#### LEADING OFF

- Northwestern State scored a season-high seven runs in the fourth inning against Stephen F. Austin on Tuesday to secure its first run-rule victory of the season. It was head coach Lacy Prejean's first home win as the Demons' skipper.
- NSU left a season-high 13 runners on base in the second game of Tuesday's doubleheader, including eight in scoring position. It was the second time this season they left 10 or more runners on base. They left 10 on against Evansville in a 3-0 win against the Aces.
- The Demons stole five bases in game one against SFA, the first time since March 2019 against Abilene Christian stealing five bases in one game. NSU is just five steals short of matching last year's season total of 28. Freshman **Sophia Livers** leads the team with seven steals in seven attempts this year.
- Tristin Court** brings a seven-game hitting streak into the Longhorn Invitational, matching the best streak of her career. Court leads the team with a .382 batting average and is 11-for-22 overall in the past seven games. She has already hit seven doubles this year, including two more on Tuesday, a new career-best, single-season mark.
- Senior catcher **Ashlyn Walker** leads the Southland Conference in caught stealing this year having thrown out five runners so far. She had 10 all of last year ago and finished third in the conference.
- NSU has had seven or more hits in five of the past six games. They are 4-1 during that stretch in game with seven hits.
- After drawing seven in two games on Tuesday, NSU now leads the Southland as a team and ranks 15th in the country in walks this year with 59.

**THE FIELD**

- Northwestern State will play Penn State and Tarleton for the first time in program history this weekend.
- For the second time in three seasons NSU will play the No. 2 ranked team in the polls when it faces Texas on Friday. The Demons played No. 2 Alabama during the 2022 season at a neutral site, falling to the Tide 8-3. NSU is winless against ranked teams in the past 10 seasons (0-25). The Demons have played the No. 1 ranked team in the country on one occasion when they faced top-ranked Florida during the 2017 season.

**PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE**

- Northwestern State had three players chosen for the preseason all-conference team -- Maggie Darr (Sr. - P), Laney Roos (Sr. - OF) and Ashlyn Walker (Sr. - C).
- Roos got her second straight preseason nod while the battery of Darr and Walker each earned their first.
- NSU had the third most preseason selections behind McNeese's eight and Southeastern's five. The Demons were picked to finish sixth in the preseason poll.

**DARR DARR BINKKKKKKs**

- Maggie Darr was NSU's game one starter through the entire 2023 season leading to a career year for the now senior in her second full season of action. She threw more than 100 innings and had more than 100 Ks in a season for the first time in her career in 2023, leading the team in both categories.
- She finished third in the conference with 126 strikeouts and eighth with 127.1 innings pitched in 2023.
- She currently has a 7.27 strikeout/7 rate for her career, the second highest of any NSU pitcher. In 2022, she topped out with an 8.26 rate with 92 Ks in 78 innings, good enough for 68th in the nation that year and second in the Southland. She finished just under one punchie per inning last season at 6.93 rate this past year.
- Her fewest walks allowed/7 rate sits just outside the top 10 right now at 2.10. She has a 3.46 strikeout-to-walk ratio for her career.
- As it stands she has the fourth lowest opponents batting average (.243) in program history.

**NSU's IRON WOMAN**

- Graduate senior Kat Marshall has been a mainstay for the Demons at first base for multiple years.
- She leads the team with 181 total games started for her career. She had a streak of 88 games started streak broken against SFA (Feb. 13). She has lined up at first base for NSU in 181 of the past 186 overall games.
- Marshall is NSU's active leader in hits (139), doubles (34), home runs (13), extra-base hits (48) and RBI (87).
- She's had double-digit doubles in each of the past two seasons and needs just six more to enter the top 10 all time in program history.
- She is the fourth player in program history to record more than 1,000 career putouts and needs 228 more to pass Brianna Rodriguez (1, 327) for the most all-time. Marshall had a career-high 346 putouts in 2023.

