## AGGIE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### KICKOFF

Looking to finish the season on a high note, the NM State football team travels to Mobile, Ala., for an 11 a.m. kickoff against South Alabama this Saturday, Nov. 3.

Brock Bowling will once again have the call on Saturday while former NC State head coach Tom O'Brien serves as the analyst on the ESPN3 broadcast. Aggie fans can also listen to NM State Athletics/US Bank Hall of Famer Jack Nixon and former NM State football player, Preston Williams, on the Aggies' flagship station 99.5 FM KXPZ or listen to the game live with their mobile or tablet device on the TuneIn app for free.

#### WHERE TO WATCH

Aggie fans trying to catch the game on TV can watch the ESPN3  $\,$ broadcast on their desktop or mobile device. In addition, fans with AppleTV, Chromecast, Roku and other webcast products that have the WatchESPN function can catch the game on their television set.

## EYING THE JAGUARS

Saturday's contest between NM State and South Alabama will be the first meeting between the two teams. The Jaquars are 5-6 overall and 1-6 Sun Belt action when the two teams square off in Ladd-Peebles Stadium at II a.m. (MT) on Saturday while NM State checks in at 3-8 and 2-5 in Sun Belt play.

The Jaguars had a great non-conference season, beating the likes of Mississippi State (21-20) on the road in their season-opener and then a ranked San Diego State (42-24) team at home handedly. However, South Alabama has struggled in conference play with its lone win coming against Georgia State. USA will playing for bowl eligibility as well as it sits at 5-6 on the year.

Dallas Davis under center for USA ad is averaging  $246.9~\mathrm{yards}$  per game through the air with nine touchdowns, but has also thrown nine picks. Davis has thrown for 2,222 yards so far this season with a 123.70 efficiency rating. He's also fourth on the team in rushing with 176 net

yards and two runs into the end zone.

Xavier Johnson paces the running game for South Alabama, checking in with 633 yards on the ground with an average of 5.0 yards per rush and seven TDs. Tyreis Thomas is second on the team with 300 net yards on the ground for 4.1 yards per rush, but just trails Johnson by one with six rumbles into the end zone.

Gerald Everett has been the go-to target for Davis this season, bringing in 43 catches for 648 yards for four touchdowns. Josh Magee is right on his tails with three catches to the house for 533 yards on 40 receptions. However, Davis has thrown to 17 different targets so far this season

The Jaguar defense has picked up opposing quarterbacks eight times while recovering nine of the 14 forced fumbles in 2016. South Alabama is fourth in scoring defense between SBC teams and third in total defense, allowing just 367.8 yards to its opponents.

## DYNAMIC DUD

Rodney Butler (150), the nation's leading tackler, and Dalton Herrington (98) combined total of 248 tackles is second-most by any two players in FBS football with Virginia's pair of Kiser (134)/Blanding (120) in the lead with 254 combined tackles.

## HOME SLATE WRAP UP

With the 2016 home slate all wrapped up for NM State, the Aggies finished the year 3-2 at home. The last time NM State had 3 or more wins at home during the season was back in 2007 when it was 4-3 in Aggie Memorial Stadium.

## GOING OUT WITH A BANG

Senior linebacker Rodney Butler has had a senior season every player would hope to have. The Palm Springs, Calif., product has led the nation (FBS) in tackles in 11 of the 13 weeks since the Aggies' season-opener on Sept. 3 at UTEP. Should Butler finish the season as the nation's

leading tackler, he would only be the third Aggie ever to do so in program history, joining Jimmy Cottrell (179, 2005) and Derrick Richardson (137, 2008).

His 364 career tackles is fourth-most amongst active FBS football players and No. 23 amongst Division I football players. His 7.91 career tackles per game is ranked 10th compared to other FBS players while his 157 solo tackles ranks him 45th amongst active FBS football players. In addition, his 207 assisted tackles sit him at No. 2 on the active career list and No. 16 compared to active Division I football players. Butler's 44 assisted tackles for loss also places him at No. 26 on the FBS active career list.

## FIRST ONE IN THE BOOKS

Connor Cramer took his first snap under center in Division I on Saturday and took most of the snaps against Appalachian State at home. The transfer from New Mexico Military Institute picked up his first-career touchdown pass when he connected with Tyrian Taylor for a 54-yard bomb in the second quarter as well.

