#### **OPENING TIP**

- Northeastern is off to a 3-0 start in CAA play for the fourth time in program history since joining the league in 2005; The Huskies started a program-best 8-0 in the 2012-13 season
- The Huskies have won eight straight home games in CAA action, and 12 of the last 13 dating back to last season
- Northeastern is riding a season-best four-game winning streak
- Freshman **Tyson Walker** scored a careerhigh 32 points (5th-best in school history for a freshman) in the win over Elon last Thursday night; He is the reigning CAA Rookie of the Week
- Coach Bill Coen is No. 3 all-time in CAA wins with 155, three shy of former Drexel Coach Bruiser Flint for No. 2
- Roland scored an amazing 81 points in his first two games this season, including a single-game school record 42 in a win over Harvard, 84-79 (11/8); He was recently named No. 25 on the ESPN.com list of top players in the country through 1 month of the season
- The Huskies are shooting 45% from 3 (93-209) in their 9 wins, compared to 35% (48-139) in their 6 losses
- NU has protected its second-half leads, going 9-0 when leading with 10 minutes remaining

Tyson Walker scored a career-high 32 points and Jordan Roland finished with 17 to lead Northeastern past Elon, 77-68, on Thursday night inside Matthews Arena. The Huskies have won eight straight at home in league play.

Bolden Brace tallied 10 points, three rebounds and two steals. Max Boursiquot led the way on the glass with eight rebounds.

Elon came back from 14 points down in the second half to slice the deficit to two with just over 2 minutes remaining, but the Huskies' Walker made consecutive jumpers that led to a 10-0 run and seal the victory.



#### **THE COEN FILE**

Reigning CAA Coach of the Year *Bill Coen* enters his 14th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program in 2019-20. He is currently second in school history with 232 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86. Coen stands third all-time in CAA history with 154 CAA wins (league+postseason), behind former coaches Jim Larranaga (George Mason, 1998-2011 / 183) and Bruiser Flint (Drexel, 2002-16 / 158).

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 13 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 32 All-CAA honors, including 10 first team accolades and seven All-Rookie selections. Nineteen of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and eight Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have proven that they are contenders in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 10 of Coen's 13 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern also has appeared in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals in all 13 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals seven times, and to the title game four times, including back-to-back appearances and two Championship titles, one in 2014-15 and the other in 2018-19. Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 13 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

In 2018-19, Coen and the Huskies captured the CAA Tournament title for the second time in the last five seasons, returning to the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies finished with a 23-11 record, netting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time during Coen's tenure and the first time as a program since four-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-87. The Huskies brought a seven-game win-streak into the national tournament where they faced blue blood and No. 17 Kansas in the second round. Following these accomplishments, Coen was tabbed as a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award for the second time in his career (2013). Coen coached Vasa Pusica to All-CAA First team, NABC First Team All-Region and USBWA All-District honors while Jordan Roland earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team.
