- Jemel Jones led the Aggies with his season-high 34 points on an efficient 13-24 shooting performance. He added seven rebounds, marking his second-highest rebounding total this season. His 34-point outing marks him the first Aggie to score 30+ points in a game since Feb. 19, 2022, when Teddy Allen scored 30 at Grand Canyon.

- The Aggies had four players score in double figures on the day Jemel Jones (34) Jayland Randall (14), Julius Mims (12) and Anthony Wrzeszcz (11).

- Randall came up big in the first half and finished the game with 14 points while going 4-8 from beyond the arc. This marks his 13th game this season with at least two made three-pointers.

- Jae'Coby Osborne finished the day with four points and five rebounds. With five boards, he has now recorded at least five rebounds in six consecutive games.





THE OPENING TIP

- Coming off a tough road swing that ended in a nail-biting overtime loss at Middle Tennessee, NM State returns home to the Pan American Center for its final two regular season games, beginning Thursday night against Jax State. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. on March 5.
- Thursday's contest marks the second meeting between the two programs this season. The Aggies claimed the first matchup in Jacksonville, Ala., earning a 79-70 road victory over the Gamecocks earlier this year.

THE JONES EFFECT

- Senior guard Jemel Jones continues to pace the Aggies offensively, leading the team with 17.4 points per game – a mark that ranks fifth in Conference USA.
- Jones had his best performance as an Aggie in the overtime loss to Middle Tennessee where he put up his season-high 34 points on an efficient 13-24 shooting performance. He added seven rebounds, marking his second-highest rebounding total this season. His 34-point outing marks him the first Aggie to score 30+ points in a game since Feb. 19, 2022, when Teddy Allen scored 30 at Grand Canyon.

1,000 POINT CLUB

- With his 26-point performance against UTEP, senior guard Jemel Jones surpassed the 1,000-point mark at the Division I level — reaching the milestone in just two seasons.
- Jones poured in 625 points last season at Cal State Bakersfield, and with six games remaining in the regular season, has already added 407 points for the Crimson & White this year.
- Prior to competing at the Division I level, Jones was a prolific scorer in junior college, tallying 1,999 points across two seasons at South Suburban and Olive-Harvey.

HE HAS THE “JUICE”

- Graduate forward Julius Mims has emerged as the anchor of the Aggie frontcourt this season, ranking second on the team in scoring at 11.0 points per game while leading NM State on the glass with 8.9 rebounds per contest – a mark that ranks first in CUSA.
- Mims is coming off one of his strongest stretches of the season, highlighted by a 13 points and a career-high 17 rebound performance while adding a block and an assist in the win over Jax State. His 17-rebound effort stands as the second-highest total by a CUSA player this season.
- With his eight double-doubles on the season, he is tied for the most in league in that category.

LATE-GAME BATTLES

- Close contests have tested the Aggies throughout the season, as NM State has suffered six losses by three points or fewer.
- Two of those narrow defeats came in overtime, both decided by a single point.

DEFENSIVE DISRUPTION

- NM State continues to establish itself as one of the top defensive teams in Conference USA and nationally.
- The Aggies rank 32nd in the country in field-goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 40.7% shooting. NM State also sits 45th nationally in three-point percentage defense, limiting opponents to 30.9% shooting from beyond the arc.

FIGHTING FOR HUNTSVILLE

- With two regular season games remaining, NM State is battling to secure a spot in the Conference USA Tournament in Huntsville, Ala. The Aggies currently sit tied for 10th place with UTEP (the final qualifying position) as only the top 10 teams advance to postseason play.
- In the event of a three-way tie between NM State, UTEP and FIU, the tiebreaker would place FIU first, followed by NM State. UTEP would move ahead of the Aggies for the 10-seed if NM State drops one game and UTEP wins out, or if NM State wins one and UTEP wins both of its remaining contests.

