SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

Incarnate Word (3-14, 0-0 SLC) - The Cardinals head to Natchitoches following a 2-2 weekend at the Mississippi Gulf Coast Classic. There, UIW secured two victories against Jackson State. The Cardinals have played three games against Southland Conference foes - all counted as non-conference matchups - dropping a pair to Central Arkansas (13-2; 9-0) and another to Sam Houston State (5-2).

The Cardinals enter conference play 10th in team batting average (.245), last among 12 teams in pitching (7.66 earned runned average) and fifth in team fielding percentage (.957).

Offensively, UIW is led by Danielle Ramirez, who has posted a .375 average in 11 games. Alex Alonzo leads the team with eight RBIs and is hitting .286 on the season. In the circle, Kristin Hebert owns two of the Cardinals three victories and boasts a 5.11 ERA in 12 appearances including six starts.

2015 Southland Conference Softball Tournament

For the second time in three seasons, the Southland Conference Softball Tournament returns to Lady Demon Diamond on the campus of Northwestern State. This year, the three-day event takes place May 6-8.

Six softball teams make the field with the top two seeds receiving byes. The double-elimination will be streamed live on the Southland Digital Network.

In 2014, Northwestern State entered the league tournament as the No. 2 seed after posting a 15-10 mark in Southland play. Once there, NSU knocked off No. 6 Central Arkansas (5-3) and No. 1 McNeese State twice (3-2; 11-0) to claim the program's second consecutive league tournament title.

SERIES HISTORY

U/W - NSU owns a 2-1 all-time advantage in the series, taking the inaugural series from the Southland newcomer in Natchitoches last season. In that series, current softball director of operations **Kaylee Guidry** picked up both wins, tossing a combined 12 innings, striking out 12, giving up just four hits while allowing one earned run.

CHASING HISTORY

With Saturday's 11-10 comeback victory against Ball State, seventh-year head coach **Donald Pickett** picked up his 162nd victory at the helm of NSU softball, moving past Gay McNutt (1995-2000) for sole spot of second place in all-time victories. Rickey McCalister (1987-1994) leads the way with 245 total victories.

LAST TIME OUT: at No. 5 LSU

Northwestern State couldn't muster anything in its last outing against No. 5 LSU, falling 11-0 at Tiger Park. LSU jumped out to a 10-0 lead after the first inning, tallying seven hits, two walks and two steals in the frame. Lady Demon starter **Shelby Sells** lasted just 2-3 of an inning, allowing six hits and nine runs. **Skylar Cagle** secured the inning's final out but not before giving up one hit and three walks while allowing two runs. **Mikayla Brown** closed out the final three innings, allowing just two hits and one walk while holding the Tigers scoreless.

NSU's lone baserunner on the day came in the fourth when **Brittany Virgoe** was hit by a pitch. It was Virgoe's 29th of her career, placing her one away from tying Shanté Jones's (1996-99) program record.

The loss was the 28th in 31 meetings to LSU and second in five innings over a span of three days to the Tigers.

LADY DEMONS ON SOUTHLAND OPENING WEEKEND

For the first time in four seasons, Northwestern State is scheduled to open Southland Conference play in Natchitoches. Three seasons ago, in 2012, the Lady Demons were slated to start conference play at Sam Houston State but weather postponed the series and NSU opened at home going 1-1 against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Over the past five years, NSU has secured a 7-6 record on conference opening weekends. A season ago, NSU shut out Houston Baptist, 3-0 and 4-0 in a Saturday doubleheader before falling 9-8 in the Sunday finale. **Shelby Sells** earned the Game 1 win, tossing a complete game and allowed just two hits while striking out four. **Brittney Jones** finished the weekend 4-for-9 with three RBIs and two runs scored. **Brittany Virgoe** and **Kellye Kincannon** each went 5-for-10, accounting for one run and two RBIs.

NSU PLAYERS AMONG SOUTHLAND LEADERS

Senior **Brittany Virgoe** is tied for second in the Southland with 18 runs scored, followed in fifth by **Sidney Salmans**, with 16. Salmans ranks tenth in hits (21). Senior **Cassandra Barefield** is tied for first in doubles (7), followed closely behind by **Natalie Landry** and **Micayla Sorosiak** with six. Sophomore **Kellye Kincannon** ranks second in total bases (43), RBIs (20) and home runs (5). She is tied for fifth in hits (23). In the circle, **Skylar Cagle's** 3.82 earned run average is good enough for eleventh among all pitchers while **Micaela Bouvier** ranks eighth in strikeouts (35).

