#### Next Up

Following a thrilling come-from-behind overtime victory on Halloween, the NM State football team is ready to travel to San Marcos, Texas to face Texas State on Saturday at 2:00 p.m. MT on ESPN3. The game will also be broadcast on AM 570. Despite having zero touchdowns in the first three quarters of the game, Larry Rose III scored a career-high four touchdowns in the fourth quarter and in overtime to give the Aggies (1-7, 1-3 SBC) a 55-48 victory over Idaho on Saturday night. This is the first time NM State has had a player rush for four or more touchdowns since 1999. Rose III scored to make it a one-possession game with under 10 minutes to go in the game, but Idaho extended the lead again. That is when Rose III put the team on his back and carried them to victory to snap a 17-game losing streak. With 3:56 remaining, Rose III scrambled into the end zone to cut the Vandals lead back to one score. With 00:51 left on the clock, the sophomore once again used a 1-vard run for a touchdown to force overtime. Rose III then leaped over the pile and into the end zone for the go-ahead touchdown over the Vandals. As quarterback Matt Linehan attempted a pass on Idaho's overtime possession, freshman Terrill Hanks grabbed an interception as he caught the ball between his feet to secure the win for the home team. Rose III finished the game with 212 rushing yards and four touchdowns. With these 212 yards, he now has 1,083 rushing yards for the season to become the first back-to-back 1,000-yard rusher for NM State since Denvis Manns, who had 1,000-yard seasons from 1995-98. Rose III needs just 20 yards for a new season-high after he amassed 1,102 rushing yards during the 2014 season. Additionally, Rose III now has 2,185 career rushing yards to rank No. 6 all-time in the Aggie record books. With his four touchdowns against Idaho, the running back has 19 rushing touchdowns in his career, which is tied for ninth all-time in the NM State record books. Rose III ranks second in the Sun Belt in rushing through all games. Quarterback Andrew Allen went 22-of-38 for 300 yards and three touchdowns. Quarterback Nick Jeanty was 2-of-2 for 26 yards in overtime. Joshua Bowen had a career-high 106 yards on a personal-best 10 receptions, while Royce Caldwell chipped in a career-best 73 receiving yards. Freshman linebacker Javahn Fergurson, who played just his second game of the season on Saturday night, had an impressive game-high 17 tackles with 1.0 sacks and 1.0 tackles for loss. Fergurson's sack came in overtime as he stopped Idaho's Linehan on first down prior to Hanks collecting the game-ending interception. Hanks finished the night with eight tackles as well. Next week's opponent, Texas State, is currently 2-5 on the season and 1-2 in conference play after they fell 37-13 to Georgia Southern last Thursday night. Robert Lowe led Texas State in rushing as he amassed 90 yards on 20 carries. Quarterback Tyler Jones was 10-of-25 for 87 yards and a touchdown. He also threw one interception. The Aggies and the Bobcats have only met on the gridiron twice before, with Texas State capturing victories in both meetings. The teams last played on Nov. 1, 2014 as Texas State won 37-29.

- Xavier Hall scored his first touchdown of the season. This was the eighth touchdown of his career.

- Larry Rose III had 212 rushing yards for the game. He now has 1,117 yards on the season to become the first back-to-back 1,000-yard rusher since Denvis Manns, who had four 1,000-yard rushing seasons from 1995-98.
- Rose III has 2,185 career yards to rank No. 6 all-time in career rushing yards.
- Rose III ranks second in the conference in rushing yards.

- Rose III has 19 career rushing touchdowns to rank tied for No. 9 all-time for career touchdowns.
- Jaden Wright intercepted a ball in the end zone to prevent a touchdown in the first quarter. This was his third career interception and his second of the season. This was the team's fifth interception of the season.
- Stephen Meredith's sack in the first quarter was the team's first sack since Rodney Butler collected one against Georgia State on Sept. 12, 2015.
- The Aggies had 3.0 sacks against Idaho, which is more than the first seven games combined (2.0 sacks).
- Terrill Hanks had the game-winning interception, which he caught with his feet.
- Javahn Fergurson had a career-high 17 tackles and 1.0 sacks.
- Anthony Torres had 135 punting yards on four punts.



## **DOUG MARTIN**



## THIRD SEASON • OCOACHMARTINNMSU

Doug Martin begins his third season at the helm of the NM State football program in 2015. The Aggies joined the Sun Belt Conference for the 2014 season after playing as an independent team during Martin's inaugural season at NM State.

