MINERS AND AGGIES TO CLASH IN 93RD MEETING

UTEP tangles with NM State, as the Battle of I-10 will be played in Las Cruces on Saturday. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. MT. The two programs will meet for the 93rd time at Aggie Memorial Stadium. The Miners are looking for their seventh consecutive victory over the Aggies, and fourth straight in Las Cruces. UTEP won the 2013 meeting at Aggie Memorial, 42-21. During the six-game winning streak, UTEP has averaged 36.8 points per game to NM State's 17.5 per contest.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

UTEP will play its third consecutive road game to open the 2015 campaign. UTEP is the only FBS program to start 2015 with three games away from home. The last time the Miners opened up a season with three road games was 1985. UTEP fell at Air Force 48-6 (Aug. 31), at no. 3 SMU 35-23 (Sept. 7) and at Colorado State 41-24 (Sept. 14).

THE SERIES

UTEP leads the series 55-35-2. This is the longest-running series in school history (93rd meeting). UTEP has reeled off six consecutive victories over NM State for the first time since 1986-91. The six-game winning streak ties the second longest for the Miners in the series. UTEP beat NM State seven consecutive times from 1927-33. NM State holds a 19-18-1 edge in games played in Las Cruces. However, the Miners have posted three consecutive wins at Aggie Memorial Stadium (2009, 2011 & 2013) for the first time since a four-game road winning streak from 1986-91.

THE LAST MEETING

UTEP rushed for 344 yards, its most in a game versus a Division I opponent since 1991, in a 42-24 throttling of NM State on Sept. 13, 2014 in the Sun Bowl. After the Aggies took a 10-7 lead on a 28-yard field goal by Maxwell Johnson early in the second quarter, UTEP scored 35 of the next 42 points. **Darrin Laufasa** accounted for two of the five touchdowns during that stretch, both in the second quarter. He reeled in a two-yard pass from **Jameill Showers** and later punched it in from the goal line. UTEP was up 21-10 at the break and, following a scoreless third quarter by both teams, put the pedal to the metal over the final 15 minutes. The Miners tallied 21 points in the final period, with Showers, **Aaron Jones** and reserve quarter-back **Garrett Simpson** all rushing for short scores. Jones (25 carries-168 yards-two TDs) recorded his third

straight 100-yard rushing game to open the season. **Nathan Jeffery** chipped in with 79 yards on 12 carries. Showers had efficient numbers at 13-for-16 passing for 126 yards. **Nick Usher** was a standout on defense with nine tackles, including two for losses, and a forced fumble. NM State got on the scoreboard first, but after that, UTEP kept the Aggies out of the end zone until the final quarter. Teldrick Morgan had eight receptions for 202 yards for NM State. The last time UTEP had more rushing yards against a Division I opponent was on Aug. 31, 1991 versus New Mexico (349). The Miners gained 470 yards, and NMSU collected 425.

CONNECTIONS

UTEP has two players from the state of New Mexico on its roster – freshman QB **Kavika Johnson** (Las Cruces) and sophomore TE **Sterling Napier** (Rio Rancho). Johnson attended Mayfield High School, where he led the Trojans to consecutive state championship games. NM State has one El Paso native on its roster in senior DB Kedeem Thomas-Davis (El Dorado HS).

Players from both schools who attended the same high school are: UTEP OL **Christopher Misaalefua** & NM State OL Dustin Lamb (Lindsay [Calif.] HS); UTEP TE **Sterling Napier** & NM State OL Abram Holland (Cleveland HS [Rio Rancho, N.M.]); and UTEP QB **Kavika Johnson** & NM State LB Chris Acosta, OL Raymond Fierro and DB Brett Kowalski (Mayfield HS [Las Cruces, N.M.]).

UTEP Wide Receivers Coach **Todd Whitten** coached at NM State from 1992-93, working with the offensive line. Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Line Coach **Spencer Leftwich** was also part of the Aggies' staff from 1992-93, directing the quarterbacks.

