STORYLINES

- Delaware opens its final homestand of the season tonight as the Blue Hens host Northeastern.
- Win a win tonight, Delaware would reach 20 wins for the eighth time in program history.
- Delaware is attempting to win double digit conference games for the 12th time in program history. The Blue Hens have won double digit CAA games four times (10 in 2003-04, 12 in 2011-12, 13 in 2012-13, and 14 in 2013-14).
- Nate Darling has scored 182 points (30.3 ppg) over his last six games, the most by a Blue Hen over a six-game stretch in school history.
- Darling scored 36 points at William & Mary on Saturday, the fourth time this season he's eclipsed the 34-point mark. Darling is one of five Division I players to score at least 34 points four times this year.
- Darling is the first Blue Hen with four 30-point games in the same season since Mike Pegues also had four in 1999-2000.
- Darling hit five three-pointers at William & Mary to set a new UD season record, and now has 89 triples on the year. That leads the CAA and ranks sixth in the nation.
- Northeastern guard Jordan Roland leads the CAA and ranks fifth nationally with 23.3 points per game, while Darling is third in the CAA and 14th in the nation with 21.6 points per game.
- Northeastern is 7-7 in CAA games despite a +81 scoring differential, while Delaware is 9-5 in league games with a -2 differential.
- Delaware leads the all-time series with the Huskies, 30-28, and won the first meeting this year, 76-74, in Boston. Darling scored 34 points as Delaware rallied from a 15-point deficit with 9:21 remaining.

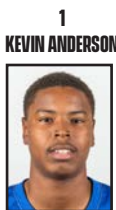

DELAWARE VS. NORTHEASTERN

Delaware leads the all-time series with Northeastern, 30-28, and the Blue Hens are 14-11 against the Huskies in Newark.

Northeastern has won four of the last five meetings in the Bob Carpenter Center, including two straight.

DELAWARE VS. NORTHEASTERN FIRST MEETING

Nate Darling scored 34 points and Delaware rallied from a 16-point deficit in the final 12 minutes as the Blue Hens posted an impressive 76-74 victory over Northeastern at Matthews Arena on Jan. 25.

Delaware trailed 58-42 with 11:51 remaining and was still down 15 with 9:21 to play, but the Blue Hens reeled off 13 straight points to pull within 63-61 on a Jacob Cushing three-pointer at the 7:13 mark.

UD finally drew even on two Kevin Anderson free throws with 3:55 to go, and took its first lead of the half at 74-73 when Darling hit a foul shot at the 1:27 mark.

Delaware still led by a point in the final seconds, when the Huskies' Tyson Walker lost the ball and was tied up by Cushing, giving Delaware possession with four seconds left. After Darling hit two clutch free throws, the Blue Hens intentionally fouled with 1.3 seconds on the clock.

Walker made the first, and after he intentionally missed the second, Dylan Painter grabbed the rebound to seal the victory.

Darling, who scored 28 points in the second half, went 11 of 19 from the field and 9 of 11 from the foul line on the afternoon. Anderson finished with 12 points, seven rebounds and six assists, while Ryan Allen added 10 points while shutting down NU's leading scorer Jordan Roland late in the game.

Roland led the Huskies with 27 points, but did not score in the final nine minutes.

Delaware got off to a strong start, as a Painter dunk and Darling layup gave the Blue Hens a 21-18 lead with nine minutes left in the half. However Northeastern answered with a 21-4 run, going in front 39-27 before taking a 42-29 advantage into the break.

LAST TIME OUT

William & Mary used a late 10-point run to take control for good and the Tribe held on for an 81-77 victory over Delaware Saturday afternoon at Kaplan Arena.

The Blue Hens, who had their seven-game winning streak snapped, led 61-60 when Ryan Allen drilled a jumper with 5:51 remaining. However William & Mary scored the next 10 points, going up 70-61 following a three-point play by Nathan Knight with 3:35 on the clock.

Delaware got back within three at 70-67, and again closed the gap to three twice in the final 20 seconds, but the Tribe hit five of six free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

Nate Darling continued his torrid stretch by scoring 36 points, as he buried five three-pointers and hit all 11 of his free throw attempts. Darling set the UD single season record for three-pointers made, and now has 89 triples on the season with at least three weeks remaining.