**DOWN...BUT NOT OUT**

- On Feb. 24 NSU engineered its largest come-from-behind win in nearly 10 years to beat Syracuse 11-8 to close out the Best on the Bayou weekend at ULM. It was the first win over a Power 5 school since beating Boston College 9-5 in 2019.
- The Demons fell behind 6-0 after the first two innings and outscored the Orange 11-2 over the final five innings for their largest comeback win since an 11-10 win over Ball State on Feb. 28, 2015.
- NSU hit three home runs in the span of four batters in the third inning to spark the comeback and scored five runs in the sixth to take the lead after trailing 8-5 entering the inning.
- The Demons drew a season-high seven walks in the game and got the tying run to score from third on a bases-loaded hit by pitch drawn by Ashlyn Walker. The next batter, freshman Aly Delafield, put NSU ahead on a two-run, two-out single to right.

**DOUBLE CAMO**

- Freshman Cameron Curtis had a breakout day for the Demons on the second day of the Best of the Bayou weekend at ULM.
- Curtis recorded her first collegiate hit in the first game against Evansville, a double to center field. That came one inning after her first outfield assist where she doubled off a runner at second base to end the inning.
- Later in the day she recorded her next two career hits that also went for two bases against Sam Houston. She had a 2-for-3 game against the Bearkats with two doubles, her first career RBI, and her first two runs scored.

**100-HIT CLUB**

- NSU has had three players so far this year join the 100-hit club for their careers.
- Taylor Williams surpassed 100 career hits during ULM's Best of the Bayou weekend by going 9-for-16 (.562) with a home run and nine RBI. Her 100th career hit drove in a run on a single to right against Sam Houston on Feb. 24.
- Tristin Court got 100th career hit during weekend number two of the season in the first game on Sunday against Houston. Her 100th was a two-run home run that capped a 5-run inning against the Cougars. Court had 26 hits during her freshman season at Louisiana Tech.
- Bailie Ragsdale got her 100th hit on a perfectly placed bunt passed the third baseman against SFA on Feb. 27.
- The Demons now have five active members of the 100-hit club as Ragsdale, Williams and Court joined Laney Roos, and NSU's active leader in hits Kat Marshall.
- Ashlyn Walker is likely to reach the milestone this year with 84 to her name so far, she had 45 hits in her two seasons at North Texas before transferring to NSU.

**MADE A GOOD CHOICE**

- NSU first-year head coach Lacy Prejean was named d1softball.com's best new head coaching hire prior for the 2024 season.
- The Demons were one of 35 schools across the country to hire a new head coach prior to the season. There were five Power 5 programs among those including three in the ACC and two from the Big 10.
- Prejean is the only new coach in Southland Conference softball this season.
- Lindsay Leftwich, who spent the past 12 years as an assistant under Beth Torina at LSU, was an all-conference third baseman for the Demons from 2001-04.

**THE ROOS LEGACY**

- Twin sisters Laney and Lexie Roos are just the latest in a lineage of Roos girls to play softball for Northwestern State.
- They are the younger sisters of pitcher Kylie Roos who was a two-time all-conference pitcher for NSU from 2010-13.
- Kylie has the fourth best single-season win percentage in program history after going 17-5 (.773) in the circle in NSU's SLC Tournament Championship season of 2013.
- Kylie ranks fourth in career wins (50), shutouts (15) and strikeouts (465) in school history.
- Laney is the biggest offensive threat of the sisters after a .365 season in 2022 where she had 58 hits, 11 doubles and drove in 32. The 58 hits was tied for eighth most in a season by a player under head coach Donald Pickett.

**SISTERHOOD OF THE TRAVEL BALL PANTS**

- Before they were teammates at Northwestern State, four Dallas area Demons got to know each other on the travel ball circuit.
- Tristin Court, Kenzie Seely, Ashlyn Walker and Taylor Williams were all teammates on the Excel Elite summer travel ball team.