ABOUT NM STATE

The Aggies are 0-2 to start the 2015 campaign. NM State opened the season with a 61-13 loss at Florida on Sept. 5 and dropped its opening Sun Belt Conference game to Georgia State, 34-32, at Aggie Memorial Stadium on Sept. 12. During the Aggies' first two contests, the offense has gained 729 yards of total offense (156 rushing, 573 passing), while the defense has yielded 1,188 yards to opponents (434 rushing, 754 passing). The Aggies are averaging 22.5 points per game and giving up 47.5 points per contest. Larry Rose III is leading the team in rushing with 133 yards (4.4 avg.) and a pair of scores. QB Tyler Rogers has been solid, throwing for 573 yards on 45-of-82 passing (54.9 percent), four touchdowns and an interception. Rogers is currently ranked third in the Sun Belt with 286.5 passing yards per game. WR Tyrain Taylor is pacing the squad with 12 receptions for 225 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Taylor hauled in 10 of those passes against Georgia State, gaining 206 yards and two touchdowns. Taylor added a 75-yard score during the first quarter versus Georgia State. Taylor's 6.5 receptions per game are ranked fourth in the Sun Belt, while his yards per game (112.5) ranks second. DB Jaden Wright ranks first on the defense with 18 tackles (12 solo) and has the team's lone interception. Wright also recovered a fumble (10 yards). Overall, the defense has sacked the quarterback two times and has recovered three fumbles.

LAST WEEK: UTEP 20, TEXAS TECH 69

Patrick Mahomes passed for four touchdowns and rushed for two others as Texas Tech took advantage of an injury-depleted UTEP squad and ran away to a 69-20 victory on Sept. 12 in Lubbock. Following a competitive first 25 minutes, the Red Raiders scored 45 of the game's final 48 points, primarily after the Miners' **Aaron Jones** went down with a foot injury. Jones was in a boot for the second half. Mahomes passed for 361 yards in three quarters before giving way to backup Davis Webb. **Mack Leftwich**

threw for a career-high 164 yards for the Miners. He completed 14-of-22 passes. Portland State transfer Hayden Plinke had a big game for UTEP as well with four receptions for 87 yards. Jones rushed 17 times for 139 yards in the first half. Without him in the second half, UTEP gained 64 yards on the ground. The Miners compiled 414 yards of offense, 227 rushing. The Red Raiders scored the game's first 10 points. They struck quickly, with Mahomes finding Jakeem Grant for a 60-yard touchdown a little over a minute in. The Miner defense stiffened on Texas Tech's next possession, but the Red Raiders were still able to connect on a 32-yard field goal by Michael Barden. UTEP cut it to 10-7 with a 10-play, 75-yard drive. Jones picked up 55 of the 75 yards - 31 rushing, 24 receiving - including a 24-yard touchdown reception from Leftwich. Texas Tech extended the lead to 17-7 when Mahomes hooked up with Justin Stockton for a 46-yard touchdown. Jones single-handedly pulled the Miners within a field goal on a school-record 91-yard run early in the second quarter. Jones was responsible for 146 of the 166 yards on UTEP's two touchdown drives in the first half. The 91-yard run was tied for the fifth-longest in Conference USA history. Texas Tech rode the running game to its third touchdown of the day, as DeAndre Washington gained 29 yards on four carries and Mahomes plowed across the goal line to push the lead to 24-14. UTEP sliced the deficit to seven points (24-17) on a 24-yard field goal by Jay Mattox with 5:13 to play in the half. But Texas Tech responded with a pair of touchdowns before going to the locker room. Mahomes passed for 80 yards and rushed for 44 on the two drives. He had a 12-yard running score and hit Reginald Davis for a 35-yard TD as the Red Raiders opened a 38-17 cushion. The Miners gained 163 yards on 24 carries in the first half behind Jones. UTEP's only points of the second half came on a 42-yard field goal by Mattox early in the fourth quarter. Texas Tech scored the first 17 points of the second half to pull away. Texas Tech piled up 674 yards, as Mahomes completed 18-of-33 passes to pick apart an inexperienced Miner secondary. The Red Raiders also rushed for 229 yards led by Washington, who gained 138. Grant was Texas Tech's leading receiver with seven catches for 141 yards.

