- The Huskies are 7-0 in CAA play for just the second time in program history and looking to match their bestever start in CAA play at 8-0 (2012-13); The Huskies' 7-0 start is 11th-best in CAA history
- · Northeastern is one of the best teams in the country at defending the three-point line, leading the CAA at .292
- · Northeastern has the best RPI ranking in New England; #34 Northeastern, #64 UConn, #80 Providence, #102 Rhode Island, #116 UMass, #171 New Hampshire, #208 Boston College, #252 UMass Lowell, #262 Boston University, #268 Vermont
- · Northeastern has seven players born outside the United States, third-most in the country behind Maine's 11 and Cal Baptist's eight
- The Huskies rank 319-of-343 active D1 teams in the country in terms of experience with just three upper classmen and no seniors (KenPom.com); This is the first time in head coach Bill Coen's 15 years that he has coached a team without a senior (Last team to not have a senior was 2002-03)
- The Huskies lost 70% of their scoring from a season ago, and replaced it with freshmen and sophomores that account for 65% of the team's offense (next closest in the CAA is Towson at 55%)
- The Huskies played the 17th-toughest non-conference schedule (per ESPN's College Basketball Power Index)
- · The Huskies are the winningest program in CAA play since Coach Coen's arrival in 2006 with 153 conference victories; The Huskies have a CAA-best five CAA Championship game appearances since 2013
- The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three consecutive CAA Championship Game appearances (2018, '19, '20), earning their ninth NCAA tournament bid in 2019

## LAST GAME SUMMARY **NORTHEASTERN 72. JAMES MADISON 63**

Game 13 | Cabot Center | Boston, Mass.

Jahmyl Telfort scored a career-high 23 points in the second half, while Shaquille Walters and Chris Doherty each tallied double-doubles to lead Northeastern past James Madison, 72-63, on Saturday inside the Cabot Center. The Huskies are off to their second-best start to CAA play at 7-0.

Walters recorded his second double-double in the last three games with 15 points and 11 rebounds. Doherty grabbed a career-high 10 boards to go with 10 points for his first career double-double. Tyson Walker reached double figures for the 10th straight game with 12 points and a game-high five assists.

The Huskies held a six-point lead at the half, and JMU got within three early in the second half before Telfort went on a 13-1 run to give the Huskies a 13-point lead, 52-39 (13:32). The Huskies extended their lead to 20 points and led for over 31 minutes in the game.

NU limited Preseason CAA Player of the Year Matt Lewis to 14 points, and Jalen Hodge was the final JMU player in double figures with 14.



- Sophomore **Tyson Walker** has been named CAA Player of the Week a leaguebest two times (Dec. 14, Jan. 11)

#### **#00 JASON STRONG says ...**

I chose the word *equality* to wear on my jersey because it is a baseline word for what should be present in the world. ## #10 GREG EBOIGBODIN says ...

Since the beginning of October, Nigerians have taken to the streets to protest police brutality in their country. Young people in particular are mobilizing in major Nigerian cities, calling for the abolition of the SARS special police task force that has been operating for more than two decades. The task force, which is under government jurisdiction, has been accused of inflicting severe human rights violations on its citizens. And people have had enough.

The **#EndSARS** hashtag dates back to at least 2017, when people began using it online share their experiences of violence and assault at the hands of SARS. This most recent protest was launched by an October 8 viral video which allegedly showed SARS officers killing a young man in one of the country's southern states. While authorities have denied that the video is real, according to Al Jazeera, the man who filmed it has been arrested, leading to more outrage from citizens. And this recent round of mass protests has led to further violence against the protestors themselves, including 25 people who were shot in Lagos, Nigeria while demonstrating on October 21, with an unnamed witness telling BBC News that soldiers "pulled up... and they started firing directly" at protestors. An investigation by Amnesty International also found that Nigerian army and police killed at least 12 peaceful protesters on October 20.

In addition to protesting police brutality, demonstrators are also speaking out against Nigeria's bad governance, citing grievances such as poor educational opportunities for citizens.

# #24 SHAQUILLE WALTERS says ...

My word *revolutionise* is a testament to the facts that there needs to be fundermental change and we are all collectively responsible to doing so, because the inequalities that exist within the interchanging parts of our society come in various forms and sizes.



- Coen previously helped Rhode Island make two tournament appearances as an assistant coach (1993, 1997), while helping Boston College to five tournaments as an assistant/associate head coach (2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006)



# THE COEN FILE

*Bill Coen* enters his 15th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program. He is currently second in school history with 249 wins, trailing Jim Calhoun's 250 from 1972-86, and second all-time in CAA history with 170 CAA wins (league+postseason), trailing Miami (FL) head coach Jim Larranaga's 183 wins at Georgia Mason from 1998-2011.

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his previous 14 seasons at Northeastern, NU players have earned 33 All-CAA honors, including 10 first-team accolades and eight All-Rookie selections. A total of 25 of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and 12 Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have remained the most consistent in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 11 of Coen's 14 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern has appeared in the CAA tournament quarterfinals in 13 of 14 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals eight times, and to the title game five times, including three straight appearances (2018-20) and two titles (2015, '19). Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 14 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three straight CAA title game appearances in 2019-20, falling just short to top-seeded Hofstra, 70-61, in Washington, D.C. Northeastern is a CAA-best 11-4 in the league tournament since 2015, and have a pair of NCAA tournament appearances in 2015 and '19.

Northeastern has won a league-best 147 league games during Coen's leadership, and won a CAA-best three regular-season titles since joining the league in 2005-06 (2012-13, 2014-15, 2017-18). The Huskies have appeared in the NCAA postseason in two straight seasons with an NIT appearance in 2018 and NCAA tournament appearance in 2019. The NCAA canceled all winter and spring championships in 2020, immediately following the 2020 CAA Championship.