Martin was officially announced as the Aggies' 34th head football coach on Feb. 1, 2013, after the departure of former head coach DeWayne Walker to the NFL. Martin was no stranger to the NM State program as he was the Aggie offensive coordinator under Walker in 2011.

NM State went 2-10 for the second year in a row in 2014. During Martin's second year, the Aggies began the season 2-0 for the first time since 1999. After topping Cal Poly in a 28-10 victory, NM State defeated Georgia State, 34-31, in its first Sun Belt Conference game.

The Aggies also faced I-10 rival UTEP, Rio Grande rival New Mexico and No. 17 LSU in 2014. Under Martin's tutelage, Larry Rose III became the first freshman to rush for over 100 yards against LSU since 2011. Later in the season, Rose III rushed for 229 yards against UL-Monroe to become the first NM State player to rush for over 200 yards since 2003 when Eric Higgins ran for 218 yards. This feat ranked Rose III as No. 7 all-time for single game performances.

With Martin guiding him, Rose III amassed 1,102 yards over the season to become the first 1,000 yard rusher since Kenny Turner in 2011. This was also the first time a freshman rushed for over 1.000 yards since Denvis Manns in 1995.

As a team, the Aggies averaged 420.9 yards of total offense per game after amassing 2,252 rushing yards and 2,899 receiving yards through 12 games. Defensively, NM State had two players amass triple-digit tackling on the season as Rodney Butler racked up 119 tackles and Derek Ibekwe accumulated 102 tackles. In addition, 21 student-athletes garnered double-digit tackles on the season. In all, the defense had 1,028 tackles, fivesacks, 11 interceptions and 10 fumble recoveries.

NM State went 2-10 in 2013 during Martin's first season as head coach after playing one of the toughest schedules in the school's history. The Aggies faced five teams that had participated in a bowl game the previous season while also playing two teams ranked in the top 15 in the nation.

NM State kicked off the 2013 season with a trip to Austin, Texas, to face the 15th-ranked Texas Longhorns and also made a trip to Los Angeles during the season to play No. 13 UCLA. The Aggies' home schedule included games versus Minnesota, which was the first school out of the Big Ten to play at Aggie Memorial Stadium, and Boston College, which was the first school out of the Atlantic Coast Conference to make a trip to Las Cruces.

The Aggies averaged 20.9 points per game and 382.2 yards per game in 2013, including 141.8 yards per game on the ground and 240.5 yards per game through the air. The team had a season-high 224 yards rushing against Abilene Christian on Oct. 26 and a season-high 380 yards passing and receiving versus Boston College

on Nov. 9.

Martin's influence and system began to take shape during the final five games of the season as NM State went 2-3 in those games and had fourth-quarter chances for a win in two of the three losses.

Martin would start making an impact on the squad as soon as he accepted the head coaching position. Before the season began, the Aggies had four players placed on six different preseason watch lists, the most for any NM State football team in the school's history. NM State also had 12 players honored on the College Sports Madness Independent Preseason All-Conference team and 11 players on the Phil Steele College Football Preview All-Independent team.

During the season, senior safety Davis Cazares was nominated as a Bulsworth Trophy finalist, honoring the most outstanding collegiate football player who began his career as a walk-on. Linebacker Clint Barnard would be named to the Capital One Academic All-District VII first team. The Aggies would also pick up three FBS Independent Player of the Week nods in 2013 under Martin, Cazares and Barnard on the defensive side and punter Cayle Chapman-Brown on special

At the conclusion of the 2013 season, NM State would place five players on the All-Independent Football team including Cazares, Trashaun Nixon, Austin Franklin, Andy Cunningham and Davonte Wallace.

In 2012, Martin left his offensive coordinator position at NM State to take the same position for Boston College out of the ACC. The Eagles ranked 47th in the nation in passing offense, as Martin guided wide receiver Alex Amidon and offensive tackle Emmett Cleary to All-ACC honors. Amidon finished the season ranked 11th among all receivers in the country in receiving yards per game (100.8). He ranked second among all ACC receivers in both receptions per game (6.5) and receiving yards per game.

