NSU reserves the right to remove from its premises those individuals whose conduct disrupts players, coaches, officials, other fans. No refunds will be given.

DISABILITY ACCOMODATIONS

SMOKING

No smoking is permitted in William "Dick" Price Stadium.

RESTROOMS AND CONCESSIONS

Restrooms and concessions are located throughout the concourse of the stadium.

ALCOHOL, FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Alcohol, food and non-alcoholic beverages are not permitted in William "Dick" Price Stadium.

DISABILITY SEATING

For information on special seating for our guests that have disabilities, please call the NSU Ticket Center at (757) 823-9009 or visit the NSU Ticket Center.

EVACUATION

In case of an emergency and the stadium needs to be evacuated, instructions will be given over the public address system. Event staff and officers will assist fans to the appropriate exits.

EXITING AFTER GAMES

Guests will leave the stadium via the main gates. No access to the track or field will be allowed until the visiting team players and coaches have cleared to the locker room area. Also, no traffic will be allowed to access the stadium until 30 minutes after the conclusion of the game.

FIRST AID

In the event that first aid care is needed, see the nearest police officer or event staff member. That person will then contact the proper personnel to insure the quickest response to the situation.

LOST CHILDREN

Parents/guardians with a lost child should contact the nearest police officer or event staff member. That person will then contact the proper personnel to insure the quickest response to the situation. If a child gets separated from his/her party, he/she should notify the nearest police officer or event staff member.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

All permissible carried items and entrants are subject to search. Prohibited items will be discarded. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation, and the person in possession of such items is subject to arrest.

- Explosives & Firearms
- Knives

Prohibited Items:

- Coolers & containers
- Pets (with the exception of service animals)
- Lawn chairs and other portable seating devices
- Artificial noisemakers
- Food and non-alcoholic beverages

HOURS OF OPERATION

The NSU Ticket Office is open Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

The NSU Ticket Center is located on the east side of campus across from Joseph G. Echols Memorial Hall.

GAME DAY INFORMATION

For home games:

The gates to William "Dick" Price Stadium will open two (2) hours prior to kick-off.

The stadium ticket booths will open three hours prior to kickoff for 2025.

The stadium will call and player guest booth (Ticket booth on each side of the stadium) will open three hours prior to kickoff for 2025.

Public will call tickets are available for pickup at the NSU Ticket Center.

GAME DAY TICKET ISSUES

Ticket issues should be directed to the NSU Ticket Center at (757) 823-9009.

LOST TICKET/REFUNDS

The NSU Ticket Center is not responsible for tickets that are lost, stolen, or mailed to a third party. No refunds or exchanges are permitted if the game is played.

STUDENT TICKETS

All NSU students who are currently enrolled in classes can receive admission to all home football games. Students are **REQUIRED** to present a valid student ID card upon entry into William "Dick" Price Stadium. The student ID card will be scanned for entry into the each home football game. Please ensure your card is valid. You can check your card functionality at the NSU Spartan Card Office during regular university business hours.

PARKING INFORMATION

CAMPUS PARKING

Norfolk State University has limited on-campus parking on game day. Fans may access on-campus parking by entering University Gates 3, 4 and 6 off Corprew Avenue, but these spaces fill up fast. Fans may also park at the Marie V. McDemmond Center or the TBA satellite lots and ride the campus shuttle to the stadium.

Parking through Gate 1 (off Park Ave.) is limited to President's guests, members of the NSU Athletics Foundation and those with tailgating spots in the band practice field, on the grass area behind the baseball center field fence or on the basketball courts. Parking through Gate 8 is limited to handicap individuals and those with athletics department parking passes. There is no parking for single-game or season ticket holders through Gates 1 or 8.

PARKING PASSES

Parking passes for the 2025 football season cost \$100 for a season pass or \$20 per game. Season passes can be bought in-person only at the NSU Ticket Office. Single-game parking passes can be bought the week of the game in-person only at the NSU Ticket Office or upon entry to the lots on game day.

NSU Ticket Office hours are Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. The NSU Ticket Center opens on gamedays at 10 a.m.

FACULTY/STAFF/STUDENT PARKING

All faculty, staff and students are required to have a decal in order to park on campus in the designated lots on game day on a first-come, first-served basis. Decals will be strictly enforced on game day or an event fee will be assessed.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

Hampton Roads Transit (HRT), the City of Norfolk and Norfolk State University (NSU) are teaming up this season to provide FREE parking and transit options for fans. This year, MacArthur South and North Garages will be FREE for game patrons. Buses will queue at MacArthur South Garage to shuttle fans to the stadium.

