#### The Opening Tip

Coming off their first victory of the season against Virginia Lynchburg this past Thursday, the Spartans look to keep it rolling against some solid competition with games against High Point and La Salle this week.

Wednesday's game against High Point will mark the halfway point of a three-game home stand for the Spartans, concluding with La Salle on Friday. The Spartans will have a week long break after La Salle, heading to the Jacksonville Thanksgiving Classic next weekend.

The Spartans filled up the stat sheet in their 123-48 win over VUL last week, making history along the way. Chanette Hicks recorded the first triple-double since 1996 and the first in NSU's Division I history, finishing the game with 20 points, 14 assists, and 11 steals. Her 14 assists also tied the single game record in NSU's DI history.

Hicks leads the team averaging 18.7 points a game, leading the MEAC in that category. Hicks also leads the team with eight assists per game, which is also ranked first in the conference. After Hicks' 11 steal performance against VUL, she now also leads the MEAC with 4.7 steals per game.

After averaging 10 points per game in her first two outings, La'Deja James exploded for 29 points against VUL. James now ranks fourth in the MEAC averaging 16.3 points per game, giving the Spartans two of the top five scorers in the MEAC so far this season.

Blaire Thomas has continued to dominate on the glass for NSU, adding 11 more rebounds in the game against VUL. Thomas leads the Spartans averaging 8.7 rebounds per game, which ranks her third in the conference.

#### Series History vs. High Point

This will be the sixth overall matchup against HPU, and the fourth time during head coach Larry Vicker's tenure. NSU is 2-3 all time versus the Panthers, and 1-2 under Vickers.

#### Last Meeting vs. High Point

The Panthers hosted the Spartans last year, coming away with an 83-51 victory.

Raven Russell dropped 17 points to lead the Spartans, while Lindsey Edwards led the Panthers with 20 points. Camryn Brown scored 18 in last year's game against the Spartans, and wil be returning on this 2019-20 Panther's squad.

#### Series History vs. La Salle

This will be the third overall matchup against the Explorers, and the second time during head coach Larry Vicker's tenure. NSU is 0-2 all time versus the La Salle, and 0-1 under Vickers.

#### Last Meeting vs. La Salle

The Spartans traveled to Philadelphia in their most recent game against La Salle, with the Explorers coming out on top against the Spartans 62-52.

Raven Russell dropped 15 points to lead the Spartans, while Shalina Miller led the Panthers with 14 points. Deja King scored 13 in last year's game against the Spartans as well. King and Miller return to this 2019-20 La Salle team.

Kayla Spruill is the only player besides Claire Jacobs to average in double-digits, scoring

The Explorers have the size advantage with most teams they matchup against, with all of their starters at least 6 foot. Four players are averaging at least five rebounds.

#### **Big Shoes to Fill**

The Spartans will look to replace production after losing four starting seniors from last year's squad, Khadedra Croker, Alexys Long, Raven Russell, and Kendrea Dawkins. Each one of these players that graduated from NSU possessed unique skillsets that Spartans are looking to replace.

Russell averaged double digits in scoring last season and was a All-MEAC second team selection. Long was the team's 3-point specialist that led the team with 42 made three-poiners. Croker led the Spartans with 60 blocks, also good for second in the MEAC. Dawkins was the team's leading rebounder averaging 5.6 per game.

There are also some familiar faces coming back, with La'Deja James and Dana Echols returning to the fold. During the Spartans push to the MEAC Championship game last year, both James and Echols were instrumental to the team's success. James led the team in scoring with 13.1 ppg, while Echols was the team's assist leader with 4.7 apg. James was named to the All-MEAC second team in this year's preseason poll voted on by coaches and SID's in the conference.

#### The Transfers

The experience lost with the four senior starters from last year was filled by number of transfers that are coming into this Spartans team. New faces that transferred to NSU and are playing this year include Chanette Hicks, Mikaela Jones, and Blaire Thomas.

