Setting the Scene

This weekend, Norfolk State closes out a stretch of six-of-eight games at home. The Spartan men's basketball team will first host Morgan State on Saturday at 6:30 p.m. at Joseph Echols Hall. The Bears are the last team NSU has not faced yet this year.

Battling for first place in the league, the Spartans will also take on Coppin State on Monday. At 7-2, they are currently a half game back of North Carolina Central (8-2) for the top spot in the conference. Following the game against CSU, NSU closes out the regular season with four of five games on the road.

The game will be broadcast live on Hot 91.1 FM with Ross Gordon and Woube Gebre on the call. The audio feed is available through www.TuneIn.com or the TuneIn Radio App (search for "WNSB").

Series History

Morgan State is one of the few teams in the league that has gotten the better of NSU at times in their recent history. The Spartans have won the last two after the Bears took three of four before that. Last year, NSU escaped with a 75-74 win at MSU to improve to 37-15 all-time. The Spartans have won the last three at Echols Hall.

Scouting the Opponent

Morgan State is currently fourth in the league standings at 7-4 behind NCCU, NSU and North Carolina A&T (8-3). The Bears own a 13-13 overall record in their first season under new head coach Kevin Broadus. All of their MEAC losses have been by nine points or less, including last Monday at home

against North Carolina Central, 58-57.

The Bears are the league's top rebounding team with a +3.5 margin on the glass, and they average a league-best 12.7 offensive rebounds per game. They also pace the MEAC in blocks at 4.2. They score right around 70 points per game and have given up on average 71 points each time out, allowing teams to shoot just 40.9 percent from the floor.

Stanley Davis leads the team in points (13.4), rebounds (5.8) and assists (2.1) per game, shooting nearly 47 percent from the field and 82 percent from the free throw line. Troy Baxter leads the MEAC in blocks (2.0) while averaging 11.3 points and 5.4 rebounds. Sherwyn Devonish (10.2 points) also scores in double figures.

Last Time Out

NSU exploded for 53 points in the second half, outscoring Delaware State by 22 during that time in a 85-57 win last Saturday at Joseph Echols Hall. NSU shot 13-of-36 from 3-point range and 44 percent overall. They forced 20 DSU turnovers and outscored the Hornets 27-6 in points off turnovers and 13-0 in fastbreak points.

Joe Bryant Jr. totaled 20 points on 7-of-13 shooting with four rebounds and four assists, and Devante Carter tallied a career-high 19 points on 6-of-11 shooting with eight rebounds and four assists. Jermaine Bishop (18 points, four rebounds, three assists) and Steven Whitley (11 points, eight rebounds, four steals, three assists) also had solid games.

Recent Trends

- The team's 36 3-point attempts against Delaware State fell one short of the program record of 37 set two seasons ago. Only six other times in its history has NSU made more 3-pointers in a game than its total of 13 versus the Hornets.
- NSU's scoring margin of +5.5 is on pace to be its best in its Division I era, topping last year's mark of +4.1. Its current field goal % defense of 40.2 and scoring defense of 64.9 are on pace to be the second best. In addition, the team's 3-point field goal % defense of 29.9 is currently third, and its 69.9 free throw shooting percentage is the fourth-best.
- The Spartans are shooting 47.6 percent (137-of-288) from the floor the last five games, including 37.6 percent (44-of-117) from 3-point range.
- They are averaging 8.7 3-pointers during the last 10 games. In the last nine games, opponents have shot just 28.2 percent from deep (53-of-188).
- The Spartans are a total +52 on the glass during its last nine games (+5.8 per game).
- NSU has outscored opponents in points off turnovers in 11 of the last 15, including six of the last seven. The Spartans have outscored or been even with opponents in second-chance points in eight straight and 10 of the last 12 games.
- The Spartans have averaged 29.5 bench points the last six games, and 13.8 fastbreak points and 20.3 points off turnovers the last four games.
- The Spartans are outscoring teams in every specialty stat category: points off turnovers (17.6-13.9), second-chance points (10.3-8.5), points in the paint (27.2-25.3), fastbreak points (10.4-7.9), and bench points (23.8-17.4).
- The guard foursome of Bishop, Bryant, Whitley and Carter have combined for 61 of the team's 73 double-digit scoring performances this year.
- NSU has used 10 different starting lineups this year, including seven different lineups during an eight-game span from Dec. 1-Jan. 4.