JONES' 91-YARD SPRINT

Aaron Jones set a record with his 91-yard touchdown run at Texas Tech. It's the longest rushing play in program history. The previous long was 90 yards by two former Miners. Willie Fuller had a 90-yard run against Utah in 1988 and James Hammonds duplicated it versus West Virginia in 1950.

MORE ON 91

Aaron Jones' 91-yard touchdown run is tied for fifth-longest in Conference USA history. North Texas' Brandin Byrd ran for a 91-yard touchdown at Tulsa on Nov. 30, 2013. Jones' record-breaking run is also the second-longest run play in the FBS in 2015. South Alabama's Xavier Johnson ran for a 92-yard score against Gardner-Webb during the fourth quarter on Sept. 5. Jones' 91-yard run is ranked fourth in the FBS for overall longest play. Stanford's Bryce Love registered a 93-yard catch, while Wyoming's Tanner Gentry hauled in a 92-yard reception.

JONES MOVING ON UP

Aaron Jones gained 139 yards rushing against Texas Tech on Saturday. It was Jones' seventh-best performance during his career. Jones' 91-yard touchdown run moved him to eighth place on the alltime UTEP rushing list. He now has 2,341 yards, surpassing **Pug Gabrel's** 2,321. Jones needs 77 yards to overtake Donald Buckram's 2,417 yards and 494 yards to move into third place in program history. He is 1,126 yards away from overtaking Howard Jackson's second-place standing (3,466), while he would need 1,236 yards to dethrone John Harvey's (3,576) UTEP record.

ALL-PURPOSE JONES

Aaron Jones racked up another 162 all-purpose yards on Saturday. Jones now has 2,754 all-purpose yards (2,341 rush, 413 rec.) in his career. He needs 477 yards to crack the top 10 in program history. Fred Wendt ranks 10th with 3,231 yards. Last season, Jones' 1,614 all-purpose yards (1,321 rush, 293 rec.) were seventh-best during a single season in program history.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

Aaron Jones has hit 100-plus yards rushing 10 times in 23 games during his UTEP career. Jones is tied for fifth in program history with Paul Smith (1996-99). Last week Jones surpassed Donald Buckram (2006-10), Robert Elliott (1974-77) and Pug Gabrel (1947-50), who each notched nine apiece. John Harvey (1985-88) leads the all-time list with sixteen 100-yard games, while Howard Jackson (2001-04) tallied 14, Toraino Singleton (1994-95) 12, and Marcus Thomas (2004-07) 11.

JONES' OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

Aaron Jones accounted for 146 of the 166 yards gained on UTEP's two touchdown drives at Texas Tech. On UTEP's first touchdown drive, Jones carried the ball seven times for 31 yards, while ending the drive with a 24-yard touchdown reception. Jones' 91-yard score accounted for all the yards on two plays during the Miners' second touchdown drive. Jones (315 total yards) has accounted for 51 percent of the Miners' 618 yards of total offense.

ANOTHER CAREER DAY FOR AARON JONES

Aaron Jones led UTEP in receiving yards (83) and receptions (six) at Arkansas to open the 2015 season. He established a career high in receiving yards, surpassing his previous best of 72 against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 29, 2014. He added a 36-yard juggling reception during the second quarter versus the

Jones also tied his career high in receptions, as he hauled in six passes against Old Dominion on Oct. 11, 2014. Jones ranked second in receptions (30), while leading the team in touchdowns (three) in 2014.

AARON JONES ACCOLADES

Aaron Jones was named to the Conference USA second team after a stellar sophomore campaign. Other achievements included: 2014 Dave Campbell Texas Running Back of the Year, 2014 Dave Campbell Player of the Year Honorable Mention, 2014 Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Semifinalist, and Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award National Player of the Week Honorable Mention (11/18 & 9/2). The running back has also earned recognition this season, being named to the AllState AFCA Good Works Team, Doak Walker Award list, Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award list, Maxwell Award watch list and 2015 Dave Campbell Texas Football Best Running Back.