The Spartans are expecting steady production from Norfolk native and Virginia Tech transfer Hicks, who sat out all of last season because of NCAA transfer regulations. During her career at VT, Hicks averaged 12.2 points per game and holds the single-season record for steals with 123, as well as the all-time school record with 288 steals in her career.

Jones and Thomas will bring length and size as well as considerable experience in the post for the Spartans. Jones started her career at South Georgia Tech, before moving to St. Petersburg College, while Thomas spent her freshman season at lowa State before transferring to lowa Western CC for one year and then Johnson C. Smith.

All three of the incoming transfers provide extra defensive capabilities for a team already known for its rock solid defense. Hicks should provide perimeter defense and a ton of steals, while Jones and Thomas will clog the paint and make opponents shots just a little more difficult.

#### The Returners

Another post presence returning for the Spartans is senior De'Janaire Deas, who has been at NSU her whole career and has appeared in 81 games for the Spartans. Last year Deas av-

eraged 5.2 ppg while shooting 47% from the field, and also averaged four rebounds per game. While NSU has traditionally had plenty of talented players in the painted area, Coach Vickers will also have a bevy of guards to choose from in his rotation.

Armani Franklin returns after spending two years with NSU. During her freshman season Franklin was named to the All-MEAC Freshman team after averaging 5.4 points, 2.3 rebounds and 1.8 assists in 20.8 minutes per game.

The daughter of former Spartan running back Orlando Goodhope, Danyael Goodhope returns after playing her first season at NSU as a junior. Prior to last season Goodhope made stops at Winthrop and Odessa College. She had a standout high school career at local powerhouse Princess Anne HS in Virginia Beach, where she was a three-time Virginia High School League Group 5A state champion.

Shekinah Howard and Jameila Barrett are sophomores returning to this NSU squad that are looking to take a step forward in their second season as Spartans. Both players won state titles and scored over 1,000 points during their high school career.

#### The Freshmen

One more player not yet mentioned in the backcourt is Cam Platt-Morris, a recent graduate of Woodbridge HS entering her freshman year at NSU. She carried Woodbridge to a VHSL State Championship and was named first-team allstate her senior year. As a senior she was selected by the Washington Post as an All-Metro honorable mention.

NSU also welcomes Norfolk local Ta'Liyah Edmonds, a graduate from Norview HS entering her freshman season. Listed at 6-2, she is the tallest member of the NSU roster and will be yet another shot blocking threat and post defender.

#### **Starting Strong**

In each of the last two seasons, NSU has only won two of their first five games. With plenty of new players it will be important for this Spartans team to mesh together early in the season

#### **January Friendly to Spartans**

In the past two seasons combined NSU is 11-3 in the month of January, mostly against other MEAC teams.

"We've had really good Januarys and really good early Februarys, but the last two years we haven't started strong and we haven't finished strong," Vickers said. "That will be our focus going into this season."

#### **Finishing Strong**

Last season the Spartans finished 3-1 in their last four games, taking them on a run to the championship game in the MEAC Tournament. It was the first finals appearance for the Spartans since 2005.

Norfolk State women's basketball knocked off top-seeded North Carolina A&T, 60-43, in the semifinals of the MEAC Tournament inside Scope Arena. In doing so, the Spartans snapped a 28-game win streak against conference opponents by the Aggies.

The Spartans would eventually fall 57-45 to Bethune-Cookman in the MEAC championship game.

La'Deja James led NSU in scoring with 18 points in all three games during the MEAC Tournament. James was named to the MEAC All-Touurnament team for her efforts.

#### Just Win, Baby

NSU's 72-51 win over Howard in the MEAC Quarterfinals ensured the Spartans finished above .500 last season with an 17-15 record, after finishing 2017-18 with an 18-11 record.

This marks just the second-ever occurrence of back-to-back winning seasons in NSU's Division I history. The Spartans went 15-13 in 1998-99 then followed up with a 19-11 record in 1999-2000.