- In 18 of the Spartans' 24 games this year, they have scored the same amount or more points in the second half than the first (+5.7 points per second half), including six of the last seven games. They did the same in 28 of 36 games last year, when they averaged 8.1 points more in second halves than first halves. Opponents have done the same in 18 of 24 games this year, including each of the last 14.
- The Spartans also shoot better in second halves (44.4-40.8) and have a better turnover margin as well (+1.2 - +0.2). Opponents shoot better in second halves too (42.4-38.0). For NSU on the glass, it's the opposite, as its rebounding margin is +1.7 in first halves but +0.8 in second halves.
- The Spartans have also had the same amount or more fouls than the opposition in 18 of 24 games this season (+1.8 in fouls per game). They did the same in 26 of 36 games last year (+2.2).
- NSU started MEAC play 6-0 for the fourth time ever. The Spartans went 16-0 in 2012-13, and they started the 2011-12 and 2018-19 seasons 8-0 in the MEAC. Norfolk State owns a 21-4 conference record over the last two years.
- NSU shot 60% against Florida A&M, the first time reaching that plateau in five years and the 13th time overall as a Division I program. The Spartans last did so on March 17, 2015 at Eastern Kentucky.

MEAC Rankings

The Spartans rank 1st in the MEAC in scoring margin (+5.5), and field goal % defense (40.2). They are also second in scoring defense (64.9), 3-point field goal % (33.5), opponent rebounding (34.1), rebounding margin (+2.5), turnover margin (+1.42), assist-turnover ratio (0.9), offensive rebound % (31.7), and 3-pointers (7.7), and third in free throw % (69.9), 3-point field goal % defense (29.9), assists (13.2), steals (7.5), and defensive rebound % (72.0).

In MEAC games only, they stand first in scoring margin (+12.1), 3-point field goal % (37.0), and 3-pointers (8.9), second in scoring defense (63.9), free throw % (71.1), opponent rebounding (31.4), rebounding margin (+5.8), assists (14.2), assist-turnover ratio (1.0), and offensive rebound % (34.7), and third in scoring offense (76.0), 3-point field goal % defense (28.2), and defensive rebound % (73.0).

National Rankings

On a national level, Norfolk State stands No. 35 in turnovers forced (16.04), No. 44 in 3-point field goal % defense (29.9), No. 57 in field goal % defense (40.2), No. 63 in scoring defense (64.9), No. 74 in steals (7.5), No. 82 in offensive rebounds (11.25), No. 87 in turnover margin (+1.5), No. 95 in scoring margin (+5.5), No. 108 in rebound margin (+2.5), No. 122 in rebounds per game (36.58), and No. 130 in 3-pointers per game (7.7).

Conference Domination

Since the start of the 2011-12 season, Norfolk State is 108-29 in regular season MEAC play, a 78.8 winning percentage. Among all D-I programs, NSU ranks 11th in the nation in conference winning percentage during that time (See table page 8).

At 108-29 (58-11 at home - 33-4 since the start of the 2015-16 season - and 50-18 on the road), NSU is ahead of North Carolina Central (103-35) for the best record in the league since 2011. Counting MEAC tournament games, the Spartans are 120-36, while the Eagles are 119-39 during that time.

NSU also owns a 167-131 overall record since the start of the 2011-12 season, second in the conference to North Carolina Central (179-110).

Conference Standings

The Spartans have finished fourth or better in the MEAC standings in 12 of the last 13 seasons, including eight straight years. Only 13 other teams in Division I have a longer streak than NSU's eight of finishing in the top 4 of their respective conference standings (see table page 8).