Additionally, MacArthur Center is three light rail stops from Norfolk State's campus. Fans parking at the garage can catch The Tide at MacArthur Station for the FREE light rail ride to the stadium. Compli-

mentary rides are available two hours before and after each game.

The two closest stations to the stadium are the NSU Station (coming from the west) and the Ballentine/Broad Creek Station (coming from the east).

DISABILITY PARKING

In an effort to keep up with the high demand for handicap accessible parking on game day, available parking for handicapped patrons has been increased to exceed the university's current available spots to accommodate supply and demand. The goal of the Athletics Event Parking Plan is to provide a comprehensive program of high quality transportation and parking services in a dynamic University setting. The department has assessed the University's parking program for special events and has recommended implementing best practices, safety procedures, and clear and effective communication techniques to enhance the current parking plan to assist with handicap accessible parking.

- For the general public, handicap accessible parking is designated in lots 9, 11 and 12. Patrons must have a prepaid parking pass in order to enter through gate 8 to park in the designated handicapped accessible lots. Passes can be purchased at the NSU ticket office .

- Handicap accessible parking is designated in lot 6 for NSUAF members with handicap placards on Presidential Parkway.

- In addition to lots designated for handicap accessible parking there are also dedicated spaces available in each lot on Corprew Avenue for public parking.

- The gate on Gym Road will be utilized to allow a direct line from public parking to the stadium for a handicap accessible entrance directly into the stadium for ticket holders only. Patrons have several options to purchase tickets prior to game day.

- Athletics will continue to communicate and refocus the effort to include the new gate access change on campus announcement and athletics website.

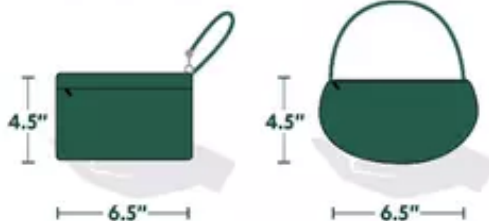

DIRECTIONS TO CAMPUS

I-64 EASTBOUND

Take Interstate 64 East. Travel through the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel to Norfolk. Follow the signs onto Interstate 264 West to Norfolk.

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 12 --Ballentine Blvd. Turn RIGHT onto Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT at Middle Towne Crescent. Turn LEFT at Gate 8.

-- or --

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 11B --Brambleton Ave. Take the first RIGHT onto Park Ave. Turn RIGHT at Gate 1.

I-64 WESTBOUND

Take Interstate 64 West. Follow the signs onto Interstate 264 West to Norfolk.

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 12 --Ballentine Blvd. Turn RIGHT onto Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT at Middle Towne Crescent. Turn LEFT at Gate 8.

-- or --

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 11B --Brambleton Ave. Take the first RIGHT onto Park Ave. Turn RIGHT at Gate 1.

I-95 NORTH/SOUTHBOUND

Take Interstate 95 North or South to Richmond, VA. Take Interstate 295 East to Interstate 64 East. Continue on Interstate 64 East. Travel through the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel to Norfolk. Follow the signs onto Interstate 264 West to Norfolk.

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 12 --Ballentine Blvd. Turn RIGHT onto Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT at Middle Towne Crescent. Turn LEFT at Gate 8.

-- or --

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 11B --Brambleton Ave. Take the first RIGHT onto Park Ave. Turn RIGHT at Gate 1.

ROUTE 58 EASTBOUND

Take US-58 E/US Highway 58 (Exit 11A on Interstate 95, Exit 12A on Interstate 85). Take the US-13 N ramp toward I-264 E/I-64. Merge onto I-664 S via the ramp on the left. Merge onto I-264 E via Exit 15A on the left toward Portsmouth/Norfolk.

- Merge onto VA-337/Tidewater Dr via EXIT 10 on the LEFT.

Turn RIGHT onto Brambleton Ave. Turn LEFT onto Park Ave. Turn RIGHT at Gate 1.

-- or --

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 12 --Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT onto Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT at Middle Towne Crescent. Turn LEFT at Gate 8.

ROUTE 17 NORTHBOUND (EASTERN N.C.)

Take US-17 N, crossing into Virginia. Take the Chesapeake Expressway S/I-64 W ramp. Keep LEFT at the fork in the ramp. Keep RIGHT to take the US-17 ramp toward I-64/I-664/Suffolk/Richmond. MERGE onto I-464 N. I-464 N become I-264 E.

