The New Mexico State Aggies (5-9) play the fourth of a seven-game homestand as they host Texas Southern Tuesday night. The Aggies dropped a 58-57 overtime heartbreaker to No. 24/25 Colorado State on Saturday night, while the Tigers (3-9) upset Kansas State 58-56 Sunday.

Aggie Quick Hits

- The Aggies loss to Colorado State marked the first time since the 2011-12 season that NM State has lost more than one game at the Pan American Center in a season. That season the Aggies lost three games at home (Arizona, New Mexico, Nevada). NM State had its 14-game home court winning streak at the Pan American Center snapped by New Mexico on Dec. 20, still the Aggies sport a 34-4 record at the Pan Am since the start of the 2012-13 season.
- The Aggies' 14-game home court winning streak was the second longest, dating back to the 11-12 season. The longest is 15-games, with the 14-game and an 11-game streak.
- In the last 45 contests played by NM State at the Pan Am, the Aggies are 41-4.
- The Aggies have lost four players to significant injuries this season, including two starters (Daniel Mullings and Tshilidzi Nephawe) and two newcomers expected to make strong contributions (Tanveer Bhullar and Anthony January).
- NM State has dropped all seven of its road games this season, with five of those teams either ranked or receiving votes in the AP and/or USA Today polls.
- NM State is averaging 15.4 turnovers a game this season, and has turned the ball over 20 times in three games (Wichita State, Stetson, New Mexico).
- NM State held Florida A&M to 33 points on Nov. 26, the fewest points scored at the Pan American Center and the fewest points scored against the Aggies since March 1952.
- The Aggies are averaging 75.0 points a game at the Pan American Center this season, while giving up just 56.6 points. On the road, NM State is averaging 65.9 points, while allowing 74.7 points a contest.

2014-15 NM STATE BASKETBALL

- NM State looks to complete the rare four-peat in 2014-15, as the Aggies have won the WAC Tournament title and participated in the NCAA Tournament three years in a row.
- Senior Remi Barry is leading the Aggies in scoring. Barry is averaging 13.9 points a game (sixth in the WAC) after scoring double-digits in 12 of this season's 14 games. He is sixth in the WAC in field goal percentage, shooting 49.6 percent from the floor. He leads the WAC in 3-point field goal percentage at 59.3 percent.
- Redshirt freshman Pascal Siakam grabbed his second double-double against Colorado State (13 pts/13 rbs). In 14 games, Siakam is averaging 11.9 points and is second on the team with 7.1 rebounds (tops for active players). He leads the WAC in blocked shots with 2.1 per game (55th nationally), is second in WAC in field goal percentage, .541, and ranks fifth in the league in board work. He has six games of three or more blocked shots.
- Of the 15 players on the NM State roster, nine are from countries other than the United States. Five players are from Toronto, Canada, with two from France, one from Cameroon and one from South Africa.

What's Up

The Aggies welcome Texas Southern to the Pan American Center for the first time. NM State is 5-9 after falling to No. 24/25 Colorado State 58-57 in overtime on Saturday.

The Tigers (3-9) have a pair of upsets during the last 10 days. First it was then No. 25 Michigan State 71-64 in East Lansing on Dec. 20, then a wild 58-56 win at Kansas State on Sunday. There was also a 61-60 loss at Auburn on Dec. 23. TSU is paced by forward Chris Thomas (6-5, Jr., Denver, Colo.) who averages 15.3 points, 5.2 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.8 steals. Guard Madarious Gibbs (6-1, Sr., Newnan, Ga.) chalks up 10.7 points with 3.4 rebounds and 4.0 assists. Guard Deverell Biggs (6-1, Sr., Omaha, Neb.) adds 10.2 points with 2.9 boards, 1.9 assists and 1.7 steals. The Tigers are scoring 60.2 points an outing, while allowing 72.6 per game.

What Will They Do Next

NM State's unique marketing series, "What Will They Do Next" has got folks wondering what they might see at an Aggie Basketball game. So far this season, NM State has presented Pie Night complete with a pie eating contest, The Zooperstars, a mascot basketball game, given away 10 42-inch HD televisions, 5,000 trading cards, 6,000 rally towels and one live turkey. "What Will They Do Next?" The only way one can find out is to be in attendance at the Pan American Center.