As the offensive coordinator for the Aggies in 2011, Martin helped NM State rank 47th in the country in total offense and 26th in passing offense. He helped guide the Aggies to a win over Minnesota, the program's first win against a team from the Big Ten. Under Martin, the Aggies had three All-WAC selections in wide receiver Taveon Rogers, offensive tackle Davonte Wallace and running back Kenny Turner. Quarterback Matt Christian led the Aggies with 2,158 vards passing and 15 touchdowns in 2011.

With seven seasons under his belt as the head coach at Kent State University and eight as the offensive coordinator, Martin was instrumental in building a true football program at the university. A total of 20 Golden Flashes earned All-Mid-American Conference accolades from 2007-10, including Eugene Jarvis, who was atop the active Football Bowl Subdivision running backs list with 3,722 career yards on the ground, and Brian Lainhart, whose 17 career interceptions was also tops among active FBS players.

In 2010, Roosevelt Nix was named the MAC Defensive Player of the Year under Martin's watch. Also under Martin, four players were

selected in the NFL draft including Jameson Konz (2010 - 7th round, Seattle Seahawks), Usama Young (2007 - 3rd round, New Orleans Saints), Jack Williams (2008 - 4th round, Denver Broncos) and Julian Edelman (2009 - 7th round, New England Patriots), with Young becoming the sixth-highest pick in the history of the program.

Over the past four years, Martin's offense at Kent State recorded a remarkable 16,907 yards of total offense, averaging 422.6 yards per game during that spanned including 26.3 points a game.

In December of 2006, Martin signed a four-year extension that kept him in Blue and Gold through 2010. The extension rewarded a 2006 campaign that saw Kent State pull off the fourth-largest turnaround in the nation, improving by five wins over the previous year's total.

Included in the performance was a five-game winning streak, including four straight MAC victories - the Flashes' longest conference streak ever. Furthermore, the nation's 25th-ranked team in total defense in 2006, limited Miami and Bowling Green to a combined 17 points as Kent State won road games against the RedHawks and Falcons in the same season for the first time since 1972. Kent State saw five players earn All-MAC accolades.

In addition to his head coaching duties, Martin also served as quarterbacks' coach and was the offensive coordinator for all but the 2009 season.

Martin is widely regarded as one of the nation's premier quarterback mentors. His list of protégés includes three-time All-Conference USA selection and current NFL passer David Garrard, record-setting CFL quarterback Marcus Crandell and other pros Richard Alston and Joshua Cribbs, who both played quarterback in college under Martin before switching positions in the NFL.

In 2005, Martin's spread passing attack posted the third-highest yardage total in school history while the team's 15 touchdown passes were the sixth most in a single year at Kent State. The Flashes also reached the 30-point mark three times in 2005, running the total number of games with at least that many points to 16 since 2003.

In Martin's first season, the Golden Flashes posted a 5-6 overall record, winning their final four games for the program's longest winning streak since 1976. The team also finished in fourth place in the MAC East Division with a 4-4 mark while producing three All-MAC players and two honorable mention All-Americans.

Martin also handled the offensive play-calling duties and the unit responded to his coaching, scoring 335 points and racking up 4,168 yards, the second- and third-highest totals, respectively, in school history.

Under his guidance, the Flashes averaged 30.5 points per game, just the third time in school history a team averaged 30 or more points. The team also set a single-game scoring mark in its 69-17 win over Eastern Michigan Nov. 13. Four times in 2004 the Flashes totaled more than 400 yards on offense, including two games over 500.

Additionally, in two years tutoring All-MAC quarterback Joshua Cribbs, Martin saw Cribbs develop into one of the top dual threats in the country. Always a talented runner, Cribbs finished his career as the owner of KSU career records for total offense, passing yardage, touchdowns, points and completions. He also ranked fourth nationally in total offense and completed a school-record 64.5 percent of his passes. As a team, the Flashes had a completion rate of 62.8 percent, also a school record.

While his spread offensive style is his calling card, Martin revamped his defensive coaching staff and saw that unit go from ranking 12th of 14 teams in the MAC in total defense in 2003 to first in the league in 2004. It marked the first time since 1987 that the team led the MAC in total defense and just the second time since joining the conference in 1951. Kent State also ranked 15th nationally in total defense.

Martin was named the school's 19th head coach on March 1, 2004, replacing Dean Pees. Martin joined the Kent State staff in January 2003 as offensive coordinator. After just one year on the staff, Martin made an instant impact on the Golden Flashes' offense. In its first season under Martin's system, Kent State averaged 26.8 points per game, the second-highest in the last 30 years, and scored 30-or-more points in each of the final six games and did so in a school-record eight games overall.

