STORYLINES

- Delaware looks for its third straight win this afternoon against Northeastern.
- The Blue Hens snapped a five-game losing streak in Hempstead with a dramatic 73-71 win over Hofstra on Thursday. Kevin Anderson hit a tie-breaking layup with 0.3 seconds left, the number one play on ESPN's SportsCenter Thursday night.
- Delaware has hit clutch shots to win each of its last two games, as Jacob Cushing buried a go-ahead three-pointer with five seconds left in last Saturday's 79-78 home victory over Elon.
- Justyn Mutts scored a career-high 30 points on 14 of 17 shooting vs. Hofstra, and grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds to post his seventh double-double of the season.
- Dylan Painter recorded his second double-double with 15 points and a career-best 12 rebounds. Mutts and Painter combined for 45 points and 25 rebounds while shooting 18 of 26 from the field. Delaware held a 48-28 advantage in points in the paint.
- Mutts is the third Blue Hen to reach the 30-point mark this season, along with Nate Darling (37) and Kevin Anderson (32) vs. UTSA on Nov. 10. Delaware is one of six schools that has three players different players who have scored 30 points this season.
- The victory was the Blue Hens' fourth true road win of the season. Delaware has won eight games outside of Newark this season, four road wins and four neutral site victories.
- Delaware holds a slim 29-28 all-time advantage over Northeastern, but the Huskies have won eight of the last 10 meetings.
- Northeastern is 14-12 against the Blue Hens in Boston, and had won three straight at Matthews Arena prior to UD's 82-80 double overtime win last season.



DELAWARE VS. NORTHEASTERN

Delaware holds a slim 29-28 all-time advantage over Northeastern, but the Huskies have won eight of the last 10 meetings.

Last year the teams split a pair of matchups, with each winning on the other's home floor.

Northeastern is 14-12 against the Blue Hens in Boston, and had won three straight at Matthews Arena prior to UD's 82-80 double overtime win last season.

DELAWARE VS. NORTHEASTERN LAST YEAR

Ithiel Horton scored 27 points and the Blue Hens got several key stops late in regulation and both overtime periods as Delaware posted an impressive 82-80 double overtime win over Northeastern at Matthews Arena on Dec. 30, 2018.

Ryan Allen added 19 points while Eric Carter finished with 18 points and 10 rebounds for the Blue Hens.

Darian Bryant had six points for Delaware, Kevin Anderson added five, and Collin Goss chipped in five points and eight boards. Bolden Brace finished with 18 points, 10 rebounds and six assists for the Huskies, who put five players in double figures.

Delaware fell behind by three in double overtime, but Allen drained a three-pointer and following a Northeastern free throw, the Blue Hens scored five straight points to go up four. It was a two-point game when the Huskies' Donnell Gresham went to the line and hit the first free throw but missed the second with 15 seconds to play.

Northeastern grabbed the offensive rebound, but Gresham missed inside and Goss collected the board. Allen when then fouled and hit one of two foul shots, before the Huskies' half court heave was off the mark.

Delaware also was up four points early in the first overtime period, but the Huskies battled back to take a one-point lead before Carter hit a tying foul shot with 1:10 on the clock. Both teams missed three-point attempts from there to force the second extra session.

The Blue Hens trailed 34-29 at the break but then scored the first five points of the second half to pull even, while a Horton three-pointer from the top of the key gave Delaware a 49-45 edge with 10 minutes remaining.

However the Huskies answered with eight straight points to go back in front. Northeastern was up four late but Anderson hit a three-pointer, and following one free throw by Vasa Pusica, Carter hit a jump hook and Pusica missed at the buzzer to force overtime.

Northeastern hit three consecutive three-pointers late in the second half to break open a two-point game as the Huskies pulled away for a 75-64 victory over Delaware at the Bob Carpenter Center on Feb. 28, 2019.

The Huskies were clinging to a 57-55 lead with six minutes remaining before Donnell Gresham, Jordan Roland and Vasa Pusica buried three straight triples to make it an 11-point game with 3:23 on the clock. Ryan Allen answered with a layup for the Blue Hens, but Northeastern scored the next seven points to put the game away.