Series Record

This is the first meeting between the Aggies and Texas Southern, a member of the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

Looking Ahead

The Aggies continue their longest homestand of the season and play their first game of 2015 on Saturday when UC Irvine visits the Pan Am Center.

The Anteaters (6-5) are coming off winning the Las Vegas Holiday Hoops Classic championship by beating Bradley 55-47 and Green Bay 72-70. UCI plays at Oregon on Monday, then at home against Hampden-Sydney on Wednesday before coming to Las Cruces. UC Irvine was paced by center Mamadou Ndiaye (7-6, So., Dakar, Senegal) who was averaging 12.0 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game when he injured his foot after five games. He could be back against the Aggies. Guard Luke Nelson (6-3, So., Worthing, England) averages 11.1 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 1.1 steals. Guard Alex Young (6-1, Jr., Phoenix, Ore.) adds 10.7 points with 3.5 boards, 3.5 assists and 1.6 steals. Forward Will Davis II (6-8, Sr., Sacramento, Calif.) chalks up 10.2 points with 5.6 rebounds and 1.5 assists. The Anteaters are scoring 67.8 points an outing, while allowing 62.3 per game.

Looking Back

The Aggies gave No. 24/25 Colorado State a hard run, but suffered a heart-breaking 58-57 loss to the Rams Saturday night at the Pan American Center.

NM State held an eight-point first half lead and a five-point second half lead, only to have the Rams battle back both times. Trailing by three with four seconds left, Ian Baker buried a 3-pointer to send the game into overtime. In the extra frame, with the Aggies up three with 1:20 to go, CSU scored the last four points and held on to remain unbeaten.

Remi Barry led the Aggies with 14 points, while Pascal Siakam picked up his second career double-double with 13 points and 13 boards, and added four blocks. Baker tallied 12 points with eight boards and four assists.

The Aggies shot 38 percent, held the Rams to 35 percent from the floor and outrebounded CSU 41-36. However, they turned the ball over 17 times to just five for CSU.

M*A*S*H Unit

NM State has had a rough time with injuries at the start of this season. The Aggies suffered several injuries during preseason practice with ankle injuries to both Tanveer Bhullar and Anthony January that have cost both the start of the season. January is out for the season and will apply for a medical redshirt. Bhullar had to be casted and is expected to be out at least until the start of conference play. Second team Preseason All-WAC forward Tshildzi Nephawe suffered a foot injury during the preseason, but was able to come back to start the first six games. But his foot was not healing properly, so he was shut down at Thanksgiving with a January target to return. Then in practice following the first the New Mexico game, WAC Player of the Year Daniel Mullings broke his finger severely enough to have surgery. Mullings is expected to be out until at least early February.

Menzies Moving Up

Head coach Marvin Menzies has joined the number three spot on the New Mexico State all-time coaches wins list. In his eighth season at NM State, Menzies has a 157-97 record and needs just one more win to take over third all-time. Jerry Hines (1929-40, 1946-47) posted 157 wins in 12 seasons. Hall of Famer Lou Henson (1966-75, 1997-2005) holds the NM State record with 289 wins on the Aggie bench (289-152, 16 years), while Neil McCarthy (1985-97) has 229 victories (229-114, 12 years). Menzies was named one of Forbes' top 25 college coaches for the money in November.

No Scoring Here

New Mexico State held Florida A&M to just 33 points in their game on Nov. 26, 2014. It marked the fewest points allowed by the Aggies since March 4, 1952 when NM State beat Eastern New Mexico 34-27 in the NAIB Tournament.

The Aggies also held Northern New Mexico to only 39 points on Dec. 22, 2014.

The games are just the seventh and eighth times since 1950 that NM State has allowed an opponent less than 40 points in a game.

Against Nationally Ranked Competition

New Mexico State is 1-18 against teams ranked in either the AP or USA Today Top 25 since the 2006-07 season. The Aggies last win against a nationally ranked team was on Jan. 20, 2007, when they defeated No. 13/15 Nevada 80-73 at the Pan American Center. NM State has lost the last 18 contests against teams nationally ranked since then. Coach Marvin Menzies' Aggies are 0-16 against nationally ranked squads.