The redshirt junior wrapped up his first game 10-of-24 from the air for 93 yards through the air and a team-high 74 yards on the ground.

Heading into Saturday's game, Rodney Butler sits in a tie for seventh on the all-time tackles list with 364, tying D'Wayne Taylor (364, 1998-01). Butler needs 10 tackles to pass Bob Kinder (373, 1983-86) for sixth alltime and 15 tackles to pass Leo Barker (378, 1979-83) for fifth all-time.

Butler's 150 tackles this season is good for eight-best in a single-season at NM State. With one game remaining, he could move up as high as third place with 15 tackles.

Heading into week 14 of the 2016 season, several players as well as the team ranks in the top-50 nationally amongst Football Subdivision Teams.

Senior linebacker Rodney Butler still leads the nation in total tackles with 150 (13.6/game). Fellow linebackers Dalton Herrington (98), Terrill Hanks (91) and Jacob Nwangwa (85) checks in at 40th 66th and 105th, respectively, in the country. The three Aggies also claim the top-10 spots in the Sun Belt Conference, checking in at Nos. 1, 3, 8 and 11. In the solo tackles department. Butler sits in 30th with 57 (5.2/game). Butler and Jaden Wright's three forced fumbles rank them 22nd in the nation and third in the SBC while Hanks' two FFs is tied for seventh in the league. Jaden Wright also moved into 23rd in the country with four interceptions on the year and third in the Sun Belt.

Offensively, Tyler Rogers is ranked No. 33 in the country with 258.8 passing yards per game while his total of 2,588 has him sitting at No. 50. His 22.00 completions per game is good for 18th in the country and first in the SBC.

Freshman Peyton Theisler sits at No. 49 in the country after averaging 41.9 yards per punt through 11 games.

## AROUND THE BELT

Entering this weekend, NM State is in third when it comes to total offense (4.513 yards) behind league leader Troy and second in the passing offense (2,829 yards) category.

Tyler Rogers continues to lead the Sun Belt in total offense with 291.2 yards per game while his 258.8 passing yards per game is second in the league.

On the defensive end, NM State has three represented in the league's top-10 tacklers list in Rodney Butler (No. 1). Dalton Herrington (No. 3) and Terrill Hanks (No. 8). Hanks is also tied for eighth with 11.5 tackles for loss while Butler's three forced fumbles has him tied for third amongst SBC players. Jaden Wright is tied for third with four interceptions on

The 2016 season will have come to an end for the Aggies after their game at South Alabama on Saturday. NM State will look back at the positives from this season and build upon that in spring ball before ramping it up again for the 2017 season.

Along with last Saturday's win, Tyler Rogers became just the second player this season to have caught, thrown and rushed for a touchdown in a game. From the past five seasons, there have been 11 players to achieve the feat, two that have done it twice, with eight of the 11 players being quarterbacks.

## EXPLOSIVE PLAYS

So far this season, the Aggies have had plays of 30-yards or longer 17 separate times. Of those 17, six have resulted in touchdowns - two coming against Kentucky and one against Idaho, Georgia Southern, Texas State and Appalachian State. These explosive plays have come from eight different players with Tyrian Taylor leading the team with four while and Johnathan Boone has three, followed by Royce Caldwell, Izaiah Lottie Jaleel Scott with one each.

## NOTHING BUT HOGAN

Redshirt junior Gregory Hogan has been a favorite target for quarterback Tyler Rogers this season. He's targeted the 6-1 wide out 32 times this season, second-most on the team behind OJ Clark (42), and Hogan and rewarded him for his confidence – hauling in three TD catches. The Houston, Texas, product is also second on the team in receiving yards with 377 while the next closes player is Izaiah Lottie with 346 receiving yards. Hogan only trails Tyrian Taylor, who hoas 381 receiving yards on 21 catches for two touchdowns.

#### ENTER THE HALL

In the absence of All-American running back Larry Rose III, senior Xavier Hall fulfilled the mantra of next man up. The Las Cruces native is second on the team with 33.6 rushing yards per game with one rumble into end zone. He also picked up a career-high 39 reception yards at Troy.

