• Bill Coen became the all-time winningest coach at Northeastern, surpassing Jim Calhoun (1972-86) with 251 wins; Coen tied the CAA tournament record with his 18th win in the quarterfinal win over William & Mary

- · Northeastern ranks second among New England schools in the latest RPI rankings; #47 UConn, #78 Northeastern, #95 Providence, #174 Vermont, #175 Boston University, #176 UMass, #190 Rhode Island, and #286 Boston College; The Huskies are the topranked team in the CAA in the RPI (Hofstra #128)
- The Huskies have a league-best five championship game appearances since 2013, winning in '15 and '19, and are trying to become the fourth team in CAA history to play in four straight title games; The Huskies are 12-4 (.750) in the tournament since 2015

CAA Defensive Player of the Year/First-Team All-CAA • Tyson Walker led the CAA in steals per game (2.4) and ranks 12th nationally; He led the CAA in league games with 19.3 points and 2.5 steals per game, and finished No. 3 in assists per game (5.1)

CAA Sixth Man of the Year/All-Rookie Team

- · Jahmyl Telfort is second among all freshmen in the CAA with 10.8 points per game, tallying double-figures in 10-of-17 games this season
- · Northeastern has seven players born outside the United States, third-most in the country behind Maine's 11 and Cal Baptist's eight
- The Huskies rank 319-of-343 active D1 teams in the country in terms of experience with just three upper classmen and no seniors (KenPom.com): This is the first time in head coach Bill Coen's 15 years that he has coached a team without a senior (Last team to not have a senior was 2002-03)
- The Huskies lost 70% of their scoring from a season ago, and replaced it with freshmen and sophomores that account for 65% of the team's offense
- · Northeastern played the 17th-toughest nonconference schedule (per ESPN's College Basketball Power Index)

Game 18 | Atlantic Union Bank Center | Harrisonburg, Va.

Tyson Walker led all scorers with 19 points, Chris Doherty grabbed a career-high 18 rebounds, and Bill Coen etched his name on the top of the Northeastern record book with his 251st win, moving ahead of legendary coach Jim Calhoun's 250 wins from 1972-86, as the second-seeded Huskies (10-8) defeated No. 7 seed William & Mary (7-10), 63-47, in the quarterfinals.

Walker, the CAA Defensive Player of the Year, posted a game-high five steals and dished out four assists. Doherty finished one point shy of a double-double with nine points, and eight of his 18 boards were on the offensive end. Coen tied former George Mason coach Jim Larrañaga (1998-2011) for the league record with 18 CAA tournament wins and he is trying to lead Northeastern to its fourth consecutive CAA Championship Game, and sixth in the last nine years.

CAA Sixth Man of the Year *Jahmyl Telfort* finished with 11 of his 13 points in the second half, grabbing five rebounds, while fellow freshman *Coleman Stucke* tallied 13 points, eight in the final 20 minutes, connecting on 3-of-7 shots from behind the arc and grabbed five boards.

#### **#00 JASON STRONG says ...**

Since the beginning of October, Nigerians have taken to the streets to protest police brutality in their country. Young people in particular are mobilizing in major Nigerian cities, calling for the abolition of the SARS special police task force that has been operating for more than two decades. The task force, which is under government jurisdiction, has been accused of inflicting severe human rights violations on its citizens. And people have had enough.

The **#EndSARS** hashtag dates back to at least 2017, when people began using it online share their experiences of violence and assault at the hands of SARS. This most recent protest was launched by an October 8 viral video which allegedly showed SARS officers killing a young man in one of the country's southern states. While authorities have denied that the video is real, according to Al Jazeera, the man who filmed it has been arrested, leading to more outrage from citizens. And this recent round of mass protests has led to further violence against the protestors themselves, including 25 people who were shot in Lagos, Nigeria while demonstrating on October 21, with an unnamed witness telling BBC News that soldiers "pulled up... and they started firing directly" at protestors. An investigation by Amnesty International also found that Nigerian army and police killed at least 12 peaceful protesters on October 20.

In addition to protesting police brutality, demonstrators are also speaking out against Nigeria's bad governance, citing grievances such as poor educational opportunities for citizens.

#### #24 SHAQUILLE WALTERS says ...

My word *revolutionise* is a testament to the facts that there needs to be fundermental change and we are all collectively responsible to doing so, because the inequalities that exist within the interchanging parts of our society come in various forms and sizes.

#### NORTHEASTERN SIGNS TO RANDRIASALAMA DURING SIGNING PERIOD

- A native of Montreal, Quebec, Randriasalama is a 6-foot-3 guard that shot nearly 40 percent from behind the arc last season.
- Randriasalama attends College Jean-de-Brebeuf in Montreal and led his high school team to a 15-3 record in 2019-20 and qualified for the national tournament before it was cancelled due to COVID-19
- He finished with a team-best 17.8 points per game, adding 4.9 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game and was selected to the all-star and all-league teams

#### **20 POINTS OR LESS**

- Northeastern limited William & Mary to just 19 second-half points in the CAA tournament quarterfinals (3/7/21)


#### **HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 50 POINTS UNDER BILL COEN**

#### **NCAA APPEARANCES**

- The Huskies made their ninth ever appearance in the NCAA tournament in 2019, posting a record of 3-9 in the Big Dance
- Head Coach *Bill Coen* made his ninth appearance in the Big Dance and second as a head coach in 2019
- Coen previously helped Rhode Island make two tournament appearances as an assistant coach (1993, 1997), while helping Boston College to five tournaments as an assistant/associate head coach (2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006)



#### **THE COEN FILE**

Bill Coen enters his 15th season as head coach of the Northeastern basketball program and is the all-time winningest coach in program history, surpassing Hall of Fame Coach Jim Calhoun's 250 wins from 1972-76. Coen is No. 2 all-time in CAA history with 172 CAA wins (league+postseason), trailing Miami (FL) head coach Jim Larrañaga's 183 wins at George Mason from 1998-2011.

Coen is widely regarded for his ability to evaluate and develop talented players. In his 15 seasons at Northeastern, Huskies have earned 34 All-CAA honors, including 11 first-team accolades and nine All-Rookie selections. A total of 25 of Coen's former players have earned professional contracts and 12 Huskies remain active in professional basketball.

Coen's teams have remained the most consistent in the CAA. The Huskies have finished .500 or better in 12 of Coen's 15 seasons at the helm, including back-toback 14-win seasons in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Northeastern has appeared in the CAA tournament quarterfinals in 14 of 15 seasons under Coen, advanced to the semifinals eight times, and to the title game five times, including three straight appearances (2018-20) and two titles (2015, '19). Since Coen took the reins of the Northeastern men's basketball program 15 seasons ago, Northeastern has accomplished the best win percentage among current CAA teams in conference and CAA tournament play.

The Huskies became the fifth program in CAA history to make three straight CAA title game appearances in 2019-20, falling just short to top-seeded Hofstra, 70-61, in Washington, D.C. Northeastern is a CAA-best 11-4 in the league tournament since 2015, and have a pair of NCAA tournament appearances in 2015 and '19.

Northeastern has won a league-best 154 league games during Coen's leadership, and won a CAA-best four regular-season titles since joining the league in 2005-06 (2012-13, 2014-15, 2017-18, 2020-21). The Huskies have appeared in the NCAA postseason in two straight seasons with an NIT appearance in 2018 and NCAA tournament appearance in 2019. The NCAA canceled all winter and spring championships in 2020, immediately following the 2020 CAA Championship.