Air Canada

The loss of guard Daniel Mullings is certainly a costly one for the Aggies. Mullings had chalked up 21 points against Wyoming (his second 20-point effort of the season) and a career-high 15 rebounds against Stetson. He posted 10 points with nine rebounds at New Mexico. The 6-2, 170 pound senior from Toronto, Ontario, was second on the team and eighth in the WAC in scoring, averaging 13.4 points this season. He led the squad in rebounds with 7.4 per outing and steals at 2.0 per contest, ranking fourth and third in the league respectively.

Mullings, who was a 2013-14 honorable mention AP All-American, was the WAC Player of the Year in 2014 after averaging 16.8 points, 4.9 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. He hit 46.6 percent from the floor (201-of-431) and 72.7 percent from the foul line (168-of-231). He also led the team with 1.9 steals per outing.

The WAC Preseason Player of the Year for 2014-15, Mullings is ninth in career scoring at NM State with 1,512 points. Mullings is nine points from tying or 10 points from passing Wendell McKines (2007-12) with 1,521 points in eighth on the list.

Mullings swiped the Aggie record for career steals against with his three steals at New Mexico. He lifted his total to a NM State record 218, passing the previous record of 216 held by Hearnst Leroche (2008-12). Mullings recorded 65 steals last season (1.9 per game), ranking fifth on the single season steals chart.

He is ninth on the career assist chart with 299 and is one away from becoming the ninth player in school history with 300 assists. He's three from Brandon Mason (1999-03) with 302 in eighth.

Mullings third in both career free throws made (404) and attempted (569) at NM State.

Aggies love Chili

NM State center Tshilidzi Nephawe is seeking his spot in the Aggie record books, but will have to wait awhile.

Nephawe, a second team All-WAC performer last season, was chosen first team Preseason All-WAC. "Chili" averaged 11.1 points, 7.8 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per outing last year, with eight double-doubles.

Slowed by a preseason injury, Nephawe was averaging 5.8 points and 4.8 rebounds a outing this season when he sat out the Wyoming and UNM games to further heal. His return is unknown.

Nephawe is tied for fourth on the NM State career blocks list with 124, equaling the total of Slab Jones (1976-80). He needs one to take over fourth and 13 to tie or 14 to pass Hamidu Rahman (2008-12) with 137. Tshilidzi is ninth at NM State in career free throws made (308) and seventh in free throws attempted (455).

Coach Interviews

Interviews with head coach Marvin Menzies or any New Mexico State assistant basketball coach must be coordinated through assistant athletic director for media relations Bill Powers, 575-646-2926 or powers@nmsu.edu, or assistant media relations director Dennis Driscoll, 575-646-3269 or drdrisco@nmsu.edu.

Student-Athlete Interviews

All student-athlete interviews must be arranged by the Media Relations Office. Student-athletes have been instructed not to grant any interview, in person or by telephone, not arranged by the Media Relations staff. Student-athlete telephone numbers are private and will not be released.

Interviews with student-athletes must be coordinated through the Athletic Media Relations Office at least 24 hours in advance to minimize the demands on the student-athlete's time. No student-athlete interviews will be conducted on the day of a game, unless requested for a post-game interview.

Head coach Marvin Menzies will review ALL media requests for players either before or after practice or requests by phone. Approval by Menzies is needed before interviews can be scheduled. Menzies and/or Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations Bill Powers reserve the right to deny interview requests.

Phone interviews must also be coordinated through the Athletic Media Relations Office with the requested player returning the call at an agreed up time from an Athletic Media Relations office phone.

Keep in mind, team locker rooms are off limits to media representatives at ALL TIMES. Interviews during practice are strictly prohibited. New Mexico State basketball practices are open to the media for only the first 15 minutes of practice time. Anyone not on the New Mexico State men's basketball staff will be asked to leave after the first 15 minutes of practice.

Post Game

New Mexico State provides equal access to all members of the working media.

At home games, Menzies will hold a postgame press conference in the Media Room, which is found in the Pan American Center Annex, directly under the Barbara Hubbard Room. Access to the Media Room can be found on the south side of the Pan American Center, and can be entered from the east side.

Requests for player interviews should be made to Assistant Athletic Director for Media Relations Bill Powers or the opposing SID no later than four minutes left in regulation time.

