TIPPING OFF

- Northeastern (8-9 CAA) enters Saturday's regular season finale ranked in sole possession of fifth place in the CAA standings.
- The Huskies have clinched the No. 5 seed in the 2020 CAA tournament, which will take place between March 11 and March 14 at Elon's Schar Center.
- NU is guaranteed a 2:30 p.m. tip-off in Thursday's CAA quarterfinal round against fourth-seeded Towson, with which the Huskies split the 2019-20 regular season series (home team went 2-0).
- The Huskies have clinched their fifth consecutive CAA quarterfinal berth - the program's longest streak during its conference tenure.
- · With a win and a Towson loss, Northeastern would share fourth place in the year-end CAA standings with the Tigers and tie the Huskies' program record for best CAA regular season finish (2012-13, 2017-18).

ROUND ONE AGAINST THE PRIDE

- · Senior forward Ayanna Dbublin scored a season high, 16 points, as Northeastern rolled to the 74-51 win against Hofstra at Matthews Arena during both teams' CAA regular season opener (Jan. 5).
- The Huskies enjoyed their best shooting game of the 2019-20 season, converting 56 percent of their attempts from the field, including a 71-percent clip inside the 3-point line.
- NU forced 25 turnovers out of the Pride, sporting the dominant, 31-12 advantage in points off turnovers.

THANK YOU. SENIORS

- · Northeastern celebrated Senior Day before its Feb. 23 win against Towson. The Huskies honored the three members of their 2019-20 senior class: Rachel Aho, Courtney Redcross and Shannon Todd.
- Together, Northeastern's 2019-20 senior class has earned 60 victories during the last four seasons and are three wins shy of tying the 2018-19 senior class for the seventh most victories by a four-year NU class all-time.
- The Huskies' trio of seniors helped NU earn national postseason tournament berths in the 2018 Women's Basketball Invitational and the 2019 WNIT.

TOP OF THE HILL

- · Sophomore forward Alexis Hill upped her career scoring high to 28 points during Northeastern's most recent outing at College of Charleston (March 1).
- · Hill paired her 28 points with 12 rebounds and six steals, recording the fifth double-double and the fourth 20-point scoring game of her 2019-20 season.
- From Jan. 10 to Jan. 19, Hill posted four consecutive double-doubles - the first four of her collegiate career. During the stretch, she averaged 15.0 points and 11.8 rebounds across her 35.8 minutes per game.
- On the defensive side, she ranks among the top 30 NCAA Division I players in steals per game (2.6), ranking second among CAA players in the category behind Towson's Kionna Jeter (3.3).

CURRENCE'S CALLING

- Six games after dropping 23 points during Northeastern's Feb. 2 win against UNCW, sophomore guard Kendall Currence etched a new career scoring high - 24 points on Feb. 21 against James Madison.
- · Against JMU, Currence scored 16 of her career high, 24 points, during the fourth quater, where she shot identical five-for-six marks from the field and from the foul line.
- The NU sophomore has averaged 11.2 points across her 15 career February games.

TENACIOUS TODD

- On Feb. 21, senior guard Shannon Todd became the 22nd member of Northeastern's 1,000-point scoring club, fittingly reaching the milestone upon draining a 3-pointer from the right wing.
- Todd enters Saturday's game 21 points shy of tying Kash Cannon for 21st place on the Huskies' all-time scoring list (1,053 career points).
- Northeastern is 10-3 when Todd scores 10 or more points.
- · She is the sixth NU player all-time to eclipse 150 career 3-point field goals:

CONTROLLING THE ROCK

- Northeastern ranks among the top 60 NCAA Division I programs in turnovers forced per game (18.4). The Huskies are 7-4 when inducing 20 or more turnovers from their opponents.
- On the flip side, the Huskies rank outside the top 300 NCAA Division I programs in turnovers committed per game (19.2). NU is 6-9 this season when committing 20 or more turnovers.

