5 THINGS

1. UTEP has reeled off seven consecutive victories over NM State to tie its longest winning streak in the series.
2. Junior RB **Aaron Jones** has rushed for 2,341 yards in his career, ranking no. 8 on the all-time UTEP list and needs 77 yards to move past **Donald Buckram's** 2,417 yards.
3. Junior LB **Alvin Jones** had a breakout 2015 campaign. The El Paso native led the Miners in just about every defensive category – tackles (93), solo stops (48), tackles for loss (14.5), sacks (6.5) and recorded a pair of safeties.
4. UTEP led Conference USA in fewest sacks allowed (12) and ranked no. 6 nationally in sacks allowed per game (1.0) in 2015.
5. UTEP offense has ranked no. 1 in Conference USA in time of possession the past two seasons. Nationally, the Miners ranked no. 6 in time of possession (33:38) in 2015.

MINERS AND AGGIES TO COMMENCE 2016 IN THE SUN BOWL

UTEP and NM State will open the 2016 season, as the FirstLight Federal Credit Union Battle of I-10 will be played in El Paso in the 94th meeting on Saturday. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. MT in the Sun Bowl. The Miners are looking to extend their winning streak to eight against the Aggies, and fourth straight in the Sun Bowl. In the last contest in the Sun City, UTEP defeated NM State 42-24 on Sept. 13, 2014. During the current seven-game winning streak, UTEP has averaged 38.7 points per game to NM State's 21.7 per contest. It's only the eighth time the two programs will open a season against each other in series history.

SEASON OPENER IN THE SUN CITY

UTEP will open at home for the first time since the 2013 season when it hosted New Mexico. The Miners opened at home for five consecutive seasons (2009-2013) before playing at New Mexico to commence the 2014 campaign. Last year, UTEP opened at Arkansas, followed by a trip to Lubbock (Texas Tech) and a third consecutive road game in Las Cruces.

OPENING AGAINST NM STATE

UTEP and NM State will launch a new campaign in El Paso for the first time since 1987 and fourth time ever (1981, 1983, 1987, 2016). The Miners and Aggies are opening against each other for the eighth time in the series history and the first since opening the 2005 season in Las Cruces. UTEP holds a slim 4-3 lead against NM State in season openers, while the Orange and Blue is 2-1 in the Sun City. The Miners and Aggies opened against each other three consecutive seasons (1981, 1982, 1983) at one point.

KUGLER'S SUCCESS AGAINST NM STATE

Head Coach **Sean Kugler** is 3-0 against NM State in his first three seasons at the helm of the UTEP program. Kugler is looking to become the third coach in UTEP history to start 4-0 against the Aggies. **Mack Saxon** won his first five games against NM State (1929-33), while **Bobby Dobbs** won his first four against the I-10 rival (1965-68). **Mike Brumbelow** fashioned a 6-0-1 record versus NMSU (1950-56), winning his first two and tying the third contest. **Bob Stull** forged a 3-0 mark in his three seasons at the helm (1986-88), while **David Lee** (1989-91) and **Mike Price** (2004-06) won their first three games against NM State before losing on the fourth attempt.

LONGEST ACTIVE WINNING STREAKS IN A RIVALRY SERIES

UTEP has won seven consecutive games against rival NM State, matching Kansas State's seven straight victories over rival Kansas. Navy currently holds the longest active winning streak in rivalry games, defeating Army in 14

consecutive contests. Programs that have won 12 consecutive in a rivalry series include Boise State over Idaho, Wisconsin over Minnesota and Oregon over Washington. Florida has been on the winning side against Tennessee in 11 straight games, while Cincinnati has owned 10 in a row versus Miami (Ohio). Alabama is currently on a nine-game winning streak against Tennessee, while LA Tech (vs. Louisiana-Lafayette) and Oregon (vs. Oregon State) are on eight-game winning streaks.