Kevin Anderson and Collin Goss each finished with 10 points on the day for the Blue Hens, while Justyn Mutts and Ryan Allen both contributed eight.

Knight posted his Division I leading 21st double-double of the season with 33 points and 12 rebounds for the Tribe. William & Mary shot 58.2 percent from the field, including 17 of 28 in the second half.

William & Mary led 32-30 with 5:19 left in the first half before the Blue Hens scored the next 11 points, including the final nine by Darling, to go in front 41-32 at the 2:54 mark. The Tribe answered with a pair of baskets before Dylan Painter scored inside, as Delaware took a 43-36 advantage at halftime.

William & Mary opened the second half with a 15-2 run, taking a 51-45 lead and forcing a Delaware timeout with 14:15 to play. The Blue Hens were down seven a minute later but responded with a 13-point spurt of their own to go up 59-53 on a Goss layup at the 9:18 mark.

However the Tribe scored seven straight to go back in front, and began their game-clinching run a minute later.

DELAWARE SEEKING EIGHTH 20-WIN SEASON IN UD HISTORY

With a win tonight, Delaware would reach 20 wins for the eighth time in program history.

HENS SURPASS LAST YEAR'S WIN TOTAL

With 19 wins this season, Delaware has already surpassed last year's win total.

Delaware has now increased its win total during all four years under Martin Ingelsby. UD won just seven games in 2015-16 prior to Ingelsby's arrival, but won 13 games during his first season. They then won 14 games in 2017-18, before finishing 17-16 a year ago.

DELAWARE WINS SEVEN STRAIGHT LEAGUE GAMES

Prior to Saturday's loss at William & Mary UD had won seven straight league games, tied for the second longest CAA win streak since the Blue Hens joined the league in 2001-02.

BLUE HENS LOOKING FOR DOUBLE DIGIT CONFERENCE WINS

Delaware is attempting to win double digit conference games for the 12th time in program history.

The Blue Hens have won double digit CAA games four times (10 in 2003-04, 12 in 2011-12, 13 in 2012-13, and 14 in 2013-14).

2019-20 UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

TWO WINNING STREAKS

Delaware, which opened the season with nine consecutive wins, won seven in a row from Jan. 18 through Feb. 13. This is the third season in which the Blue Hens have recorded two separate winning streaks of at least seven games, along with 1998-99 (8, 13) and 2000-01 (7, 7).

HENS WINS 10TH GAME OUTSIDE NEWARK

With last Thursday's win at Elon, Delaware won its 10th game outside of Newark. The Blue Hens have already won six road games and four neutral site contests.

UD has won 10 games away from the Carpenter Center for just the third time since 1999-2000. The 2013-14 squad won 15 road/neutral games, while the 2012-13 team also won 10.

DELAWARE WINNING CLOSE GAMES

Prior to the William & Mary loss, Delaware won its previous seven games by a total of 27 points. The Blue Hens are 7-1 in games decided by four points or less this season.

Delaware won three consecutive games in the final seconds from Jan. 18-25. Jacob Cushing buried a go-ahead three-pointer with five seconds left in the 79-78 victory over Elon, while Kevin Anderson then scored the tie-breaking layup with 0.3 seconds left in the 73-71 triumph at Hofstra. Anderson's shot was the top play on that night's ESPN SportsCenter.

The Blue Hens then held off Northeastern, 76-74, as Dylan Painter grabbed a rebounded off a Huskies' missed free throws with 1.3 seconds remaining.

Delaware won three straight games by two points or less, the fourth time UD has accomplished that since the 2002-03 season (also in 2012-13 and 2016-17). The Blue Hens had never won three games in a row by two points or less prior to 2002-03.

TALE OF TWO TEAMS

Northeastern is 7-7 in CAA games despite out-scoring its opponents by 81 points in those contests. Delaware is 9-5 in the conference despite being out-scored by two points in league games.

The Blue Hens' last eight CAA wins have all come by eight points or less. Conversely, Northeastern's seven CAA losses have come by a total of 18 points, and none by more than five.