The Spartans once owned a streak of 16-straight winning seasons spanning between the 1981-82 and the 1996-97 seasons, the longest such streak in program history.

In addition, Norfolk State went 15-15 in 2016-17, marking three-straight non-losing seasons for the first time in the DI era.

#### Nifty Fifty

Norfolk State notched its 50th win in the last three seasons with its 60-43 win over N.C. A&T in the semifinals of the MEAC Tournament.

The first three full seasons of head coach Larry Vickers' tenure will go down as the second-most successful three years in NSU's DI history. Only the 1999-2000, 2000-01 and 2001-02 teams posted more victories, winning 55 games.

NSU's win total in the past three seasons exceeds the program's total number of wins in the five prior years. Between the 2011-12 and 2015-16 seasons, the Spartans managed only 48 victories.

#### Academic Honors Arrive

Norfolk State is finding success in the classroom as well as on the court.

Jameila Barrett, Armani Franklin, Danyael Goodhope and Zairya West were recognized on the Athletics Director's Honor Roll for the fall semester of last year. To qualify for the AD's Honor Roll, student-athletes must earn a 3.0 GPA in fall semester classes.

Franklin was again a recepient of Honor Roll for this past Spring semester. She was further honored with induction into the University's Eta Chapter of Chi Alpha Sigma, the National College Athlete Honor Society. Inductees must maintain a GPA of 3.4 or higher and are selected based on outstanding academic performance, character, citizenship and athletics ability.

#### Spartans That Earned Weekly Honors

A trio of NSU players collected weekly accolades from the MEAC last season.

Danyael Goodhope was named defensive player of the week on Jan. 15 after her five-steal performance against Bethune-Cookman. Goodhope's constant pressure played a vital role in the Spartans' 57-50 win.

Goodhope became the fifth different Spartan to earn defensive player of the week honors since the start of the 2016-17 season. In that span, a NSU player has collected the award a total of 16 times.

NSU guard La'Deja James was named the MEAC's Defensive Player of the Week on Nov. 27 after averaging 5.7 rebounds, 4.3 steals and 0.7 blocks per game across three contests. The Virginia Beach native had at least three steals in each game, including seven against Liberty.

#### Phase IV Underway

On Jan. 20, 2016, head coach Larry Vickers inherited a NSU team that was 0-16 and 0-6 in the MEAC. Serving as interim head coach for the remainder of the season, Vickers guided the Spartans to a 3-8 record in the final 11 games of the season before having the interim label removed. Since then, Vickers has rebuilt the Norfolk State women's basketball program in short order.

Phase I saw NSU finish with a 15-15 record, including a 9-7 mark in conference contests, in Vickers' first full season at the helm. The Spartans underwent a 10-1/2 game turnaround, which was tied for the eight-best improvement in Division I that season. NSU's 12-game improvement from 2015-16 was also the largest single-season win increase in program history. Vickers coached Norfolk State to its first non-losing season since 2001-02 and to a winning MEAC record for just the During Phase II, the Spartans posted their first overall winning record in 16 years, going 18-11 in

2017-18. Those 18 victories are the third-most in NSU's D-I history, ranking behind only the 22 wins by the 2002 MEAC Championship squad and the 1999-00 team's total of 19. In conference action, NSU held a record of 11-5, marking the first-ever occurrence of back-to-back winning seasons in MEAC play. Norfolk State's last string of winning conference seasons ran from 1991 to 1997, when the Spartans were members of the DII Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association. Norfolk State logged its two-longest winning streaks of the DI era in 2017-18, rattling off nine-straight between Dec. 12 and Jan. 22, then six-straight from Feb. 10 until Feb. 26.

Phase III saw the Spartans make history in posting three-straight winning conference seasons for the first time since joining the MEAC in 1997-98. NSU also hit the 10-win mark in MEAC play for the second year in a row for its first instance of back-to-back 10-win seasons in its DI history. The Spartans' 10-6 conference record in 2018-19 marked just their fifth season with double-digit conference wins since joining Division I.

