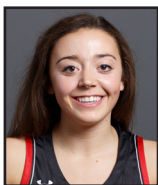

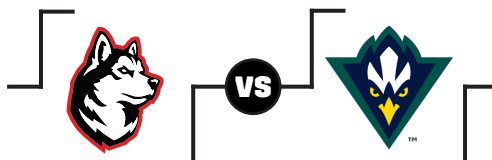

ALL-TIME SERIES

• Northeastern has won nine of the last 13 series meetings against UNCW and leads the all-time series, 14-10.

• Considering head coach Kelly Cole's five seasons at the helm of NU, the Huskies' 6-3 record against the Seahawks ranks as the team's second best mark against CAA competition behind their 7-2 record against College of Charleston.

COACHES vs. CANCER 3-POINT CHALLENGE

• Throughout the remainder of the 2018-19 regular season, the Northeastern women's basketball team will be participating in the 2019 Coaches vs. Cancer 3-Point Challenge – a national initiative during which collegiate and high school basketball teams unite for a common cause to end cancer.

• The Huskies have set a fundraising goal of \$1,000 and are actively encouraging fans to pledge their support for ever 3-pointer NU collectively hits as a team.

• As of Feb. 27, Northeastern has hit 41 3-pointers, which translates to approximately \$780 raised.

• Northeastern would post its 16th victory of the season, tying the Huskies' 2017-18 season win total.

• The Huskies would clinch a winning overall record during consecutive seasons for the first time since the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 campaigns (first time

CAA POSTSEASON PICTURE

- With two weeks remaining in the 2018-19 CAA regular season, Northeastern (5-9 CAA) sits in a tie for sixth place in the conference standings along with William & Mary (5-9 CAA). The Huskies currently own the head-to-head tiebreaker against the Tribe courtesy of Northeastern's 88-74 win against William & Mary at Cabot Center (Jan. 6).
- Three of the Huskies' final four regular season games are against opponents that are tied or rank below them in the league standings. Those three opponents - College of Charleston (March 3), William & Mary (March 7) and Elon (March 9 - yield a combined 11-32 record against the CAA.
- Northeastern trails fifth-place Delaware (8-6 CAA) by three games.

- The Huskies are seeking to secure a bye to the CAA quarterfinal round for the fourth consecutive season.

RECORD WATCH

- With a start on Friday, Jess Genco would become Northeastern's exclusive career record holder in games started, breaking her tie at 115 with Melissa Kowalski.

- Gabby Giacone' 117 career appearances rank three fewer than the Huskies' program record currently held by Ashlee Feldman (2005-09) and Danilervolino (2009-12).

REGULAR SEASON TRENDS

- Northeastern is 13-0 this season when holding its opponent to less than 40 percent shooting from the field (5-0 during CAA play).
- The Huskies are 11-4 when outrebounding their opponent, experiencing their defeats at Marist (+1), at Towson (+14), against Drexel (+8) and against Hofstra (+5).
- NU has posted as 12-2 record this year when registering 14 or more team assists.

LAST TIME OUT

- Northeastern lost a one-point home game against Hofstra, 63-62, on Feb. 24 at Cabot Center.
- The Huskies led the Pride, 51-38, through three quarters, but managed to hit one field goal during the fourth quarter (one-for-16). Hofstra won the game courtesy of Sica Cuzic's game-winning, three-point play with 2.4 seconds remaining in regulation.

HUSKIES SCORE BIG LEAGUE WIN AGAINST TOWSON

- Senior teammates Gabby Giacone and Jess Genco both sported double-doubles during Northeastern's 77-68 win against Towson at Cabot Center (Feb. 10). Giacone paired her season scoring high, 20 points, with 12 rebounds while Genco matched 16 points with 11 assists.
- Northeastern finished with four or more double-digit scorers for the second time during the 2018-19 season (Feb. 1 at College of Charleston).

- Rookie guard Kendall Currence offloaded a career high, 16 points, to pace the NU bench, which outscored the Tigers, 25-14.