Allen and Ithiel Horton led Delaware with 16 points apiece, while Eric Carter contributed 12 points and a game-high eight rebounds. Darian Bryant chipped in

with six points and four assists, while Matt Veretto and Jacob Cushing each scored five points.

Pusica paced the Huskies with 22 points, while Roland added 17 and Bolden Brace finished with 16 points and eight boards.

Northeastern shot 56.3 percent from the floor, including 12 of 26 from three-point range. Delaware shot an even 50 percent from the field, but was just 8 of 25 from behind the arc.

The Huskies used an eight-point spurt in the first half to go in front 26-19 and eventually stretched the margin to 36-26, before the Blue Hens closed within 38-33 at the break. Delaware clawed to within a pair four times in the second half, but could never pull even.

LAST TIME OUT

Kevin Anderson beat the buzzer with a driving layup as Delaware edged Hofstra, 73-71, in a CAA thriller Thursday night at the Mack Sports Complex.

Justyn Mutts put the Blue Hens up 73-71 on a put-back with 18 seconds to play, but Hofstra's Jalen Ray was fouled and knocked down a pair of free throws to tie the game with six seconds on the clock. Anderson then took the inbounds pass, drove down the lane and finished over a Hofstra defender just before the horn as Delaware won its second barnburner in a row.

Mutts was dominant inside, finishing with a career-high 30 points on 14 of 17 shooting from the field. The sophomore also grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds to post his seventh double-double of the year. Anderson finished with 15 points, while Dylan Painter also notched a double-double with 15 points and a career-high 12 boards.

Delaware connected on seven of its first 11 shots from the field, as an Anderson jumper in the paint gave the Blue Hens a 16-7 lead with 14:16 left in the first half.

However Delaware then went scoreless for over six minutes and the Pride took advantage, scoring 18 consecutive points to go in front 25-16.

The Blue Hens would later answer with a 14-point spurt of their own, taking a 36-30 lead on a three-point play by Painter at the 1:38 mark. Delaware was still up six in the final minute, before Hofstra scored the final five points of the half to pull within 38-37 at the break.

Delaware still led by a point five minutes into the second half before erupting for an eight-point spurt, taking a 54-45 advantage with 12 minutes remaining when Anderson found Collin Goss for a fastbreak layup.

Hofstra rallied back to go up 66-64 with four minutes left, and the game went back and forth from there until Anderson's game-winner.

HEART-STOPPING HENS

Delaware has won each of its last two games with game-winning shots in the final seconds. Jacob Cushing buried a go-ahead three-pointer with five seconds left in last Saturday's 79-78 victory over Elon. Kevin Anderson then scored the tie-breaking layup with 0.3 seconds left in Thursday's 73-71 triumph at Hofstra.

Anderson's shot was the top play on Thursday's night's ESPN SportsCenter.

2019-20 UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

MUTTS HAS CAREER NIGHT VS. PRIDE

Justyn Mutts scored a career-high 30 points on 14 of 17 shooting from the field in Thursday's win at Hofstra. He also led UD with 13 rebounds to post his seventh double-double of the season.

Dylan Painter also had a double-double with 15 points and a career-high 12 boards. UD's frontcourt duo combined for 45 points and 25 rebounds while shooting 18 of 26 from the floor, as Delaware held a 48-28 advantage in points in the paint.

THREE PLAYERS WITH 30

With his huge game at Hofstra, Justyn Mutts became the third Blue Hen to score 30 points this season. Nate Darling scored 37 points while Kevin Anderson added 32 in Delaware's 91-79 win over UTSA on Nov. 10.

UD is one of six schools to have three different players reach the 30-point mark this year, along with Arkansas, Minnesota, Nevada, Toledo and UNC Asheville.

The Blue Hens have four active players who have scored 30 points at UD, as Ryan Allen scored 30 in a double overtime win at Towson last year.

JUSTYN MUTTS WIN/LOSS SPLITS

In Delaware's 14 wins, Justyn Mutts is averaging 15.9 points and 9.1 rebounds while shooting 56.1 percent from the field. In UD's seven losses, he is averaging 6.7 points and 7.7 rebounds while shooting 45.7 percent from the field.