In addition, Vickers achieved a personal milestone in 2018-19 after reaching the 50-win plateau in NSU's 64-49 victory at Morgan State on Feb. 23. Vickers also owns the second-most MEAC victories in program history and is the only Spartan head coach to hold a winning record in MEAC play.

#### **Defensive Titans**

The 2017-18 season was a record-setting one on the defensive side of the ball for the Spartans. NSU ranked third nationally in defensive field goal percentage (32.8), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.9) and 18th in scoring defense (56.2).

A host of Division I era records fell in 2017-18, including fewest points allowed (1,630), scoring defense (56.2), field goal percentage defense (32.8) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.8). Additionally, the Spartans set the all-time program record in field goal percentage defense.

An unyielding defense has become a trademark for the Spartans under Vickers, who have turned in a top-40 scoring defense and a top-three field goal percentage defense in each of the last two seasons. In 2016-17, Norfolk State ranked 39th in D-I after allowing only 57.8 points per game and owned the nation's third-stingiest field goal percentage defense (33.4).

Last season, NSU ranked 11th in scoring defense (55.2), 11th in field goal percentage defense (35.1) and fourth in opponent 3-point percentage (25.8).

At the conference level, the Spartans rank first in scoring defense since the 2016-17 season, allowing 55.7 points per game in that span. During the same time period, Norfolk State tops all MEAC teams in field goal percentage defense (34%), blocks per game (5.5) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.3).

#### **Record Watching**

The 2018-19 edition of the Spartans left their marks on the record books. As a team, NSU set

single-season Division I marks in scoring defense (55.2), field goal percentage (40.1), 3-point field goals (149), defensive 3-point field goal percentage (25.8), assists (439) and assists per game (14.2).

In addition, the Spartans were third in defensive field goal percentage (35.1), third in free throw percentage (68.4), fifth in both blocks (120) and blocks per game (3.9) and in 3-point field goal percentage (29.7) and seventh in made field goals (685).

La'Deja James was eighth in steals per game (2.3) and in free throw percentage (80.0), and 13th in scoring average (13.1). Lastly, De'Janaire Deas ranked 11th in field goal percentage (47.1).

#### 4-0 Feelings

While the Spartans may start the regular season slowly, NSU has blitzed through the early portion of its MEAC schedule under head coach Larry Vickers. Norfolk State won its first four games to start MEAC play in 2017-18 and was 5-2 against conference opponents in January. The previous season, the Spartans started off 4-0 and were 5-2 in the MEAC in the month of January as well.

#### Protecting the Rock

"Turnovers have been one of our main focuses in practice," said head coach Larry Vickers. "At the pace we play, we're going to turn some teams over, so limiting our turnovers will give us a better chance to win."

With returners La'Deja James, Dana Echols, Danyael Goodhope and newcomer Chanette Hicks, the Spartans have plenty of speedy hands that can cause absolute having in the defensive back court. With these four on the court look for the Spartans to get above to 200 steals on the season.

The steals will no doubt come, but it will also be just as important for the Spartans to be smart with the ball and not to commit turnovers themselves. Last year NSU ranked third in the MEAC with 8.8 steals per game but only seventh in the conference with a -0.44 turnover margin.

#### Spreading the Love Around

NSU assisted on 27 of its 40 made baskets in last season's 93-40 victory over Cheyney. In the process, the Spartans matched the mark for the fourth-most assists in program history. Eight players recorded at least one assist in the game, and Dana Echols led all players with 12 assists on the night.

A third-year junior college transfer, Echols emerged as a steadying presence at the point for NSU and was second in the MEAC in assists per game (4.7) and is second in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.3). On the national stage, the Auburn, Ala. native was 64th in assists per game and 66th in total assists. The Spartans are 10-5 when Echols records five or more assists and are 7-0 when the junior guard scores 10 or more points.