- Northeastern opened the second quarter with an 18-6 scoring run that put the Huskies in front, 35-22, with 3:34 remaining in the first half.

- Genco fouled out with 2:35 remaining in regulation - her first career disqualification (112th appearance). She is Northeastern's all-time record holder in career minutes played (4,330, 38.3 per game).

HUSKIES IN THE WOMEN'S MID-MAJOR POLL

- From Nov. 13, 2018, to Feb. 5, 2019, Northeastern received votes during 13 consecutive releases of collegeinsider.com's Women's Mid-Major Top 25 poll - its longest streak during program history:

- The Huskies were ranked among the top 25 during nine consecutive weeks, running from Nov. 20 to Jan. 15.

- Northeastern's No. 25 ranking on Nov. 20 marked the program's first-ever poll placement under the leadership of fifth-year head coach Kelly Cole. NU last received votes in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25 poll on Nov. 26, 2013, despite being unranked.

- This season, NU is 1-4 against opponents that have been ranked in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25. The Huskies' lone win took place against No. 15 Maine (Dec. 22) while three of their four defeats have been by seven points or less: No. 14 Marist (Dec. 18), No. 16 Drexel (Jan. 18) and No. 12 James Madison (Feb. 8).



NORTHEASTERN KEEPS JMU CLOSE

• Northeastern became the second CAA team to hold James Madison under 60 points of offense, despite coming up on the wrong end of the 58-51 result on Feb. 8 at Cabot Center.

• Shannon Todd led the Huskies in scoring for the second straight game, posting 12 points and three rebounds.

• Ayanna Dublin achieved her seventh double-figure scoring game of the season, pairing 11 points with two rebounds and two assists.

• The Huskies trailed by 14 points (50-36) with 6:29 remaining in regulation before staging a 10-0 scoring run that tightened the game with three and a half minutes to go. NU misfired on consecutive one-and-done possessions, allowing JMU to close the game out during the final minute.

• Northeastern limited the Dukes to 39 rebounds – a tie for the fourth lowest mark that James Madison has hauled in this season.

GIACONE'S 'FLU GAME' FUELS NU AT CHARLESTON

• Northeastern won its most lopsided game of the season on Feb. 1, sprinting past College of Charleston, 87-56, to return its CAA winning percentage to .500 (4-4).

• After feeling under the weather before tip-off, Gabby Giaccone proceeded to lead the Huskies in both points (19) and rebounds (10), notching the fifth double-double of her senior campaign. Giaccone also scored her 1,000th career point during the game, becoming the 21st member of Northeastern's 1,000-point scoring club.

• Jess Genco tied her career assists high (12) for the third time during her collegiate career. She accounted for exactly half of the Huskies' program record (tie), 24 assists, against the Cougars.

• Kendall Currence and Samantha Michel both registered career scoring highs with 15 and six points, respectively.

• Northeastern broke away from Charleston courtesy of its 19-3 scoring run during the second quarter.

• The Huskies' 55.4 field goal percentage is the highest that Northeastern has recorded since Dec. 21, 2013, when NU shot 57.1 percent against Massachusetts.

1,000-POINT CLUB

• Considering Jess Genco (1,419 career points) and Gabby Giaccone (1,056), Northeastern is competing with two active members of its 1,000-point scoring club for the first time since the 2012-13 season (Deanna Kerkhof, Kash Cannon).

CURRENCE'S CALLING

• Freshman guard Kendall Currence has provided the Huskies with a spark off the bench during the team's last three weekends.

• The Bourne, Massachusetts, native has scored in double figures during four of her last seven games, including a career high, 16 points, scored against Towson on Feb. 10.

Genco Breaks NU Career Records

• **3-Point field goals:** Upon hitting the first of her two 3-pointers against Elon on Jan. 4, Jess Genco became Northeastern's exclusive record holder in 3-point field goals, breaking her tie at 245 with Melissa Kowalski (2000-04).

