OPENING TIP

- The Huskies are 17-11 all-time in the CAA tournament and are making their third consecutive appearance in the semifinals; NU made at least the semis in 7 of the last 8 years
- Northeastern has won its last two semifinal game appearances and are 4-4 all-time in the semifinals of the CAA
- The Red and Black are 3-3 all-time as the No. 6 seed in the CAA tournament
- NU has a league-best four CAA Championship Game appearances since 2013, winning in 2015 and '19: Charleston, Hofstra, UNCW and William & Mary each have two
- 6 of 9 league losses came by a total of 12 points, and the Huskies finished 1-6 in onepossession games during the CAA season
- · Coach Bill Coen moved into second all-time in CAA history with 162 wins (postseason+regular season). He trails former George Mason and current Miami (FL) coach Jim Larranaga's 183
- Senior Jordan Roland reached 1,000 points in his Northeastern career in just 56 games (18.0 ppg) and is No. 7 in the NCAA in scoring average (22.3); He was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Watch List and ESPN.com's Top 25 players earlier this season
- Senior Bolden Brace is No. 4 all-time with 223 3-pointers made, and the Huskies are 10-5 this season when he reaches at last 10 points and 4 rebounds

Maxime Boursiquot led four Northeastern players in double figures with 16 points, while Bolden Brace finished with 15 points and a team-best eight rebounds to lead the sixth-seeded Huskies over No. 3 seed Towson, 72-62, on Sunday night in the Hercules Tires CAA Men's Basketball Championship quarterfinals at the Entertainment and Sports Arena. The Huskies led for nearly 38 minutes and advance to the semifinals for the third consecutive year.

Tyson Walker returned to the lineup after missing the final two regular season games and scored 13 points, adding four assists. Shaquille Walters reached double figures for the fourth straight game with 14 points, going 5-for-5 from the free-throw line.

- Redshirt senior *Jordan Roland* is one of the top scorers in the country and leads the CAA with 22.3 points per game, No. 7 in the country
- He led the country in scoring over the first month of the season, and has remained inside the top 15 all season long
- **Roland** has scored 20 or more points in 16 of 31 games this year and leads the CAA with six 30-point games and in free throw percentage at .893 (12th in NCAA)
- He has a team-best 61 career double-digit scoring games and ranks No. 20 all-time on the Northeastern all-time scoring list in just 65 games for the Huskies (18.3 per game)





THE COEN FILE

Bill Coen enters his 14th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program in 2019-20. He is currently second in school history with 240 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86. Coen advanced into second all-time in CAA history with 162 CAA wins (league+postseason) trailing only former George Mason, and current Miami (FL) coach, Jim Larranaga (185, 1998-2011).

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 13 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 32 All-CAA honors, including 10 first team accolades and seven All-Rookie selections. Nineteen of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and eight Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have proven that they are contenders in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 10 of Coen's 13 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern also has appeared in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals in all 13 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals seven times, and to the title game four times, including back-to-back appearances and two Championship titles, one in 2014-15 and the other in 2018-19. Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 13 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

In 2018-19, Coen and the Huskies captured the CAA Tournament title for the second time in the last five seasons, returning to the NCAA Tournament. The Huskies finished with a 23-11 record, netting back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time during Coen's tenure and the first time as a program since four-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-87. The Huskies brought a seven-game win-streak into the national tournament where they faced blue blood and No. 17 Kansas in the second round. Following these accomplishments, Coen was tabbed as a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award for the second time in his career (2013). Coen coached Vasa Pusica to All-CAA First team, NABC First Team All-Region and USBWA All-District honors while Jordan Roland earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team.