SERIES HISTORY

UTEP leads the series 56-35-2. This is the longest-running series in school history (94th meeting). UTEP has reeled off seven consecutive victories over NM State to tie its longest winning streak in the series. The Miners also beat the Aggies seven straight times from 1927-33. The Miners hold a 37-16-1 advantage in games played in El Paso. UTEP has won nine of the last 10 games between the rivals in the Sun Bowl including the last three matchups, all by at least 13 points. NM State last defeated UTEP 34-33 on Sept. 20, 2008 in El Paso.

THE LAST MEETING

Ryan Metz threw for three touchdowns and rushed for another in his first extensive action at quarterback for UTEP, rallying the Miners from 14 points down late to a 50-47 overtime win at NM State on Sept. 19, 2015. Metz connected with **Cedrick Lang** for the game-winning six-yard touchdown pass after Parker Davidson put the Aggies ahead for the last time, 47-44, on a 44-yard field goal in the extra session. The 97 points were the second-most scored by the two teams in the history of the rivalry. A total of 99 points were scored in the 1948 matchup, won 92-7 by the Miners. Metz, who replaced injured starter **Mack Leftwich** midway through the third quarter, completed 15-of-19 passes for 218 yards. He twice rallied UTEP from two-touchdown deficits. The Miners were down 44-30 with a little over four minutes remaining in regulation. But Metz orchestrated a three-play, 75-yard drive, capped by a 48-yard TD pass to fellow El Pasoan **Cole Freytag**, then led UTEP on an eight-play, 98-yard march, taking it into the end zone himself with an eight-yard scamper. UTEP had a balanced attack with 273 yards passing and 269 rushing. The Miners' top two rushers, **Darrin Laufasa** and **LaQuintus Dowell**, both established career-bests with 85 and 76 yards respectively. The Miners scored 20 of the game's final 23 points, including a 64-yard punt return for a touchdown by **Jaquan White**, to surge to their fourth consecutive triumph in Las Cruces. **Alvin Jones** was the standout for the Miners on defense with a career-high 11 tackles and five tackles for losses, most by a UTEP player since 2000. It was the first overtime game in the history of the rivalry and the first for UTEP since the 2011 season opener.

CONNECTIONS

UTEP has two players from the state of New Mexico on its roster – sophomore QB **Kavika Johnson** (Las Cruces) and junior TE **Sterling Napier** (Rio Rancho). Johnson attended Mayfield High School, where he led the Trojans to consecutive state championship games. NM State has one El Paso native on its roster in freshman RB Robert Wiggins (Andress High School), although junior RB Dallas Hart attended Hanks High School in the Sun City after growing up in Honolulu, Hawaii.

Players from both schools who attended the same high school are: UTEP TE **Sterling Napier** & NM State OL Abram Holland (Cleveland HS [Rio Rancho, N.M.]); UTEP QB **Kavika Johnson** & NM State LB Chris Acosta and DL Brett Kowalski (Mayfield HS [Las Cruces, N.M.]).

UTEP Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Line Coach **Spencer Leftwich** was part of the Aggies' staff from 1992-93, directing the offensive line.

ABOUT NM STATE

The Aggies finished the 2015 season with a 3-9 overall record and a 3-5 conference mark. After an 0-7 start, NM State rattled off three consecutive wins, defeating Idaho 55-48 (Oct. 31), Texas State 31-21 (Nov. 7) and

UL-Lafayette 37-34 (Nov. 21). NM State averaged 28.6 points per game and gave up 45.0 points per contest. The offense averaged 433.3 yards per game, while the defense surrendered 522.3 yards per contest. Aggies RB Larry Rose III finished his sophomore campaign as the eighth-leading rusher in the nation with 1,651 yards on 240 carries (6.9 avg.) and 14 touchdowns. Rose added 30 receptions for 283 yards and a pair of scores. Senior QB Tyler Rogers returns as the team's leading passer. Last season Rogers played in the first four contests before being sidelined with an injury. Rogers completed 71-of-134 attempts for 966 yards with seven touchdowns and three interceptions. Rogers led the quarterbacks in passing yards per game (241.50). Senior WR Tyrian Taylor returns after leading the team in receiving yards (691) on 39 receptions with four scores. Junior LB Derek Ibekwe is also back after leading the defense in tackles (92), while senior DL Noah Brown led the team in sacks (3.5).