### WEEKLY ACCOLADES

Linebacker Rodney Butler has earned two Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week honors this year while kicker Parker Davidson earned week two special teams player of the week. The two earned the weekly honor following the Aggies' 32-31 victory over Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico at home. Butler earned his second honor in week five after he recorded 18 tackles, a forced fumble and interception against UL-Lafayette.

## AGGIES BESTED BY VANDALS

The Aggies had a rough game in their final trip up to Moscow, Idaho, to play in the Kibbie Dome last weekend. NM State started off strong thanks Jared Phipps who picked of Ul's Matt Linehan in the end zone off of a deflection. Tyler Rogers and company quickly worked down the field in their first possession to get ahead 6-D.

Idaho responded right back with a touchdown of their own, but NM State quickly regained the lead when Rogers threw a dart to the tight end, Clayton Granch, for a 10-yard strike to regain the 13-7 lead. However, the lead was short-lived as Idaho scored 20 unanswered points and never looked back.

Backup Nick Jeanty came in late in the fourth quarter and threw a 45-yard bomb to Jaleel Scott with 1:12 left to play in the game as NM State left Moscow with a 55-23 loss.

### WILD FINISH IN LAS CRUCES

The Aggies' last home game against UL-Lafayette finished in dramatic fashion as both teams teetered back-and-forth on winning drives. To start, the Aggies had a chance to win the game in regulation on a missed 20-yard field goal by Parker Davidson. Then in the first overtime period, NM State scored first in their possession. On the Ragin' Cajun's drive, Darius Hoggins fumbled the ball and just so luckily landed on it in the end zone to send the game into a second overtime period.

With ULL starting the second-overtime period, the Ragin' Cajuns settled for a 22-yard field goal. However, the kick was no good as it ricocheted off the left post and set the Aggies up for another game-winning drive. In a turn of events, it was the Aggies turn to fumble the ball near the end zone as Sebastian Anderson leaped onto the ball in the end zone to give NM State the 37-31 victory.

The last double-overtime game for NM State came in 2005 against Idaho, a heartbreaking 38-37 loss. The two other times the Aggies played in a double-overtime game was in 2000 at Idaho and in 1998 at home against Utah State on homecoming, both of which resulted in losses.

## BEYOND THE TROJANS

Needless to say, Aggie fans wish the last two games against Troy could be erased from their memory. However, should last year's trend hold true, the Aggies are in store for a three-game winning-streak. NM State notched a win in the very next game against UL-Lafayette and looks to follow that trend this week at Idaho before returning home against Georgia State (Oct. 22) to match last year's rally.

## SHOOTOUT IN LEXINGTON

Aggie fans were in for a treat in week three of this season as NM State entered Commonwealth Stadium guns a blazing against the Kentucky Wildcats. The Aggies scored on their first drives of the game and took a 21-14 lead after one quarter of play before heading into the locker room tied 35-35. New Mexico State would leave the Bluegrass State with a 62-42 loss, but gave UK a run for its money 'til the bitter end.

## AGGIF RANGE ROWI

The NM State football team and local law enforcement agencies partnered together for the Aggie Badge Bowl on Friday Night in Aggie Memorial Stadium. Donations at the flag football game exceeded \$4,300 and will go to the Officer Jose Ismael Chavez Memorial Fund.

During the event, NM State recognized Officer Chavez and his family, family members of law enforcement officers, and former NM State quarterback Andrew Allen's father. Allen's father was killed in the line of duty last November.

In addition to student-athletes from the NM State football team, members of the Las Cruces Police Department, the New Mexico State University Police Department, the Dona Ana County Sheriff's Department, the Mesilla Marshal's Department, the Dona Ana County Fire Department and the Dona Ana County Detention Center participated in the flag football game.

## PRESEASON PICKS

The NM State football team was picked to finish ninth in the Sun Belt Conference in a poll voted on by the league's head dcoaches. The league's reigning offensive player of the year, Larry Rose III was picked to be the preseason offensive player of the year as well as First-Team All-Sun Belt. Senior center Anthony McMeans was selected to the second-team as well.

- Conner Cramer set career-highs in rushing yards (74) and passing yards (93)
- Cramer notched his first career touchdown on a 54-yard pass to Tyrian Taylor in the second quarter
- Larry Rose III gained 33 all-purpose yards which put his career total at 4,060 and he is now 39 yards away from passing Taeveon Rogers (4,098) for fourth all-time on the career list.
- NM State's 3-2 mark at home is the first time its head three-plus wins at home in a season since 2007.

