#### Setting the Scene

The Spartans close out the 2018 Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament this weekend with a pair of games at the Mohegan Sun Arena in Connecticut. First, the Norfolk State men's basketball team will face Siena on Friday night at 8:30 p.m.

NSU will then play either Stony Brook or Holy Cross. Should the Spartans win Friday night, they would compete on Sunday at 11 a.m. in the winner's game of the Springfield Bracket. A loss on Friday night to Siena would force the Spartans to play on Saturday night at 8:30 p.m.

Both games this weekend will be broadcast live on ESPN3, with Pat O'Keefe handling play-by-play. The game can be viewed through the WatchESPN app. The tournament will also host live stats through its StatBroadcast page.

#### Series History

Norfolk State and Siena have never meet in their respective histories. The Spartans have also never played Holy Cross.

They have seen Stony Brook on the court before, a 74-68 victory for the Spartans last year up in New York. Ironically, as part of a home-and-home, Stony Brook will return to Echols Hall on Nov. 27, and the teams could potentially meet up twice in a week and a half. The Spartans haven't faced a non-conference opponent twice in one season since the 2011-12 campaign, when they played Marquette as part of the Paradise Jam (once at Marquette, once in the U.S. Virgin Islands).

The Saints stand 1-1 on the season, falling by 10 to Providence but defeating George Washington on the road last Thursday by eight. Both Providence and George Washington are part of the tournament's Naismith Bracket, which also includes Michigan and South Carolina. Siena shot 40 percent from 3-point

range (25-of-62) over its first two games as well as 42 percent overall. The Saints have also turned the ball over just 10 times per game and held a slight rebounding edge combined against their higher major opponents. Three players have hit double figures, including Jalen Pickett (13.0 points, 7.5 assists) and Kevin Degnan (12.0 points, 6.0 rebounds). Sloan Seymour has tallied 10.5 points, and he and Degnan have combined to hit 15-of-27 from deep. Evan Fisher (9.5 points, 6.0 rebounds) is another name to watch out for as well.

#### **Last Time Out**

South Carolina shot 52 percent overall and made 11 3-pointers on the way to an 81-64 win over Norfolk State on Tuesday night at Colonial Life Arena. The Gamecocks had a pair of players score 18 points each with Hassani Gravett shooting 5-of-6 from deep. A.J. Lawson also had 18 points with eight assists and six rebounds. NSU made 10 3-pointers for the night, with Nic Thomas hitting five in a row late in the game as part of a 5-of-7 night. He finished with 15 points as the only NSU scorer in double figures. He and Joe Bryant Jr. combined to score the last 23 points of the game for the Spartans. NSU made 43 percent from the floor (20-of-47), including 10-of-22 from 3-point range. Bryant, Mastadi Pitt, Alex Long and Jordan Butler each scored eight.

#### **Back-to-Back Big Games**

The wins over Mid-Atlantic Christian and then Clarion marked the first time in NSU's Division I history the Spartans won back-to-back games by at least 25 points. They also scored 52 points off turnovers during that two-game stretch.

#### **MACU Game Facts**

A few nuggets from NSU's 108-50 win over Mid-Atlantic Christian on Nov. 8:

- NSU won by 58 points, the second-biggest margin of victory in its D-I history after last year's 78-point win over the Mustangs
- The team's totals of 59 rebounds, 11 blocks and 83 field goal attempts all rank as the third-most in D-l history. NSU's 39 field goals were tied for the sixth-most as well
- The Spartans had 58 points in the paint, 37 points off turnovers, 26 second-chance points and 24 turnovers forced, all of them the most since last year's game against MACU
- · Since 2002-03, the Spartans have never had at least 59 bench points

#### **MEAC Rankings**

The Spartans sit second in the MEAC in scoring defense (60.0), blocks (5.0) and turnover margin (+6.50), and third in scoring margin (+12.5), field goal percentage defense (36.9), 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.3), defensive rebounds (28.3) and defensive rebound percentage (70.6).

#### National Rankings

On a national level, Norfolk State ranks 34th in turnover margin (+6.5), 38th in turnovers foced (19.00), 42nd in scoring defense (60.0), 63rd in field goal percentage defense (36.9), 68th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.3) and 90th in blocks per game (5.0).