- Merge onto VA-337/Tidewater Dr via EXIT 10 on the LEFT. Turn RIGHT onto Brambleton Ave. Turn LEFT onto Park Ave. Turn RIGHT at Gate 1.

-- or --

- Leave I-264 at EXIT 12 --Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT onto Ballentine Blvd. Turn LEFT at Middle Towne Crescent. Turn LEFT at Gate 8.

GATE INFORMATION

* Use Gate 1 to access the NSU Tennis Complex, the NSU Softball Field, Marty L. Miller Field, Gill Gymnasium and Spartan Lanes.

* Use Gate 8 and the University Police Station lot (off Corprew Ave.) to access Joseph G. Echols Hall and Spartan Lanes as well as William "Dick" Price Stadium on non-game days.

* Use Gates 3, 4 and 6, the McDemmond Center or satellite lots (TBA for 2021) for parking on football game days. Parking through Gate 1 on football gamedays is limited to President's guests, members of the NSU Athletics Foundation, and tailgaters. Parking through Gate 8 on football gamedays is limited to handicap individuals and those with athletics department parking passes.

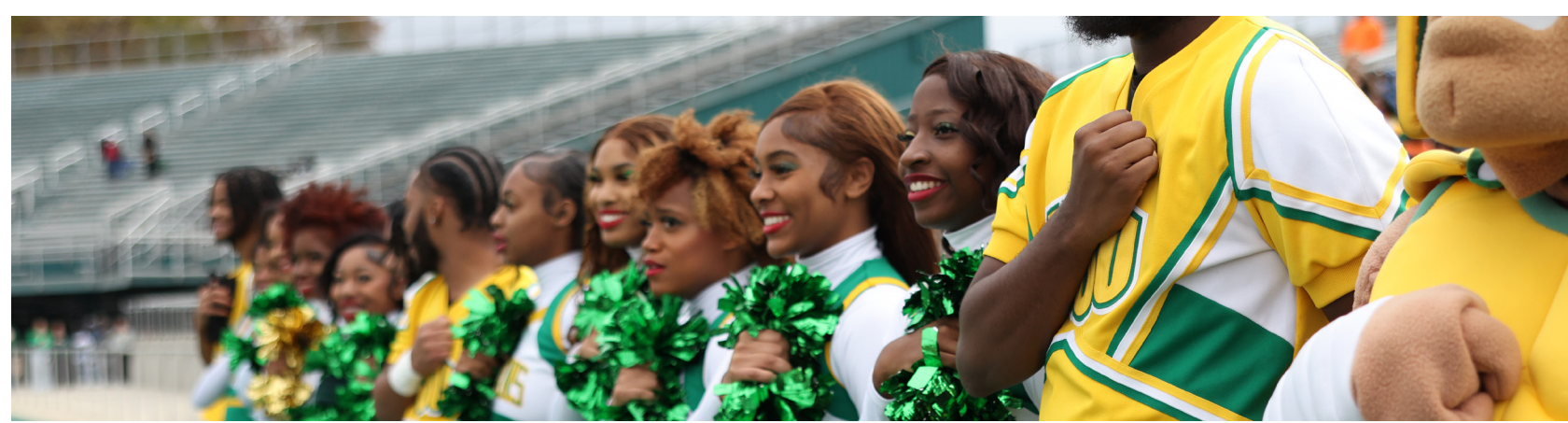

TAILGATING POLICIES

Tailgating will open four (4) hours prior to kick-off unless otherwise communicated, the listed times can be found on the schedule in section one. Please note that the stadium gates open two hours prior to kick-off. Tailgating will be shut down two hours after the conclusion of the game.

Tailgating is defined by Norfolk State University as parking in a designated location or area and/or setting up non-permanent items (i.e. tents, tables, chairs) to consume food and beverages prior to a home football game.

Tailgating Areas are defined on the maps and descriptions in Sections 2 and 3.

Tailgating Times – Designated Tailgating areas will open four hours prior to each home game to allow for set-up and drop off. Any vehicles used for dropping off persons or equipment must be immediately removed from the tailgating area. No vehicles will be permitted to drop off on any tailgating lot two hours prior to game time, no exceptions.

Site Visits - Site visits to view tailgating spots prior to purchase are optional, and are solely the customer's responsibility. Norfolk State Athletics Representatives are not required to attend any site visits, but are available to answer any questions the customer may have prior to the purchase of their tailgating spot.