## Back-to-Back 1,000 yards

Larry Rose III became the first back-to-back 1,000-yard rusher for the Aggies since Denvis Manns. Manns had four consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons from 1995-98. Rose III racked up 1,102 yards as a freshman and 1,651 yards as a sophomore.

## Associated Press All-American

After a standout sophomore season, Larry Rose III was selected to the AP All-America Third Team. He became the first Aggie to earn this honor since Karl Dean who was selected for the Third Team in both 1974 and 1975.

## Offensive Student-Athlete of the Year

After leading the Sun Belt Conference in both rushing yards and all-purpose yards with 1,651 and 1,934, respectively, Larry Rose III was selected as the Offensive Student-Athlete of the Year. This honor is voted on by the head coaches and one media member from each SBC school.

## Preseason Offensive Student-Athlete of the Year

As the reigning Offensive Student-Athlete of the year, junior Larry Rose III was selected to repeat the title for the 2016 season.

## In the Record Books

Larry Rose III broke the NM State all-time single season rushing record just 10 weeks into the season. A 191-yard rushing performance gave him 1481 yards for the season up to that point. In addition, Rose III's 1,651 total rushing yards ranks No. 6 all-time in the SBC record books.

# **DOUG MARTIN**

## FOURTH SEASON

Doug Martin begins his fourth season at the helm of the NM State football program in 2016.

Martin was officially announced as the Aggies' 34th head football coach on Feb. 1, 2013, after the departure of former head coach DeWayne Walker to the NFL. Martin was no stranger to the NM State program as he was the Aggie offensive coordinator under Walker in 2011.

The Aggies concluded the 2015 season with a 3-9 record, which is the best record for the program since 2011. In conference play, NM State defeated Idaho 55-48, Texas State 31-21 and UL-Lafayette 37-34 to collect three victories in a row. This was also the first time the team won three in a row since 2004.

As the offensive coordinator, Martin guided sophomore Larry Rose III as he broke the NM State single-season rushing record in just 10 games. Overall, Rose III had 1,651 rushing yards to finish the year ranked No. 6 all-time in the conference. For his accomplishments, Rose III earned Associated Press All-American Third Team honors and was named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive Player of the Year.

Overall, the Aggies won five conference Player of the Week awards. Rose III won back-to-back honors, while Andrew Allen and Parker Davidson both won after leading the team to victory against ULLafayette. Jaden Wright was named Defensive Player of the Week at the beginning of the season.

NM State went 2-10 for the second year in a row in 2014. During Martin's second year, the Aggies began the season 2-0 for the first time since 1999. After topping Cal Poly in a 28-10 victory, NM State defeated Georgia State, 34-31, in its first Sun Belt Conference game.

The Aggies also faced I-10 rival UTEP, Rio Grande rival New Mexico and No. 17 LSU in 2014. Under Martin's tutelage, Larry Rose III became the first freshman to rush for over 100 yards against LSU since 2011. Later in the season, Rose III rushed for 229 yards against UL-Monroe to become the first NM State player to rush for over 200 yards since 2003 when Eric Higgins ran for 218 yards. This feat ranked Rose III as No. 7 all-time for single game performances.

With Martin guiding him, Rose III amassed 1,102 yards over the season to become the first 1,000 yard rusher since Kenny Turner in 2011. This was also the first time a freshman rushed for over 1,000 yards since Denvis Manns in 1995.

As a team, the Aggies averaged 420.9 yards of total offense per game after amassing 2,252 rushing yards and 2,899 receiving yards through 12 games. Defensively, NM State had two players amass triple-digit tackling on the season as Rodney Butler racked up 119 tackles and Derek Ibekwe accumulated 102 tackles. In addition, 21 student-athletes garnered double-digit tackles on the season. In all, the defense had 1,028 tackles, fivesacks, 11 interceptions and 10 fumble recoveries.

NM State went 2-10 in 2013 during Martin's first season as head

coach after playing one of the toughest schedules in the school's history. The Aggies faced five teams that had participated in a bowl game the previous season while also playing two teams ranked in the top 15 in the nation.

