**OPENING KICKOFF**

- Coming off a record-setting offensive explosion against Elizabeth City State, the Norfolk State football team takes to the road for the third time in four games to start the year this weekend, meeting the Red Flash of St. Francis (Pa.) University.
- Juan Carter** threw five touchdown passes, two each to **Justin Smith** and **Marcque Ellington**, in a 63-26 win over Elizabeth City State last week.
- The win was **Dawson Odums'** first as head coach at NSU.
- 2021 is NSU's 80th season of collegiate football.

**SERIES HISTORY**

- This marks the first-ever meeting between the two teams.
- This is also NSU's first-ever game with a current Northeast Conference School.

**NSU IN WEEKLY MEAC HONORS**

NSU has dominated the MEAC weekly football awards the last two weeks, winning a combined six for performances against Wake Forest and Elizabeth City State.

- NSU quarterback **Juan Carter** was named the MEAC Offensive Player of the Week each of the last two weeks, throwing for a combined seven touchdowns in the two games (five vs. ECSU, a career high).
- LG Jalen Powell** (Wake) and **C Colby Byrd** (ECSU) have won the last two Offensive Lineman of the

Week awards.

- RB J.J. Davis** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week after rushing eight times for 121 yards and two touchdowns (including a 72-yarder) vs. ECSU.
- DL Chris Myers** was tabbed Defensive Player of the Week after the ECSU win after registering two of NSU's eight sacks and helping hold the Vikings to negative-49 rushing yards.

**NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN**

- Dawson Odums** was named the 18th head coach in NSU history on April 21. He replaced **Latrell Scott**, who resigned after five seasons to pursue another opportunity.
- Odums spent 10 seasons at Southern, one as a defensive line coach and nine as head coach (2012-21).
- He compiled a 63-35 record on the field with the Jaguars, including 53-17 in the SWAC, with one conference title.
- Odums also has served stints as an assistant coach at Bethune-Cookman, N.C. A&T, Georgia Southern, Gardner-Webb and Clark Atlanta. He also served as interim head coach at Clark Atlanta in 2004.
- Odums is a native of Shelby, N.C. who played collegiately at North Carolina Central.

**SCOUTING THE RED FLASH**

Wagner scored its first win of the week last Saturday at home, outscoring visiting Wagner 33-10 in the second half en route to a 39-24 win.

- Quarterback **Jyron Russell** threw four touchdown passes, two to **Kahtero Sumers**, in the victory.
- SFU intercepted two passes, including one that **Raymond Crittenden** returned seven yards for a game-sealing score in the final minute.
- The Red Flash opened the year with losses to Eastern Michigan (35-15) and No. 6 FCS ranked Delaware (27-10).
- The Red Flash, who like NSU did not compete in the 2020-21 school year, were picked to finish fifth in the preseason Northeast Conference poll.

### ALL EYES ON THE SPARTANS

Several Spartans were named to preseason national watch lists. They include:

• **QB Juwan Carter** - Walton Payton Award (FCS Offensive POTY), College Football Performance Awards FCS POTY, Black College Football POTY

• **DL De'Shaan Dixon** - Reese's Senior Bowl watch list, NFLPA Collegiate Bowl big board.

• **P Ryan Richter** - FCS Punter of the Year watch list.

• **WR Da'Kendall James, RB Kevin Johnson, DL De'Shaan Dixon and DB Devyn Coles** were also named to the Black College Football Player of the Year watch list along with Carter.

### PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

• NSU was picked to finish second in the new-look, six-team MEAC this season. South Carolina State was the preseason favorite according to the poll of head coaches and sports information directors.

• **QB Juwan Carter** was voted the preseason MEAC Offensive Player of the Year and was one 14 Spartans named to the preseason All-MEAC teams, most in the conference.

• Carter, **RB Kevin Johnson, WR Da'Kendall James, TE Shawn McFarland, OL Jalen Powell and OL Justin Redd** were all voted to the preseason All-MEAC first-team offense.

• Also voted to the preseason All-MEAC first team were **DL De'Shaan Dixon, DL Chris Myers, DL Tavien Blackwell, DB Devyn Coles, K Josh Nardone and P Ryan Richter**.

