Northeastern State University Head Coach

KENNY EVANS



Kenny Evans became head coach of the Northeastern State RiverHawks football program in 2008 after 28 years as an assistant coach at six other universities. During that span, Evans coached in six bowl games, two national playoffs, and was part of a coaching staff that won eight conference championships. His ninth conference championship was added in 2010 as the RiverHawks posted their first winning season in 10 years.

Evans led NSU to its second-consecutive winning campaign in 2011 as the team posted a 7-5 mark as an independent, which included a six-game win streak and a trip to the Mineral Water Bowl against Minnesota State University. The 2011 team was one of the most successful in school history, as the RiverHawks recorded 30 team and individual school records

Evans has coached or recruited nine All-American, 11 conference players of the year, over a dozen who have made it into the National Football League, as well as numerous All-Conference players at seven different colleges.

Before taking the NSU job, Evans coached linebackers at Louisiana Tech for Derek Dooley in 2008. In 2005, he was named the National Assistant Coach of the Year by the Football Foundation while coaching at the University of North Texas on the staff of Darrell Dickey.

While at North Texas, Evans had phenomenal success as the assistant head coach, recruiting coordinator and defensive coordinator. He helped build that program to its greatest success where the Mean Green won 38 conference games in a row, four conference championships and qualified for four bowl games. During that stretch, Evans' defenses were nationally-ranked in most statistical categories, a feat also accomplished at Missouri Southern and Southeastern Oklahoma.

The Warner, Okla., native and Northeastern State graduate began his coaching career at Miami (Okla.) High School in 1981 before joining the college ranks as a graduate assistant coach at the University of Oklahoma for Barry Switzer and the Sooners. Afterwards, he followed long-time Sooner offensive coordinator Galen Hall to the University of Florida where he coached wide receivers for the Gators for one year.

His coaching career took him on a 12-year run with the late Jon Lantz to Southeastern Oklahoma and later to Missouri Southern. As defensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator, Evans helped rebuild both program to national prominence before joining Dickey at North Texas.

"I have been fortunate during my career to be a part of some great programs and great mentors," Evans said, whose father, Pete Evans, was a long-time and successful high school coach.

His experiences at NCAA Division I and NCAA Division II levels infused a wealth of knowledge into the RiverHawks' program upon his arrival on campus. His philosophy is simple -- "Discipline, Organization, Enthusiasm and Energy."

Evans is making good on his promise to return Northeastern State to the glory years of the past, exemplified by the back-to-back winning seasons, the 2010 LSC North championship and the 2011 record-breaking campaign.

"These first four years under my belt have been a cultural changing time for our program," Evans said, "The foundation has been set for the return of championships as we develop quality student-athletes. I am extremely excited where this program is headed and look forward to joining the MIAA Conference and competing against some of the best programs in the country."

Evans has a 14-year-old son, Elliott, who plays football, basketball and the violin.

Paul Lane >> Offensive Coordinator

Paul Lane is in his first season as the offensive coordinator of the RiverHawks.

Lane, a 1994 graduate of NSU, was an NAIA Division I Football All-American in 1992 and helped lead Northeastern State to two Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference Championships (1990-91).

He was a three-time All-Conference performer and was a member of two NSU teams that qualified for the NAIA Division I Football National Championship.

where he spent four years from 2002-06 serving as both the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. He helped lead the Savage Storm to two Lone Star Conference North Division Championships (2004-05) and two conference runner-up finishes (2002-03).

Southeastern had the No. 1-ranked scoring offense in the LSC in both 2003 and '04. The team was also No. 2 in total offense in the league both of those seasons, and the Storm had the No. 1-ranked turnover margin in Lane's final year in 2005.

Lane was also the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Kilgore College from 1998-02. He was also the O-line coach at Butler County Community College from 1996-98 following his stint at NSU as the O-line coach from 1993-96.

Lane received his Master of Science in college teaching from Northeastern State in August 1998. He also earned his Bachelor of Science in health & physical education from NSU in January 1994.

Prior to returning to Northeastern State, Lane spent six years at Forest Laboratories in St. Louis, Mo., as a senior medical representative in the Therapeutics Division.

His last coaching stop came at Southeastern Oklahoma State University,



Steve Patterson >> co-Defensive Coordinator

Steve Patterson is entering his first year as the co-defensive coordinator for NSU.

Patterson, a former assistant head coach at Central Oklahoma, will immediately assume the position of co-defensive coordinator.

A native of Miami, Okla., Patterson earned his bachelor's degree at Oklahoma State in 1991 and a master's from NSU in 2003. He began his coaching career at Wilburton High School in 1991 before moving to Claremore High School in 1993. Patterson returned to his hometown to serve as an assistant coach at

NEO from 2000-2006. He left the Golden Norsemen in 2006 for Central Oklahoma where he was the defensive coordinator for one season before being elevated to assistant head coach for the Bronchos from 2007-2011.

At UCO, Patterson coached 23 All-Lone Star Conference players, two All-Americans, three LSC North Linebackers of the Year and two who played in the NCAA Division II Cactus Bowl. His 2009 defense ranked No. 5 nationally in passes intercepted, his 2008 defense was No. 20 in NCAA Division II in rushing defense and in 2007, the UCO was ranked No. 29 in total defense.

He also helped lead the Norse win the Southwest Junior College Football Conference championships in 2000, 2002 & 2003. In 2005, NEO finished the year ranked sixth en route to claiming the SJFC co-championship at 9-3. He left the program after coaching 37 NCAA Division I-A defensive players and 52 who signed with Division I or I-AA teams.

Immediately after high school, Murray signed and played football at Pittsburg State, then later transferred to Northeastern State to continue his education.

Murray entered the military where he became an instructor and master fitness trainer in the Army during Operation Just Cause and Desert Storm.

Murray brings a wealth of knowledge from life experiences and has been a positive influence in the RiverHawks' camp.

According to head coach Kenny Evans, Murray's work ethic and stability make him a great strength coach and he has worked to help form NSU's linebackers into the team's top performers.

He also will coordinate the team's Habits and Attitude Class.



Greg Richmond >> Defensive Line

Greg Richmond begins his third season as an assistant coach at Northeastern State. He is responsible for the defensive line.

After two seasons as strength & conditioning coach at Oklahoma State, Richmond began the 2010 football year at Oklahoma City's Douglas High School before being hired on by head coach Kenny Evans.

Richmond played linebacker and defensive end for the Cowboys before signing a free agent contract with the NFL's Philadelphia Eagles. He was a member of the Eagles' developmental teams in 2004 & 2006 and on the in-

A two-year starter for the RiverHawks, Cawyer will coach tight ends, the position he played at NSU, and he also will have recruiting responsibilities.

A native of Commerce, Okla., Cawyer earned All-Lone Star Conference accolades as a senior.

He signed with the University of Tulsa out of high school

and lettered there in 2007 where he saw action in all 14 games as a redshirt freshman before transferring to NSU.

A highly decorated prep athlete, Cawyer caught 52 passes for 778 yards and 17 touchdowns in high school, while also totaling 281 tackles, 15 sacks and seven interceptions during his career.

As a senior, he had 41 catches at tight end for 603 yards and 13 TDs.