They secured their second-ever MEAC regular season title last year at 14-2, joining the 2012-13 team that finished 16-0.

Conference Streak

Last year, NSU secured its 21st straight season with a .500 or better conference record in its Division I era. In fact, in Norfolk State's 64 seasons in either the EIAC, CIAA or the MEAC, the program has had just one losing conference record (9-10 in the CIAA in 1990-91).

NSU ranks eighth in the nation for the longest streak of .500-or-better conference records in a row in D-I (See table page 8). NSU has posted 27 straight .500 or better conference records, dating back to that 1990-91 campaign.

Every other team in the MEAC has had at least one losing conference record since 2015-16.

Series Edge

NSU has a winning record against every school in the MEAC, with several of those series covering a lot of ground in the Division II era. The Spartans' closest rival over the years has been North Carolina A&T at 26-23 (See table page 9).

Winning the State

Since the start of the 2011-12 season, NSU has the fourth-most wins (167) among the 14 Division I schools in the state of Virginia. The Spartans trail Virginia (239), VCU (219) and Old Dominion (177)

Predictable Numbers

Since the start of the 2015-16 season, NSU is 72-12 when shooting better than the opposition and 9-67 when the other team has a better shooting percentage.

Good from 3

Norfolk State has made a 3-pointer in 342 straight games, dating back to a contest at South Carolina State on Jan. 25, 2010, when NSU finished 0-of-17 from 3-point range.

Ahead at the Half

The Spartans are 129-29 (81.6 winning percentage) since the start of the 2011-12 season when leading or tied at the half.

What Deficit?

NSU has erased a double-digit deficit in a victory 19 times since the start of the 2014-15 season.

Cleaning Out the Early-Season Notebook

- NSU nailed 20 3-pointers against Apprentice School, breaking the previous best of 18 set last year against Maryland Eastern Shore. The Spartans also had 13 at Coppin State, tied for the seventh-most in school history.
- The Spartans tied their Division I record with 26 assists against Apprentice. Their 32 3-point attempts are tied for the third-most in a single game in D-I history, and their 3-point percentage of 62.5 is the fifth best mark over that time.
- Its 113 points scored against Apprentice are the second-most since moving to D-I in 1997, topped only by a 115-point performance in November of 2013. The 59-point margin of victory is the second-biggest in D-I history as well behind a 78-point win over Mid-Atlantic Christian in December of 2017.
- They recorded 16 steals, the most in a game January of 2009 (17).
- Since 2002-03, NSU has never had at least 28 fastbreak points in a game.
- NSU last played three of its first four games of the season at home in 2014-15.
- The Spartans have had three 30-point wins for the second year in a row.
- They recorded back-to-back 40-point wins for the first time in their Division I history following the 93-53 victory over Penn State Wilkes-Barre and the season-opening 100-59 win against Greensboro. The previous best was back-to-back 25-point wins last year.
- Wilkes-Barre also had 28 turnovers, the most by an NSU opponent since Morgan State had 29 on Jan. 21, 2013. The Spartans' 41 points off turnovers are the most since also posting 41 against Mid-Atlantic Christian two years ago. They have not had more than that since 2002-03.
- NSU had not started a season 2-0 since 1998-99.
- The team's 57 rebounds against Greensboro are tied for the fourth-most in D-I records.
- The Spartans reached the 100-point plateau for the third season in a row.

Early Start

This year's start date of Nov. 5 marked the earliest start to the season ever for NSU. Prior to this year, the Spartans' earliest start date was Nov. 6 last year and Nov. 9 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons.

This was just the second time in the past 16 years NSU began its season at home, and the first time starting off with back-to-back games at home since 2002-03. It was also the first time in five years the Spartans did not open their season at a Power 5 opponent following games at South Carolina (2015), Mississippi State (2016), Auburn (2017), and Michigan (2018).