RUNNING BACK DEPTH

During the 2014 season, **Nathan Jeffery** and **Josh Bell** complemented starting ball carrier **Aaron Jones** by combining for 787 yards and nine rushing scores. Jeffery and Bell have graduated since then; senior **Jeremiah Laufasa** and freshman **Treyvon Hughes** are being looked on to back up Jones in 2015. Both Laufasa (6-foot, 225 lbs.) and Hughes (6-foot-1, 225 lbs.) have similar running styles to Jeffery (6-foot, 210 lbs.) and Bell (6-foot, 220 lbs.), who bruised and grinded past defenders. Laufasa brings most of the experience as he has played in five games for the Miners, rushing for 81 yards on 18 attempts (4.5 avg.) and a score, while hauling in 52 yards worth of passes. Prior to transferring to UTEP, Laufasa appeared in 13 games, making one start, during his sophomore campaign (2013) at Washington State, while rushing for seven touchdowns. Hughes has two yards on 11 carries in 2015.

PASS CATCHING FULLBACK

FB **Darrin Laufasa** tallied a career-high 20-yard reception during the first quarter at Texas Tech. The catch surpassed his previous high of 16 yards at Colorado State on Sept. 28, 2013. Laufasa has gained 37 yards on three receptions in 2015.

DARRIN VERSUS NM STATE

Darrin Laufasa has found pay dirt four times during his UTEP career – all against NM State. In 2013, Laufasa scored a pair of touchdowns in Las Cruces, the first on a 17-yard run and the second on a career-long 45-yard dash to the end zone. Last year, Laufasa scored on a two-yard reception and on a one-yard plunge. In his two games versus the Aggies, Laufasa has gained 78 yards on 11 carries and three touchdowns, and two receiving yards with a score.

UTEP RUSHING ATTACK VS. NM STATE

During the **Sean Kugler** era, UTEP has pounded out 637 rushing yards on 114 attempts (5.6 avg.) and 10 rushing scores against the Aggies. The Miners are averaging 318.5 yards per game. Last season, UTEP rushed for 344 yards and five scores, while in 2013, the rushing attack went for 293 yards and five touchdowns

SOLID DAY FOR PLINKE

Transfer TE **Hayden Plinke** led UTEP in receptions (four) and yards (87) against Texas Tech on Sept. 12, including a 42-yard catch and punishing run that helped set up a **Jay Mattox** field goal during the second quarter. Plinke's yards were the most for a tight end during the **Sean Kugler** era, surpassing Eric Tomlinson's 75 yards at Colorado State on Sept. 28. 2013. Plinke was also the first tight end to lead the Miners in receiving since **Craig Wenrick's** 50-yard performance at Middle Tennessee on Nov. 30, 2013. Plinke's 87 yards at Texas Tech were the most for a UTEP tight end since **Jamar Hunt's** 86 yards to open the 2008 season at Buffalo. Plinke, so far, has five receptions for 100 yards in 2015, ranking second on the team in both categories.

FROM REBOUNDING TO PASS CATCHING

Former UTEP basketball forward **Cedrick Lang** is using his fifth-year status to play tight end for head coach **Sean Kugler**. Lang recorded his first collegiate reception during the third quarter at Texas Tech – a four-yard catch that went for a first down. He finished with two catches for 11 yards versus the Red Raiders.

MACK'S THE MAN

Head Coach **Sean Kugler** announced on Aug. 31 at the first media luncheon that sophomore **Mack Leftwich** would be his starting quarterback. Leftwich made his sixth career start on Saturday. Leftwich completed 14-of-22 (63.6 percent) passes for a career-high 164 yards and a touchdown at Texas Tech. His completion percentage was the third best during his career, while he tied his career high with 14 completions. Leftwich's first-ever start at North Texas (Nov. 9, 2013) saw the then-true freshman complete 70 percent of his passes (14-of-20). Leftwich's touchdown pass, a 24-yard toss to **Aaron Jones**, was his first since Nov. 16, 2013 versus FIU. Leftwich is completeing 63.9 percent (23-for-36) of his passes for 284 yards in 2015.





#SHOWTIME JONES

JUNIOR AARON JONES is coming off a brilliant performance in week two against the Red Raiders. Jones tallied 162 all-purpose yards (139 rushing, 23 receiving).