From 2002-04 Martin's teams averaged nearly 30 points per game and posted the highest offensive totals in back-to-back years in school history. From 2002-03 alone, scoring offense increased by 10 points, touchdowns grew from 24 to 40, total offense was up by more than 40 yards per game and passing yardage increased by nearly 100 yards per game.

In 2004, that trend continued as the Flashes' increased their scoring, touchdowns, passing yards and total yards per game.

Martin arrived at Kent State following 11 seasons at East Carolina University, the last seven of which he was in charge of the team's offense. He was at ECU for all of Steve Logan's tenure there, serving as the tight ends coach and special teams coordinator for two seasons (1992-93), then another two years as wide receivers coach (1994-95) before being promoted to offensive coordinator in 1996.

At East Carolina, Martin played a significant role in the development of quarterback David Garrard, who broke 28 school passing records and total offensive records from 1998-01. In addition, Martin coached the top three receivers in ECU history. During Martin's time at ECU, the team advanced to five bowl games; the Liberty Bowl in 1994 and 1995, the GMAC (formerly Mobile Alabama) Bowl in 1999 and 2001 and the galleryfurniture.com Bowl in 2000.

Prior to joining the staff at East Carolina, Martin was a graduate assistant at the University of Kentucky, his alma mater, from 1986-87 and then spent the 1988-91 seasons at East Tennessee State University, where he coached the running backs his first year, then served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks/wide receivers coach his final three seasons.

Martin was a four-year letterwinner at Kentucky from 1981-84, spending time as a part-time starter at quarterback before injuries limited him to the holder role. A native of Oak Ridge, Tenn., Martin earned a bachelor's degree in history from Kentucky in 1985.

Martin and his wife Vicki have a daughter, Molly, and two sons, Cory and Bobby.

## The Series: NM State vs. Texas State

## The Last Meeting

Texas State 37, NM State 29 Nov. 1, 2014, Las Cruces, N.M.

LAS CRUCES, N.M. — Despite a pair of career-highs, the NM State football team dropped their seventh straight game Saturday, falling to the Texas State Bobcats 37-29 at Aggie Memorial Stadium.

Running back Larry Rose III set a new career high in rushing yards as he amassed 181 yards on 24 carries and scored one touchdown. Aggie quarterback Tyler Rogers went 36-for-52 for 404 yards and three touchdowns. Wide receiver Jerrel Brown had a season high 139 yards on seven receptions and one touchdown. NM State leading receiver Teldrick Morgan added 70 yards and one touchdown as well.

The Aggies (2-7, 1-4 SBC) chalked up 639 total yards of offense, with 235 on the ground and 404 through the air. Despite outpacing the Bobcats (5-3, 3-1 SBC) by 239 yards, Texas State came away with the win.

Despite the visiting team beggining their first drive with good field position, the Aggie defense held Texas State to a 36-yard field goal, putting the Bobcats up 3-0.

On the following Aggie drive Rogers connected with Brown for 86-yard touchdown pass for a 7-3 advantage. The 86-yard reception was the longest reception for the Aggies since Oct. 19, 2013, and was the third longest pass in Aggie history.

The Bobcats answered with a score of their own on their second drive of the game as they took the ball 66 yards on 10 plays for the score. The drive was capped off by a 14-yard run by Robert Lowe to put the Bobcats back on top 10-7. Following an interception, Texas State's Lowe scored his second touchdown of the contest on a five-yard rush up the middle, adding to the Texas State lead, 17-7.

With 3:00 left in the half, Rose III rushed for 24-yards to give the Aggies a chance to score. The drive was finished off with a two-yard pass from Rogers to Matthews as NM State cut the Texas State lead to 17-14 at the break.

The Bobcats found the end zone twice more to take 30-14 lead. The Aggies responded as they drove up the field for 75 yards on eight plays which ended in a 13-yard rush by Rose III. The rush put Rose III at 140 yards on the day with 6:27 left in the third quarter. The touchdown was Rose III's sixth of the season. Texas State received the kickoff with a 30-21 advantage.

Texas State drove the ball in for another score on the ensuing drive, ending with a 23-yard pass to Laurence White to lead 37-21. With 2:35 left, Rogers connected with Morgan for 21-yards and a touchdown. After a two-point conversion from Rogers, the Aggies cut the Bobcat's lead to 37-29.