INJURY UPDATE

Aleks Novakovich has missed the last 11 games with a stress fracture in his left foot, and will not play in tonight's game..

DARLING ON A TEAR

Nate Darling has scored 182 points (30.3 ppg) over his last six games, the most by a Blue Hen over a six-game stretch in school history.

CAPTAIN CLUTCH

Nate Darling went 9 of 10 from the free throw line, all in the last 55 seconds, to help hold off Towson. He then hit the game-winning basket with five seconds left in the 80-78 win over James Madison. Last Thursday he buried a three-pointer with 21 seconds left to put UD in front for good at Elon.

DARLING TIES UD 30-POINT MARK

Nate Darling scored 36 points at William & Mary, the fourth time this season he's eclipsed the 34-point mark. He also scored 34 at Northeastern on Jan. 25 and vs. Towson on Feb. 6, and scored a career-high 37 vs. UTSA on Nov. 10.

Darling is one of five Division I players to score at least 34 points four times this season: Markus Howard (Marquette, 6 times), Jhivvan Jackson (UTSA, 4), Mason Jones (Arkansas, 4), Nate Darling (Delaware, 4), Breein Tyree (Ole Miss, 3).

Darling is the first Blue Hen with four 30-point games in the same season since Mike Pegues also had four in 1999-2000.

Darling is the second player in UD history to score 34 points four times in a season, along with Pegues who also did it four times in 1998-99.

DARLING NEARING 600 POINTS

Nate Darling has scored 561 points this season, 12th most in a UD single season, and needs 39 more to reach 600. Only four players in UD history have scored 600 points in a season: Davon Usher (679 in 2013-14), Mike Pegues (675 in 1998-99, 667 in 1999-2000), Greg Smith (660 in 1996-97), and Devon Saddler (656 in 2012-13, 603 in 2011-12).

DARLING SETS UD SINGLE-SEASON 3-POINTERS MARK

Nate Darling made five three-pointers at William & Mary to set the UD record for three-pointers in a season. Darling has now made 89 triples, breaking the previous mark of 86 held by Ryan Allen in 2017-18 and John Gordon in 1998-99.

DARLING 14TH IN NATION IN SCORING

Nate Darling currently ranks third in the CAA and 14th in the nation by averaging 21.6 points per game.

A Blue Hen has averaged at least 20 points per game 10 times in program history, and none since Mike Pegues in both 1998-99 (21.8 ppg) and 1999-2000 (20.8 ppg).

DARLING AMONG NATION'S LEADERS IN THREE-POINTERS

Nate Darling ranks sixth in the nation with 89 three-pointers made, seventh with 3.42 three-pointers per game and 28th with a 40.5 three-point percentage.

DARLING LEADS NATION IN MINUTES PLAYED

Nate Darling leads Division I with 38.31 minutes played per game. George Tinsley of Binghamton ranks second with 38:21 minutes per game.

Darling has played at least 35 minutes in all but one of his 26 games this season (he played 27 minutes vs. Maryland Eastern Shore on Nov. 29).

DARLING FREE THROW STREAK

Nate Darling has made his last 29 free throw attempts. He hit his final eight foul shots vs. Towson, went 9 for 9 vs. James Madison, 1 for 1 at Elon, and 11 for 11 at William & Mary.

DELAWARE BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

For the 16th straight season, all University of Delaware men's basketball games will be carried on FM radio. All games will be carried on 94.7 WDSB. Scott Klatzkin and Bill Harman will call the action.

Additionally, all Blue Hen men's basketball home games and select road games will be broadcast by the UD student radio station, WVUD 91.3 FM.

Delaware currently leads the CAA and ranks 15th in the country with a 48.1 field goal percentage this season. The Blue Hens are also 32nd in the nation with a 76.0 free throw percentage and 46th with a 36.3 three-point percentage.

Ryan Allen currently ranks sixth in UD history with 201 three-pointers made. He has hit a three-pointer in all but six of his appearances for Delaware.

Allen connected on 86 three-pointers during his rookie season, tying the UD single season mark also held by John Gordon in 1998-99. That record was broken by Nate Darling on Saturday.

