FOUR THINGS TO KNOW

1. The Huskies and Hawks are meeting for the fourth time in series history, and first time since 1992. Monmouth holds a 2-1 advantage in the series as the teams prepare to meet for the first time as CAA members.

2. On Monday, Jahmyl Telfort became the 41st player in Northeastern history to reach 1000 career points, and 20th to do so in three seasons or less. Telfort has scored 20+ points in nine games this season, and is sixth in the CAA in scoring (16.0ppg).

3. Coleman Stucke is averaging 14.2 points per game in his last six outings, highlighted by a 34-point performance on Jan. 28 at Delaware. He's one of 34 players in program history to score at least 34 in a game, and the first in nearly two years.

4. Chris Doherty has double-doubles in three of his last nine games, including a 12-point, 16-rebound effort at Towson (Jan. 26). He's averaging 10.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg in league play, and recently had a season-high 22 pts vs. Elon (Feb. 4).

SETTING THE STAGE

The series with Monmouth

The Huskies and Hawks are meeting for the fourth time in series history, and first time since 1992. Monmouth holds a 2-1 advantage in the series as the teams prepare to meet for the first time as CAA members.

He cannot be contained

Junior captain Coleman Stucke has reached double figures in 11 of the 24 games he's played this season after doing so only four times all of last season, highlighted by a career-high 34 points at Delaware on Jan. 28. Stucke is averaging 14.2 points per game in his last six outings.

Stucke's day marked the 34th time in team history, and first time since 2021, that a Husky score at least 34 in a game. He finished the day 12-of-19 from the field and 6-of-13 from three and 4-of-5 from the stripe. His six threes were also the most for a Husky since 2021.

Hot shooting

On Dec. 18 at UIC, NU opened the game 9-of-9 from the floor before finishing 47% overall (27-of-58), and followed it up with a 28-of-59 (47.5%) afternoon at Davidson on Dec. 21.

Northeastern then went 27-of-53 (51%) overall vs. NC A&T on Dec. 29 to finish with 88 points, the team's highest scoring night since Dec. 30, 2019.

The Huskies have shot 50% or better five times this season, including a season-best 26-of-44 night (59.1%) at Stony Brook on Jan. 19, their best shooting performance since Nov. 19, 2021 (60% vs. Duquesne).

Second half surge

Trailing by one at halftime, the Northeastern offense caught fire in the second half at Stony Brook on Jan. 19. The Huskies shot 71% (15-of-21) over the final 20 minutes and 73% from three (8-of-11) to earn the road victory.

Climbing the charts

Jahmyl Telfort's 11 points on Monday at Charleston made him the 41st player in Northeastern history to reach 1000 career points. He's also the 20th player in team history to do it in three seasons or less, and the 15th to reach 1000 career points in the Bill Coen era.

Shouldering the load

Jahmyl Telfort has put the Huskies on his back this season, eclipsing the 20-point plateau nine times.

Telfort has reached double-figures in all but three games, including a career-high 31 points on Dec. 29 vs. NC A&T, one of 73 players in team history to score at least 31 points in a game. He is currently fifth in the CAA in field goal perc. (46.4%) and sixth in points per game (16.0).

In home games, Telfort is averaging 16.8 points per game and shooting 47% from the floor (57-of-119).

Double 'em up

Chris Doherty (15 points, 14 rebounds) and Joe Pridgen (14 points, 14 rebounds) had big nights for Northeastern on Jan. 16 vs. Delaware, recording their first double-doubles of the season in a 59-58 come-from-behind victory.

It was the first time this season, and first since Nov. 30, 2021, that two Huskies both recorded double-doubles in the same game.

Doherty has three double-doubles in his last nine games.

Welcome back, 33

After missing five games with an injury, Chris Doherty returned to the lineup on Dec. 10 against Holy Cross. Doherty came off the bench to lead the Huskies with 14 points and nine rebounds, helping the group to a 59-58 victory.

Doherty was 6-of-6 from the floor on the afternoon, marking the second time in his last six games (dating back to last season) that he was perfect from the floor (10-of-10 vs. William & Mary on Mar. 2 at the CAA First Round).

Doherty is averaging 9.4 ppg and 6.1 rpg overall and 10.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg in league play, including a season-high 22 points on Feb. 4 vs. Elon.

By the slimmest of margins

Ten of NU's 25 games have been decided by five points or less, including five losses by one possession (vs. Harvard, vs. Princeton, at William & Mary, at Delaware, vs. Elon).