Mutts is averaging 18.5 points and shooting 64.7 percent in UD's four CAA wins, but just 3.5 points and a 26.3 field goal percentage in the four CAA losses.

INJURY UPDATE

Aleks Novakovich has missed the last four games with a stress fracture in his left foot. He is expected to be sidelined four to six weeks.

BLUE HENS CONNECT FROM DEEP VS. PHOENIX

Delaware tied a season-high by hitting 13 three-pointers during last Saturday's win over Elon. The Blue Hens also hit 13 triples in two of their first four games of the year, vs. Bridgewater on Nov. 5 and vs. UTSA on Nov. 10.

Ryan Allen and Nate Darling each connected on five threes, the first time multiple Blue Hens hit five three-pointers since Kory Holden (6) and Cazmon Hayes (5) vs. William & Mary on Jan. 28, 2016.

1,200TH WIN

Last Saturday's victory over Elon was the 1,200th in Delaware basketball history. The program's record stands at 1201-1322-2 since the inaugural season in 1905-06.

DARLING NAMED TO HENSON AWARD MID-SEASON WATCH LIST

Nate Darling was one of 50 players named to the Lou Henson Award Mid-Season Watch List on Jan. 9.

The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player. Ryan Allen was one of 50 players named on the preseason watch list in November.

PAINTER SHINES AT JMU

Dylan Painter recorded his first career double-double with career-highs of 23 points and 10 rebounds during the win at James Madison on Jan. 9. He finished 8 of 11 from the floor, 7 of 8 from the foul line, handed out three assists and made two blocks in 33 minutes of action.

Painter added his second career double-double with 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds Thursday at Hofstra.

Painter is averaging 10.7 points and 5.8 rebounds in just 20.8 minutes per game, while shooting 62.3 percent from the field.

ANDERSON HOT FROM DEEP

Kevin Anderson tied his then career-high by knocking down four three-pointers during the win at JMU, including the game-winner with 38 seconds to play. He then buried a career-best five triples last Thursday vs. William & Mary.

Anderson shot 53 of 155 (34.2%) from three-point range during his first two seasons, but is 31 of 76 (40.8%) from behind the arc this year, the ninth highest percentage in the league.

HENS HEAT UP FROM FIELD VS. ELON

Delaware had shot under 50 percent in five consecutive games, before shooting 56.0 percent against Elon including 64.0 percent in the second half.

The Blue Hens have shot over 50 percent in nine of their 21 games this season.

UD currently ranks second in the CAA and 23rd in the country with a 47.7 field goal percentage this season. The Blue Hens are also 66th in the nation with a 36.0 three-point percentage and 58th with a 74.8 free throw percentage.

ALLEN REACHES 1,000 POINTS

Ryan Allen surpassed the 1,000-point mark on Dec. 28 vs. UNCW. He became the 36th player in UD history to reach 1,000 points, and now ranks 30th in program history with 1,084 points.

DARLING 47TH IN NATION IN SCORING

Nate Darling currently ranks fourth in the CAA and 47th in the nation by averaging 19.0 points per game.

A Blue Hen has averaged at least 20 points per game 10 times in program history, and none since Mike Pegues in both 1998-99 (21.8 ppg) and 1999-2000 (20.8 ppg).

DARLING AMONG NATION'S LEADERS IN THREE-POINTERS

Nate Darling ranks 17th in the nation with 61 three-pointers made, 26th with 3.05 three-pointers per game and 63rd with a 37.9 three-point percentage.

DARLING SECOND IN MINUTES PLAYED

Nate Darling ranks second in Division I with 38.23 minutes played per game. He trails only Jahlil Jenkins of Fairleigh Dickinson at 39:17 minutes.

Darling did not come out of the lineup in any of the last three games.

ALLEN MOVING UP THREE-POINTERS LIST

Ryan Allen scored 21 points vs. Bridgewater, and tied his career-high by knocking down six three-pointers. Allen connected on his first five attempts from behind the arc during the win, and finished with six treys for the fifth time in his career.

Allen has appeared in just 73 games during his Blue Hen career, but already ranks seventh in school history with 189 three-pointers made. He has hit a three-point-er in all but six of his appearances for Delaware.

Allen connected on 86 three-pointers during his rookie season, tying the UD single season mark also held by John Gordon in 1998-99.