• Genco has monopolized the Huskies' quantifiable 3-point records, owning the program's single-game (nine), single-season (87), and career marks (268+).

• **Assists:** With her second assist during the Huskies' Jan. 27 game at Hofstra, Genco became the program's exclusive record holder in career assists, breaking her tie at 464 with Tesha Tinsley.

Huskies in the RPI

• As of Feb. 26, Northeastern ranks No. 114 in the RPI rankings (fourth highest among CAA programs).

May Collects Five Steals Against Delaware

• Playing her first career game in historic Matthews Arena, freshman Katie May hauled in five steals during the Huskies' Jan. 20 win against Delaware.

• May's five steals are the most by a Northeastern freshman since Nov. 13, 2015, when Jess Genco recorded five steals during her collegiate debut against Boston University.

Defending Home Court

• Northeastern started 8-0 at home for the first time during its modern era (since at least the 1978-79 season).

• The Huskies' eight-game winning streak at Cabot Center is the program's longest in the facility since NU won 10 consecutive games between Feb. 16, 2012, and Jan. 10, 2013.

GENCO EARNS FOURTH CAA WEEKLY HONOR

• Jess Genco collected her third CAA Player of the Week honor on Jan. 7 upon averaging 27.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists during the Huskies' back-to-back, league-opening wins against Elon (Jan. 4) and William & Mary (Jan. 6).

• Genco co-leads the CAA in Player of the Week selections (Nov. 19, Dec. 17, Jan. 7) and was named the award's Honorable Mention recipient on Dec. 3.

BREAK IN THE ACTION

• Northeastern's CAA opener against Elon marked the Huskies' first game in 13 days – the program's longest layoff since its 14-day break between Nov. 29, 2014, and Dec. 13, 2014.

2018-19 RECORD PERFORMANCES

• **Winning streak:** Northeastern's nine-game winning streak to begin the 2018-19 season is tied for the program's longest winning streak with that of its 1998-99 team.

• **Consecutive season-opening wins:** The Huskies' nine consecutive season-opening wins broke the program's previous record – seven – set by their 1968-69 team.

• **Team assists, single game:** Northeastern combined to yield 24 assists during its 87-56 victory at College of Charleston (Feb. 1). Jess Genco tied her career assists high (12) for the third time.

• **Individual 3-point field goals, single game:** Jess Genco has become the first Northeastern women's basketball player to ever hit eight or more 3-pointers during a single game. Genco first broke the Huskies' single-game record on Nov. 28 at Florida (eight 3-pointers) and reset her program-best mark on Dec. 15 at Providence (nine).

LAST OF THE UNDEFEATEDS

• Prior to experiencing its first defeat of the season on Dec. 18 at Marist, Northeastern had entered the contest as one of 17 undefeated Division I programs and one of only five that hailed from a non-power five conference.

TINSLEY TO GENCO: A 20-YEAR TIME MACHINE

• Northeastern's 2018-19 team is already considered to be among the program's all-time greats alongside that of its 1998-99 team. Both squads boasted program record, nine-game winning streaks and were led by dynamic point guards: Tesha Tinsley (1996-2000) and Jess Genco (2015-present).

• The Huskies' lone NCAA tournament appearance was earned by virtue of its 1999 America East postseason championship – a 57-55 victory against Maine. Northeastern drew the No. 13 seed in the Midwest Region, where NU lost to fourth-seeded North Carolina, 64-55, during the first round.

• Tesha Tinsley's No. 10 jersey was retired by Northeastern on Feb. 12, 2017, before the Huskies' 61-44 victory against College of Charleston. Tinsley's jersey is the second Northeastern basketball jersey to be retired alongside that of the late Reggie Lewis.

WHEN GIACONO GOES AFTER IT

• Northeastern is 6-1 this season when Gabby Giacone scores eight or more points and records eight or more rebounds.

• Giacone has achieved six double-doubles this season (17 career double-doubles).