Closing the gap

The Huskies trailed by as many as 16 points in the first half against Delaware on Jan. 16 before storming back to win, 59-58. It marked the first time since Dec. 3, 2021 vs. Colgate that NU trailed by at least 15 points and came back to win the game.

It was also the second time this season (Dec. 10 vs. Holy Cross) that Northeastern overcame a 10+ point deficit to win.

At the stripe

The Huskies got to the line 31 times on Dec. 29 vs. NC A&T, the most since Feb. 13, 2020, going a season-best 22-of-31. It's one of two times this season that Northeastern has gotten to the line at least 30 times (Jan. 7 at Hampton).

Northeastern had their best day at the line on Jan. 19 at Stony Brook, going 14-of-15 (93.3%).

Youth movement

While many teams across the country look to the transfer portal to fill out their rosters, head coach Bill Coen brought in six freshmen for the 2022-23. It's the most for NU since the 2009-10 season.

"We felt it was a better value to stick with the high school kids," said Coen. "The nature of college basketball now is that most of the high majors are recruiting out of the transfer portal. There were high school kids that were getting, in our estimation, overlooked and undervalued."

Northeastern has had at least two freshmen in the starting lineup 11 times this season. The rookies have also accounted for 37% of the team's total minutes in 2022-23.

The winningest coach in Northeastern history

Head coach Bill Coen moved ahead of Hall of Fame coach Jim Calhoun's 250 wins set from 1972-86 for the all-time Northeastern record with a win vs. William & Mary on Mar. 7, 2021.

Coen is No. 2 all-time in CAA history with 179 regular season and postseason wins, five shy of breaking the conference record.

Deep bench

Northeastern had a season-high 49 points off the bench on Dec. 18 at UIC. The Huskies are 74th in the NCAA and third in the CAA averaging 23.44 bench points per game.

Dominating the glass

Northeastern outrebounded Georgia State 50-24 on Dec. 2. It was the most rebounds in a game for the Huskies since the 2011-12 season.

The Huskies have outrebounded their opponent in 13 of the last 18 games, and 15 times overall this season. Northeastern is 95th in the NCAA, and third in the CAA in rebound margin (3.3).

NU held their opponents to 19 rebounds in back-to-back games on Jan. 16 and Jan. 19, the first time since the 2014-15 season that the Huskies kept an opponent under 20 rebounds in consecutive games.

Your rebounding is offensive

Northeastern pulled down a season-high 20 offensive rebounds on Jan. 16 vs. Delaware. It's just the third time since the 2011-12 season that the Huskies recorded at least 20 offensive boards.

The Huskies have recorded at least 13 offensive boards eight times this season.

Block party

Northeastern is 75th in the nation and third in the CAA averaging 4.0 blocks per game, led by 16 from both Alexander Nwagha and Collin Metcalf.

Northeastern's 100 blocks through 25 games mark the first time since 2016-17 season that the Huskies have recorded 100 blocks in a season.

Balancing act

The Huskies have looked to a number of players to lead the charge so far this season, with six different players leading the team in scoring through 25 games:

- Coleman Stucke - 4 games
- Chris Doherty - 3 games

Across the Pond

The Huskies recently returned from London, England, where it competed in the first-ever London Basketball Classic. Northeastern, which has a campus in London, prides itself on being a global institution, and the athletic department has mirrored that mission.

"Northeastern is the global leader in experiential learning, and that's all about experiencing different cultures," said head coach Bill Coen. "We're so grateful for the opportunity to come to London and learn about the history, culture and traditions of this country, and to play against some outstanding programs. Alexander Nwagha stepped in at the 5 spot in the absence of Chris Doherty earlier this season, collecting 54 rebounds in a five-game span highlighted by 17 against Princeton on Nov. 26 en route to his first career double-double. Nwagha had 30 rebounds in his first two seasons at Northeastern combined.

Guess who's back

After being ineligible all of last season due to NCAA transfer rules and missing two games earlier this season (injury), Joe Pridgen had a coming out party on Nov. 24 vs. Manhattan. Pridgen went for 20 points on 9-of-15 overall, including the game-winning bucket in OT. Pridgen started his collegiate career at Holy Cross (2019-20) before transferring to UNCW (2020-21).

Down to the wire

Chase Cormier's last second free throws on Nov. 24 vs. Manhattan marked the first time since Jan. 11, 2014 that the Huskies scored in the closing seconds to force overtime.

Additionally Lauren Tebsherany, now in her third season with the program, is just 1-of-6 women serving as a director of operations for a Division I men's basketball program out of 363 teams.