The Spartans were 6-0 last season when assisting on 20 or more field goals and are 12-0 under head coach Larry Vickers when reaching the 20-assist threshold.

#### Who Are These Spartans

Head coach Larry Vickers welcomed eight newcomers into the program prior to the start of the 2019-20 season, the five include two freshmen and three transfers. There are another three transfers that will not be eligible to play until next season.

Chanette Hicks is a Norfolk native and graduate of Maury HS that transfered to NSU from Virginia Tech. Hicks sat out all of last season because of NCAA transfer regulations. During her career at VT, Hicks averaged 12.2 points per game and holds the single-season record for steals with 123, as well as the all-time school record with 288 steals in her career.

Mikaela Jones is a Portsmouth native that comes to NSU from St. Petersburg CC in Florida. Prior to St. Petersburg, Jones spent her freshman season at South Georgia Tech

Blaire Thomas is a forward from Waterloo, lowa. Thomas spent her freshman season at Iowa State, before moving on to Iowa Western CC and finally Johnson C. Smith. During her time at Johnson C. Smith, Thomas averaged 11.7 ppg, and 5.2 rpg,

Cam Platt-Morris is a four-year letter winner from Woodbridge HS. She helped Woodbridge HS to a VHSL State Championship and was named firstteam all-state her senior year. As a senior she was selected by the Washington Post as an all-Metro honorable mention.

Ta'Liyah Edmonds played two years of Varsity Basketball at Norview High School during her junior and senior years. During her junior year, she was named the most improved player on the team. Listed at 6-2, she is the tallest player on this NSU roster.

- \*Jalynn Holmes is from Upper Marlboro, Md., and comes to NSU after two seasons at Towson. She averaged 3.6 ppg in 59 appearances for Towson, scoring a career-high 16 points against UMass.
- \*Mangela Ngandjui is also from Upper Marlboro, Md. and one of two transfers from UNC-Greensboro. She appeared in 77 games, averaging just over four points and three rebounds per game.
- \*Amesha Miller is the other transfer from UNC-Greensboro to come to NSU this season. During two seasons she averaged 5.6 points per game, 3.4 rebounds per game, and 1 block per game.
- \*Will not be eligible to play in the 2019-20 season due to NCAA transfer regulations.

NSU in the MEAC Tournament: Norfolk State made its 21st appearance in the MEAC Tournament last season, making it all the way to the Championship game.

The Spartans topped Hampton, 61-52, in 2002 for their only MEAC Tournament championship.

NSU received a bye into the quarterfinals for the first time since the 2002 championship season. Since their first MEAC Tournament in 1999, the Spartans have received a firstround bye only one other time, doing so in 2000. When Norfolk State has received a first-round bye, it has made the championship game all three times.

The Spartans entered the tournament as the fourth seed for the second-year in a row. NSU holds a 4-3 all-time record as the No. 4 seed in the MEAC Tournament and reached the semifinals as the fourth seed in 2015 before falling to Maryland Eastern Shore, 69-64, in overtime.

In total, NSU is 19-19 all-time in the MEAC Tournament and is 1-3 in the final round.

Head coach Larry Vickers owns a 3-4 record in MEAC Tournament play and made his first-ever appearance in the finals.

NSU vs. the MEAC: Norfolk State concluded its 22nd season of MEAC play. The Spartans joined the conference for the 1997-98 season after spending their first 24 seasons in Division II as a member of the CIAA.

221 (.396) in conference tilts. The Spartans posted consecutive winning seasons in the MEAC for the first time in 2017-18, going 11-5 after a 9-7 mark in 2016-17. Norfolk State then turned in its third-straight winning conference record with a 10-6 mark this season. Prior to their current run, the Spartans had not strung together three-consecutive winning conference seasons since doing so in seven-straight seasons in the CIAA from 1990 to 1997.