Allen hit a three-pointer in the first 29 games of his career, the second longest streak in school history. Peca Arsic drained a triple in 36 consecutive games from 1994-96.

MUTTS SEEING DOUBLE

Justyn Mutts recorded four consecutive double-doubles from Nov. 19 through Dec. 2, and now has seven on the season. His 16 rebounds vs. Maryland Eastern Shore are the most by a Blue Hen since Marvin King-Davis had 18 vs. South Florida on Dec. 3, 2015.

Mutts posted consecutive 20-point, 15-rebound performances (22/16 vs. UMES, 24/15 vs. Columbia), becoming just the second Blue Hen in the last 50 years to accomplish that feat. Greg Smith had 22 points/15 rebounds vs. Widener on Dec. 22, 1996 and 24 points/16 rebounds at Virginia on Dec. 30, 1996.

DELAWARE SETS PROGRAM MARK FOR FASTEST TO 10 WINS

Delaware won 10 games before the end of December for the first time in program history.

The previous record for fastest to 10 wins was set last year on Jan. 3. The 1999-2000 team reached 10 wins on Jan. 4 and the 1998-99 team did it on Jan. 5.

UD SETS BEST START IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Delaware opened the season with nine consecutive wins, the best start in program history. The 1998-99 team held the previous record with eight straight victories to open the season.

UD PROGRAM WINNING STREAKS

Delaware's nine-game winning streak to open this season is tied for the fifth longest in program history.

DELAWARE RECEIVES VOTE IN AP TOP 25 POLL

Delaware received one vote in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll on Dec. 2. It marked the fourth season the Blue Hens have received votes in the Top 25 Poll, along with 1991-92, 1998-99 and 1999-2000.

DARLING, ANDERSON NAMED TO SUNSHINE SLAM TEAM

Nate Darling was named Most Valuable Player of the Sunshine Slam, while Kevin Anderson was selected to the All-Tournament Team.

Darling averaged 25.7 points and 5.7 rebounds during the three games in Kissimmee, Fla, leading the Blue Hens in scoring all three contests. He went 17 of 27 from three-point range, and poured in 37 points during the win over UTSA.

Anderson converted two driving layups in the final 64 seconds to put Delaware in front for good in the victory over Southern Illinois. He then erupted for a career-high 32 points vs. UTSA.

The win over UTSA marked the first time in UD history that two Blue Hens scored at least 30 points in the same game.

DARLING HAS CAREER GAME VS. UTSA

Nate Darling scored a career-high 37 points during the win over UTSA on Nov. 10, as he finished 12 of 19 from the field including 8 of 10 from three-point range.

Darling's 37 points are tied for 12th most in a game in UD history, and the most since Davon Usher scored 42 vs. College of Charleston on Feb. 12, 2014.

Darling's eight three-pointers are one shy of the Blue Hen single game record of nine set last year by Ithiel Horton at UNCW.

BLUE HENS FEATURE OLDER STARTING LINEUP

Delaware is featuring a veteran starting lineup this season, as all five current starters are 21 years old.

Collin Goss, who was the first Blue Hen off the bench Saturday, is 23 while Jacob Cushing, the second player off the bench, is 21.

HENS LOOKING TO CONTINUE SUCCESS UNDER INGELSBY

Delaware has increased its win total during all three years under head coach Martin Ingelsby. The Blue Hens won just seven games in 2015-16 prior to Ingelsby's arrival, but won 13 games during his first season. They then won 14 games in 2017-18, before finishing 17-16 a year ago.

Last season Delaware finished fifth in the CAA standings, posting its highest win total and highest CAA finish since 2013-14. The Blue Hens also advanced to the CAA Tournament Semifinals for the first time in five years after erasing a 14-point halftime deficit in the 85-79 win over William & Mary in the quarterfinals, the largest halftime comeback in CAA Tournament history.

INGELSBY SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

Head coach Martin Ingelsby is currently in his fourth year leading the Blue Hens. On June 20, he signed a two-year contract extension through the 2023-24 season.

CARR, ARLETTI SIGN NLI'S WITH BLUE HENS

Andrew Carr and Gianmarco Arletti signed National Letters of Intent with the UD program in November.