SEVEN

UTEP is scheduled to play seven home games in 2016 for the first time since the 2003 campaign. The Miners have played seven home contests nine other times (1928, 1948, 1953, 1965, 1968, 1971, 1973, 1983 & 2003). The Miners were scheduled to play six home games during the 1948 and 1953 seasons but played a seventh home contest due to the Sun Bowl game. The Miners posted a 6-1 record at home in 1953 and 1965 – tied for the most wins during one season in the Sun City. The 1988 Miners finished 6-0 at home.

SUCCESS IN THE SUN BOWL

Beginning with a 33-10 victory over FIU in the Sun Bowl on Nov. 16, 2013 -- the final home game of head coach **Sean Kugler's** first season -- the Miners are 9-3 in the last 12 games on their home field. It's the best stretch since posting a 9-4 mark from 2008 through the 2010 season. The Miners went 3-2 in El Paso last season and 5-1 in 2014. The Miners have outscored their opponents 336-248 at home during that span.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

The Miners' 105-man roster includes 20 seniors, 25 juniors, 19 sophomores and 41 freshmen (28 true/13 red-shirt). UTEP has 47 lettermen returning (24 offense/21 defense/two special teams) and 17 returning starters (eight offense/six defense/three special teams). Twenty-three active players on the 2016 roster have started games for the Miners, led by senior FB **Darrin Laufasa** (32 starts), senior DL **Gino Bresolin** (25 starts), senior OL **Jerome Daniels** (25 starts), junior OL **Will Hernandez** (25 starts), junior DB **Devin Cockrell** (24 starts), senior LB **Nick Usher** (24 starts) and junior OL **Derek Elmendorff** (19 starts).

DEPTH CHART

The two-deep for the NM State game features nine projected senior starters (five offense/four defense), seven junior starters (three offense/four defense) and seven sophomore starters (four offense/three defense). Of the 26 players listed in the offensive two-deep, 17 are upperclassmen (nine seniors/eight juniors). Of the 23 players listed in the defensive two-deep, 14 are upperclassmen (six seniors/eight juniors). Nine freshmen have made the depth chart (three offense/six defense), featuring true freshmen **Greg Long** (LT), **Kolbi McGary** (SS), **Justin Rogers** (CB), **Eddie Sinegal** (WR) and **Quadraiz Wadley** (RB).

HOMETOWN TALENT

Since **Sean Kugler** was hired as UTEP's head coach, he vowed to suit up El Paso's best players. He kept his word as seven El Paso high school standouts signed letters of intent in 2016. Overall the 2016 roster will be composed of 26 Sun City players, while 11 are listed on the depth chart.

LOCAL PLAYERS ON DEPTH CHART

Twelve area players have graced the two-deep entering the 2016 season. They are OL **Derek Elmendorff** (Franklin HS), WR **Cole Freytag** (Coronado HS), FB **David Jackson** (Parkland HS), RB **Aaron Jones** (Burgess HS), LB **Alvin Jones** (Burgess HS), QB **Kavika Johnson** (Mayfield HS [Las Cruces, N.M.]), OL **Greg Long** (Eastwood HS), K/P **Alan Luna** (Franklin HS), QB **Ryan Metz** (Andress HS), DB **Brandon Moss** (Chapin HS), WR **Warren Redix** (Montwood HS) and WR **Eddie Sinegal** (Andress HS).

OTHER PROGRAMS & THEIR LOCAL TALENT

UTEP has 11 El Paso players on its two-deep depth chart. Akron has 13 players from Akron, Ohio. West Virginia has nine players from Morgantown, W. Va., while Pitt has eight players from Pittsburgh, Pa. Arizona State has eight players from the Phoenix Metro Area.