**NEARLY SEEN IT ALL**

- For the second straight season NSU possesses one of the most experienced teams in the Southland Conference.
- The Demons return seven of their eight starting position players from a year ago. Of that group five have made over 110 starts at the Division I level. Junior Bailie Ragsdale will join that group with her next start, ending her 2023 sophomore season with 99 starts.
- Laney Roos has started 122 consecutive games for NSU.
- In the circle Maggie Darr and Kenzie Seely each have more than 30 starts in their careers and made more than 15 this past year.

**THE DELAFIELD LEGACY**

- Freshman Aly Delafield has NSU Purple and White running through her veins.
- She is the younger sister of former Demon pitcher and outfielder E.C. Delafield who was an all-conference player for the Demons from 2018-20. She had a 28-14 record with over 200 strikeouts in the circle and hit .277 at the plate with 34 extra-base hits and 64 RBI.
- Her grandfather, Sammy Joe Odom, is a member of the N-Club Hall of Fame at NSU. He was a 1963 All-American on the defensive line for the Demon football team. He also played two seasons for the Houston Oilers and on the Top 100 Demons of the Century roster.

# LACY PREJEAN

Northwestern State Director of Athletics Kevin Bostian announced the hiring of Lacy Prejean as the 12th head coach of the NSU softball program in July 2023.

Prejean comes to Natchitoches after spending the past five seasons as an assistant at UL Lafayette helping lead the Ragin' Cajuns to four Sun Belt Championships, four NCAA Regionals and the Seattle Super Regional this past year.

"When you look for a head coach, there are certain qualities you would like that person to embody," Bostian said. "Lacy Prejean checks the boxes we wanted to see as the next Northwestern State softball coach. She has an insatiable work ethic and is not afraid to get her hands dirty to accomplish the goals she has for herself and for her program.

"She is deeply tied and rooted to her home state, which gives her insight into what type of person fits well here. Lacy played the game at a high level and has played for and coached alongside some of the most successful and influential coaches in college softball. The combination of those factors have prepared her to become a successful head coach, and we look forward to see her do just that at Northwestern State."

Prejean worked on the staff at ULL that won an average of 49 games in each of the past five non-COVID shortened seasons. In each of those seasons they also had more than 20 conference wins, including a perfect 25-0 run through the Sun Belt in her first year on staff in 2019.

During that time, the Ragin' Cajuns

also won the conference tournament title each year advancing to the NCAA Tournament with regional appearances at Ole Miss, Clemson and twice at LSU. ULL made its first trip to the Super Regionals since 2016 this past season at Washington.

The team success of the previous five seasons in Lafayette for Prejean were in many ways reminiscent to the success she saw there in her first stint with her hometown school.

The Scott native began her coaching career with the Ragin' Cajuns in 2004 after an outstanding four-year playing career at Alabama. ULL also won a pair of conference titles then and earned three NCAA Regional appearances in her first three seasons with the team.

"Lacy will be a very successful head coach," UL head coach Gerry Galsco said. "She is extremely intelligent and her work habit matches her intelligence. She is personable, charismatic and energetic. In short, she is a home run hire for Northwestern State."

Three years after returning home to begin her career, Prejean joined her alma mater to continue it.

She worked on the staff with Hall of Fame coach Patrick Murphy as the Director of Softball Operations at Alabama from 2007-09. There she managed many off-field duties that helped round out and add to her coaching toolbox, all of which were instrumental to consecutive WCWS appearances for the Tide during her two seasons on staff.

"Lacy will always be one of my favorite student-athletes I've coached

at Alabama," Murphy said. "She will create a family atmosphere in Natchitoches like never seen before. The young women who play for her will love the entire experience."

After a stint working for her family business back home and coaching travel softball for the Louisiana Hotshots 14u and 16u teams, Prejean found her way back to the Cajun staff with the hiring of coach Gerry Glasco in 2018.