Allen hit a three-pointer in the first 29 games of his career, the second longest streak in school history. Peca Arsic drained a triple in 36 consecutive games from 1994-96.

BLUE HENS' COMEBACK AT NORTHEASTERN

Delaware rallied to defeat Northeastern on Jan. 25 despite being down 16 points (58-42) with 11:51 remaining and 15 points (63-48) with 9:21 remaining.

The 16-point deficit was the largest second half comeback since UD trailed William & Mary by 16 with 14:33 left before posting an 84-80 home victory on Jan. 21, 2015.

The Blue Hens rallied from their largest deficit with less than 10 minutes remaining since coming back from 20 points down to Charleston with 8:52 left while defeating the Cougars, 67-64, at the BCC on Feb. 5, 2014.

DELAWARE NAMED NABC TEAM OF THE WEEK

Following its impressive road wins at Hofstra and Northeastern, Delaware was named the NABC Division I Team of the Week on Jan. 30.

MUTTS HAS CAREER NIGHT VS. HOFSTRA

Justyn Mutts scored a career-high 30 points on 14 of 17 shooting from the field during the win at Hofstra. He also led UD with 13 rebounds to post his seventh double-double of the season.

Dylan Painter also had a double-double with 15 points and a career-high 12 boards. UD's frontcourt duo combined for 45 points and 25 rebounds while shooting 18 of 26 from the floor, as Delaware held a 48-28 advantage in points in the paint.

THREE PLAYERS WITH 30

With his huge game at Hofstra, Justyn Mutts became the third Blue Hen to score 30 points this season. Nate Darling scored 37 points while Kevin Anderson added 32 in Delaware's 91-79 win over UTSA on Nov. 10.

UD is one of six schools to have three different players reach the 30-point mark this year, along with Arkansas, Minnesota, Nevada, Toledo and UNC Asheville.

The Blue Hens have four active players who have scored 30 points at UD, as Ryan Allen scored 30 in a double overtime win at Towson last year.

DARLING NAMED TO HENSON AWARD MID-SEASON WATCH LIST

Nate Darling was one of 50 players named to the Lou Henson Award Mid-Season Watch List on Jan. 9.

The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player. Ryan Allen was one of 50 players named on the preseason watch list in November.

MUTTS SEEING DOUBLE

Justyn Mutts recorded four consecutive double-doubles from Nov. 19 through Dec. 2, and now has eight on the season. His 16 rebounds vs. Maryland Eastern Shore are the most by a Blue Hen since Marvin King-Davis had 18 vs. South Florida on Dec. 3, 2015.

Mutts posted consecutive 20-point, 15-rebound performances (22/16 vs. UMES, 24/15 vs. Columbia), becoming just the second Blue Hen in the last 50 years to accomplish that feat. Greg Smith had 22 points/15 rebounds vs. Widener on Dec. 22, 1996 and 24 points/16 rebounds at Virginia on Dec. 30, 1996.

UD SETS BEST START IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Delaware opened the season with nine consecutive wins, the best start in program history. The 1998-99 team held the previous record with eight straight victories to open the season.

DARLING, ANDERSON NAMED TO SUNSHINE SLAM TEAM

Nate Darling was named Most Valuable Player of the Sunshine Slam, while Kevin Anderson was selected to the All-Tournament Team.

Darling averaged 25.7 points and 5.7 rebounds during the three games in Kissimmee, Fla, leading the Blue Hens in scoring all three contests. He went 17 of 27 from three-point range, and poured in 37 points during the

Anderson converted two driving layups in the final 64 seconds to put Delaware in front for good in the victory over Southern Illinois. He then erupted for a career-high 32 points vs. UTSA.

The win over UTSA marked the first time in UD history that two Blue Hens scored at least 30 points in the same game.

DARLING HAS CAREER GAME VS. UTSA

Nate Darling scored a career-high 37 points during the win over UTSA on Nov. 10, as he finished 12 of 19 from the field including 8 of 10 from three-point range.

Darling's 37 points are tied for 12th most in a game in UD history, and the most since Davon Usher scored 42 vs. College of Charleston on Feb. 12, 2014.