FEW YELLOW FLAGS

Since **Sean Kugler** arrived at UTEP, the Miners have reduced their penalties. In 2015, UTEP ranked no. 2 in Conference USA and 10th in the nation in fewest penalties (57), while its 4.75 penalties per game ranked second in the conference and 13th in the nation. UTEP ranked no. 2 in the league in penalty yards (503) and penalty yards per game (41.92). In Kugler's three seasons (37 games) at the helm, the Miners have averaged 4.6 penalties per game and 38.5 penalty yards per contest. In the three seasons (37 games) prior to Kugler's arrival, UTEP averaged 5.1 penalties per game and 44.9 penalty yards per game.

TIME IS PRECIOUS

Since the arrival of head coach **Sean Kugler**, the UTEP offense has ranked no. 1 in Conference USA in time of possession the past two seasons, while ranking no. 2 in 2013. Nationally, the Miners ranked no. 6 in time of possession in 2015 (33:38) and no. 2 in 2014 (34:57). Winning time of possession has been a consistent element of the Kugler era, as the Miners have done so in 30 of 37 games.

PROTECTING THE FIELD GENERAL

Head Coach **Sean Kugler** played on the offensive line at UTEP from 1985-1988. Since Kugler was hired as head coach in 2013, sacks allowed have been reduced dramatically. In 2015 UTEP led Conference USA in fewest sacks allowed (12) and ranked no. 6 nationally in sacks allowed per game (1.0). In Kugler's three seasons, UTEP

quarterbacks have been sacked 52 times in 37 games (1.4 per game). In the three previous seasons (37 games), Miner signal callers went down 84 times (2.3 per game).

BREAKING DOWN THE O-LINE

The offensive line is the deepest it has been in the **Sean Kugler** era. The offensive linemen on the depth chart played a combined 79 contests in 2015. The line will consist of first teamers LT **Jerome Daniels** (11 starts), LG **Will Hernandez** (12 starts), C **Derron Gatewood** (played in five games), RG **John De La Rosa** (six starts) and RT **Jerrod Brooks** (played in four games). The second unit also brings experience as LG **Derek Elmendorff** (eight starts), C **Tanner Stallings** (played in nine games at Hutchinson CC), RG **Anthony Kyles** (four starts) and RT **Chris Thomas** (seven starts) round out the depth chart. True freshman LT **Greg Long** made the two-deep after an impressive showing at camp.

TOUGH TO GET AROUND

The average weight of the offensive line has increased every year since head coach **Sean Kugler's** arrival. In 2016, the average weight of the line is 320 pounds. During Kugler's first season in 2013, the line averaged 298 pounds. The 2014 unit averaged 309, while last season's platoon averaged 313 pounds.

A WILL TO PROTECT

Will Hernandez has made a name for himself since his arrival at UTEP in 2014 and has been the most consistent O-lineman the last two seasons. Hernandez is listed as the no. 1 left guard on the depth chart and has started all 25 games in his career. The 6-foot-3, 330-pound junior has been part of an offensive unit that has yielded just 25 sacks in 25 contests the last two campaigns.

LAUFASA'S MAJOR IMPACT

Darrin Laufasa came to UTEP in 2013 and helped fellow freshman **Aaron Jones** gain over 800 yards. Laufasa also paved the way for Jones to gain over 1,300 yards in 2014. Besides the offensive line performing its duties, Laufasa has been a major player in protecting the quarterback and creating holes for the running attack. During his career, Laufasa has rushed for four touchdowns and has caught a pair of scores. In fact, of Laufasa's six scores, five have come against UTEP's 2016 season opening opponent, rival NM State. He rushed for a career-high 85 yards on eight carries, including a career-long touchdown run of 66 yards versus the Aggies in 2015.

DARRIN DOMINATES AGGIES

Senior FB **Darrin Laufasa** likes playing I-10 rival NM State. In three career games against the Aggies, Laufasa has rushed for 163 yards on 19 attempts (8.6 avg.) and four scores with three receptions for 17 yards and a touchdown. Last season Laufasa gained a career-high 85 yards on eight carries, including a career-long 66-yard scamper to pay dirt. In 2014 Laufasa scored two touchdowns – a two-yard reception and a one-yard rushing plunge into the end zone. In Laufasa's freshman season, he scored a career-high two rushing touchdowns along with 74 yards on nine carries (8.2 avg.), and a season-long 45-yard run to pay dirt.