A former catcher, Prejean served as a defensive coach during both stops with the Ragin' Cajuns while also assisting the head coach with offensive development. With her guidance, the Cajuns posted two of the top 10 best single-season team fielding percentages in



school history in the past five seasons.

She has helped develop five NCAA All-Americans, including Danyelee Gomez, Summer Ellyson and most recently Karly Heath and D1 softball and NFCA Freshman All-American Mihyia Davis a year ago. The Cajuns have also produced 16 all-region player, 26 other all-conference honorees and had four different Sun Belt Player of the Year award winners in the past five seasons.

Prejean excelled in all aspects of the Cajuns' softball program during her time, assisting with camps during the fall, winter and summer, yearly athletic scholarships, on- and off-campus recruiting, academics, fundraising and alumni events.

All told, as a member of a collegiate coaching staff, Prejean has been to two Women's College World Series, three NCAA Super Regionals, nine NCAA Regionals and won six conference championships.

A Carencro High School graduate, Prejean was a four-time All-SEC catcher for Alabama from 2000-03, helping the

Crimson Tide to their first WCWS berth in 2000.

That year, Prejean started 60 games for the Tide, hit .254 on the season with four home runs and 21 RBIs on her way to being named SEC Freshman of the Year and the first of her four all-conference honors.

She earned an invitation to try-out for the USA National Team following her junior season at Alabama and was named an Easton All-American in her senior year. In 2006 she won a gold medal for the USA in the Women's Baseball World Cup in Taiwan.

Lexi Smith joined Northwestern State's softball staff as a pitching coach in August of 2021.

Her impact was immediate on the NSU pitching staff in her first season as the Lady Demons had the best overall ERA in the Southland Conference in 2022.

She helped guide freshman pitcher Sage Hoover to Freshman of the Year honors in her first season with a Southland-best 175 strikeouts, the most by a pitcher in 14 seasons under head coach Donald Pickett.

NSU ended the season with four pitchers ranked in the top 10 in the conference in ERA including two in the top three.

Smith was the pitching coach at NCAA Division III Southwestern for one season, where she tutored all-conference pitcher Kinly McCaffery.

Melissa Mayeux joined the NSU softball coaching staff in August of 2023.

Mayeux reunites with Prejean after the two spent three years together as player and coach for UL Lafayette where Mayeux garnered Sun Belt Player of the Year honors in 2022.

A native of Le Barcares, France, Mayeux was a do-it-all utility player in her three seasons with the Rajun Cajuns, playing seven different positions on the field, including all five infield spots, while maintaining a near .300 batting average and .900-plus OPS at the plate.

In her Sun Belt Player of the Year senior season of 2022, Mayeux rose to the top of UL's impact player list during a nine-game stretch in late March where she hit .440 with four home runs, a pair of doubles and nine RBI.

From that point forward she led the Cajuns in average (.336), runs (35), hits (42), doubles (12), home runs (6), RBI (29) and fielding percentage (.989) over a 28-game span to secure the Sun Belt's top honor of the season.

Her award-winning season capped a career that included a total of

42 extra base hits, with at least one of each kind in each of her three seasons, accounting for nearly half of her 89 career hits. She also drove in a total of 75 runs and scored 74 across 129 games played and 110 starts as the Cajuns won back-to-back conference titles in her final two seasons in Lafayette.

A highly decorated player before ever arriving in Louisiana, Mayeux was a member of the French U-18 Junior National baseball team and at the age of 14 was accepted into one of only two baseball academies in France.

Two years later she became the first female player to be added to Major League Baseball's International Registration List, thus making her the first female player eligible to be signed or drafted by an MLB club.

After deciding to play softball collegiately in the States, Mayeux began her career at Miami Dade College where she was a two-time All-Southern Conference player, led the team in average both years, hitting .431 during her sophomore campaign, and had 14 home runs, 31 doubles and 90 RBI in two seasons.