2,341 – the **RUSHING YARDS** gained **DURING HIS CAREER** at UTEP. The El Paso native has played in 23 games with the Orange and Blue, averaging 101.8 yards per game. He's carried the ball 429 times during his three seasons (5.5 avg.). Jones now ranks ninth all-time in the school record book in rushing yards.

2,754- the amount of **ALL-PURPOSE YARDS** Jones has accumulated during his career for the Orange and Blue; he needs 477 yards to enter the top 10 in school history.

91– a new **CAREER HIGH** rushing yard score and school record at TTU. Previously, Willie Fuller (1988 vs. Utah) and James Hammonds (1950 vs. West Virginia) each gained a 90-yard rush for UTEP.

MULTIPLE QBS UNDER CENTER

A trio of UTEP quarterbacks have completed passes in 2015. **Mack Leftwich** (23-of-36), **Ryan Metz** (6-of-9) and **Kavika Johnson** (4-of-5) all found themselves under center this season. During **Sean Kugler's** first season, four quarterbacks completed passes during the season: **Jameill Showers** (107-of-188), **Mack Leftwich** (44-of-75), **Blaire Sullivan** (15-of-26) and **Garrett Simpson** (3-of-3). Showers was the only quarterback to play in 2014, starting all 13 games.

RECEIVERS CATCHING ON

After seeing multiple drops by UTEP pass catchers during camp and the first few weeks of practice, UTEP quarterbacks are completing 66.0 percent (33-of-50) of their attempts in 2015. **Hayden Plinke** (five receptions), **Warren Redix** (three receptions), **Cedrick Lang** (two receptions), **Donovan Walker** (one reception) and **Sloan Spiller** (one reception) have all hauled in their first catches as Miners this season.

PROTECTING THE FIELD GENERAL

The UTEP offensive line has continued its consistent play, allowing only two sacks in its first two games of 2015. So far, UTEP ranks tied for second in Conference USA, being one of six schools to allow two or less sacks this season. Middle Tennessee has allowed only one sack. Last season, the Miners' offensive line allowed only 13 sacks in 13 games, ranking no. 1 in Conference USA and tied for eighth in the nation.

BIGGER O-LINE

The final game of head coach **Sean Kugler's** first season (2013) saw a starting offensive line that averaged 298 pounds. Since then, Kugler has assembled a starting offensive line that averages 313 pounds in 2015. LT **Jerome Daniels** (305 lbs.), LG **Will Hernandez** (330 lbs.), C **Eric Lee** (305 lbs.), RG **Derek Elmendorff** (310 lbs.) and RT **John De La Rosa** (315 lbs.) compose the starting run blockers/pass protectors. The second unit offensive line averages 329 pounds. According to the depth chart LT **Anthony Kyles** (300 lbs.), LG **Josh Silvas** (375 lbs.), C **Derron Gatewood** (315 lbs.), RG **Christopher Misaalefua** (355 lbs.) and RT **Chris Thomas** (300 lbs.) make up the second unit.

KEEPING AN EYE ON ERIC LEE

Senior C **Eric Lee** was named to the Rimington Trophy Spring Watch List on May 19. The list includes 52 of the best centers in Division I football. Lee saw playing time for the first time last season, starting in all 13 games. Lee is one of six starting centers in Conference USA to make their return for the 2015 campaign. The others are redshirt junior Jarred Barr (Charlotte), senior Kirby Wixson (LA Tech), redshirt junior Josh Chester (Middle Tennessee), junior Kaydon Kirby (North Texas) and junior Cameron Tom (Southern Miss).

VERY FEW INFRACTIONS

UTEP has committed 10 penalties on the young season thus far. The Miners were penalized two times at Arkansas and eight times at Texas Tech. The Miners committed 65 in 13 games last season (5.0 penalties per game), ranking fourth in Conference USA for fewest penalties. UTEP has committed 75 penalties during the last 15 contests dating back to last year.

