- The Huskies played the 17th-toughest schedule during the non-conference season (per ESPN's College Basketball Power Index); Northeastern faced three Power 5 opponents for the first time since the 2018-19 season when the Huskies faced four Power 5 opponents (1-3), including an NCAA tournament loss to
- · Northeastern played just two games on its original 2020-21 schedule, UMass at home (12/13) and at Georgia (12/22); NU added road games at Syracuse (12/16), Old Dominion (12/20) and No. 9/8 West Virginia
- The Huskies are 4-0 in CAA play for just the fourth time in program history and looking to start 5-0 for the first time since 2016-17
- · Northeastern has seven players born outside the United States, third-most in the country behind Maine's 11 and Cal Baptist's eight
- The Huskies are one of the youngest teams in the country with just three upper classmen and no seniors; This is the first time in head coach Bill Coen's 15 years that he has coached a team without a senior (Last team to not have a senior was 2002-03)
- · Coach Coen's 246 wins at Northeastern is four shy of the all-time record of 250, set by Jim Calhoun from 1972-86: He is second all-time in CAA history with 167 wins in league regular season and postseason play
- The Huskies are the winningest program in CAA play since Coach Coen's arrival in 2006 with 150 conference victories; The Huskies have a CAA-best five CAA Championship game appearances since 2013
- The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three consecutive CAA Championship Game appearances (2018, '19, '20), earning their ninth NCAA tournament bid in 2019
- The Huskies lost nearly 70 percent of their scoring from last year, including CAA scoring champion Jordan Roland (21.9 ppg), Bolden Brace (10.5 ppg), Tomas Murphy (9.3 ppg), Max Boursiquot (9.0 ppg), Guilien Smith (3.3 ppg) and Myles Franklin (3.0 ppg)

LAST GAME SUMMARY NORTHEASTERN 67. HOFSTRA 56

Game 10 | Cabot Center | Boston, Mass.

Tyson Walker scored a game-high 23 points, including a career-best 7-of-13 from behind the arc, and Quirin Emanga tallied a career-best 14 points to lead Northeastern past Hofstra, 67-56, on Saturday inside the Cabot Center on Solomon Court. The Huskies made a season-high 15 3-pointers, including 9-of-18 in the second half.

Jason Strong was the final Husky to reach double figures with 11 points. Jahmyl Telfort led NU on the glass with a career-best nine boards.

The Huskies led for a majority of the first half and built a nine-point lead at halftime, 30-21. Hofstra started the second half on a 17-0 run to take the lead before Walker made three consecutive triples, including two from way downtown, to rally Northeastern to a 16-1 run over seven minutes to take back control of the game. NU outscored the Pride 37-18 over the final 12:44 to earn the victory.

Northeastern attempted 37 threes in the game, the most since taking 36 at Elon on Feb. 23, 2017. The Huskies scored 10 points off Hofstra's 17 turnovers and the nine turnovers for Northeastern is a season low.

WALKER NAMED CAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Sophomore **Tyson Walker** earned his second CAA Player of the Week recognition on Monday after averaging 17.0 points and 7.0 assists per game
- Walker handed out a career-high nine assists in the come-from-behind victory over Hofstra (1/7), adding 11 points as the Huskies came back from 19 points down in the second half to win 81-78 in overtime
- On Saturday (1/9), Walker answered when Northeastern needed him most, going 5-for-8 from behind the arc and scoring a game-high 23 points, including three straight 3-pointers, to lead a 16-1 run as the Huskies swept the Pride, 67-56, for the first time since the 2014-15 season

THE ARC

- The Huskies have limited their opponents to just 28 percent shooting from behind the arc, tops in the CAA and 17th in the country
- Northeastern held Syracuse (.111) and No. 8 West Virginia (.095) under 12 percent shooting from beyond the arc, and limited conference opponents to 27 percent shooting from long range, tops in the CAA
- NU made a season-high 15-of-37 shots from 3-point range, including 9-for-18 in the second half in the 11-point win over Hofstra (1/9) inside the Cabot Center
- The 37 attempts is the most since taking 36 shots from behind the arc at Elon in a double-overtime win on Feb. 23, 2017

#00 JASON STRONG says ...

I chose the word *equality* to wear on my jersey because it is a baseline word for what should be present in the world. The definition is, the state of being equal, especially in status, rights, and opportunities. That is what is needed in America to continue to make it a better place. By having this on my jersey I want to remind people that we can never stop working toward equality.

#10 GREG EBOIGBODIN says ...

Since the beginning of October, Nigerians have taken to the streets to protest police brutality in their country. Young people in particular are mobilizing in major Nigerian cities, calling for the abolition of the SARS special police task force that has been operating for more than two decades. The task force, which is under government jurisdiction, has been accused of inflicting severe human rights violations on its citizens. And people have had enough.

The **#EndSARS** hashtag dates back to at least 2017, when people began using it online share their experiences of violence and assault at the hands of SARS. This most recent protest was launched by an October 8 viral video which allegedly showed SARS officers killing a young man in one of the country's southern states. While authorities have denied that the video is real, according to Al Jazeera, the man who filmed it has been arrested, leading to more outrage from citizens. And this recent round of mass protests has led to further violence against the protestors themselves, including 25 people who were shot in Lagos, Nigeria while demonstrating on October 21, with an unnamed witness telling BBC News that soldiers "pulled up... and they started firing directly" at protestors. An investigation by Amnesty International also found that Nigerian army and police killed at least 12 peaceful protesters on October 20.

In addition to protesting police brutality, demonstrators are also speaking out against Nigeria's bad governance, citing grievances such as poor educational opportunities for citizens.

#24 SHAQUILLE WALTERS says ...

My word *revolutionise* is a testament to the facts that there needs to be fundermental change and we are all collectively responsible to doing so, because the inequalities that exist within the interchanging parts of our society come in various forms and sizes.



NCAA APPEARANCES

- The Huskies made their ninth ever appearance in the NCAA tournament in 2019, posting a record of 3-9 in the Big Dance
- Head Coach *Bill Coen* made his ninth appearance in the Big Dance and second as a head coach in 2019
- Coen previously helped Rhode Island make two tournament appearances as an assistant coach (1993, 1997), while helping Boston College to five tournaments as an assistant/associate head coach (2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006)



THE COEN FILE

Bill Coen enters his 15th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program. He is currently second in school history with 246 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86, and second all-time in CAA history with 167 CAA wins (league+postseason), trailing Miami (FL) head coach Jim Larranaga's 183 wins at Georgia Mason from 1998-2011.

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his previous 14 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 33 All-CAA honors, including 10 first-team accolades and eight All-Rookie selections. A total of 25 of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and 12 Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have remained the most consistent in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 11 of Coen's 14 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern has appeared in the CAA tournament quarterfinals in 13 of 14 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals eight times, and to the title game five times, including three straight appearances (2018-20) and two titles (2015, '19). Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 14 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three straight CAA title game appearances in 2019-20, falling just short to top-seeded Hofstra, 70-61, in Washington, D.C. Northeastern is a CAA-best 11-4 in the league tournament since 2015, and have a pair of NCAA tournament appearances in 2015 and '19.

Northeastern has won a league-best 147 league games during Coen's leadership, and won a CAA-best three regular-season titles since joining the league in 2005-06 (2012-13, 2014-15, 2017-18). The Huskies have appeared in the NCAA postseason in two straight seasons with an NIT appearance in 2018 and NCAA tournament appearance in 2019. The NCAA canceled all winter and spring championships in 2020, immediately following the 2020 CAA Championship.