The Aggies defense forced a three and out and NM State regained possession of the ball with 53 seconds left and no timeouts. Rogers' attempted Hail Mary fell short as Texas State held on to the victory.

NM State takes on Louisiana-Lafayette next Saturday at 6 p.m. for Homecoming at Aggie Memorial Stadium.

#### **Notables**

- Larry Rose III has 1,117 rushing yards through eight games. This gives the sophomore back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons, which is the first time an Aggie has done this since Denvis Manns from 1995-98.
- Rose III has 2,185 rushing yards over his career. He now ranks sixth all-time for career rushing yards in the Aggies record books.
- Rose III has 10 rushing touchdowns this season, which is tied for 10th in rushing touchdowns during a season.
- Rose III's 19 career rushing touchdowns are tied for ninth all-time.
- Prior to his injury, Tyler Rogers had 3,753 career passing yards, which is 319 yards back from being ranked in the top 10 all-time.
- Rogers has completed 340 passes over his career, which ranks No. 8 all-time in the record books.
- Rogers' 26 passing touchdowns ranks 10th all-time.
- Teldrick Morgan has 97 career receptions, which is 23 shy of ranking in the top 10 all-time.
- Morgan has nine receiving touchdowns in his career, which is four behind the 10th ranked all-time number of receiving touchdowns.

#### **Home Grown Talent**

The NM State football team has 18 players from the state of New Mexico, with seven of those players being from Las Cruces.

Two key players from the state who return for the 2015 season are wide receiver Josh Bowen from Albuquerque and running back Xavier Hall from Las Cruces.

#### **Teldrick Morgan**

#### **Biletnikoff Award Watch List**

The Biletnikoff Award is presented annually to the nation's outstanding college football receiver, regardless of position. Morgan is one of just four Sun Belt receivers named to the list of 48 candidates.

#### **Paul Hornung Award Watch List**

The Paul Hornung Award, presented by Texas Roadhouse and the Louisville Sports Commission, is given annually to the most versatile player in major college football.

#### 1,000-yard rusher

Larry Rose III racked up a team-high 1,102 rushing yards and nine touchdowns on 186 carries during the 2014 season. The Fair-field, Texas native became the first NM State player to eclipse the 1,000-yard rushing mark since 2011 and was the first freshman to accomplish this feat since 1995. Rose III had a career-high 229 rushing yards against UL-Monroe on Nov. 22 to become one of just six conference players to rush for more than 200 yards in a single game.

#### **Veteran Offensive Line**

NM State returns four starting offensive linemen from the 2014 roster. Thomas McGwire (right tackle), Houston Clemente (left Tackle), Isaiah Folasa (left guard) and Abram Holland (left tackle). The Aggies are one of just 34 schools with four starters returning for the offensive line. Additionally, Andy Cunningham, who had three starts, and Dezmand Candielaria, who started in four games, will also be returning for the 2015 season.

#### **Team Captains**

#### **Rodney Butler**

During the 2014 season, Butler led the Aggies with 119 tackles, which included 58 unassisted and 61 assisted tackles to earn a Second Team All-Sun Belt selection. Butler collected eight games with double-digit tackles and had a career-high 17 tackles at UTEP on Sept. 13.

#### Alex Trujillo

Trujillo played in five games during the 2014 season and started against UTEP. The redshirt senior amassed 10 tackles and one tackle for loss during his five games.

#### **Robert Wagner**

During the 2014 season, Wagner appeared in five games. The redshirt junior helped the defensive unit garner 14 tackles for loss and four forced fumbles during his five games.

#### **Teldrick Morgan**

Morgan had 75 receptions for 903 yards to average 12.0 yards per catch and 82.1 receiving yards per game in 2014. The redshirt junior had a career-long 57-yard reception at UTEP on his way to a personal-best 202 receiving yards. Overall, Morgan amassed four games of at least 100 receiving yards, eight games with 50 or more receiving yards and seven touchdowns. Morgan was recently selected to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team.

#### **Andy Cunningham**

Cunningham, a four year starter, has played every position on the offensive line. He played in the first six games of the 2014 season before being sidelined due to injury for the second time in his collegiate career. Prior to his injury, the redshirt senior helped anchor an offensive line that allowed Tyler Rogers to throw for 1,471 yards and Larry Rose III to rush for 290 yards in the first half the season.