PENALTIES DURING THE KUGLER ERA

In 27 games with head coach **Sean Kugler**, UTEP has committed 125 penalties totaling 1,033 yards. That breaks down to 4.6 penalties and 38.3 penalty yards per contest. Prior to Kugler's arrival, the Miners averaged 5.8 penalties and 51.8 penalty yards per game the previous five seasons. During Kugler's first two seasons, UTEP averaged 56.5 penalties. The previous five campaigns, the Miners averaged 71 penalties.

PENALTIES IN C-USA

UTEP currently ranks fourth in Conference USA in penalty yards per game (47.5), while it is one of five schools to commit 10 or less penalties two games into the season. North Texas has committed seven penalties, but has played one game in 2015. LA Tech leads the conference with least amount of infractions (eight), while leading the way with 37.5 penalty yards per game. Marshall and UTSA each have committed 22 penalties, while the Roadrunners lead the league with 103.0 penalty yards per game.

TIME BANDITS

UTEP won the time of possession on Saturday at Texas Tech, 40:15 to 19:45. This is another consistent element during the **Sean Kugler** era. In 2014, UTEP won the time of possession in 12 of 13 games. The Miners ranked second in the nation in time of possession (34:57) behind Michigan State (35:21) in 2014. UTEP has led in time of possession in 14 of the last 15 games dating back to the 2014 season. UTEP's 40+ time of possession at TTU was the third time doing so in the Kugler era. The Miners held possession for 41:53 at NM State on Sept. 14, 2013 and 41:26 against Old Dominion on Oct. 11, 2014. Overall during Kugler's three seasons at the helm, the Miners have won time of possession in 21 of 27 games. UTEP currently ranks second in Conference USA with its 35:28 time of possession. Rice is first at 37:28.

RED ZONE OFFENSE

UTEP is 4-for-4 in the red zone in 2015. The Miners have converted three field goals and a touchdown when getting near the goal line. UTEP ranks tied for first in Conference USA with its 100 percent conversions. Florida Atlantic is 10-for-10 (six touchdowns and four field goals), Rice is 7-for-7 (seven touchdowns), and North Texas is 2-for-2 (two field goals).

THIRD DOWN CONVERSIONS

A season after converting 42 percent of third-down conversions, UTEP is converting 40.6 percent of its third downs (13-of-32) thus far in 2015. However, the Miners did convert 7-of-14 (50 percent) third-down conversions at Arkansas to open the season. The Miners are ranked sixth in Conference USA in third-down conversions. Rice leads the way with 69.4 percent (25-of-36).

CONSECUTIVE STARTS

Five Miners made their 15th consecutive start dating back to last season on Saturday. OL Jerome Daniels, OL Will Hernandez, FB Darrin Laufasa, OL Eric Lee and DL Roy Robertson-Harris achieved the feat. Laufasa, dating back to 2013, has started 22 of 27 games, while Robertson-Harris has made 23 starts in his last 26 games since 2013.

FEWEST SENIORS ON OFFENSE

UTEP is one of 25 FBS schools with four or less seniors at offensive skill positions (QB, RB, WR, TE) in 2015. The Miners feature three seniors in those positions: RB Jeremiah Laufasa, TE Cedrick Lang and WR Autrey Golden. There are seven other programs that feature only three seniors. Those schools are Colorado, Miami, Minnesota, Ohio State, Purdue, Washington State and Wyoming. Three schools (Eastern Michigan, Florida State and Louisville) have two seniors, while six programs (Kentucky, Nevada, Old Dominion, Pitt, Syracuse and Wake Forest) feature only one senior. UCF is the only program not to have any seniors at a skill position. The Miners have a total of five seniors on offense. OL Eric Lee and OL Josh Silvas, Golden, Lang and Laufasa are the featured seniors. UCF and Louisville have four, Kentucky and Old Dominion have three, while Florida State, Nevada, Pitt and Wake Forest feature two seniors on offense.

UTEP DEFENSE VERSUS NM STATE

The UTEP defense has forced six NM State turnovers the last two seasons. In 2013, **Dashone Smith** intercepted two passes, while **Da'Carlos Renfro** and **Traun Roberson** each recovered a fumble. Last season, **Damian Payne** and **Wesley Miller** each picked off a pass. **Nick Usher** forced a fumble, but it was recovered by the Aggies.

