OPENING TIP

• Northeastern has dropped three conference games by a total of six points, falling in the closing seconds in all three; The Huskies are 1-4 this season in games decided by 3 points or less

• The Huskies entered last Saturday's game as the third-best free throw shooting team in the country at 81 percent, but shot a season-low 64 percent from the charity stripe in the OT loss at UNCW

• Eight of NU's nine losses this season have been by single digits

• Northeastern has won seven straight games against Drexel inside Matthews Arena; Last loss was Feb. 1, 2012 (61-53)

• Senior **Bolden Brace** became the 39th player in program history to reach 1,000 points in his career against Hofstra (1/14) and moved into 34th on the all-time NU scoring list with 1,031 points

• Coach **Bill Coen** is No. 2 all-time in school history with 234 wins and No. 3 in CAA history with 156 CAA wins, two shy of former Drexel Coach Bruiser Flint

• Senior **Jordan Roland** checked in at No. 25 on the ESPN.com list of top players in the country through 1 month of the season after scoring an amazing 81 points in the first two games and a single-game school record 42 in a win over Harvard (11/8)

UNCW 76, NORTHEASTERN 74 (OT)

GAME 19 | Trask Coliseum | Wilmington, N.C. | Jan. 18

Jordan Roland scored a Trask Coliseum record 38 points and **Tyson Walker** scored 17 points as Northeastern dropped a tough CAA contest at UNCW, 76-74, in overtime on Saturday night.

The Huskies built a 16-point lead with 10 minutes remaining in the game and looked well on their way to the victory, but UNCW responded with hot-shooting (67%), including 3-of-7 from long range, to outscore the Huskies 25-6 over the fina, 9:36 and send the game into OT.

Northeastern scored the first four points, but split a pair of trips to the free-throw line which would have given them a six-point lead. UNCW rattled off eight straight from there and created a turnover at the end of the game to pick up their first CAA win.

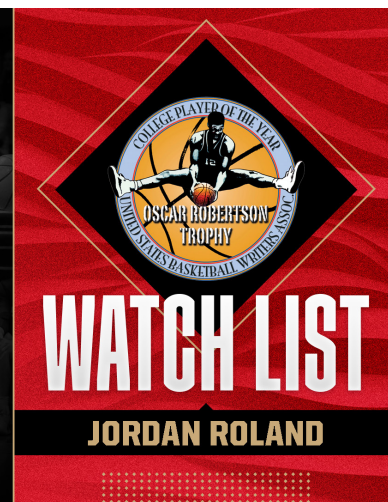

THE COEN FILE

Reigning CAA Coach of the Year **Bill Coen** enters his 14th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program in 2019-20. He is currently second in school history with 234 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86. Coen stands third all-time in CAA history with 156 CAA wins (league+postseason), behind former coaches Jim Larranaga (George Mason, 1998-2011 / 183) and Bruiser Flint (Drexel, 2002-16 / 158).

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 13 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 32 All-CAA honors, including 10 first team accolades and seven All-Rookie selections. Nineteen of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and eight Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have proven that they are contenders in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 10 of Coen's 13 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern also has appeared in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals in all 13 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals seven times, and to the title game four times, including back-to-back appearances and two Championship titles, one in 2014-15 and the other in 2018-19. Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 13 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

In 2018-19, Coen and the Huskies captured the CAA Tournament title for the second time in the last five seasons, returning to the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies finished with a 23-11 record, netting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time during Coen's tenure and the first time as a program since four-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-87. The Huskies brought a seven-game win-streak into the national tournament where they faced blue blood and No. 17 Kansas in the second round. Following these accomplishments, Coen was tabbed as a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award for the second time in his career (2013). Coen coached Vasa Pusica to All-CAA First team, NABC First Team All-Region and USBWA All-District honors while Jordan Roland earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team.

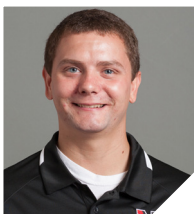