THE PREVIOUS MATCHUP

- In the first meeting, NM State (12-13, 5-10 CUSA) bounced back from a tough loss earlier in the week with a resilient 79-70 road victory over Jax State inside Pete Mathews Coliseum. The Aggies relied on strong defense, timely shot-making and a commanding effort on the glass to secure the win.
- Julius “Juice” Mims turned in one of his most dominant performances of the season, posting 13 points and a career-high 17 rebounds to record his fourth double-double in a five-game stretch.
- Jayland Randall delivered a spark off the bench with a game-high 20 points on 7-12 shooting, including 5-7 from beyond the arc. His five made three-pointers matched a season high.
- Elijah Elliott made his presence felt at the free throw line, scoring 12 points all at the charity stripe, including key late-game makes to seal the victory.

NEW PIECES TO THE PUZZLE

- After losing more than 94% of its scoring and 87% of its rebounding to graduation and the transfer portal, NM State made it a priority this offseason to reload its roster with players capable of producing immediately.
- To bolster the scoring column, the Aggies added Jemel Jones, Elijah Elliott, Jayland Randall, and Chris Terrell.
 - Jones arrives after an impressive season at Cal State Bakersfield, averaging 18.9 points per game and earning Big West Newcomer of the Year honors.
 - Elliott transfers from Southern Illinois, where he averaged 14.0 points per game before an injury shortened his season. His year included a 21-point performance against Oklahoma State.
 - Randall joins the Aggies from Southern Indiana, where he





posted 15.0 points per game last season.

– Terrell comes from Division II Delta State after ranking among the nation’s top scorers with 21.2 points per game while also leading all D-II players with 3.5 steals per contest.

• To strengthen the frontcourt and rebounding efforts, NM State added Julius Mims, Kyrese Mullen, and Cyr Malonga.

– Mims transfers from Idaho, where he averaged 8.6 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds per game while shooting 66.1% from the field.

– Mullen comes in after three seasons at Hampton, most recently averaging 7.3 points and 6.8 rebounds per game.

– Malonga joins the Aggies after two seasons at East Carolina, highlighted by a 10-point, nine-rebound performance against SMU during his freshman campaign.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

• Senior guard **Jemel Jones** was named to the 2025-26 CUSA Preseason All-Conference Team. A transfer from CSU Bakersfield, Jones joins the Aggies following a standout season in which he averaged 18.9 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.1 assists. He set multiple single-season program records for the Roadrunners, including total points (573) and scoring average (18.9), and earned All-Big West Second Team and Big West Newcomer of the Year honors.

SCOUTING THE GAMECOCKS

• Jacksonville State enters Thursday’s matchup with a 13-11 overall record and a 9-9 mark in Conference USA play, currently sitting tied for second in the league standings. The Gamecocks are led by 10th-year head coach Ray Harper.

• Defensively, Jax State ranks among the nation’s best — sitting 36th nationally in field goal percentage defense (41.1%), 47th in

scoring defense (68.3 ppg) and 51st in three-point field goal percentage defense (31.4%).

• Offensively, the Gamecocks are paced by Conference USA’s leading scorer Mostapha El Moutaouakil, who averages 19.3 points per game while also leading the team in rebounding at 7.1 per contest. He ranks sixth nationally in free throw attempts (242).

• AC Bryant provides a major perimeter threat, ranking 37th nationally with 2.96 three-pointers made per game.



JASON HOOTEN

HEAD COACH | THIRD SEASON | TARLETON, '93 | RECORD: 304-218 (.589)



Former NM State Director of Athletics Mario Moccia announced the hiring of Jason Hooten as the 28th head coach of the Aggie men's basketball program on Friday, March 24. Hooten brings with him an impressive 13 years of head coaching experience across his 30-year coaching career.

Hooten embarked on one of the most unique challenges throughout college basketball in the 2023-24 season. NM State was the only team in Division I that returned zero points, rebounds, or assists. With 15 newcomers to Las Cruces, only Tarleton, Hooten's alma mater, had more new faces around the gym.

