## OPENING TIP

• Five of Northeastern's eight CAA losses have come by a total of nine points; The Huskies are 1-6 this season (1-5 CAA) in one-possession games

• The Huskies lost by more than 7 points on Thursday night at Delaware for the first time since Nov. 25, 2019, falling to South Alabama, 74-62; 12 of 14 losses have been by single digits

• The Huskies are 8-0 this season when shooting 50 percent or better and 0-9 when their opponent shoots at least 50 percent

• Northeastern is 12-3 when leading with 10 minutes remaining, and 1-11 when tied or trailing

• NU holds the league's second-best road record over the last three years at 16-10 (.615), behind Hofstra's 20-6 (.769) mark

• Coach **Bill Coen** moved into second all-time in CAA history with 159 wins (postseason+regular season). He trails former George Mason and current Miami (FL) coach Jim Larranaga's 183 wins

• Senior **Jordan Roland** reached 1,000 points in his Northeastern career in just 56 games (18.0 ppg) and is No. 6 in the NCAA in scoring average (23.0); He was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Watch List and ESPN.com's Top 25 players earlier this season

• Senior **Bolden Brace** became the 39th player in program history to reach 1,000 points; **Brace** is No. 5 all-time with 216 3-pointers made, and the Huskies are 7-3 this season when he reaches at last 10 points and 5 rebounds

## LAST GAME SUMMARY DELAWARE 70, NORTHEASTERN 48

GAME 27 | Bob Carpenter | Newark, Del. | Feb. 20

**Jordan Roland** scored 16 points and Tyson Walker finished with 10 as Northeastern dropped a 70-48 decision to Delaware on Thursday inside the Bob Carpenter Center. The Huskies lost by more than 7 points for the first time since Nov. 25, 2019.

The Blue Hens shot 54 percent in the game and were opportunistic by scoring 24 points off 14 NU turnovers. The Huskies made 6-of-21 shots from behind the arc to shoot less than 31 percent from 3-point range for the sixth straight game.

Delaware's Nate Darling scored all 17 of his points for the Blue Hens in the first half. Justyn Mutts added 13 and eight rebounds, while Ryan Allen finished with 10.

## THE COEN FILE

Reigning CAA Coach of the Year **Bill Coen** enters his 14th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program in 2019-20. He is currently second in school history with 237 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86. Coen advanced into second all-time in CAA history with 159 CAA wins (league+postseason) trailing only former George Mason, and current Miami (FL) coach, Jim Larranaga (185, 1998-2011).

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 13 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 32 All-CAA honors, including 10 first team accolades and seven All-Rookie selections. Nineteen of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and eight Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have proven that they are contenders in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 10 of Coen's 13 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern also has appeared in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals in all 13 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals seven times, and to the title game four times, including back-to-back appearances and two Championship titles, one in 2014-15 and the other in 2018-19. Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 13 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

In 2018-19, Coen and the Huskies captured the CAA Tournament title for the second time in the last five seasons, returning to the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies finished with a 23-11 record, netting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time during Coen's tenure and the first time as a program since four-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-87. The Huskies brought a seven-game win-streak into the national tournament where they faced blue blood and No. 17 Kansas in the second round. Following these accomplishments, Coen was tabbed as a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award for the second time in his career (2013). Coen coached Vasa Pusica to All-CAA First team, NABC First Team All-Region and USBWA All-District honors while Jordan Roland earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team.

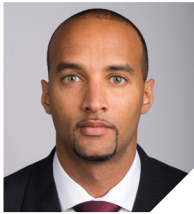

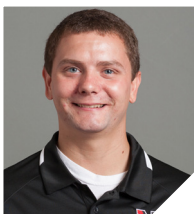
