Address: 700 Park Ave | Norfolk, VA 23504

**Description:** Traveling on Park Ave turn right onto Presidential Pkwy. Proceed the length of the road, until approaching a slight bend in the road. James D. Gill Building will be on your left of the roundabout.


## **Role of First Responder:**

- 1. Designate someone to call Campus Police:
- 2. Provide the following information to dispatch: 757-823-8102
- \*\*IF USING A SCHOOL PHONE DIAL 3-8102

Cellphone: 208-240-0411

- a. Your first, last name and position
- b. Patient(s) name; details of what happened
- c. Exact location of emergency
- d. Number of injured individuals
- e. Condition of the injured individuals and the care you have provided
- f. Vitals and any pertinent information
- g. Where someone will meet the ambulance
- h. Wait for emergency person to end the call
- i. Once EMS has been activated, a Norfolk State certified athletic trainer or designated member of the emergency response team will **initiate the secondary emergency communication process.**

**Primary Route:** Heading down Presidential Pkwy, continue the length of the road. It is the last building on the left, across from the roundabout circle.

**Medical Equipment:** AED is located behind the home bench during competition. Emergency medical equipment (Medical Supply Bag, Splint Bag, Crutch Bag, and Spine Board) is maintained in the Spartan Sports Medicine Center in the Gill Building.