BAREFIELD BEAKS HOME RUN RECORD

With a second inning center field blast last on Feb. 20 against Belmont, NSU senior **Cassandra Barefield** became the program's all-time leader in homer runs with 39. The long ball was her third in as many days, allowing the Houston native to break Erin Mancuso's (1999-2002) mark. Barefield has posted 14 home runs each of the past two seasons; a number that ranks third for homers in a season. She also ranks fourth in program history for hits by pitch in a season (12) and fifth in seasonal slugging percentage (.638).

QUALITY PITCHING, QUALITY WINS

Six of Northwestern State's nine wins have come when the Lady Demon pitching staff has allowed three or fewer runs.

After trailing 3-0 on with ULM threatening for more in the first inning on Feb. 18, head coach **Donald Pickett** brought **Micaela Bouvier** in to get NSU out of the jam - instead, she did more than that. The redshirt freshman allowed just one hit while striking out a season-high 10 batters over the next six innings to help secure a 4-3 comeback victory against the in-state foe.

Less than 24 hours later, starter **Shelby Sells** carried the momentum inside the circle, registering NSU's first shutout win of the season, 4-0 against Saint Louis. Sells struck out six Billiken batters going to full distance for the Lady Demons. The following day, Bouvier replicated the feat, shutting out Belmont, allowing just one hit in four innings pitched.

LANDRY'S RESURGENCE

After hitting just .178 as a sophomore in 13 starts and 27 appearances, starting right fielder **Natalie Landry** has reinvented herself on the diamond. The Denham Springs, Texas, product is second in batting average (.357) and doubles (6). She is tied for third in hits (20). Landry's grand slam home run against Belmont on Feb. 21 was the third of her career - the last, ironically coming on the same date in 2014 against Butler. Her first grand slam came on Feb. 22, 2013 against Southern Miss.

THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

If there was any concern about the future of NSU softball after losing eight letterwinners including four second team all-conference members from a year ago, the Lady Demons of the foreseeable future put to rest right off the bat.

No where is this more evident than in the case of **Sidney Salmans**. The freshman leadoff hitter ranks fifth in batting average (.300), second in runs scored (16), second in hits (21) and is tied for first in triples (1). She is NSU's leader with four stolen bases. Sophomores **Kellye Kincannon** (.359) and **Brittney Jones** (.320) rank first and fourth respectively in average. Kincannon is the team leader in hits (23), home runs (5) and RBIs (20). Jones is third in doubles (5) and home runs (3) while leading the team with a whopping 12 walks.

In the circle, freshman **Mikayla Brown** (1-0) ranks first in earned run average (1.68 ERA, five appearances). Sophomore **Skylar Cagle** boasts a 3.82 ERA and 2-1 record. **Micaela Bouvier**, the Southland Conference Pitcher of the Week (2/16-2/21) is 4-4 with a 4.37 ERA.

TAKING ONE FOR THE TEAM

Over the past decade and a half, no NSU softball player has been hit by more pitches than senior **Brittany Virgoe**. Virgoe's hit by pitch on Tuesday at No. 5 LSU was the 29th of her career, second only to Shanté Jones (1996-99), who was hit by 30 pitches in four seasons.

Virgoe was hit by a whopping 14 pitches in 105 at-bats during her 2012 freshman campaign. By contrast, the Anaheim, Calif., native was hit just three times in 2013 before tripling that number with nine one season ago. She has registered three thus far this season.

BAYLOR STANDOUT FINDS HOME WITH NSU

Two years removed from being named the Big 12 Conference's Defensive Player of the Year as a senior, NSU tabbed Baylor softball standout **Kathy Shelton** as an assistant coach. Following the 2013 season, she was one of just 20 Big 12 student-athletes to receive the Dr. Prentice Gautt Postgraduate Scholarship.

Shelton is the Lady Bears single-season leader in steals (41) as well as all-time leader (121) in the category. As a sophomore, she led the team in batting average (.359), hits (74), runs (35) and stolen bases (33), playing a vital role in the Lady Bears' 2011 Women's College World Series berth.

NORTHWESTERN STATE IN THE SOUTHLAND RANKINGS

NSU is hitting .292 as a team, ranking fourth in the Southland entering conference play and is second in runs scored (104), hits (153) and RBIs (99) while taking first in doubles (37) and home runs (21). NSU is fifth in walks (57) and is tied for third in hits by pitch (11).