NM State kicked off the 2013 season with a trip to Austin, Texas, to face the 15th-ranked Texas Longhorns and also made a trip to Los Angeles during the season to play No. 13 UCLA. The Aggies' home schedule included games versus Minnesota, which was the first school out of the Big Ten to play at Aggie Memorial Stadium, and Boston College, which was the first school out of the Atlantic Coast Conference to make a trip to Las Cruces.

The Aggies averaged 20.9 points per game and 382.2 yards per game in 2013, including 141.8 yards per game on the ground and 240.5 yards per game through the air. The team had a season-high 224 yards rushing against Abilene Christian on Oct. 26 and a season-high 380 yards passing and receiving versus Boston College on Nov. 9.

Martin's influence and system began to take shape during the final five games of the season as NM State went 2-3 in those games and had fourth-quarter chances for a win in two of the three losses.

Martin would start making an impact on the squad as soon as he accepted the head coaching position. Before the season began, the Aggies had four players placed on six different preseason watch lists, the most for any NM State football team in the school's history. NM State also had 12 players honored on the College Sports Madness Independent Preseason All-Conference team and 11 players on the Phil Steele College Football Preview All-Independent team.

During the season, senior safety Davis Cazares was nominated as a Bulsworth Trophy finalist, honoring the most outstanding collegiate football player who began his career as a walk-on. Linebacker Clint Barnard would be named to the Capital One Academic All-District VII first team. The Aggies would also pick up three FBS Independent Player of the Week nods in 2013 under Martin, Cazares and Barnard on the defensive side and punter Cayle Chapman-Brown on special teams

At the conclusion of the 2013 season, NM State would place five players on the All-Independent Football team including Cazares, Trashaun Nixon, Austin Franklin, Andy Cunningham and Davonte Wallace.

In 2012, Martin left his offensive coordinator position at NM State to take the same position for Boston College out of the ACC. The Eagles ranked 47th in the nation in passing offense, as Martin guided wide receiver Alex Amidon and offensive tackle Emmett Cleary to All-ACC honors. Amidon finished the season ranked 11th among all receivers in the country in receiving yards per game (100.8). He ranked second among all ACC receivers in both receptions per game (6.5) and receiving yards per game.

As the offensive coordinator for the Aggies in 2011, Martin helped NM State rank 47th in the country in total offense and 26th in passing offense. He helped guide the Aggies to a win over Minnesota, the

program's first win against a team from the Big Ten. Under Martin, the Aggies had three All-WAC selections in wide receiver Taveon Rogers, offensive tackle Davonte Wallace and running back Kenny Turner. Quarterback Matt Christian led the Aggies with 2,158 yards passing and 15 touchdowns in 2011.

With seven seasons under his belt as the head coach at Kent State University and eight as the offensive coordinator, Martin was instrumental in building a true football program at the university. A total of 20 Golden Flashes earned All-Mid-American Conference accolades from 2007-10, including Eugene Jarvis, who was atop the active Football Bowl Subdivision running backs list with 3,722 career yards on the ground, and Brian Lainhart, whose 17 career interceptions was also tops among active FBS players.

In 2010, Roosevelt Nix was named the MAC Defensive Player of the Year under Martin's watch. Also under Martin, four players were selected in the NFL draft including Jameson Konz (2010 - 7th round, Seattle Seahawks), Usama Young (2007 - 3rd round, New Orleans Saints), Jack Williams (2008 - 4th round, Denver Broncos) and Julian Edelman (2009 - 7th round, New England Patriots), with Young becoming the sixth-highest pick in the history of the program.

Over the past four years, Martin's offense at Kent State recorded a remarkable 16,907 yards of total offense, averaging 422.6 yards per game during that spanned including 26.3 points a game.

In December of 2006, Martin signed a four-year extension that kept him in Blue and Gold through 2010. The extension rewarded a 2006 campaign that saw Kent State pull off the fourth-largest turnaround in the nation, improving by five wins over the previous year's total.

Included in the performance was a five-game winning streak, including four straight MAC victories - the Flashes' longest conference streak ever. Furthermore, the nation's 25th-ranked team in total defense in 2006, limited Miami and Bowling Green to a combined 17 points as Kent State won road games against the RedHawks and Falcons in the same season for the first time since 1972. Kent State saw five players earn All-MAC accolades.

