# NSU ATHLETICS 2006-07 IN REVIEW

The 2006-07 school year was another extremely successful one for the NSU Athletics Department. In addition to numerous academic and athletic accolades, the Spartans captured three MEAC team championships and won the school's third consecutive Talmadge Layman Hill Award for MEAC men's all-sports excellence. Listed below are some of the highlights.

- 1) NSU captured its third straight Talmadge Layman Hill Award for MEAC men's all-sports excellence in 2006-07. It is the fourth Talmadge Layman Hill Award in the program's history.
- 2) The NSU men's cross country team won a record seventh straight MEAC championship in October. That title catapulted the Spartans and coach Kenneth Giles to a sweep of the conference track titles in 2006-07.
- 3) Thirty-four NSU athletes were named to the MEAC Commissioner's All-Academic Team. To qualify, athletes had to be at least a sophomore in class standing and have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- 4) First baseman Ernie Banks was selected by the Florida Marlins in the 44th round of the Major League Baseball first-year player draft in June 2007. Banks, who helped NSU to a school Division I record 25 wins in 2007, became the first NSU baseball player drafted since 2001.
- 5) The Spartan softball team, led by NSU Female Athlete of the Year Hitomi Greene, won a school Division I record 26 games and finished second in the MEAC with a 13-1 conference record.
- 6) Senior Imani Moorman capped a stellar track and field career by winning the high jump at the 2007 MEAC Outdoor Championship. It was the fifth individual MEAC title of her career.
- 7) Guard Tony Murphy achieved several milestones for the men's basketball team. He scored a school Division I single-game record 43 points against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in December, and later in the year became the 26th player in school history to score 1,000 career points.
- 8) Senior tight end Jonathan Allen earned his second consecutive first-team All-MEAC football honor.