In the circle, NSU is sixth in earned run average (4.85), compared to last week's 4.38 ERA and fifth place mark. The staff is second in strikeouts (80) while the Lady Demons have allowed the third fewest home runs (9).

The Lady Demons are last in the league in fielding percentage (0.939) and has the highest number of errors (34).

SUCCESS BREEDS EXPECTATION

After claiming Southland Conference Tournament championships each of the last two seasons, NSU was picked to win the Southland regular-season title, garnering six first-place votes and 116 points from the league's head coaches. NSU was picked second by the conference's sports information directors, tallying five first-place votes and 109 points.

"It says a lot about the respect anyone has about what we've done here the last couple years," seventh-year head coach **Donald Pickett** said. "It's a new year and we can't get wrapped up in preseason polls. We've got to come out and prove ourselves again."

NSU returns 13 letterwinners including five starters as well as four pitcher who look to help NSU do just that.

7th Season at NSU



Donald Pickett enters his seventh year at the helm of the Northwestern State softball program after guiding the Lady Demons to consecutive Southland Conference Tournament crowns and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2013 and 2014.

One season ago, under Pickett's direction, NSU posted a 30-22 record including a 15-10 mark in Southland play. Beginning on April 12 against Central Arkansas, NSU won 13 of its final 16 games including three straight at the conference tournament in Hammond.

With the conference tournament title in tact behind an 11-0 victory over McNeese State, Pickett's squad headed to the Waco Regional alongside No. 13 Baylor, Houston and Tulsa.

For their efforts, nine Lady Demons were named to the All-Southland squad. Six NSU players were also selected as members of the Louisiana Sports Writers Association's all-Louisiana squad. Senior Tara McKenney and freshman Kellye Kincannon also became the first NSU players in over 10 years to earn All-South Region honors from the National Fastpitch Coaches Association.

Several Lady Demons climbed the school's individual career records list highlighted by McKenney who finished fifth in at-bats (712), third in hits (246) and third in triples (14). Not to be undone, Cassandra Barefield entered her 2015 senior campaign second all-time with 36 home runs.

In 2013, Northwestern State found itself in similar circumstances. As they did in 2014, the Lady Demons took second place in the regular season after a hot finish to the season. When it mattered, NSU posted three straight conference tournament victories including a dramatic 5-4 win against Sam Houston State to claim the title.

The squad made an NCAA Tournament appearance in the Baton Rouge Regional and played a nailbiter against Super Regional qualifier UL Lafayette.

Pickett was voted Coach of the Year honors on the 2013 All-Louisiana softball team, outpolling his NCAA Tournament counterparts from LSU and UL Lafayette among the voters from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Five Lady Demons were included on the All-Louisiana Team.

The 2013 haul of accomplishments included the best winning percentage in the program's history (.727), the longest winning streak (11) since 1998, the fewest losses (15) since 1983 and the best 20-game start (16-4) since 1990. The Lady Demons won every conference series except the opener at eventual champion McNeese State.

Five players altered the school record books as the Lady Demons finished four spots higher than predicted in a preseason coaches' poll.

"Donald deserves all the credit in the world for resurrecting the NSU softball program. It was very satisfying for me to see how happy he was when the team won the Southland Conference tournament championship and had the privilege of representing our conference at the NCAA Regionals, because I knew very well the arduous and persevering path that he had taken over the past five seasons," said NSU director of athletics Greg Burke.

Meanwhile, the renovation of the Lady Demon Softball Complex was completed, giving NSU an outstanding facility that already has been chosen to host the 2015 Southland Conference Tournament after impressing everyone as the 2013 conference tourney was played here.

But there are more steps forward to take. Donald Pickett has a plan, and he's working it.

To see where Pickett plans to carry NSU softball, you only see where he's already been as an assistant coach.

Pickett helped Tennessee-Chattanooga to three NCAA Tournament appearances and the brink of a Women's College World Series berth while on the Mocs' staff.

The 36-year-old Pickett finished his 17th season of collegiate coaching experience, his fifth as head coach at NSU. He spent two years helping establish a brand-new program at Memphis after working in a pair of highly successful programs at Tennessee-Chattanooga and Chattanooga State Community College. At Chattanooga State, Pickett was part of a staff that coached the team to three top-five finishes in the junior college

softball world series along with three regional and conference championships.