AARON VS. NM STATE

Junior RB **Aaron Jones** missed last season's contest at NM State, but has put up big numbers against the Aggies during his two meetings. Jones is averaging 132.5 yards per contest (265 yards) on 47 carries with a trio of touchdowns. In 2013, Jones ran for 97 yards on 22 attempts with a score, while in 2014 Jones let loose for 168 yards on 25 carries with a pair of touchdowns.

WELCOME BACK, AARON

Though **Aaron Jones's** 2015 season came to an early close due to a season-ending injury, the El Paso native had a memorable couple of games. Jones, who still has two years of eligibility, set a program record while moving up on the all-time UTEP rushing list. The junior rushed for 209 yards (104.5 ypg) on 32 attempts (6.5 avg.) and a touchdown, while adding another 106 yards on nine receptions (11.8 avg.) and another score. Jones set a program record with a 91-yard scamper for a touchdown at Texas Tech on Sept. 6. Before leaving the Texas Tech contest with the injury, Jones ran for 139 yards in the first half, the seventh-best performance of his career. The week before at Arkansas, Jones registered a career-high 83 yards receiving on six catches (tied for his career best).

AARON ON THE WATCH

Aaron Jones was named to the 80th annual Maxwell Award Watch List on July 5, the Doak Walker Award Watch List on July 14 and the Fourth Annual Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Watch List on Aug. 16. Other preseason honors include Athlon Sports Preseason All-C-USA second team and the 2016 Dave Campbell's Preseason All-Texas second team.

RANKINGS BEFORE THE INJURY

Before sustaining his season-ending injury, **Aaron Jones** had ranked no. 5 in Conference USA and no. 38 nationally in rushing yards per game (104.5), while his all-purpose yards per game (157.5) ranked no. 4 in C-USA and no. 22 in the nation.

MORE ON 91

Aaron Jones's school-record 91-yard touchdown run at Texas Tech last season is tied for fifth-longest in Conference USA history. It was the longest rush of the season within C-USA and tied for ninth with three other players nationally.

AARON'S CAREER NOTES

Aaron Jones has rushed for 2,341 yards in his career, ranking no. 8 on the all-time UTEP list and needs 77 yards to move past **Donald Buckram's** 2,417 yards. **John Harvey** (3,576 yards) is the all-time leading rusher in school history. Jones has also compiled 2,754 all-purpose yards in his career. Jones needs 477 yards to crack the top 10 in program history. Jones has 10 games with 100 yards rushing in his career, tying him for fifth in program history with **Paul Smith** (1996-99). In his career, Jones has 20 total touchdowns (16 rush, 4 rec.).

GREENLEE TO START UNDER CENTER IN 2016

Transfer quarterback **Zack Greenlee** was officially announced to the roster on June 6, 2016 and was named the starting quarterback on Aug. 22. The 6-foot-1, 215-pound Stockton, Calif. native will have two years of eligibility with the Orange and Blue. The junior transfer comes to the Sun City from Fresno State, where he started five games under center in 2015. Greenlee led the Bulldogs in touchdown passes (13), passing yards (866) and quarterback rating (113.9). He completed 74-of-156 pass attempts with six

JUNIOR AARON JONES makes his way back to the gridiron in 2016 after missing the last 10 games of 2015. Jones has averaged 101.8 yards per game during his career at UTEP, while averaging 5.5 yards per carry (429).

interceptions. Greenlee tallied a career high in passing yards (285) and touchdown throws (six) on 20-of-35 attempts at Hawai'i, tying for the second-most touchdown passes in school and Mountain West single-game history. Greenlee also threw for three scores against Abilene Christian and three more against No. 21 Utah, including a career-long 82-yard scoring pass against the Utes.

