonio, Texas), and Brandee Walton of St. Mary's High School (Phoenix, Az.)

Last Season: Under the helm of first-year head coach, Mark Trakh, the Aggies finished the 2011-12 season with a 6-24 overall season record. This left NM State with a 3-11 Western Athletic Conference record. The Aggies made an appearance at the WAC Championships at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas, Nev. (3/7). The Aggies were seeded eighth in the tournament but were quickly booted out by No. 1 66-58 State. Senior guard Tabitha Wampler was the most recent Aggie to join the 1,000 Point Club with a career 1,254 points (2008-12). She joins former teammates Danisha Corbett and Madison Spence along with Aggie great Anita Maxwell (2,601) and Andrea Kabwasa (1,788). Another highlight for the Aggies in 2011-12 was coach Trakh coaching his 500th game of his career as a Division I head coach. In his 17th year on the sidelines, the

floor general notched the milestone against Hawai'i in Las Cruces Feb. 16.

Historical Season:

-- The 2012-13 season marks the 40th season of Aggie women's basketball. The first season was 1973-74.

-- This season also marks 25 years since the Aggies last NCAA tournament appearance. The 1987-88 team was the last in program history to receive an NCAA berth.

Student-athlete telephone numbers are private and will not be released. Phone interviews must also be coordinated through the NM State Athletic Media Relations Office.

The requested coach or student-athlete will return the call at an agreed upon time. Practices are open to all members of the media unless otherwise designated by the coaching staff. Interviews with coaches and/or student-athletes can be conducted at the conclusion of practice. Members of the media need to coordinate all interview requests through the NM State Athletic Media Relations Office prior to showing up.

Mark Trakh begins his second year as the head of the NM State womens basketball program. Last year, Trakh coaches the Aggies to a 6-24 record overall and coached senior Tabitha Wampler to the 1,000 Point Club (1,254).

New Mexico State athletic director Dr. McKinley Boston announced the hiring of Mark Trakh as the new head coach of the Aggie women's basketball program on Friday, April 8, 2011.

Trakh (pronounced TRACK), became the 10th head coach in NM State history and has nearly 30 years of head coaching experience, including 16 at the NCAA Division I level at both Southern California and Pepperdine.

Trakh served as the head coach at USC from 2004-09, where he compiled a 90-64 overall record. In his first two seasons, he guided the Women of Troy to their first NCAA appearances in seven years, as the team advanced to the second round in both 2005 and 2006. The Trojans finished in the top half of the Pac-10 all five years and were the conference tournament runner-up in 2009 and regular season runner-up in 2005.

Trakh coached four all-Pac-10 performers at USC, including two-time first-team honoree Eshaya Murphy, who was later tabbed in the second round of the WNBA Draft in 2007. In all, his players made various all-Pac-10 teams 20 times and also excelled in the classroom, garnering a spot on the conference all-academic squad on 14 occasions.

On the recruiting trail, Trakh helped the Trojans sign four classes ranked in the top 12 nationally, including the No. 1 class in 2006, according to USA Today and All Star Girls Report. Trakh successfully recruited 10 Street & Smith All-Americans, seven McDonald's All-Americans, three Parade All-Americans and the 2006 National Player of the Year.

Before accepting the position at USC, Trakh had a highly successful 11-year tenure as head coach at Pepperdine from 1993-2004. Under his direction, the Waves posted six consecutive 20-win seasons from 1997-2003, made six straight postseason appearances and claimed four West Coast Conference titles. Trakh was twice named the league's coach of the year in both 1999 and 2002, and ended his tenure with a 199-123 overall record and a 99-55 mark in the WCC.

The Waves had two WCC Players of the Year in Rasheeda Clark (2000) and Tamara McDonald (2002), with Clark going on to become the school's first ever WNBA Draft pick. Trakh coached 10 first-team all-conference players at Pepperdine and his student-athletes posted an impressive 100 percent graduation rate during his stay in Malibu.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Trakh had a Hall of Fame career as the head girls' coach at Brea Olinda High School in Brea, Calif., from 1981-93. He helped lead the Ladycats to national prominence with a 354-45 overall record, highlighted by four state titles (1989, 1991, 1992 and 1993), six CIF Southern Section championships and 12 Orange

League Crowns. In his final five campaigns, Brea Olinda posted an amazing 161-8 record and did not lose more than two games in any single season.

Among his standouts at Brea Olinda were current Long Beach State head coach Jody (Anton) Wynn and current Hawai'i associate coach Da Houli. Trakh, a California State High School Coach of the Year, is a member of both the City of Brea Athletic Hall of Fame as well as the Southern California High School Basketball Coaches' Hall of Fame.

A 1981 graduate of Long Beach State, the Wanque, N.J., native earned his bachelor's degree in journalism and also has his teaching credential.