Former guard Jon Lee has also joined the program as a graduate manager. Brace graduated in 2013 before playing nine years professionally overseas. Lee was named to the Senior CLASS Award Second Team during his senior season as a captain with current assistant coach Joel Smith, and was a two-time All-CAA honoree.

• Won three national titles at UConn where he coached from 1986-2012; Made his return to coaching at Division III Saint Joseph (CT) in 2018 before retiring in 2021

Dave Leitao (1984-86) - Served as an assistant coach on Calhoun's staff that made NCAA tournament appearances in all three seasons he was there (*Played basketball at NU from 1978-82*)

Bill Coen is the all-time winningest coach in Northeastern history and has led the Huskies to a CAA-best four regular-season championships since 2006 and two NCAA tournaments over the last eight seasons. Coen has recruited some of the most talented players across the globe, including 26 players that have gone on to play professional basketball.

Coen broke the all-time CAA record with 19 tournament wins and his 175 regular season and postseason wins in the CAA are second most in league history, eight shy of matching the record held by former George Mason and current Miami (FL) coach Jim Larranaga. The Huskies are an impressive 13-6 (.684) in the CAA tournament since 2015, and have advanced to the CAA quarterfinals in each of Coen's 16 seasons at the helm.

The Huskies lead the conference with 156 league wins since Coen's arrival in 2005-06, and produced 34 All-CAA first team selections and nine All-Rookie accolades. Northeastern became the fifth program in CAA history to make three consecutive trips to the championship game in 2018, '19 and '20, and have advanced to the semifinals in four of the last five seasons.

NCAA TOURNAMENTS

2015: The Huskies captured their first-ever CAA tournament championship, defeating No. 1 seed William & Mary, 71-60 in Royal Farms Arena in Baltimore, Md., and Quincy Ford earned Most Valuable Player. Northeastern took on No. 9 Notre Dame in the first round of the NCAA tournament, and the Huskies had the ball in the final seconds with a change to tie or take the lead, but turned it over with two seconds left as the Irish held on to defeat NU, 69-65, in Pittsburgh inside the CONSOL Energy Center.

2019: After falling in overtime in the 2018 CAA title game, the Huskies rebounded by defeating the top seed Hofstra in the CAA championship game, 82-74, behind a tremendous performance from tournament MVP Vasa Pusica. The Huskies drew No. 17 Kansas in the opening round out in Salt Lake City, Utah, falling 87-53.

CAA CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES

The Huskies lead the conference with five championship game appearances since 2013. Northeastern made three straight title games from 2018-20, and advanced to the semifinal round in each of the last four seasons.

BOSTON CONNECTIONS

Coen has built a reputation for success in the Boston area. He came to Northeastern after spending nine seasons coaching at Boston College. A longtime member of head coach Al Skinner's staff, Coen served four years as an assistant coach before being promoted to the role of associate head coach in May 2001.

During Coen's nine years at Boston College, the Eagles posted a 175-108 (.618) overall record and enjoyed six postseason berths, while winning three Big East regular season crowns. In 2000-01, the Eagles went 27-5 and defeated Pittsburgh to take home the school's first-ever Big East Tournament Championship. Between 2000-01 and 2005-06, the Eagles posted the most victories in any six-year span in school history. BC entered the ACC in 2005-06, and made a run to their first NCAA Sweet 16 since the 1991 season in 2006, falling to Villanova in a thrilling overtime game, 60-59.

RHODE ISLAND

Prior to his arrival in Boston, Coen worked under Skinner for eight seasons at the University of Rhode Island, six as an assistant coach and two as a graduate assistant. During that time, the Rams enjoyed four seasons of postseason play, heading to the NCAA Tournament in 1993 and 1997, while receiving NIT bids in 1992 and 1996. Combined, the Rams' postseason record while Coen was on staff was 5-4. In 1991, Coen received his MBA from Rhode Island.

UNDERGRADUATE WORK

A 1983 graduate of Hamilton College in Clinton, N.Y., Coen played four years for the Continentals, winning three ECAC Championships. As a senior, he served as team captain and led Hamilton to a national ranking.

After graduation, Coen spent three years working in the computer software industry, before accepting his first coaching position at Canajoharie (N.Y.) High School. In his one year as head coach, he led the school to a 19-3 mark and was named Coach of the Year. The following year, he returned to his alma mater and served two seasons as assistant varsity coach and head junior varsity coach. During his tenure, Hamilton compiled a 38-10 mark.

Coen is an active member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and resides in Charlestown.