New Mexico State student-athletes will be brought to the Media Room for interviews. The opponents coach (and players) will be available for interviews upon request. Requests should be made to opposing team SID if available.

Head coach Marvin Menzies will review ALL media requests for players after each game and reserves the right to select players from submitted list.

Credentials

Credentials for New Mexico State University home games are issued for working media ONLY and should be requested as early as possible due to space limitations. All members of the media must request credentials in writing through Powers at powers@nmsu.edu, or Dennis Driscoll at drdrisco@nmsu.edu.

Requests are honored from sports editors of daily newspapers and sports directors of television and radio stations. Requests from individuals not employed by a media outlet WILL NOT be considered.

New Mexico State has been given the mantle as the favorite to win the Western Athletic Conference by both the league's coaches and the media. And both groups selected Aggie senior guard Daniel Mullings as the league's preseason player of the year.

The Aggies received seven of the eight first place votes from the coaches, the most they could receive since they couldn't vote for their own team or players. Seattle U received the other first place vote and was second in the straw poll of the coaches, with Grand Canyon third.

The media, that had no voting restrictions, gave NM State 17 of the 18 first place votes and was second on the ballot that gave Seattle U a first place vote.

The media gave a nod to Grand Canyon to finish second, with Seattle U third and Utah Valley fourth.

Mullings led the Aggies on the Coaches Preseason All-WAC team, and was joined by senior center Tshilidzi Nephawe on the first team. Senior guard DK Eldridge was selected to the second team. The trio were also selected in the same positions on the media's All-WAC team.

Head Coach

Head coach Marvin Menzies begins his eighth season at the helm of the New Mexico State men's basketball program in 2014-15. In his tenure, Menzies has guided the Aggies to four WAC Tournament Championships and four NCAA Tournament berths in 2010, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

He led the Aggies to their second back-to-back conference tournament championships in program history in 2013 and 2014. It was also the second back-to-back tournament champions in the WAC since 2001 and 2002. The 2014 title was NM State's fourth WAC Tournament title in five years. The conference crown led the Aggies to their 21st appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Following a 73-69 overtime loss to San Diego St., the Aggies posted a 26-10 overall record, which was the 27th 20-win season in school history and fifth under Menzies.

After the 2013-14 season, Menzies has an overall record of 152-88. He ranks fourth all-time at NM State and he is only the second coach in program history to win over 120 games in his first six seasons.

Menzies coached 17 all-conference players at NM State including three in 2013: Bandja Sy (first team), Daniel Mullings (second team), Sim Bhullar (third team and newcomer), who was also WAC Freshman of the Year. Bhullar earned WAC Tournament MVP honors and was the first freshman to garner the honor since Shawn Bradley in 1991. Mullings was also a member of the WAC All-Tournament Team.

The Aggies broke a pair of school records in 2012-13; blocked shots in a season (193) and field goal percentage in a game (68.6 percent vs. UTSA). NM State also tied a program record with 12 blocked shots at UTSA. The Aggie defense was tough all season and held teams to 60 points or less 16 times in 2012-13.

Menzies piloted the Aggies to 12-straight wins (Jan. 3 to Feb. 16). It was the longest streak under Menzies and longest since the 2006-07 season. NM State finished the season winning 18-of-21 games.

Menzies directed NM State to its second conference tournament title in three years in 2012 with a 25-point win over Louisiana Tech, 82-57, in the championship game. The Aggies made their 19th NCAA Tournament appearance in school history and faced No. 17 Indiana. After a 79-66 loss to the Hoosiers, the Aggies finished the season with a 26-10 overall record. The 26 wins are the most since the 1992-93 season, and it was the third 20-win season of Menzies' tenure.

Menzies recorded his 100th career victory in the quarterfinals of the 2012 WAC Tournament. The Aggies had four all-conference selections in 2012: Wendell McKines (first team), Hernst Laroche (second team), Hamidu Rahman (honorable mention) and Daniel Mullings (newcomer).

The 2011-12 season was very successful for the Aggies. For the first time in school history, NM State had three 1,000-point scorers in the same season (McKines, Laroche and Rahman). McKines became just the second player in program history with 1,000-career points and 1,000-career rebounds. He was only the second active player in the NCAA to achieve the feat in 2011-12 and 12th player in WAC history.