He also has coached the Austin (Tenn.) Eagles American Softball Association summer team to four national tournament appearances and two top-five finishes in the ASA nationals.

Pickett learned about the Northwestern coaching post from Pat Murphy, the coach of College World Series participant Alabama, who was among several nationally-prominent coaches consulted during the summer 2008 search for a new Lady Demons head coach.

“Starting with his high level of character and integrity, Donald Pickett has an amazing reputation in the collegiate softball world. He will serve as a good role model for our student-athletes while also providing them with the motivation and coaching needed to return Northwestern State to the point of challenging for Southland Conference titles and NCAA postseason berths,” said NSU director of athletics Greg Burke, announcing Pickett’s hiring.

Working for five seasons under coach Frank Reed at UTC, Pickett helped the Mocs advance within one win of the World Series. The Mocs had an overall 210-126 record while picking up three Southern Conference championships before Pickett joined coach Wendy Thees at Memphis following the first year of softball for the Tigers.

Also serving as assistant to Reed at Chattanooga State CC for three seasons, Pickett helped post a 151-27 record, including a 62-3 mark in 2001. A year earlier, Pickett was part of the National Fastpitch Coaching Staff of the Year, and in 2002, Pickett was among the Chattanooga State team that was inducted into the Chattanooga Sports Hall of Fame.

A 2005 UTC graduate, Pickett is regarded as an excellent recruiter whose expertise coaching hitting and defense is recognized nationally.

Coaching and administrative colleagues of Pickett’s were effusive in their praise.

“Donald is ready to be a head coach,” said Thees. “His softball knowledge is incredible and he does a great job of getting to know his players and recruits.”

Said Lynn Parkes, the senior woman administrator at Memphis: “Donald Pickett is a man of character and integrity. He loves the game of softball and loves working with young people. I think he will do a fantastic job.”

In Pickett’s first season as assistant coach at his alma mater, the 2001 Lady Mocs opened the season with back-to-back no-hitters and knocked off top-25 teams in Ohio State and Baylor, rolling to a 44-15 record while never dropping more than two games in a row. The Lady Mocs posted two upset wins over top-seeded and No. 12 ranked Florida Atlantic in the NCAA Regionals. UTC then just missed capturing a berth in the World Series after narrow losses to Georgia Tech and Florida State.

“There may not be a better fundamental coach out there,” said UTC’s Reed. “He is a

good person, the type of person your family would like to be associated with, and he is perhaps one of the most ‘up and coming’ young coaches out there right now.”

A strong reference came from an in-state rival of UTC’s, head coach Torey Acheson at Tennessee Tech.

“At Tennessee-Chattanooga, those players all became better under him.....technically, his knowledge base is really good....he is an upstanding human being; he was raised right.”

Said Laura Mincy, assistant athletic director and SWA at UTC: “Donald is very determined and passionate about college softball. He’s a gem.”

Donald is married to Paige Pickett, and they have one daughter, Ainsley Elizabeth (6), born Jan. 9, 2009 in Natchitoches.

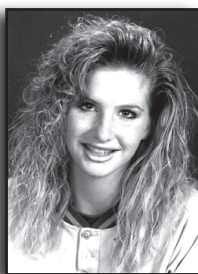

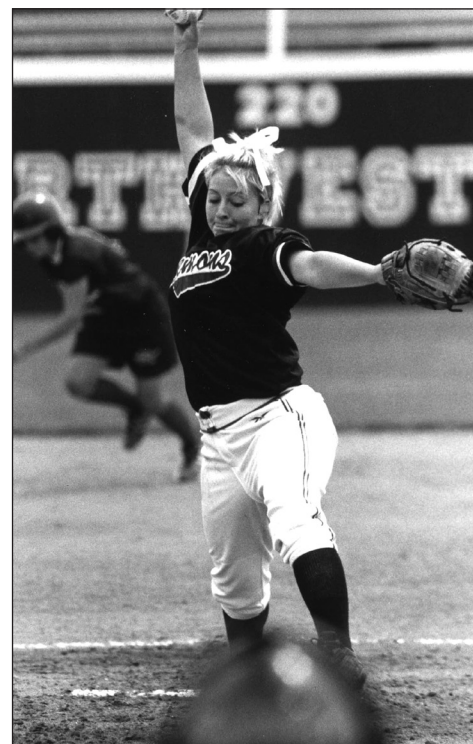