Carr, a 6-9 forward from West Chester, Pa., averaged 19 points and eight rebounds per game last year during his junior season. He led West Chester East High School to a 21-7 record, an appearance in the PIAA District I Class 5A title game and the Vikings' first state tournament berth in 17 years.

Carr's father, Phil, and his uncle, Tim, both played for the Blue Hens in the 1980's and each served as team captain during their senior seasons.

Arletti, a 6-5 guard from Bologna, Italy, is currently in his second year at Holy Cross Prep Academy in Delran, N.J. He averaged 17.2 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.1 steals last year as the Lancers finished 17-10 and won a share of the Burlington County League Independent Division title.

Arletti also competed for Italy in the FIBA 3x3 U18 Europe Cup Qualifier this summer on Aug. 3-4.

GARDNER SITTING OUT SEASON AS REDSHIRT

Junior guard Reggie Gardner is sitting out this season after transferring to Delaware from North Carolina Central during the summer.

Gardner appeared in 33 games for the Eagles last year, averaging 5.8 points per game. He was a second team All-MEAC selection in 2017-18, when he started all 35 games and averaged 10.8 points per outing.

ROOKIE SUCCESS

Delaware has featured a pair of CAA Rookies of the Year recruited by Martin Ingelsby, while the Blue Hens are the only school to feature a CAA All-Rookie Team member during each of Ingelsby's three seasons.

Ryan Daly was named CAA Rookie of the Year, in 2016-17, Ryan Allen won the award in 2017-18, and Ithiel Horton was named to the All-Rookie squad last year.

Delaware won 16 CAA Rookie of the Week awards during the last three years, by far the most in the league (Drexel was second with nine winners).

BLUE HENS IN THE BAHAMAS

Delaware took its first ever summer foreign trip on August 5-11 when the Blue Hens traveled to Nassau for three games in the Bahamas. UD won two of three games against local teams in Nassau.

DELAWARE PICKED FIFTH IN CAA PRESEASON POLL

Delaware was picked fifth in the CAA Preseason Poll announced during the league's Media Day.

Martin Ingelsby is currently in his fourth season as University of Delaware men's basketball head coach during the 2019-20 season.

On June 20, Ingelsby signed a two-year extension through the 2023-24 season.

After spending the previous 13 years on the Notre Dame coaching staff from 2003-16, Ingelsby led the Blue Hens to 13 victories during his first season in Newark, including a win over Hofstra in the CAA Tournament.

During his second year Delaware won 14 games, and earned a CAA Tournament victory for the second consecutive year by defeating Elon in the first round.

Last season the Blue Hens finished 17-16 and were fifth in the CAA standings, posting their highest win total and highest CAA finish in five years. UD increased its win total for the third straight season, and advanced to the CAA Tournament Semifinals for the first since 2013-14. Delaware erased a 14-point halftime deficit in the 85-79 win over William & Mary in the quarterfinals, the largest halftime comeback in CAA Tournament history.

A Blue Hen earned the CAA Rookie of the Year award in both of Ingelsby's first two years, while Delaware is the only CAA school to earn an All-Rookie Team selection in each of the last three seasons.

Ingelsby, the 24th head coach in UD men's basketball history, is a native of Berwyn, Pa., and was a standout point guard for Notre Dame from 1997-2001. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Wagner College during the 2002-03 campaign before returning to his alma mater as Notre Dame's coordinator of basketball operations. He spent six seasons in that position before being promoted to assistant coach in July 2009, a position he held for seven years. During his tenure in South Bend, Ingelsby, 39, helped lead the Irish to eight NCAA Tournament appearances.

"I really believe this is a great fit for me," Ingelsby said at the time of his hiring. "Coming from Notre Dame, to have the opportunity to be the head coach at a place like the University of Delaware is something I could not pass up. This is a great academic institution and a great community and we will be able to recruit young men who will excel in the classroom and on the basketball court. We want to win and we want to win the right way. It all starts with high character and highly competitive kids who will represent this basketball program and this University in a first-class manner on and off the basketball court. I can't wait to get started."

"We want to dream big dreams and talk about winning CAA championships and getting into the NCAA Tournament. There is a process that goes into place in building a basketball program and we will work hard to get there. Together, with the student body, faculty, alumni, community and fans, we can accomplish great things."