• **WR Justin Smith and DB Brandon Savage** were second-team selections.

### RECORD-SETTING YEAR

NSU set a new Division I era school record by averaging 28.9 points per game in 2019 and 31.8 in conference-only games.

• NSU also ran for 144.7 yards per game, its most since 2011.

• The Spartans posted three games scoring at least 40 points in 2019.

• **Juwan Carter's** 23 touchdowns passes were the most by a Spartan in the Division I era. Carter's passing (2,631) and total offensive (2,856) yardage marks are both the fourth-most in a season in NSU history.

• **Ryan Richter's** 39.7-yard punt average was also the fourth-best in school history.

### SPARTANS IN THE PROS

Norfolk State is represented in the NFL by undrafted defensive back **Bobby Price** of the Detroit Lions. Price was a two-time All-MEAC safety for NSU who started 37 games between 2016 and 2019 for NSU. Price spent much of the 2020 NFL season on the Lions practice squad, but was activated for two games late in the year and made one tackle. He made three tackles in Monday's game in Green Bay.

### FIRST-TIME FOES

NSU has four first-time opponents this year. The Spartans have never faced Toledo, Wake Forest, Virginia-Lynchburg and St. Francis (Pa.) previously.

### NSU ON THE WORLDWIDE LEADER

Ten of NSU's 11 games this year will be broadcast on one of the ESPN family of networks. The opener at Toledo and the contest at Howard will air on ESPN3 and the Wake Forest game be carried by the ACC Network Extra. The Hampton game will be seen on ESPN+.

NSU's home game with Elizabeth City State and five MEAC games will be broadcast on either ESPN+ or ESPN3. In addition, games with Howard, NCCU and South Carolina State may be chosen for re-broadcast on ESPNU later as part of the MEAC's yearly TV agreement with ESPN.

### NEW-LOOK MEAC

The MEAC will have a new look and feel in 2021 as three schools have departed the conference since the last full conference season – North Carolina A&T to the Big South and both Florida A&M and Bethune-Cookman to the SWAC. That leaves just six schools – NSU, N.C. Central, South Carolina State, Howard, Delaware State and Morgan State. The Spartans went 4-1 against the other five schools in 2019, with the lone loss being a 20-17 OT decision to S.C. State.

The change means a school-record six non-conference games this year. NSU's MEAC opener, with Howard, isn't until Oct. 23.

### ALL GAMES ON HOT 91.1 FM

Campus radio station WNSB Hot 91.1 FM will serve as the carrier of all 11 Spartan football games this fall, plus any potential postseason games, for the second year in a row. Fans can also listen to the games online at [www.tunein.com](http://www.tunein.com), or through the TuneIn Radio app by searching for WNSB 91.1 FM.

### NSU ALSO PARTNERS WITH SIRIUS

NSU's football broadcasts will be available on SiriusXM for the first time throughout the 2021 season. This weekend's game will air on SiriusXM channel 382 and on the SXM App by searching Norfolk State. The SXM App is free for most subscribers, and anyone who is not yet a subscriber can download the SXM App and get a free, limited-time preview.

Additionally, select NSU men's and women's basketball games will also air SiriusXM beginning later this year.

### TRANSFERS JOIN THE FOLD

NSU has a number of transfers who are expected to contribute this year. They include:

• **OL Jeff Woods:** Woods redshirted at UConn in 2019 before transferring to NSU in the spring of 2020. Originally recruited as a defensive lineman, Woods was moved to offensive tackle for NSU last year.

• **RB J.J. Davis:** Davis redshirted at Cincinnati in 2019 before, like Woods, transferring to NSU in the spring of 2020. He is expected to contribute at running back and on special teams.

• **DL Amadeu Vital:** Vital spent three years at Division II Glensville State with NSU defensive coordinator Steve Adams. He made 21 tackles in seven games in 2018, and nine stops in four games this past spring. He has two years remaining and will add depth to the interior of NSU's defensive line.

• **LB Tyler Long:** Long transferred to NSU in the spring of 2020 after a stellar campaign at Lackawanna (Pa.) College. He was named to the 2019 All-Northeast Conference second team after posting 53 tackles, 10 for loss and six sacks.