Darling's eight three-pointers are one shy of the Blue Hen single game record of nine set last year by Ithiel Horton at UNCW.

BLUE HENS FEATURE OLDER STARTING LINEUP

Delaware is featuring a veteran starting lineup this season, as all five current starters are 21 years old.

Collin Goss, who was the first Blue Hen off the bench Saturday, is 23 while Jacob Cushing, the second player off the bench, is 21.

INGELSBY SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

Head coach Martin Ingelsby is currently in his fourth year leading the Blue Hens. On June 20, he signed a two-year contract extension through the 2023-24 season.

CARR, ARLETTI SIGN NLI'S WITH BLUE HENS

Andrew Carr and Gianmarco Arletti signed National Letters of Intent with the UD program in November.

Carr, a 6-9 forward from West Chester, Pa., averaged 19 points and eight rebounds per game last year during his junior season. He led West Chester East High School to a 21-7 record, an appearance in the PIAA District I Class 5A title game and the Vikings' first state tournament berth in 17 years.

Carr's father, Phil, and his uncle, Tim, both played for the Blue Hens in the 1980's and each served as team captain during their senior seasons.

Arletti, a 6-5 guard from Bologna, Italy, is currently in his second year at Holy Cross Prep Academy in Delran, N.J. He averaged 17.2 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.1 steals last year as the Lancers finished 17-10 and won a share of the Burlington County League Independent Division title.

Arletti also competed for Italy in the FIBA 3x3 U18 Europe Cup Qualifier this summer on Aug. 3-4.

GARDNER SITTING OUT SEASON AS REDSHIRT

Junior guard Reggie Gardner is sitting out this season after transferring to Delaware from North Carolina Central during the summer.

Gardner appeared in 33 games for the Eagles last year, averaging 5.8 points per game. He was a second team All-MEAC selection in 2017-18, when he started all 35 games and averaged 10.8 points per outing.

Martin Ingelsby is currently in his fourth season as University of Delaware men's basketball head coach during the 2019-20 season.

On June 20, Ingelsby signed a two-year extension through the 2023-24 season.

After spending the previous 13 years on the Notre Dame coaching staff from 2003-16, Ingelsby led the Blue Hens to 13 victories during his first season in Newark, including a win over Hofstra in the CAA Tournament.

During his second year Delaware won 14 games, and earned a CAA Tournament victory for the second consecutive year by defeating Elon in the first round.

Last season the Blue Hens finished 17-16 and were fifth in the CAA standings, posting their highest win total and highest CAA finish in five years. UD increased its win total for the third straight season, and advanced to the CAA Tournament Semifinals for the first since 2013-14. Delaware erased a 14-point halftime deficit in the 85-79 win over William & Mary in the quarterfinals, the largest halftime comeback in CAA Tournament history.

A Blue Hen earned the CAA Rookie of the Year award in both of Ingelsby's first two years, while Delaware is the only CAA school to earn an All-Rookie Team selection in each of the last three seasons.

Ingelsby, the 24th head coach in UD men's basketball history, is a native of Berwyn, Pa., and was a standout point guard for Notre Dame from 1997-2001. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Wagner College during the 2002-03 campaign before returning to his alma mater as Notre Dame's coordinator of basketball operations. He spent six seasons in that position before being promoted to assistant coach in July 2009, a position he held for seven years. During his tenure in South Bend, Ingelsby, 39, helped lead the Irish to eight NCAA Tournament appearances.

"I really believe this is a great fit for me," Ingelsby said at the time of his hiring. "Coming from Notre Dame, to have the opportunity to be the head coach at a place like the University of Delaware is something I could not pass up. This is a great academic institution and a great community and we will be able to recruit young men who will excel in the classroom and on the basketball court. We want to win and we want to win the right way. It all starts with high character and highly competitive kids who will represent this basketball program and this University in a first-class manner on and off the basketball court. I can't wait to get started."

"We want to dream big dreams and talk about winning CAA championships and getting into the NCAA Tournament. There is a process that goes into place in building a basketball program and we will work hard to get there. Together, with the student body, faculty, alumni, community and fans, we can accomplish great things."