In addition to his head coaching duties, Martin also served as quarterbacks' coach and was the offensive coordinator for all but the 2009 season.

Martin is widely regarded as one of the nation's premier quarterback mentors. His list of protégés includes three-time All-Conference USA selection and current NFL passer David Garrard, record-setting CFL quarterback Marcus Crandell and other pros Richard Alston and Joshua Cribbs, who both played quarterback in college under Martin before switching positions in the NFL.

In 2005. Martin's spread passing attack posted the third-highest yardage total in school history while the team's 15 touchdown passes were the sixth most in a single year at Kent State. The Flashes also reached the 30-point mark three times in 2005, running the total number of games with at least that many points to 16 since 2003.

In Martin's first season, the Golden Flashes posted a 5-6 overall record, winning their final four games for the program's longest winning streak since 1976. The team also finished in fourth place in the MAC East Division with a 4-4 mark while producing three All-MAC players and two honorable mention All-Americans.

Martin also handled the offensive play-calling duties and the unit responded to his coaching, scoring 335 points and racking up 4.168 yards, the second- and third-highest totals, respectively, in school history.

Under his guidance, the Flashes averaged 30.5 points per game, just the third time in school history a team averaged 30 or more points. The team also set a single-game scoring mark in its 69-17 win over Eastern Michigan Nov. 13. Four times in 2004 the Flashes totaled more than 400 yards on offense, including two games over 500.

Additionally, in two years tutoring All-MAC quarterback Joshua Cribbs, Martin saw Cribbs develop into one of the top dual threats in the country. Always a talented runner, Cribbs finished his career as the owner of KSU career records for total offense, passing yardage, touchdowns, points and completions. He also ranked fourth nationally in total offense and completed a school-record 64.5 percent of his passes. As a team, the Flashes had a completion rate of 62.8 percent, also a school record.

While his spread offensive style is his calling card, Martin revamped his defensive coaching staff and saw that unit go from ranking 12th of 14 teams in the MAC in total defense in 2003 to first in the league in 2004. It marked the first time since 1987 that the team led the MAC in total defense and just the second time since joining the conference in 1951. Kent State also ranked 15th nationally in total defense.

Martin was named the school's 19th head coach on March 1, 2004, replacing Dean Pees. Martin joined the Kent State staff in January 2003 as offensive coordinator. After just one year on the staff, Martin made an instant impact on the Golden Flashes' offense. In its first season under Martin's system, Kent State averaged 26.8 points per game, the second-highest in the last 30 years, and scored 30-or-more points in each of the final six games and did so in a school-record eight games overall.

From 2002-04 Martin's teams averaged nearly 30 points per game and posted the highest offensive totals in back-to-back years in school history. From 2002-03 alone, scoring offense increased by 10 points, touchdowns grew from 24 to 40, total offense was up by more than 40 yards per game and passing yardage increased by nearly 100 yards per game.

In 2004, that trend continued as the Flashes' increased their scoring, touchdowns, passing yards and total yards per game.

Martin arrived at Kent State following II seasons at East Carolina University, the last seven of which he was in charge of the team's offense. He was at ECU for all of Steve Logan's tenure there, serving as the tight ends coach and special teams coordinator for two seasons (1992-93), then another two years as wide receivers coach (1994-95) before being promoted to offensive coordinator in 1996.

At East Carolina, Martin played a significant role in the development of quarterback David Garrard, who broke 28 school passing records and total offensive records from 1998-DI. In addition, Martin coached the top three receivers in ECU history. During Martin's time at ECU, the team advanced to five bowl games; the Liberty Bowl in 1994 and 1995, the GMAC (formerly Mobile Alabama) Bowl in 1999 and 2001 and the galleryfurniture.com Bowl in 2000.

Prior to joining the staff at East Carolina, Martin was a graduate assistant at the University of Kentucky, his alma mater, from 1986-87 and then spent the 1988-91 seasons at East Tennessee State University, where he coached the running backs his first year, then served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks/wide receivers coach his final three seasons.

Martin was a four-year letterwinner at Kentucky from 1981-84, spending time as a part-time starter at quarterback before injuries limited him to the holder role. A native of Oak Ridge, Tenn., Martin earned a bachelor's degree in history from Kentucky in 1985.

Martin and his wife Vicki have a daughter, Molly, and two sons, Cory and Bobby.
