- The Huskies played the 17th-toughest non-conference schedule (per ESPN's College Basketball Power Index); Northeastern faced three Power 5 opponents for the first time since the 2018-19 season when the Huskies took on four, including No. 17 Kansas in the NCAA tournament
- · Northeastern played just two games on its original 2020-21 schedule, UMass at home (12/13) and at Georgia (12/22); NU added road games at Syracuse (12/16), Old Dominion (12/20) and No. 9/8 West Virginia (12/29)
- The Huskies are 6-0 in CAA play for just the third time in program history and looking to start 7-0 for just the second time in program history (Won first 8 CAA games of 2012-13 season and won regular-season title at 14-4)
- · Northeastern has seven players born outside the United States, third-most in the country behind Maine's 11 and Cal Baptist's eight
- The Huskies rank 319-of-343 active D1 teams in the country in terms of experience with just three upper classmen and no seniors (KenPom.com); This is the first time in head coach Bill Coen's 15 years that he has coached a team without a senior (Last team to not have a senior was 2002-03)
- The Huskies lost 70% of their scoring from a season ago, and replaced it with freshmen and sophomores that account for 65% of the team's offense (next closest in the CAA is Towson at 55%)
- · Coach Coen's 248 wins at Northeastern is two shy of the all-time record of 250, set by Jim Calhoun from 1972-86; He is second all-time in CAA history with 169 wins in league regular season and postseason play
- · The Huskies are the winningest program in CAA play since Coach *Coen*'s arrival in 2006 with 152 conference victories; The Huskies have a CAA-best five CAA Championship game appearances since 2013
- The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three consecutive CAA Championship Game appearances (2018, '19, '20), earning their ninth NCAA tournament bid in 2019

LAST GAME SUMMARY **NORTHEASTERN 68, CHARLESTON 66**

Game 12 | TD Arena | Charleston, S.C.

Chris Doherty tipped in his only field goal of the game with 15 seconds left, while Jahmyl Telfort scored a team-high 16 and Shaquille Walters posted 15 points and eight rebounds to lead Northeastern to a 68-66 win over College of Charleston last Sunday at TD Arena.

Tyson Walker finished with 10 points and a game-high six assists, reaching double figures for the ninth straight game. Eight of the nine players that entered the game scored for Northeastern.

The Huskies led by as many as 15 points in the first half, but the Cougars used a 14-0 run early in the second half to take a 42-40 lead. NU rallied to tie the game with four minutes remaining, and picked up two late stops to preserve the tip in by Doherty.

The Huskies are 6-0 in CAA play for just the third time in program history. The best start for Northeastern came in 2012-13, winning its first eight league games en route to capturing the CAA regular-season title at 14-4.



THE ARC

- The Huskies have limited their opponents to just 28 percent shooting from behind the arc, tops in the CAA and 26th in the country
- Northeastern held Syracuse (.111) and No. 8 West Virginia (.095) under 12 percent shooting from beyond the arc, and held CAA opponents under 32 percent shooting from long range in 4-of-6 games
- NU made a season-high 15-of-37 shots from 3-point range, including 9-for-18 in the second half in the 11-point win over Hofstra (1/9) inside the Cabot Center
- The 37 attempts is the most since taking 36 shots from behind the arc at Elon in a double-overtime win on Feb. 23, 2017

WALKER MAKING CASE FOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- Sophomore **Tyson Walker** has been named CAA Player of the Week a leaguebest two times (Dec. 14, Jan. 11)
- He leads the league with 64 assists, second with 23 steals and eight in scoring (16.2 per game)
- A native of Westbury, N.Y., Walker has reached double figures in nine straight games and has four 20-plus point games this season, No. 3 in the CAA
- Walker dished out a career-high nine assists at Hofstra (1/7) and swiped a career-best five steals in the opener at UMass (12/11)
- The 6-foot guard rallied the Huskies against Elon (1/3), Hofstra (1/9) and Charleston (1/16) when it looked like leads were slipping away

#00 JASON STRONG says ...

I chose the word *equality* to wear on my jersey because it is a baseline word for what should be present in the world. The definition is, the state of being equal, especially in status, rights, and opportunities. That is what is needed in America to continue to make it a better place. By having this on my jersey I want to remind people that we can never stop working toward equality.

#10 GREG EBOIGBODIN says ...

Since the beginning of October, Nigerians have taken to the streets to protest police brutality in their country. Young people in particular are mobilizing in major Nigerian cities, calling for the abolition of the SARS special police task force that has been operating for more than two decades. The task force, which is under government jurisdiction, has been accused of inflicting severe human rights violations on its citizens. And people have had enough.

The **#EndSARS** hashtag dates back to at least 2017, when people began using it online share their experiences of violence and assault at the hands of SARS. This most recent protest was launched by an October 8 viral video which allegedly showed SARS officers killing a young man in one of the country's southern states. While authorities have denied that the video is real, according to Al Jazeera, the man who filmed it has been arrested, leading to more outrage from citizens. And this recent round of mass protests has led to further violence against the protestors themselves, including 25 people who were shot in Lagos, Nigeria while demonstrating on October 21, with an unnamed witness telling BBC News that soldiers "pulled up... and they started firing directly" at protestors. An investigation by Amnesty International also found that Nigerian army and police killed at least 12 peaceful protesters on October 20.

In addition to protesting police brutality, demonstrators are also speaking out against Nigeria's bad governance, citing grievances such as poor educational opportunities for citizens.

#24 SHAQUILLE WALTERS says ...

My word *revolutionise* is a testament to the facts that there needs to be fundermental change and we are all collectively responsible to doing so, because the inequalities that exist within the interchanging parts of our society come in various forms and sizes.

- Currently serving his second stint with DePaul as head coach (2002-05,

- A native of Montreal, Quebec, Randriasalama is a 6-foot-3 guard that shot nearly 40 percent from behind the arc last season.

- The Huskies made their ninth ever appearance in the NCAA tournament in 2019, posting a record of 3-9 in the Big Dance

- Coen previously helped Rhode Island make two tournament appearances as an assistant coach (1993, 1997), while helping Boston College to five tournaments as an assistant/associate head coach (2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006)



THE COEN FILE

Bill Coen enters his 15th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program. He is currently second in school history with 248 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86, and second all-time in CAA history with 169 CAA wins (league+postseason), trailing Miami (FL) head coach Jim Larranaga's 183 wins at Georgia Mason from 1998-2011.

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his previous 14 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 33 All-CAA honors, including 10 first-team accolades and eight All-Rookie selections. A total of 25 of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and 12 Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have remained the most consistent in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 11 of Coen's 14 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern has appeared in the CAA tournament quarterfinals in 13 of 14 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals eight times, and to the title game five times, including three straight appearances (2018-20) and two titles (2015, '19). Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 14 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three straight CAA title game appearances in 2019-20, falling just short to top-seeded Hofstra, 70-61, in Washington, D.C. Northeastern is a CAA-best 11-4 in the league tournament since 2015, and have a pair of NCAA tournament appearances in 2015 and '19.

Northeastern has won a league-best 147 league games during Coen's leadership, and won a CAA-best three regular-season titles since joining the league in 2005-06 (2012-13, 2014-15, 2017-18). The Huskies have appeared in the NCAA postseason in two straight seasons with an NIT appearance in 2018 and NCAA tournament appearance in 2019. The NCAA canceled all winter and spring championships in 2020, immediately following the 2020 CAA Championship.