NICK USHER'S PERFORMANCE VS. NM STATE

Junior DE **Nick Usher** led the Miners with nine tackles (five solo) during last season's 42-24 win in the Sun Bowl. Usher added a forced fumble, two tackles for loss and a quarterback hurry. In 2013, Usher tallied five stops in Las Cruces.

IN THE NIK OF TIME

In only his second game, redshirt freshman DB **Nik Needham** paced the Miners in tackles with six stops at Texas Tech. He also added a tackle for loss and a pass breakup, as both were the first of his career. On the season, Needham has eight tackles (all solo).

WELCOME BACK, DASHONE SMITH

UTEP DB **Dashome Smith** leads the defense with 11 tackles (six solo) this season, after missing the last three games of 2014 due to an injury. Smith opened his junior campaign by leading the UTEP defense with seven tackles at Arkansas. It was his first time leading in that category since Oct. 11, 2014 against Old Dominion. He also had seven stops against the Monarchs.



END-TO-END DEFENDERS

UTEP has two returning defensive ends that harassed offensive linemen throughout 2014. 6-foot-7, 255-pound **Roy Robertson-Harris** and 6-foot-3, 240-pound **Nick Usher** stepped up in a big way. Robertson-Harris made 13 starts his junior season after making eight in 2013, and Usher made 12 starts after zero starts his freshman campaign. Usher and Robertson-Harris each tallied a quarterback hurry against Texas Tech. Defensive Coordinator **Scott Stoker** is waiting for the two ends to have their breakout game, as they have combined for nine tackles in 2015. Last season, Usher tallied 41 tackles, 3.0 sacks and three quarterback hurries, and Robertson-Harris recorded 36 stops, while leading the team in sacks (3.5) and quarterback hurries (six).

DEPTH & EXPERIENCE AT THE DEFENSIVE BACK POSITION

UTEP has 21 defensive backs listed on the roster entering week three against NM State. Of the 21, 13 are upperclassmen. LaQuintus Dowell, Kelvin Fisher Jr., Da'Carlos Renfro, Traun Roberson (grad student), Natanael Rodriguez, Ishmael Harrison, Nathan Stukes and Trent Trammell (transfer) make up the senior DBs. Devin Cockrell, Leon Hayes, Brandon Moss (moved to DB prior to week two), Brendan Royal and Dashone Smith round out the junior class. Cockrell will miss the 2015 campaign due to season-ending surgery, while Harrison and Roberson are also sidelined indefinitely.

THE GOLDEN STANDARD

Autrey Golden returned two kickoffs for scores in 2014. The first was a 98-yard return in the third quarter against Southern Miss, while the second came at WKU, 92 yards for a TD in the first quarter. He has six kickoff return touchdowns in his career (ranked No. 1 in program history), making him the active FBS leader in the category. Golden is tied for second in Conference USA history and tied for third in NCAA history. He is now just one back of C-USA and NCAA record-holder Tyron Carrier of Houston (seven). Former Clemson star C.J. Spiller also shares the NCAA marker with seven kickoff returns for scores. Golden has a total of 98 career returns, rating third in program history and just one behind second-place Ray Holt (99).

GOLDEN'S KICK RETURN YARDAGE

Autrey Golden returned four kickoffs for 83 yards on Saturday. He now has 2,552 yards in his UTEP career, ranking second behind Cedric Johnson's 2,757. Golden needs 206 yards to become UTEP's all-time leader. On the season, Golden is averging 21.3 yards on 10 kickoff returns.

SLASH

Autrey Golden can find the end zone in multiple ways, as he scored his 10th career touchdown on Sept. 5 at Arkansas. It was on a reverse play to the left side that went 10 yards into the end zone during the second quarter. It was his first rushing score since Nov. 16, 2013 versus FIU. Golden has six kickoff returns for touchdowns, two receiving and two rushing scores.