• **DB Tayvion Land:** A former four-star recruit according to ESPN, Land played in 11 games as a true freshman at Liberty in 2019 before transferring. The Virginia Beach native made 23 tackles that year.

**DL Imani Bey (VMI), DB Ricky Harleston (JMU) and QB Jonah Fitzgerald (Old Dominion)** are other transfers who joined the program in 2020.

## DAWSON ODUMS // HEAD COACH



**Dawson Odums**, a championship coach with a track record of developing student-athletes both on and off the field during his collegiate coaching career, is in his first year as the head football coach at Norfolk State University. He was named the 18th head coach in Spartan history on April

21, 2021.

A native of Shelby, North Carolina, Odums has more than 20 years of collegiate coaching experience. Most recently, Odums enjoyed a stellar 10-year run in the Southwestern Athletic Conference at Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Odums directed Southern to a winning record in each of his eight full seasons at the helm of the program, including a 5-1 mark in the abbreviated 2021 spring season. In his last five seasons, the Jaguars posted a 29-6 SWAC record. His overall record with the Jaguars was 63-35.

After joining the Jaguars as defensive line coach in 2011, Odums was elevated to interim head coach two games into the 2012 season before earning the permanent head coach position following the year. On the field, Odums led Southern to a 53-17 SWAC mark over the last nine seasons. His ledger includes one SWAC championship (2013), one SWAC Coach of the Year honor (2013) and four SWAC West Division titles (2013, '14, '18, '19).

Odums' teams at Southern excelled in all three phases of the game. In the 2021 spring season, Southern ranked first nationally in blocked punts, second in third-down conversions, fifth in sacks and eighth in scoring offense. Southern finished the year ranked 20th in the FCS Top 25 Coaches Poll. Defensive end Jordan Lewis brought distinction to the Jaguars by winning the Buck Buchanan Award, given annually to the top defensive player in the Division I FCS. Lewis, who led the country in sacks and tackles for loss, also won SWAC Defensive Player of the Year honors.

Southern posted top-20 total offenses in 2015 and 2016 and a No. 13 mark in rushing offense en route to a SWAC West title in 2019. Odums' squads ranked in the top 10 in the FCS in punt return average four times, including leading the country in 2017, and also ranked top-10 in kickoff return average twice.

The 2013 season was a special one for Odums. His first full year as head coach at Southern culminated

in a double-overtime SWAC championship game victory over Jackson State. The win made Odums just the second coach in Southern history to win a SWAC divisional title, outright SWAC championship and SWAC Coach of the Year honors in his first year as head coach.

The Jaguars went 9-4 that year, one of four seasons in which they won at least eight games on Odums' watch. They also won nine games and captured the divisional title the following year, 2014.

Six players coached by Odums have signed with teams in the NFL or CFL. That list includes SWAC all-time leading rusher Lenard Tillery and Southern's all-time leader in receiving yards and return touchdowns, Willie Quinn. Former Jaguars defensive back Danny Johnson is on the roster of the Washington Football Team.

Jaguar student-athletes have also performed well in the classroom. Fifty-seven Southern players earned Dean's List honors during the fall 2020 semester. Under Odums' guidance, Southern's APR score has steadily risen, reaching a multi-year rate of 952 in the last NCAA report of his tenure there.

Odums' other coaching stints include a pair of stops in the MEAC. He spent three seasons at North Carolina A&T (2008-10), serving first as defensive line coach and special teams coordinator and then as defensive coordinator. Odums' first stint in the MEAC came as defensive line coach at Bethune-Cookman from 2005-07.

Prior to arriving at Bethune-Cookman, Odums spent three seasons at Division II Clark Atlanta. He served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator from 2002-03, then as interim head coach in 2004.

Odums' other stints at the Division I level include two years at Georgia Southern and one at Gardner-Webb. In his first year at GSU in 2000, Odums coached the linebackers while helping the Eagles win the Division I-AA (now FCS) national championship.

Odums played linebacker and quarterback at Crest High School in Boiling Springs, North Carolina, before competing collegiately at North Carolina Central. A defensive lineman at NCCU, Odums was a team captain and All-CIAA selection as a senior. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1997.

Odums and his wife, Audrey, have two daughters,
