GAME 5 | Hart Center | Nov. 19

Jordan Roland led the way with 28 points and **Jason Strong** added a career-best 18 as Northeastern routed Holy Cross, 101-44. It was the largest margin of victory in NU's 100-year history and the 63 points in the first half was the most since scoring 60 in 2005 vs. Lasell.

Also in double figures for the Huskies was **Tyson Walker** (15), **Myles Franklin** (10) and **Maxime Boursiquot** (10).

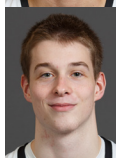

- Redshirt senior sharpshooter **Jordan Roland** continues to lead the NCAA in scoring at 30.4 points per game
- He is shooting 63% from the floor and 55% from beyond the arc
- **Roland** has 28 or more points in 4 of 5 games this year
- He has 11 consecutive double-figure scoring games, dating back to last season, and his 39 points in the opener at BU was the most by any NU player in a season opening game

THE COEN FILE

Reigning CAA Coach of the Year Bill Coen enters his 14th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program in 2019-20.

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 13 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 32 All-CAA honors, including 10 First Team and seven All-Rookie selections. Nineteen of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and eight Huskies remain active in professional basketball. Following the 2018-19 season, Coen had amassed 224 career wins in 13 seasons at Northeastern and ranks third on the CAA's list of all-time winningest coaches with 152 wins in conference regular season and tournament play. He is the lone current CAA coach to have cracked the top 10.

Coen's teams have proven that they are contenders in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 10 of Coen's 13 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern also has appeared in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals in all 13 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals seven times, and to the title game four times, including back-to-back appearances and two Championship titles, one in 2014-15 and the other in 2018-19. Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 13 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

In 2018-19, Coen and the Huskies captured the CAA Tournament title for the second time in the last five seasons, returning to the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies finished with a 23-11 record, netting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time during Coen's tenure and the first time as a program since four-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-87. The Huskies brought a seven-game win-streak into the national tournament where they faced blue blood and No. 17 Kansas in the second round. Following these accomplishments, Coen was tabbed as a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award for the second time in his career (2013). Coen coached Vasa Pusica to All-CAA First team, NABC First Team All-Region and USBWA All-District honors while Jordan Roland earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team.