The Aggies started the season with a 4-0 record, which was only the third 4-0 start since 1992-93. NM State posted a pair of rivalry wins in the stretch including a 62-53 win over New Mexico (Nov. 16) in the Pit for the first time since Dec. 15, 2002. In WAC play, NM State defeated Utah State, 80-69, (Feb. 11) for the first time in Logan, Utah, since Feb. 11, 2006.

Menzies also witnessed guard Daniel Mullings, as a freshman, record a triple-double against Hawai'i (Feb. 23). Mullings' performance was only the third triple-double in Aggie history as he recorded 28 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists.

The Crimson and White fought through injuries to finish third in the WAC (9-7) with a 16-17 overall record in 2010-11. The Aggies set a school record with a 12-game WAC home win streak that dated back to the 2009-10 season. Menzies won his 75th career game in 2010-11 and was the second fastest to reach 70 wins behind Lou Henson.

In the 2009-10 season, NM State won its second WAC Tournament crown in school history with a 69-63 win over Utah State in the title game. With the victory, Menzies directed the Aggies to their first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2007. As a No. 12 seed in the Midwest Regional, NM State faced No. 5 seed Michigan State, in Spokane, Wash. In the first meeting between the programs, the Aggies' upset bid over Michigan State fell short, 70-67.

The Aggies registered the 24th 20-win season in school history in 2009-10 with a 22-12 mark. Menzies is only the second coach in program history to win 60 games in his first three seasons.

With one of the youngest teams in the country in 2008-09, Menzies led NM State to a 17-15 record and a third-place showing in the WAC. The Aggies not only had the conference's leading scoring in guard Jahmar Young but also the top rebounder in forward Wendell McKines. Young was awarded a first team All-WAC selection and was the first sophomore to earn the accolade at NM State. The Aggies were just seconds away from their third consecutive WAC Tournament title game, but lost a heartbreaker to Utah State, 71-70, in the tournament semifinals.

In his first year, Menzies led the Aggies to their first regular season WAC title in 2007-08. NM State was co-champions after posting a 12-4 league record. Menzies also directed the Aggies to their second consecutive appearance in the WAC Tournament title game.

Nationally, the Aggies ranked in the top 25 in three statistical team categories including rebounding margin. NM State was second in the country, only trailing North Carolina, with an advantage of 8.9 rebounds per game.

Making their second consecutive appearance in the WAC Tournament title game in 2008, the Aggies (21-14) just narrowly missed the NCAA Tournament after falling in triple overtime to Boise State in one of the most exciting conference championship games of the season.

Menzies guided the Aggies to their 23rd 20-plus win season in the program's history, which was a challenge when the schedule included games at Duke, Louisville and against Texas and West Virginia. He was also the winningest first-year head coach in Aggie history. The 2007-08 edition was a veteran team with five seniors. Guard/forward Justin Hawkins became the Aggies' first two-time, first team All-WAC selection.

Menzies became the 24th coach in the history of Aggie basketball, June 29, 2007, after spending two seasons as an assistant coach under Rick Pitino at Louisville.

Considered one of the best recruiters in the country, Menzies has landed some of the nation's top recruiting classes. In his last season at Louisville, the Cardinals finished 24-10, reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament and was No. 20 in the final USA TODAY/ESPN Men's Basketball Coaches Top 25 Poll (2006-07).

Prior to joining the Cardinals' staff, Menzies spent one year at UNLV under former Atlanta Hawks coach Lon Kruger (2004-05). With the Running Rebels, Menzies helped sign an incoming class that was rated fourth in the nation.

Before his time at UNLV, Menzies worked at Southern California for a season as an assistant coach (2003-04) under Henry Bibby. In only one year with the Trojans, he assisted in producing a No. 3-ranked recruiting class.

Menzies had a four-year tenure at San Diego State (1999-03). He was the leading recruiter for the Aztecs and Steve Fisher, who won the NCAA National Championship in 1989 at Michigan. Menzies helped to guide the Aztecs to the postseason in back-to-back years (2002-03) for the first time since 1975-76. At San Diego State, Menzies signed a pair of nationally ranked recruiting classes in 2001 (top 25) and 2000 (top 40) along with the program's first-ever McDonald's All-American.

