Northwest vs. Fraser Valley

Northwest University Men's Soccer Notebook

HAPPY NEW SEASON: It's the new season, and hope springs eternal! The Eagles are 3-2 in their last five season openers.

NO FIRE IN THE SKY: Northwest also was scheduled to open against Fraser Valley last season, but the game was canceled due to poor air quality.

NO LOVE: Northwest is picked 11th in the preseason poll by Cascade Collegiate Conference coaches.

RETURNING: Jordan Travis returns after sharing the team lead last year in goals (6) and points (14). He also placed 62 percent of his 30 shots on goal (18 shots).

McINTOSH LEADS: NU head coach Gary McIntosh returns for his school-record 17th season. He has 132 wins on the Eagles' sidelines and 182 in his career. McIntosh has been the all-time leader in men's soccer coaching wins at Northwest since 2008.

FATHERS AND SONS: With the addition of Perry Travis to the coaching staff, NU now has a pair of father-son duos associated with the program. Jordan Travis is the son of Perry Travis. Coach McIntosh's son Kyler returns for his redshirt sophomore season.

SMART GUYS: The Eagles placed eight men on the Cascade Conference All-Academic Team last year, and seven of those are back in action this season. Earl Bach, Leon Bormann, Payton Gunhus, Noah Roberts, Tyler Siedenburger, Joey Starr, and Jordan Travis earned the acclaim last season.

RECOVERING: Agazi Birkner, who had nine starts in goal last season, is expected to return later this year after he has recovered from an injury. Birkner led the team with 57 saves last season and allowed 1.86 goals per game. He is fourth on NU's all-time saves list at 71. Brandon Karberg, who allowed 0.82 goals per game in two contests last season, and freshman Alexander Thiehofe saw significant time in goal in the scrimmage earlier this week.

FRESH FACES: As many as a dozen freshmen could see action this season. The new men in Kirkland are goalkeeper Alexander Thiehofe; defenders Ethan Ellwell, Jack Eberl, and Jacob Moon; midfielders Dmitry Zorchenko, Justin Harden, and Seito Gao; and forwards Tristan Gautney, Richard Delean, Tyler Hopp, Elliot Misic, and Gian Herrera. Gabe Rixmann is expected to use 2018 as a redshirt season.

COMING SOON: Northwest got a scare in its mid-week scrimmage when freshman Elliot Misic went down with an injury. Misic is expected to return soon but is improbable for the opener.

TOUGH START: Fraser Valley took one on the chin in its season opener Wednesday, falling 2-1 at The Evergreen State College. Manpal Brar had the Cascades' lone goal.

COMING UP: The Eagles launch a six-game road swing next Saturday at Simpson University. Northwest then visits California to play Pacific Union and Cal State Maritime Sept. 6-7. NU plays Caltech in Salem, Oregon, Sept. 15 and opens the CCC slate in Montana against Providence and Carroll, Sept. 20 and 22. The Eagles return home to take on Rocky Mountain Friday, Sept. 27, after 41 days without a home contest.

Head Coach Gary McIntosh



Coach Gary McIntosh II enters his 17th season as the men's soccer coach and 12th season as director of athletics at Northwest in 2019-20.

Coach McIntosh is the all-time leader in men's soccer wins at Northwest and has guided the Eagles to six consecutive double-figure wins seasons (2011-16). He has twice been named Cascade Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to his first season at NU in 2003, McIntosh was the head coach for San Diego Christian College for three seasons (1998-2000).

Gary has led the NU soccer team to the CCC playoff's in 2008, '09, '11, '12, '13, '14, '15 and the conference semifinals in 2009 and 2011. He also named 2009 Cascade Conference Coach of the Year by a vote of the CCC coaches and CCC Co-Coach of the Year in 2011.

While at San Diego Christian College he collected three consecutive Coach of the Year awards for the NCCAA West Region, compiled a 50-25 cumulative record, and trained six NAIA All-Americans. McIntosh also served as an adjunct professor for Azusa Pacific University.

McIntosh, in 2006 and again in 2007, took the helm of the Salem, Oregon-based Cascade Surge of the Premier Soccer Development League (PDL), which is part of the United States Soccer League.

A three-year captain, McIntosh played four years at Christian Heritage College, where he earned his bachelor's degree in physical education. He also holds a master's degree from Azusa Pacific and is working toward a doctorate in strategic leadership from Corban University.

Gary and his wife, Laura, have three daughters, Morgan, Ashlyn and Shannae, and one son, Kyler. The family attends Bethany Christian Assembly. Gary also enjoys hiking, fishing and walks with his wife.