"I am incredibly excited for our student-athletes, our university and all of Blue Hen Nation to welcome Coach Ingelsby," said University of Delaware Director of Athletics and Recreation Services Chrissi Rawak. "Martin demands excellence in all that he does and has a keen focus on getting young men to go beyond their limits academically, athletically, and in the community. He will have an immediate impact not only on our basketball program, but on our entire department."

While in South Bend Ingelsby primarily worked with the Notre Dame guards and played an integral role in elevating the program's national recruiting efforts. The Fighting Irish reaped the benefits of that recruiting success over his final two seasons as Notre Dame advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight in both 2015 and 2016.

The Fighting Irish enjoyed a magical 2014-15 campaign as Notre Dame won the Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament title, made its first Elite Eight appearance since 1979, and posted the second 30-win season in school history by finishing with a 32-6 mark.

Despite losing Jerian Grant and Pat Connaughton to the NBA, Notre Dame followed with another outstanding campaign in 2015-16, advancing to the ACC Tournament Semifinals before making its second straight Elite Eight appearance.

Ingelsby helped mentor Grant, a first team consensus All-American and unanimous first team All-ACC pick in 2015 before getting selected by the New York Knicks with the 19th pick in the 2015 NBA Draft. He also worked extensively with Connaughton, who played in a school-record 139 games and was the 41st pick in the 2015 NBA

Draft by the Brooklyn Nets. That season marked the first time since 1992 that two Notre Dame players were selected in the same year of the NBA Draft.

Under Ingelsby's tutelage, Irish point guard Demetrius Jackson enjoyed an outstanding season in 2015-16, earning second team All-ACC and NCAA East Regional All-Tournament Team accolades.

Ingelsby helped lead Notre Dame to a school-record seven consecutive 20-win seasons from 2006-13, while the Irish posted 97 victories from 2009-13, the most wins in a four-year period in school history. During Ingelsby's 13 seasons at his alma mater, Irish teams went 290-146 (.665) and the program posted a 168-76 record with six NCAA Tournament appearances in seven years once he assumed assistant coaching duties.

During Ingelsby's lone season at Wagner in 2002-03, he was part of the most successful season in school history as the Seahawks finished 21-11, won both the Northeast Conference regular season and tournament titles, and earned the school's first-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament.

Ingelsby was Notre Dame's starting point guard during three of his four seasons in South Bend. As a senior in 2000-01 he averaged 8.2 points and a team-high 6.4 assists as a starter in all 30 games. A team captain during his senior year, he guided the Irish to a 20-10 overall record and the Big East's West Division championship, the school's first ever conference title. Additionally, Notre Dame advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament after earning a berth in the field for the first time in more than a decade in Mike Brey's first season.

Ingelsby also started for the Irish as a freshman and sophomore, and led the team in assists during three of his four seasons. He handed out a team-high 150 assists as a freshman and earned a spot on the 1998 Big East All-Rookie Team.

A two-time member of the Big East Academic All-Star Team, Ingelsby was the recipient of the Notre Dame Club of St. Joseph Valley Rockne Student-Athlete Award during his senior season. He graduated from the Mendoza College of Business with a bachelor's degree in marketing in May, 2001.

Ingelsby enjoyed an outstanding career at Archbishop Carroll High School in suburban Philadelphia where he finished as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,425 points and led his teams to an 80-12 record during his three years on the varsity squad.

Following his senior year in 1997, he won the prestigious Markward Award, given annually to the top high school player in the Philadelphia area, and was the Gatorade Player of the Year for Philadelphia while also earning All-Catholic League honors three times. Ingelsby was also named South Catholic League MVP as a senior and was a McDonald's All-America honorable mention selection.

Ingelsby's father, Tom, was a standout guard at Villanova from 1970-73 and served as his son's head coach at Archbishop Carroll. Tom led Villanova to the 1971 NCAA championship game and played for the Atlanta Hawks during the 1973-74 season and for the Spirits of St. Louis in the ABA the following year.

Ingelsby and his wife, Colleen, are the parents of twins Will and Kate, and sons Jack and Ben.