Menzies began his collegiate career at Santa Monica (Calif.) College as an assistant coach under John McMullen. Menzies spent six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach (1991-94, 1995-96 and 1997-99). He was the team's head coach for a year (in 1994-95) and guided the Corsairs to a 24-8 record. Menzies led Santa Monica to the Western States Conference title while he earned conference coach of the year honors.

With Menzies on the staff, the program was a collective 181-46. During his tenure, 38 players went on to NCAA schools. In 1996, the Corsairs produced a school-record 27-game winning streak and a school-best 32-2 finish. Menzies recruited the top three scorers in the school's history.

Between his time at Santa Monica, he was as an assistant coach at Cal State Sacramento (1996-97). He coached under current Washington Wizards assistant Don Newman as the program transitioned from Division II to Division I.

Beginning his coaching career at his prep alma mater, Hamilton High School in Los Angeles, Calif., Menzies was an assistant coach for eight years. A California native, Menzies was a letter winner in three sports at Hamilton.

Menzies earned a bachelor's degree in economics from UCLA in 1987 and a master's degree in education from Cal State Sacramento in 2003. He and his wife, Tammy, have a daughter, Andreanna, and a son, Andre.

2014-15 (Senior)

Mullings named the Western Athletic Conference's Preseason Player of the Year and first-team Preseason All-WAC. Ranks 12th in career scoring at NM State with 1,405 points and needs just 44 points to join the NM State Top 10.

2013-14 (Junior)

Mullings was selected an honorable mention AP All-American as was named the Western Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2013-14. Mullings was also named to the All-WAC first team and the WAC All-Defensive team. Mullings played in 35 games for the Aggies and led the team in scoring (16.8 ppg), assists (3.5 apg), and steals (65 total). Mullings also led the team in free-throws made, he converted 168-of-231 attempts from the free-throw line. In a home conference game against Texas-Pan American, Mullings scored a season-high 32 points and shot 9-of-15 from the field in the 90-78 victory over the Broncs. Mullings posted his first double-double of the season in a 96-87 conference victory over Seattle U, where he scored 13 points and grabbed 11 rebounds. At Utah Valley, Mullings added his second double-double of the season by picking up 19 points and 10 rebounds in the 66-61 loss to the Wolverines. Mullings led the Aggies to their third consecutive WAC Tournament Championship averaging a team high 15.7 points and 4.7 assists during the tournament. In the final game of the season Mullings scored 18 points and recorded five rebounds in the overtime loss to San Diego St. in the NCAA tournament.

2012-13 (Sophomore)

As a sophomore, Mullings was a significant force on the hardwood for the Aggies during their second consecutive season with a WAC Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. He earned second team All-WAC and WAC All-Defensive team honors. Mullings was also named to the WAC All-Tournament team. Mullings led the Aggies with 13.8 points per game and posted team-high marks with 91 assists and 79 steals, which ranked second on NM State's single-season list. He is fifth on the career steals list with 137. Mullings ranked first in the WAC in steals (2.26 per game) and in conference games only in steals (2.61 per game). He played in 34 of the Aggies 35 games in 2012-13. Mullings shot 47 percent from the field (167-of-355), 37 percent from the 3-point line (20-of-54) and 75.9 percent from the free-throw line (129-of-170) and averaged 5.2 rebounds per game. In his second season, Mullings tallied nine 20-point games. He recorded his lone double-double of the season against Southern Mississippi (Dec. 1) with 21 points and 11 rebounds, a season-high mark. Mullings scored a season-high 26 points at Niagara (Nov. 18). Defensively, he grabbed a career-high seven steals at Seattle (Jan. 10) in the 83-82 win in double overtime. Mullings also had a season-high seven assists against Northern New Mexico (Nov. 21).

2011-12 (Freshman)

Mullings made an immediate impact for the Aggies in his freshman campaign. He played in all 36 games and started in 26 contests. He averaged 9.3 points and 4.1 rebounds per game and was named to the 2012 WAC All-Newcomer team for his efforts. Mullings shot 48.9 percent from the field (128-of-262) in his freshman season.