SOPHOMORES UNDER CENTER

Kavika Johnson and **Ryan Metz** are experienced returning UTEP quarterbacks. In 2015 Metz ranked second on the team in passing yards (900) and touchdown throws (six), while completing 58.6 percent of his passes (82-of-140) in eight games played. Johnson threw for three touchdowns with zero interceptions in nine contests. The duo combined for 339 rushing yards and a pair of touchdowns. Johnson's 209 rushing yards ranked tied for third on the team. Metz rallied the Miners past NM State on Sept. 19, tallying three touchdown passes and rushing for another. Johnson ran for a career-high 75 yards and a score and added a touchdown pass during UTEP's victory at North Texas in the season finale.

RECEIVING EXPERIENCE

Although UTEP was inexperienced at the wide receiver position entering last season, four pass catchers in **Tyler Batson** (junior), **Cole Freytag** (senior), **Warren Redix** (sophomore) and **Jaquan White** (senior) will bring extensive game action into the 2016 campaign. The four WRs combined for 105 receptions, 1,348 yards and 14 touchdowns in 2015. White led the team in catches (41), receiving yards (494) and touchdowns (seven). Batson registered the longest catch of 2015, a 76-yard touchdown reception against Florida Atlantic. Freytag chipped in with a few big plays, hauling in a 48-yard touchdown at NM State and recording a career-long 58-yard catch at FIU. Redix completed his first full season, as he made big contributions in the second half of the campaign. Redix registered a career-high 75 yards receiving at Old Dominion and scored his first career touchdown on a 32-yard reception at North Texas. Prior to the 2015 season Batson, Freytag and White combined for six receptions, 117 yards and a touchdown.

PLINKE'S BREAKOUT SEASON

Transfer **Hayden Plinke** turned in one of the better performances by a UTEP tight end in quite some time last season. In his first campaign with the Miners, Plinke tallied 37 receptions for 405 yards, ranking second in both categories for the Miners. Plinke's yards and receptions were the most by a UTEP tight end during the **Sean Kugler** era. Plinke's yards were the most by a UTEP tight end since All-American **Brian Natkin's** 787 yards on 64 receptions in 2000. Plinke earned recognition early on, garnering John Mackey Award Midseason Watch List honors. Plinke registered a career-high nine receptions for 85 yards against Rice. The senior also gained a career-high 87 yards on four receptions at Texas Tech. He added four catches for 80 yards, including a career-long 57-yard grab in a victory over Incarnate Word.

PLINKE ON MACKAY AWARD LIST

Hayden Plinke was appointed to the John Mackey Award Preseason Watch List on July 6. The John Mackey Award is presented to the most outstanding collegiate tight end. Plinke was added to the Midseason John Mackey Watch List in 2015, while **Eric Tomlinson** was named to the 2014 Preseason Watch List.

YIELDING THE CHAIN GANG

The UTEP defense ranked no. 1 in Conference USA and no. 19 nationally, yielding 226 first downs in 2015. The Miners' defense gave up 84 rushing first downs, ranking no. 1 in C-USA and tying for 11th nationally. UTEP's 18.8 opponent first downs per game ranked no. 1 in C-USA and tied for no. 35 nationally.

3RD DOWN DEFENSE

The UTEP defense surrendered only 55 third down conversions in 2015, ranking no. 1 in C-USA and tied for fifth nationally. The Miners' .357 conversion percentage ranked no. 3 in C-USA and 40th nationally.

ALVIN'S DOMINATING CAMPAIGN

Junior LB **Alvin Jones** had a breakout 2015 campaign. The El Paso native led the Miners in just about every defensive category – tackles (93), solo stops (48), tackles for loss (14.5), sacks (6.5) and recorded a pair of safeties. Jones's 14.5 tackles for loss marked the ninth-best single-season performance in program history; Jones ranked tied for second with two other players in Conference USA. Jones averaged 7.8 tackles per contest, rating no. 12 in C-USA.