RÉSUMÉ BUILDERS

- · As of Feb. 27, Northeastern held the fourth highest RPI ranking among CAA programs (No. 127), but has since slipped to No. 149.
- · As of March 6, the Huskies ranked No. 28 in non-conference strength of schedule, as five of their first six opponents of the 2019-20 season today rank among the top 60 RPI positions (three among the top 30).
- · Nov. 5 vs. South Dakota: Northeastern held a 10-point, fourth-quarter lead against South Dakota with three minutes remaining during its season opener at Cabot Center. As of March 3, the Coyotes possessed a 27-2 record, ranked No. 12 in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll, ranked No. 17 in the AP top 25 and ranked No. 1 in collegeinsider. com's Women's Mid-Major Top 25 poll.
- · Northeastern also held fourth-quarter leads against two defending conference champions in Fordham (L, 58-74) and Maine (W, 66-58).
- Dec. 4 at Harvard: The Huskies defeated Harvard, which then ranked No. 19 in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25. The victory provided NU with its second against a mid-major ranked opponent during as many seasons (No. 15 Maine - Dec. 2018).
- · Jan. 10 at Drexel: Northeastern held Drexel (then ranked No. 23 in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25) to its fourth lowest field goal percentage of the 2019-20 season (29.4%).
- · Jan. 26 at James Madison: Northeastern limited James Madison (then ranked No. 6 in the Women's

Mid-Major Top 25) to 67 points on offense - the second lowest scoring total NU had allowed against JMU at the Convocation Center during series history (2009 CAA quarterfinals). The Huskies also induced 18 turnovers the third most the Dukes have committed during CAA play. NU matched JMU in scoring across the second and third quarters (32-32).

DEFENSIVE MENTALITY

• Northeastern has kept 13 of its 17 CAA opponents below the 70-point scoring threshold, including 10 below the team's 64-point regulation benchmark.

YOUTH IN NUMBERS

- Northeastern's underclassmen have contributed in a big way to the Huskies. With two seniors in its current rotation, Northeastern's underclassmen have accounted for 76 percent of the Huskies' total minutes and 76 percent of the team's offensive production.
- · Considering Mide Oriyomi (Jan. 13) and Mossi Staples (Dec. 16), NU is one of two CAA programs to have wit-

nessed multiple first-year players earn weekly recognition this season (James Madison).

· Rookie guard Anna Boruta became the first member of Northeastern's 2019-20 freshman class to score in double figures when she piled on 11 points against Yale, shooting three-for-five from downtown.

BATTLE TESTED

- Two of Northeastern's non-conference opponents are currently ranked in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25 poll: South Dakota (No. 1), Central Michigan (No. 10). A third opponent - Yale - is currently receiving votes.
- · As of March 6, the Huskies have combined to play eight games against teams that have either been ranked nationally or ranked among the Women's Mid-Major Top 25. Northeastern's lone win took place against mid-major No. 19 Harvard on Dec. 4.
- NU kept No. 1/1 Oregon to one field goal during a four-minute stretch during the first quarter of their Nov. 11 meeting. The Huskies also held national Player of the Year candidate Sabrina Ionescu to a tie for her fifth lowest scoring total of the season (12 points) on 33-percent shooting.

CHALLENGES AHEAD

- Northeastern's 2019-20 non-conference schedule was filled with eight programs that advanced to the postseason a year ago:

CLARK COMES ALIVE

• Between Jan. 12 and Jan. 31, junior point guard Stella Clark averaged 15.5 points, 6.3 rebounds, 4.5 assists and

- 37.5 minutes across a six-game stretch (NU went 4-2).
- · Clark, a former five-time CAA Rookie of the Week selection during the 2017-18 season, was named the CAA Player of the Week on Dec. 16.

STEALING THE SHOW

- · Northeastern registered 18 steals during its Dec. 21 victory at Maine.
- The Huskies have recorded 12 or more steals during four games this season - something NU managed to accomplish once during the 2018-19 campaign.

WINNING STREAK MOMENTS

- Oriyomi's first two collegiate starts both took place against James Madison (Jan. 26, Feb. 21).
- She was named the CAA Rookie of the Week on Jan. 13, becoming the second member of the Huskies' rookie class to receive the recognition (Mossi Staples).

· Kelly Cole, a coaching veteran with more than two decades of experience and three NCAA regional semifinal appearances, begins her fifth season as the head coach of the Northeastern women's basketball team during 2018-19.