Lost Production

Of NSU's top eight scorers from a season ago, only one is back, that being senior guard Steven Whitley. Of the other seven, four players were seniors, and three transferred. Altogether, the Spartans lost 79.7 percent of their scoring from a season ago, while 60 percent of the scoring that is back is from Whitley.

Of the team's 15 players on the roster, 10 are newbies this year and 11 have never put on a uniform for the Spartans (senior Jermaine Bishop sat out last year at NSU).

Who Are You?

In fact, NSU's 10 newcomers are some of the most of any team in the nation. In information compiled by Utah's sports information staff, only 13 teams in the country have more newcomers than NSU.

Winning Record

NSU has had seven non-losing seasons in the last eight years. Prior to the start of that streak, NSU had a .500 or better overall record just twice in 14 seasons since moving to Division I in 1997.

The Spartans secured a 20-win season a year ago, their fourth since joining Division I. Their 22 wins stand as the second-most during that time behind the 26-win season of 2011-12.

MEAC Tournament History

NSU has been to the semifinals of the MEAC tournament nine times in the last 12 seasons. The Spartans have been a No. 4 seed or better in 10 of the last 12 years as well. The Spartans secured their fourth-ever trip to the finals last year along with the 2009, '12 and '17 teams. The 2012 team captured the program's only MEAC title.

Major Wins

Last year's win over Alabama in the NIT marked one of the biggest wins in NSU's Division I history. Along with the victory over Missouri in the 2012 NCAA tournament, the Spartans also defeated TCU that year in the Paradise Jam, although it was a member of the Mountain West at the time. Now a member of the SEC, Missouri was in the Big 12 in 2012.

NSU's next biggest victories over major opponents as a D-I program are wins over Atlantic-10 members Richmond (2007) and Rhode Island (2012).

NIT History

The Spartans made history against Alabama, earning their first win ever in the tournament in their second appearance. It was also the fourth win by a MEAC team and the first since the NIT went to its current format of 32 teams in 2007. Maryland Eastern Shore (1974), Coppin State (1995) and Delaware State (2006) also won games in the NIT.

It was also the eighth win by a No. 8 seed over a No. 1 seed since 2007. In first round games during that time, eighth seeds are now 8-44 against first seeds.

Postseason History

NSU made its seventh postseason appearance in its Division I era (1997-Present) last year, and all have come in the last eight years. It started with the NCAA tournament in 2012 after the Spartans won their first-ever MEAC title. NSU went to the NIT in 2013 after winning the conference's regular season title at 16-0. NSU also faced Eastern Michigan (2014), Eastern Kentucky (2015), Columbia (2016) and Liberty (2017) in the Collegelinsider.com tournaments.

Block Party

NSU has averaged 158.7 blocks per season over the previous nine years. The program's seven highest season totals all-time in terms of total blocks have come during that nine-year stretch.

Professional Spartans

Former Spartan Kyle O'Quinn is now in his eighth year in the NBA and the first with the Philadelphia 76ers. He became NSU's first NBA player in 25 years after getting drafted in the second round in 2012 by the Orlando Magic.

Aside from O'Quinn, NSU had 14 other players competing professionally at some point this year. **Pendarvis Williams** (France) and **Anell Alexis** and **Ed Seward** (Germany) were in Europe, while **Chris McEachin** was in Iraq. **Hefeng Sun** (China) and **D'Shon Taylor** (Bahamas) were competing in their home countries.

Eight other players who finished their careers recently at NSU were also playing professionally. **Jordan Butler** (Bulgaria), **Stavian Allen** (Bulgaria, Bosnia), **Jonathan Wade** (Kosovo), **Preston Bungei** (Bosnia) and **Alex Long** (North Macedonia) were in the Baltics. **Derrik Jamerson Jr.** (Austria), **Kyle Williams** (Iceland, Spain), and **Dan Robinson** (El Salvador) also competed this year.