MORE ON ALVIN'S PERFORMANCES

Alvin Jones amassed 5.0 tackles for loss at NM State last season, the most by a Miner player in a single game since 2000 (**Menson Holloway**), while it was the second-best performance in C-USA. Against UTSA, Jones racked up a career-high 3.0 sacks and tied his career best with 11 tackles in four separate contests (at NM State, vs. Rice, at ODU, vs. LA Tech). Jones tallied 11 tackles each in three consecutive contests Nov. 6-21 (Rice, ODU, LA Tech).

SACKS & TFL BY ALVIN

Alvin Jones needs 4.0 sacks and 7.0 tackles for loss to crack the all-time school lists in each category. In his career, Jones has 23.5 tackles for loss and 8.0 sacks in two seasons. **Gonzalo Floyd** leads the all-time sack list with 20.0, while **Chris Mineo** (16.5) and **Herman Whiting** (16.0) rank second and third, respectively. **Barron Wortham** is no. 1 on the all-time tackle for loss list with 45.0, followed by Floyd (41.0) and **Thomas Howard** (34.0).

THE SAFETY DANCE

As the Miners' defense tallied a trio of safeties in 2015 (the most since at least 1986), **Alvin Jones** registered two. The first came at NM State when he sacked quarterback Tyler Rogers in the end zone (UTEP's first safety since 2013), while his second came against LA Tech after Jones tackled running back Kenneth Dixon in the end zone. UTEP also tallied a team safety at FIU.

POSITION SHUFFLE

With the defense under new leadership, coordinator **Tom Mason** has changed the formation to a 3-4 set from the 4-2-5. With the new defensive formation, three Miners have switched from the defensive line to the linebacker position (**Silas Firstley**, **Lawrence Montegut** and **Nick Usher**). Of the 16 linebackers listed on the roster, two from 2015 (**Cooper Foster** & **Alvin Jones**) have true experience at the position. Both played in every game, as Jones led the team in tackles and Foster tallied five stops in 2015.

USHER IN A NEW SEASON

Senior **Nick Usher** had a standout junior season as he was named 2015 All-Conference USA Honorable Mention. The Los Angeles, Calif. native will move to the Will linebacker position this season after playing defensive end in 2015. Usher established single-season highs in tackles (46), sacks (3.5) tackles for loss (10.0) and quarterback hurries (five) a year ago. Usher ranked fourth on the team in tackles, and second in quarterback hurries and sacks. Usher tied his career-best with nine tackles at FIU, while registering a career-high 2.0 sacks during a victory over Incarnate Word.

IN THE NICK OF TIME

Nick Usher made a key play during UTEP's 24-21 victory over Rice in the Sun Bowl. With the contest tied 21-21, Usher recorded his first career blocked field goal on a 38-yard attempt that would've put Rice into the lead. The Miners took possession with 8:13 remaining in the fourth quarter. They proceeded to milk 7:25 off the clock with a 16-play, 73-yard scoring drive that ended on a 24-yard field goal with 48 seconds left.

DEFENSIVE BACKS' IMPROVEMENT

The UTEP defensive backfield struggled early last season after ranking no. 1 in Conference USA in passing yards allowed per game (191.2) in 2014. After allowing 316.5 yards passing per game in the first six contests, the Miners cut it down to 213.5 average over the last six outings. Overall in 2015, the Miners ranked 12th in the league in passing yards allowed per game (265.0).

VETERAN SECONDARY

New defensive coordinator **Tom Mason** will have four returning defensive backs. The group consists of sophomores **Kalon Beverly** (nine starts as a true freshman), **Nik Needham** (11 starts), junior **Devin Cockrell** (started all 13 contests in 2014) who returns from an injury, and senior **Dashone Smith** (played in all 12 games with three starts). Smith led the DBs with 41 tackles and returned an interception 65 yards for a score at the 5:32 mark in the third quarter at North Texas. Beverly tallied 40 tackles and a 27-yard pick six in the first quarter against Incarnate Word. Needham registered 38 tackles, including a key interception at the one-yard line which he returned 27 yards against Florida Atlantic. The Owls had driven the ball to the UTEP eight-yard line from their own 25 before Needham provided the clutch play late in the third quarter.