#### March to 100

With 89 wins now, head coach Robert Jones is 11 away from reaching 100 for his career. His 100th win

would also give him the most of any NSU coach in the Division I era, topping the 99 Anthony Evans had from 2007-13. Only four coaches in NSU history have accumulated 100 wins.

#### Playing a Ranked Opponent

The game at No. 19/18 Michigan marked the first time in two years the Spartans faced a ranked team. It was also be the eighth team the Spartans played that was ranked since their victory over Missouri in the 2012 NCAA tournament. The Spartans have now played 20 ranked opponents total since moving to Division I in 1997.

#### Early Start

This year's start date of Nov. 6 marked the earliest start to the season ever for NSU. Prior to this year, the Spartans' earliest start date was Nov. 9 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons.

This was the fourth straight year the Spartans opened their season at a Power 5 opponent (South Carolina, 2015; Mississippi State, 2016; Auburn, 2017; Michigan, 2018). It was also the 14th time in the past 15 years NSU began its season away from home.

#### **Busy Stretch**

The Spartans began the season with three games in five days from Nov. 6-10. It is one of three such stretches for NSU this year. They will also play three games in five days from Nov. 16-20 and then again from Nov. 27-Dec. 1. Of its 15 non-conference games this year, Norfolk State plays nine of them in November.

#### Redshirts

Norfolk State has eight players on its roster this year who have used a redshirt at some point in their careers. Only four teams in Division I have more (CSU Bakersfield, UCF, Rider, Saint Mary's), and only three others also have eight players with redshirt seasons (Colorado State, Florida Gulf Coast, Wisconsin).

#### **Conference Standings**

NSU has finished fourth or better in the MEAC in 11 of the last 12 seasons.

#### Conference Streak

Last year, NSU secured its 20th straight season with a .500 or better conference record in its Division I era. In fact, in Norfolk State's 63 seasons in either the EIAC, CIAA or the MEAC, the program has had just one losing conference record (9-10 in the CIAA in 1990-91).

NSU ranks eighth in the nation for the longest streak of .500-or-better conference records in a row in D-I (See table page 6). NSU has posted 26 straight .500 or better conference records, dating back to that 1990-91 campaign.

Every other team in the MEAC has had at least one losing conference record since 2014-15.

#### **MEAC Tournament History**

NSU has been to the semifinals of the MEAC tournament eight times in the last 11 seasons. The Spartans have been a No. 4 seed or better in nine of the last 11 years. Last season marked the first time in seven years the Spartans were not at least a No. 4 seed.

#### Series Edge

NSU has a winning record against every school in the MEAC, with several of those series covering a lot of ground in the Division II era. The Spartans' closest rival over the years has been North Carolina A&T (25-22).

#### Best in the Conference

Since the start of the 2011-12 season, NSU is 87-25 in regular season conference play (46-10 at home, 41-15 on the road), ahead of North Carolina Central (85-27) during that time for the best record in the league. Counting MEAC tournament games, the Spartans are 97-31, while the Eagles are 98-31 during that time.

NSU also owns a 136-106 overall record since the start of the 2011-12 season, second in the conference to North Carolina Central (149-84).

#### Winning Record

NSU had six straight non-losing seasons from 2011-17. Prior to the start of that streak, NSU had a .500 or better overall record just twice in 14 seasons since moving to Division I in 1997.

#### All-Conference

NSU had a first-team all-conference player nine times in 10 seasons from 2008-17. Last year marked the first time in 15 years the Spartans did not have at least one all-conference player.

#### Postseason History

NSU has made six postseason appearances in its Division I era (1997-Present), and all came from 2012-17. It started with the NCAA tournament 2012 after the Spartans won their first-ever MEAC title. NSU went to the NIT in 2013 after winning the conference's regular season title at 16-0. NSU also faced Eastern Michigan (2014), Eastern Kentucky (2015), Columbia (2016) and Liberty (2017) in the CollegeInsider.com tournaments.