High School

Mullings arrived in Las Cruces after a four-year career at Sir Wilfrid Laurier Collegiate Institute in Scarborough, Ontario. Mullings led the Blue Devils to a league championship and 10-0 record in both the 2009-10 and 2008-09 seasons for head coach Tony Vallejo. In 2007-08, Mullings and Laurier finished third in the Toronto District School Board East Region following an 8-2 campaign. In his first season, Mullings and Blue Devils recorded a sixth-place league showing. Additionally, Mullings played in the All-Canada Classic All-Star game.

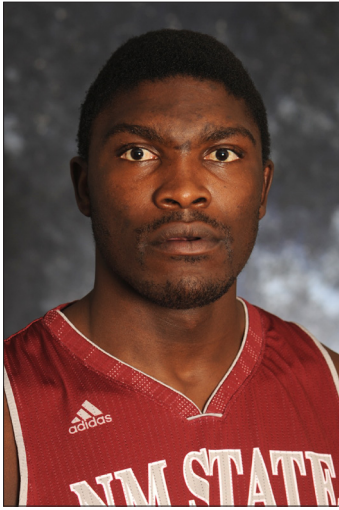

2013-14 (Redshirt Junior)

In his third season playing for the Aggies, Nephawe averaged 11.1 points and 7.8 rebounds per game. He was also named to the All-WAC second team and tied for third in the WAC in total rebounds. Nephawe also blocked 52 shots and ranked second in the WAC, behind teammate Sim Bhullar (101 blocks). Nephawe also led the Aggies in offensive rebounds (93). Nephawe recorded eight double-doubles in the season, with his first in the second game of the season against Tennessee State and scored 11 points and recorded 11 rebounds. Offensively, Nephawe scored a season-high 22 points at Seattle U in the 92-77 victory. Nephawe recorded a season-high 16 rebounds at Bakersfield in the 72-57 win over the Roadrunners. Nephawe ended his season with a 22-point and eight-rebound performance in the NCAA tournament against San Diego State.

2012-13 (Junior)

Nephawe started in the first nine games of the season before he was sidelined with a season-ending hand injury that earned him a medical redshirt. He averaged 7.2 points and 5.2 rebounds per game and shot 51.1 percent for the field (23-of-45) during the 2012-13 season. Nephawe recorded a pair of double-double games and now has three career double-doubles for the Aggies. At Niagara (Nov. 18), he posted his first double-double of the year with 14 points, a season-high mark, and 10 rebounds. Nephawe also tallied his best shooting performance of the season against the Purple Eagles with a 6-of-7 showing. Two games later, he notched his second double-double of the year with 10 points and a career-high 11 rebounds against Louisiana (Nov. 23).

2011-12 (Sophomore)

As a sophomore, Nephawe played in all 36 games and averaged 5.8 points and 3.8 rebounds per game. He shot 51.2 percent from the field (62-of-121) and 74.6 percent at the free-throw line (85-of-114). Nephawe increased his free-throw percentage in WAC play to 82.1 percent (32-of-39), which ranked second in the league. Defensively, Nephawe blocked 32 shots, a mark that ranked second on the team and eighth in the conference. Offensively, Nephawe recorded six double-digit scoring games in 2011-12. In the WAC Tournament semifinal game against Hawai'i (March 9), he posted a career-high 15 points and three assists on a season-high 6-of-8 performance from the field in 26 minutes of action. In September 2007, he was selected to attend the Basketball without Borders in Johannesburg, South Africa. The NBA and FIBA conduct Basketball without Borders camp as part of the NBA's global basketball development and community outreach program.

Eldridge was named to the Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer team in 2013-14. He started in all 36 games for the Aggies in 2013-14 and averaged 11.2 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. He shot 46.8 percent from the field (144-308) and 40.0 percent from the three-point line (42-105). 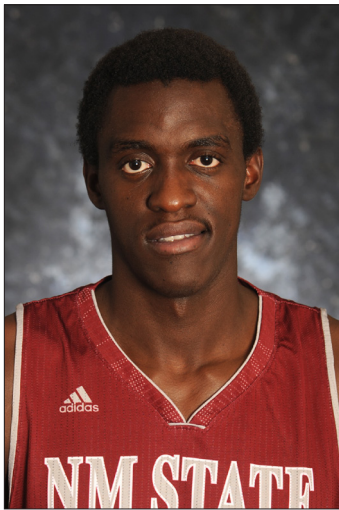