COCKRELL'S RETURN

Junior **Devin Cockrell** sat out the 2015 season due to an injury and missed some time during the 2016 spring season. Fortunately, Cockrell is back and will add much-needed depth and experience to the defensive backfield. Prior to his injury, Cockrell started 11 games his true freshman season and all 13 games in 2014. He has recorded 128 tackles in his career, with 8.0 tackles for loss, a pair of sacks and two interceptions.

YOUNG COACHING

Head Coach **Sean Kugler** sealed his coaching staff in February with the addition of **Derrius Bell** as the cornerbacks coach. Bell is the fourth-youngest coach in college football at the age of 27. Assistant Coach Sean Duggan from Hawaii is the youngest coach at 22, followed by Patrick Toney from UTSA and Brett Ekkens from Akron, both 26. Bell played under defensive coordinator **Tom Mason** before serving on his coaching staff for three seasons.

LUNA'S SPECIAL EFFORT

Junior **Alan Luna** did a solid job booting punts in his first season with the Miners. The native of El Paso finished the season tied for second in Conference USA and 16th nationally in punting average (44.4). His average also ranked sixth-best during a single season in program history. Luna kicked 65 punts for 2,885 yards, including 15 inside the 20-yard line, and 21 punts of 50 or more yards (most in C-USA). The sophomore recorded a season-high in punts (eight), yards (375) and average (46.9) at FIU on Oct. 10. Luna's season long was 61 yards at Old Dominion, while he booted a 60-yard punt in four separate games (at Arkansas, at Texas Tech, vs. Incarnate Word, at Old Dominion). In his first season Luna garnered Ray Guy watch list and All-C-USA honorable mention honors.

MATTOX'S CAREER RANKINGS

Senior **Jay Mattox** has left his mark at UTEP, having already connected on 98-of-100 extra points and 35-of-50 field goals during his career. Mattox currently ranks third in program history with 203 kicking points, while **Ricky Bishop** is second with 222. **Reagan Schneider** is the career leader for kickers with 287 points. Mattox's 98 PATs rank second in program history behind Schneider's 137 PATs. Mattox's field goal kicking has drastically improved from his freshman season as he connected on 7-of-15 FGs (47 percent) in 2013. Over the last two seasons, Mattox has connected on 80 percent (28-of-35) of his three-point attempts. Mattox's 35 field goals rank tied for fifth in program history with **Marshall Young** and **Scott Wedell**. Schneider leads the all-time list with 50.

NEW KICKOFF RETURNERS

Over the last four seasons, Miner fans witnessed **Autrey Golden** become one of the most prolific kickoff returners in NCAA history. UTEP is tied with Utah for the third-most kickoff returns for touchdowns in the nation (six) during the last four years. Golden finished his career as UTEP's all-time leading kickoff returner in yards (2,981), attempts (119) and touchdowns (six). Current Miners **Terry Juniel** and **Walter Dawn** are listed as the two kickoff returners for 2016. Juniel returned kickoffs at Glendale Community College, averaging 22.5 yards per return.

PUNT RETURN SPECIALIST

Terry Juniel transferred to UTEP as a slot receiver, but is also being looked at to return punts. Juniel is listed as no. 1 on the depth chart at punt returner in 2016 after missing the 2015 season due to injury. Juniel has proven he can excel at the task, as he returned four punts for scores with a 33.4 average per return at Glendale Community College in 2014. Four different Miners returned punts last year, with **Jaquan White** leading the way with 124 yards on eight returns (15.5), including a 64-yard return for a score at NM State. **Warren Redix** tallied the Miners' second-longest punt return, a 17-yard gain at Old Dominion.

UP NEXT

UTEP will travel to Austin to take on Big 12 program Texas on Sept. 10. The Miners and Longhorns last met on Sept. 26, 2009. Second-ranked Texas topped UTEP 64-7 in Austin. It will mark the third year in a row that UTEP will face a Big 12 opponent.
