SERIES WITH TOWSON

• The Huskies lead the all-time series with Towson, 35-27

LAST TIME OUT: Despite home runs from *Ian Fair* and *Ryan Solomon*, the Huskies dropped an 11-6 decision to Towson in the series finale in Towson, Md. on May 18, 2019. The Huskies won the series, taking the first two games, and Fair finished the nightcap 3-for-4 with a team-best four RBIs. Earning wins for the Huskies in the first two games on the mound were *David Stiehl* and *Sean Mellen*.

QUICK HITS

- The Huskies are off to their best start in program history at 19-6 and 7-0 in the CAA; Northeastern began the 1991 season 19-6 and finished 35-15 that season
- Northeastern is riding a nine-game winning streak and are 15-1 over its last 16 games
- During this winning streak, the Huskies are outscoring opponents 66-25
- NATIONAL RANKINGS: #4 in SB (2.64 per game), #5 in WHIP (1.13), #7 FLD% (.981), K's/9 (10.1) and hits allowed per game (6.94), #9 in ERA (3.21), #37 BA (.290) and #42 OBP% (.390)
- The Huskies are limiting opponents to .210 average, tops in the CAA
- *Holzwasser* has reached base safely in 43 consecutive games and broke the Northeastern HBP record (50); His 72 stolen bases are four shy of setting a new all-time school record
- Jared Dupere earned his third CAA Player of the Week distinction, while Eric Yost was named CAA Rookie of the Week after tallying three saves in the Delaware series
- Prior to last year's five-round MLB Draft, two Huskies have been selected in MLB Drafts every year since 2011, including three selections in the 2019 MLB Draft

HUSKIES LEADING THE PACK

- The Huskies are off to a 7-0 start and hold a two-and-a-half-game lead over Towson at 5-3 in the CAA North Division
- The Huskies lead the CAA in BA (.290), SLG (.430), OBP (.390), SB (66), ERA (3.21) and fielding percentage (.981)
- NU's current nine-game winning streak ranks third-best in the NCAA and is a program-best since winning 11 straight during the 2018 season (April 15-May 4)

DUPERE AND YOST EARN CAA WEEKLY HONORS

- **Jared Dupere** earned his league-best third recognition as CAA Player of the Week after batting .412 (7-for-17) with three home runs, six RBIs, five walks and went 4-for-4 in stolen bases
- *Eric Yost* was named CAA Rookie of the Week for the first time in his young career after going 3-for-3 in saves in a series sweep over Delaware
- A native of Ossining, N.Y., Yost tossed 4.0 scoreless innings last week and was called upon to close after dominant closer *Brandon Dufault* was unavailable last weekend

GOING, GOING, GONE!

- **Jared Dupere** leads the CAA with a .740 slugging percentage and ranks second with 10 home runs
- A native of Amesbury, Mass., Dupere leads the CAA with three CAA Player of the Week distinctions (2/23, 4/18, 4/27) and has seven home runs over his last 13 games for the Huskies

STREAKING

- **Scott Holzwasser** has reached base safely in 43 consecutive games, dating back to the 2019 season, and ranks second all-time in school history with 72 stolen bases, just four shy of the all-time record
- The Huskies are riding a nine-game winning streak, the longest since winning 11 straight during the 2018 season (April 15-May 4)
- The school record for longest winning streak is 20 straight wins during the 1991 season where Northeastern also started 19-6 and finished 35-15

DEPTH ON THE MOUND

- The Huskies have one of the deepest pitching staffs in the entire CAA
- The weekend starting rotation of *Kyle Murphy* (3-0, 3.67 ERA), *Sebastian Keane* (3-1, 4.84 ERA) and *Cam Schlittler* (3-0, 1.95 ERA) lead the CAA with a combined record of 9-1

THE GLAVINE FILE

Mike Glavine – the two-time CAA Coach of the Year (2017, 2018), 2018 NEIBA (New England) Coach of the Year and 2018 ABCA/Diamond Northeast Region Coach of the Year – enters his seventh season as head coach of the Northeastern baseball team and 15th season overall with the program.

Glavine led the Huskies to a final RPI ranking of No. 11 in 2020, before the season was canceled due to the global pandemic Coronavirus. Baseball America did a vote by coaches around the country in April 2020 and Coach Glavine earned the fourth-most votes as the 'most underrated College Baseball Coach' (story here). He earned his 150th win at Northeastern in a 10-0 victory over South Florida (2/22/20) as the Huskies picked up series wins against USF and Florida Atlantic before the season was halted.

Glavine has guided Northeastern to consecutive CAA regular-season titles during 2017 and 2018 – the Huskies' first within any conference since 2005 (America East). He has also led the Huskies back to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2003, earning an at-large bid during 2018 after winning a program record, 36 games, including the program's first three victories against the SEC, and attaining a top-40 RPI.

Since Glavine took over the baseball program, the Huskies have won a program-best 178 games over a six-year stretch. The Huskies have never had a losing season inside the CAA under Glavine's guidance, and Cleveland Indians' hurler Aaron Civale earned All-America honors in 2016. A total of 24 players have garnered all-league honors and NU has never finished lower than fifth during Glavine's tenure.

A native of Billerica, Mass., Glavine spent four years as a player at Northeastern and left as one of the most prolific hitters in the Huskies' history. Glavine graduated having hit 28 career home runs and accumulated 110 career RBIs, ranking him third and ninth at the time, respectively, in school history. The left-handed slugger also walked 120 times during his four seasons at NU, ranking him second all-time upon completing his final collegiate campaign.

After graduating from Northeastern, Glavine spent 10 seasons in professional baseball after being drafted by the Cleveland Indians during 1995, alternating between AA and AAA levels. During September 2003, the New York Mets called Glavine up to the major leagues, where he played with his older brother and MLB Hall of Famer, Tom. Glavine became the third Northeastern alumni to ever play in the major leagues, joining George Yankowski (1942, 1949) and Carlos Pena (2001-14).