In his first year at helm, Hooten led the Aggies to a win over I-10 rival UTEP, a 23-point second half comeback to defeat the future CUSA Tournament Champions Western Kentucky and a 12-3 record inside of the Pan American Center. The Aggies also ranked first in all CUSA programs in average home game attendance, totaling 5,638 fans per contest.

In his second season leading the Crimson & White, he led NM State to a 17-15 record, improving by four wins from his first year while tying for the second-best road conference record in CUSA at 6-3. He guided the Aggies to signature road wins, including a sold-out overtime thriller over I-25 rival New Mexico - who went on to win the Mountain West and reach the NCAA Tournament's Round of 32 - and a historic victory at I-10 rival UTEP, marking NM State's largest win in El Paso since 1937 and the third-largest home loss in UTEP history. Under his leadership, the Aggies became one of the nation's top defensive teams, ranking sixth in three-point percentage defense (29.1%), 11th in field goal percentage defense (39.6%), and 32nd in scoring defense (65.9 ppg).

In 13 seasons as the head coach at Sam Houston State University, Hooten displayed a track record of success as he compiled 261 wins, posted a .607 win percentage and helped the Bearkats to six postseason appearances, including a win in the first round of the 2023 NIT. Hooten's ability to build a winning program guided him to become the Bearkats' winningest coach in program history. Hooten and his staff helped lead the SHSU program to six 20-plus win seasons, including four in the last six seasons.

In 2023, Hooten led the Bearkats to a program-tying record of 26 wins en route to earning the No. 1 seed in the 2023 WAC Tournament. On the heels of one of Sam Houston State University's best seasons in program history, Hooten was named one of 20 finalists for the Hugh Durham Award, which is presented to the top Division I mid-major coach in the country. Hooten also appeared on the list of 25 finalists for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award – an award honoring success on the court while also displaying moral integrity off the court.

Under Hooten, the Bearkat program produced 36 all-conference honorees, including 2023 WAC Player of the Year Qua Grant who was one of four conference players of the year to take the court for Hooten. The Killeen, Texas, native also coached nine first team all-conference selections, four all-defensive team members and one Southland Conference Defensive Player of the Year.

Hooten's defensive philosophies helped build the program into one of the stingiest defenses in the country this season as the Bearkats held teams to just 59.3 points per game to rank fourth in the country and first in the conference. SHSU opponents also combined to shoot just 39.1% from the field in 2022-23 – a mark that was good for fifth in the nation and tops in the WAC.

Hooten's Bearkat teams also gave NM State fits during their two-year stint as conference foes. Sam Houston knocked off the Aggies twice in two meetings, including handing NM State a 25-point loss to end a 10-game winning streak during the 2021-22 season. The 2022-23 season was also highlighted by a pair of wins over Power Five programs as they defeated both Oklahoma and Utah during non-conference play.

Prior to being appointed the head coach at Sam Houston, Hooten served as an assistant on the Bearkats' staff from 2004 to 2010 and was a member of the coaching staff during one of two NCAA Tournament appearances in program history when SHSU reached the Big Dance in 2010. In five seasons as an assistant with Sam Houston, the Bearkats reached 20 wins four times and posted an overall record of 127-59. In 2009, RecruitingRumors.com named Hooten as one of the top 100 NCAA assistant coaches while Collegensider.com named him to the Mid-Major Top 25 assistant coaches honorable mention list.

Ahead of his time with Sam Houston, Hooten appeared on Lon Reisman's staff at Tarleton from 1993 to 2004. While coaching with his alma mater, Hooten helped the Texans construct a combined record of 204-111. Hooten's stint at Tarleton blossomed from his time as a student-athlete at TSU where he played for two seasons under Reisman (1989-91). As a guard, Hooten helped lead the Texans to a record of 52-10 while leading Tarleton in assists with 123 in 1990-91.

Hooten received his undergraduate degree from Tarleton State University in 1993 before earning his master's from Tarleton in 1995. He is married to Kristen Hooten and the two have a daughter, Jady, and a son, Jayce.