#### **Last Year's Team Tidbits**

- NSU set school records for 3-point field goals (254) and 3-point attempts (707), breaking the previous bests of 242 and 697 set in 2015-16. The Spartans set the Division I record for 3-point field goal percentage (35.9), topping the previous D-I record of 35.7 set in 1998-99. They sank 14 3-pointers in the win over Delaware State, tying that school record as well.
- Norfolk State was a second half team a year ago. The Spartans scored more points in the second half than the first in 25 of 33 games, with a 39.3-33.1 points per half discrepancy (+6.2) from the second to the first. Opponents, as well, scored the same amount or more points in the second half compared to the first half in 25 of 33 games (38.5-34.3, +4.2).
- The Spartans also had a +2.3 rebounding margin after the break compared to a +0.5 margin before. They shot 45.0 percent in second halves compared to 41.1 in first halves, including a 37.5-34.2 discrepancy in 3-point shooting.
- Seven different players led NSU in scoring last year: Derrik Jamerson Jr. and Steven Whitley (6), Alex Long, Mastadi Pitt, Nic Thomas and Kyle Williams (5), and Preston Bungei (2).
- NSU was 2-18 last year when opponents shot at least 40 percent overall, and 5-17 when the opposition scored at least 70 points. The Spartans were also 1-16 when the opponent shot better from the floor and 3-13 when the opposition shot better from 3-point range.
- The Spartans used 11 different starting lineup combinations last year.
- NSU ranked **first** in the MEAC in 3-point field goal percentage (35.9), **second** in scoring defense (73.2) and field goal percentage defense (41.8), and **third** in rebounding (38.5), opponent rebounding (35.7), rebounding margin (+2.8), defensive rebound percentage (71.2) and blocks (3.5).
- In conference games only, NSU ranked **first** in the MEAC in scoring defense (70.9), field goal percentage defense (38.4), 3-point field goal percentage (36.5), rebounding (42.9), rebounding margin (+7.2), defensive rebound

percentage (71.9) and offensive rebound percentage (36.1), second in 3-point field goal percentage defense (31.4), offensive rebounds (13.7), defensive rebounds (29.3) and blocks (3.4), and third in scoring margin (+5.5).

• On a national level, NSU stood No. 26 in offensive rebounds (12.45), No. 36 in turnovers forced (15.00), No. 41 in rebounds (38.48), No. 58 in field goal percentage defense (41.8), No. 82 in rebound margin (2.8), No. 113 in defensive rebounds (26.03) and No. 115 in 3-point field goal percentage (35.9).

#### Winning the State

Since the start of the 2011-12 season, NSU has the fourth-most wins (136) among the 14 Division I schools in the state of Virginia. The Spartans trail Virginia (190), VCU (180) and Old Dominion (142) (See table page 6).

#### **Predictable Numbers**

Since the start of the 2015-16 season, NSU is 47-6 when shooting better than the opposition and 3-49 when the other team has a better shooting percentage.

#### Good from 3

Norfolk State has made a 3-pointer in 286 straight games, dating back to a contest at South Carolina State on Jan. 25, 2010, when NSU finished 0-of-17 from 3-point range.

#### Ahead at the Half

The Spartans are 104-24 (81.3 winning percentage) since the start of the 2011-12 season when leading or tied at the half.

#### What Deficit?

NSU has erased a double-digit deficit in a victory 14 times in the previous four seasons, including three times last year.

## **Block Party**

NSU has averaged 159.3 blocks per season over the previous eight years. The program's six highest season totals all-time in terms of total blocks have come during that eight-year stretch.

#### O'Quinn in the NBA

Former Spartan Kyle O'Quinn is now in his seven year in the NBA and the first with the Indiana Pacers. He became NSU's first NBA player in 25 years after getting drafted in the second round in 2012 by the Orlando Magic. Last year, O'Quinn averaged career highs of 7.1 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.3 blocks per game while with the New York Knicks.

#### **Professional Spartans**

Aside from O'Quinn, NSU will have eight other players competing professionally. Michael Deloach (CS Dinamo Bucuresti of the Romanian National League), Pendarvis Williams (BG Goettingen of the German Basketball Bundesliga), Chris McEachin (Stade Rochelais Basket of the French NM1 League), and Jonathan Wade (Pully Basket of the Switzerland Basketball League) will all be entering at least their second year in Europe.

Anell Alexis (Universitarios De Panama of the Panamanian Basketball League) will be returning to Panama where he played previous. Three players who finished their NSU careers last year also will compete overseas: Preston Bungei (KK Jazine-Arbanasi Zadar of the Croatian Telecom Premier League), Kyle Williams (Newcastle Eagles ESH Group of the British Basketball League) and Dan Robinson (La Gallofa Cantbasket of the Spanish EBA League).