"I am incredibly excited for our student-athletes, our university and all of Blue Hen Nation to welcome Coach Ingelsby," said University of Delaware Director of Athletics and Recreation Services Chrissi Rawak. "Martin demands excellence in all that he does and has a keen focus on getting young men to go beyond their limits academically, athletically, and in the community. He will have an immediate impact not only on our basketball program, but on our entire department."

While in South Bend Ingelsby primarily worked with the Notre Dame guards and played an integral role in elevating the program's national recruiting efforts. The Fighting Irish reaped the benefits of that recruiting success over his final two seasons as Notre Dame advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight in both 2015 and 2016.

The Fighting Irish enjoyed a magical 2014-15 campaign as Notre Dame won the Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament title, made its first Elite Eight appearance since 1979, and posted the second 30-win season in school history by finishing with a 32-6 mark.

Despite losing Jerian Grant and Pat Connaughton to the NBA, Notre Dame followed with another outstanding campaign in 2015-16, advancing to the ACC Tournament Semifinals before making its second straight Elite Eight appearance.

Ingelsby helped mentor Grant, a first team consensus All-American and unanimous first team All-ACC pick in 2015 before getting selected by the New York Knicks with the 19th pick in the 2015 NBA Draft. He also worked extensively with Connaughton, who played in a school-record 139 games and was the 41st pick in the 2015 NBA

Draft by the Brooklyn Nets. That season marked the first time since 1992 that two Notre Dame players were selected in the same year of the NBA Draft.

Under Ingelsby's tutelage, Irish point guard Demetrius Jackson enjoyed an outstanding season in 2015-16, earning second team All-ACC and NCAA East Regional All-Tournament Team accolades.

Ingelsby helped lead Notre Dame to a school-record seven consecutive 20-win seasons from 2006-13, while the Irish posted 97 victories from 2009-13, the most wins in a four-year period in school history. During Ingelsby's 13 seasons at his alma mater, Irish teams went 290-146 (.665) and the program posted a 168-76 record with six NCAA Tournament appearances in seven years once he assumed assistant coaching duties.

During Ingelsby's lone season at Wagner in 2002-03, he was part of the most successful season in school history as the Seahawks finished 21-11, won both the Northeast Conference regular season and tournament titles, and earned the school's first-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament.

Ingelsby was Notre Dame's starting point guard during three of his four seasons in South Bend. As a senior in 2000-01 he averaged 8.2 points and a team-high 6.4 assists as a starter in all 30 games. A team captain during his senior year, he guided the Irish to a 20-10 overall record and the Big East's West Division championship, the school's first ever conference title. Additionally, Notre Dame advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament after earning a berth in the field for the first time in more than a decade in Mike Brey's first season.

Ingelsby also started for the Irish as a freshman and sophomore, and led the team in assists during three of his four seasons. He handed out a team-high 150 assists as a freshman and earned a spot on the 1998 Big East All-Rookie Team.

A two-time member of the Big East Academic All-Star Team, Ingelsby was the recipient of the Notre Dame Club of St. Joseph Valley Rockne Student-Athlete Award during his senior season. He graduated from the Mendoza College of Business with a bachelor's degree in marketing in May, 2001.

Ingelsby enjoyed an outstanding career at Archbishop Carroll High School in suburban Philadelphia where he finished as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,425 points and led his teams to an 80-12 record during his three years on the varsity squad.

Following his senior year in 1997, he won the prestigious Markward Award, given annually to the top high school player in the Philadelphia area, and was the Gatorade Player of the Year for Philadelphia while also earning All-Catholic League honors three times. Ingelsby was also named South Catholic League MVP as a senior and was a McDonald's All-America honorable mention selection.

Ingelsby's father, Tom, was a standout guard at Villanova from 1970-73 and served as his son's head coach at Archbishop Carroll. Tom led Villanova to the 1971 NCAA championship game and played for the Atlanta Hawks during the 1973-74 season and for the Spirits of St. Louis in the ABA the following year.

Ingelsby and his wife, Colleen, are the parents of twins Will and Kate, and sons Jack and Ben.