SPECIAL JAY

Junior Kicker Jay Mattox tied a career high on Saturday - again - by connecting on a pair of field goals versus Texas Tech. He also added a pair of extra points, ranking sixth in scoring (7.5 points per game) for kickers after week two in Conference USA. Mattox is 4-for-4 in field goals and 3-for-3 in extra points. Mattox has made a dramatic improvement on his field goal kicking, connecting on 85.0 percent (17-of-20) since the start of the 2014 season after only 46.7 percent (7-of-15) in 2013.

Δυτο-ΜΔΤΤΟΧ

Dating back to the WKU game on Nov. 8, 2014, **Jay Mattox** has made 11 consecutive field goals. Mattox was 2-for-2 against WKU, Rice (Nov. 21) and Utah State (Dec. 20), and was 1-for-1 against Middle Tennessee (Nov. 29). And in 2015, Mattox is 4-for-4 to start the season. The junior has also connected on 78-of-79 extra points during his career at UTEP.

UTEP'S NEW PUNTER

El Paso native **Alan Luna** is averaging 45.1 yards per punt in 2015. The redshirt freshman had a long of 60 yards during the second quarter at Arkansas in the season opener. Luna currently ranks third in Conference USA and 17th nationally after two weeks. Luna has booted 10 punts for 451 yards. Florida Atlantic's Dalton Schomp leads the league with a 50.1 yards per punt, while San Jose State's Michael Carrizosa leads the nation with a 51.9 average.

OVERALL PUNTING

UTEP is ranked sixth in Conference USA with a 37.4 net per punt average. Florida Atlantic leads with a 45.6 average. The Miners have yielded 57 yards on 10 punts this season.

#GOLDEN STANDARD

SENIOR AUTREY GOLDEN is seeing more action at wide receiver in 2015, but is best known for his special teams play. He's considered one of the greatest kickoff returners in NCAA history.

2,552 – the amount of **YARDS GAINED RETURNING KICKOFFS** during Golden's career. His total ranks second in school history behind Cedric Johnson's 2,757 return yards.

6 – the amount of **KTCKOFF RETURN TOUCHDOWNS** Golden has scored during his career. He is UTEP's all-time leader and the active leader in the FBS, leaving him one shy of tying the NCAA record. Golden returned two for scores in each of his first three seasons.

10 – the total number of times Golden has **REACHED PAYDIRT** during his career. His 10-yard scamper at Arkansas was his second rushing touchdown for the Orange and Blue. Overall Golden has six kickoff return TDs, two receiving TDs and two rushing scores.





CAPTAINS

The Miners' captains for 2015 feature four seniors and one junior -- (offense) WR **Autrey Golden** and RB **Aaron Jones**, (defense) DL **Roy Robertson-Harris** and LB **Jimmy Musgrave**, and (special teams) DB **Traun Roberson**.

HOME COOKIN'

There are 22 El Paso products on the 2015 roster (three seniors, four juniors, five sophomores and 10 freshmen), including eight on the week two depth chart -- RG **Derek Elmendorff** (projected starter), WR **Cole Freytag**, RB **Aaron Jones** (projected starter), LB **Alvin Jones** (projected starter), P **Alan Luna** (projected starter), QB **Ryan Metz**, WR **Warren Redix** and LG **Josh Silvas**.

HEAD COACH SEAN KUGLER

Sean Kugler is in his third season as UTEP's head coach, as he went from two wins in his first season to a winning campaign and a bowl bid during his second. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Miners (1985-88) and a three-year starter at right guard. Kugler returned to the Sun City as a UTEP assistant coach (1993-2000), working as a graduate assistant/defensive line coach in 1993, tight ends & assistant strength and conditioning coach in 1994 and offensive line coach from 1995-2000. He coached in the NFL with Detroit (2001-05), Buffalo (2007-09) and Pittsburgh (2010-12) and was also assistant head coach at Boise State in 2006 when the Broncos finished 13-0 and upset Oklahoma, 43-42, in the Fiesta Bowl.

PLAYERS TURNED COACHES

Sean Kugler is the second UTEP head coach who played for the Miners at one time. The other is **Walter Milner**, a three-year letterman from 1931-33 who served as head coach in 1942. Kugler is one of 14 active Division I head coaches who played at the school where they are currently coaching.