Admittance – All individuals entering the tailgating area are required to have a game ticket listed with the correct date. Wristbands will be distributed to those inside the tailgating area at any of the entry points to the designated tailgating areas.

Conduct – Individuals attending football games at Norfolk State University are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner. Individuals acting in a disruptive, disrespectful, or disorderly manner will be removed from the premises or may be subject to a citation.

Consumption of Alcohol is only permitted in the designated tailgating areas. No alcohol may be sold. The distribution of alcohol to underage minors is both illegal in the Commonwealth in Virginia, and prohibited on Norfolk State University's campus.

Norfolk State University does not sanction the consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages by underage persons, nor does it sanction the violation of federal and state laws.

Consumption and preparation of food is only permitted in the areas listed previously as designated tailgating areas. No food may be sold. Propane and charcoal grills are the only permissible sources of heat cooking. Burned coals and/or residue from cooking cannot make contact with the paved surfaces and/or grass areas. Hot coals must be completely extinguished with water prior to leaving the tailgating area. Any open flames, including fire pits, are prohibited.

Fire Extinguisher – All individuals are required to have a mini fire extinguisher available for use, in case of an emergency, at their site. The extinguisher must be readily accessible.

Trash – All groups and individuals participating in tailgating are responsible for the proper disposal of their trash, charcoal, and any other debris in their site. Proper trash receptacles will be readily available in each of the tailgating areas. Failure to properly dispose of trash can result in the revocation of tailgating rights to the purchaser of the tailgating spot.

Solicitation – No sales activities (admission wristbands, food, beverages, and/or clothing/paraphernalia, etc.) are permitted in the tailgating areas or on campus unless authorized by the Norfolk State University Office of Auxiliary Services.

Structures – No permanent or semi-permanent structures may be constructed or placed on University grounds for any activity. Metal stakes, or similar items, are prohibited from puncturing the ground surface in the tailgating areas at any time, sandbags/ water barrels are permitted for stabilization. All tents must be less than 600 square feet in size (20x30). No tents over this size are permitted for construction on the tailgating area. Any tents put up over this threshold will be removed immediately.



TAILGATING POLICIES

Driving Lane – Driving is permitted on the band practice field tailgating area, and the designated driving lanes can be found on the maps in section 3. Tailgaters are allowed to drive on the grass, but only in the designated driving lanes. Tailgaters may park their vehicle temporarily next to their own purchased tailgating area for drop-off and pick-up of tailgating equipment ONLY. Tailgaters are required to remove their vehicle from the tailgating immediately after drop-off using only the marked lanes. Designated equipment drop off times will be communicated to tailgaters in the event of any changes. Tailgaters are prohibited from moving any barricades, barriers, or Norfolk State University equipment at any time. Tailgaters are prohibited from obstructing the driving lane at any point in time, whether it is their vehicle or personal equipment. Due to public safety issues, vehicles may be restricted from the tailgate area prior to the 2 hour kick-off time window. In the event that the tailgate area becomes too populated, vehicles may be restricted from the area at the discretion of the Norfolk State University athletics staff. The policy in which no vehicles are permitted on the tailgating area within 2 hours prior to kick-off is not flexible and will be strictly enforced at each event.

Tailgating Ticket Policy – All tailgaters must have a game-ticket to enter the tailgating zones, including passengers in any vehicles used to enter the tailgating zones. Failure to present a valid game ticket to a representative at the entrance of these gates will result in the denial of entry for the individual. Game tickets can be purchased at the Norfolk State University Ticket Center located in front of Echols Hall. Game tickets can be purchased the week leading up to game-day, as well as game-day itself. We do urge those who wish to tailgate to purchase their game-tickets prior to Saturday morning to ensure that they have the game-ticket in their possession at the start of tailgating.

Additional Parking – Additional parking passes can be purchased at the ticket center located across the street from Echols Hall.

Fines –Any violation of these guidelines will result in damages and fees charged to the credit card on file or invoiced to the reservation holder, cancellation of future tailgating privileges, forfeiture of prepaid expenses for the season, and a one-year suspension from tailgating activities. For example, a \$500 stage fee will be charged if a stage is installed without proper approval; damages to the irrigation system from improper structure use will be assessed and billed; and a cleaning fee will apply for failure to discard trash or remove equipment.

Rentals –The reservation holder or their representative must be present for all contracted equipment deliveries, including tents, grills, and similar items—to ensure compliance with the approved setup times, and is responsible for providing vendors with reservation details and space assignments; equipment and rentals may not be installed in designated tailgate areas before the authorized time.

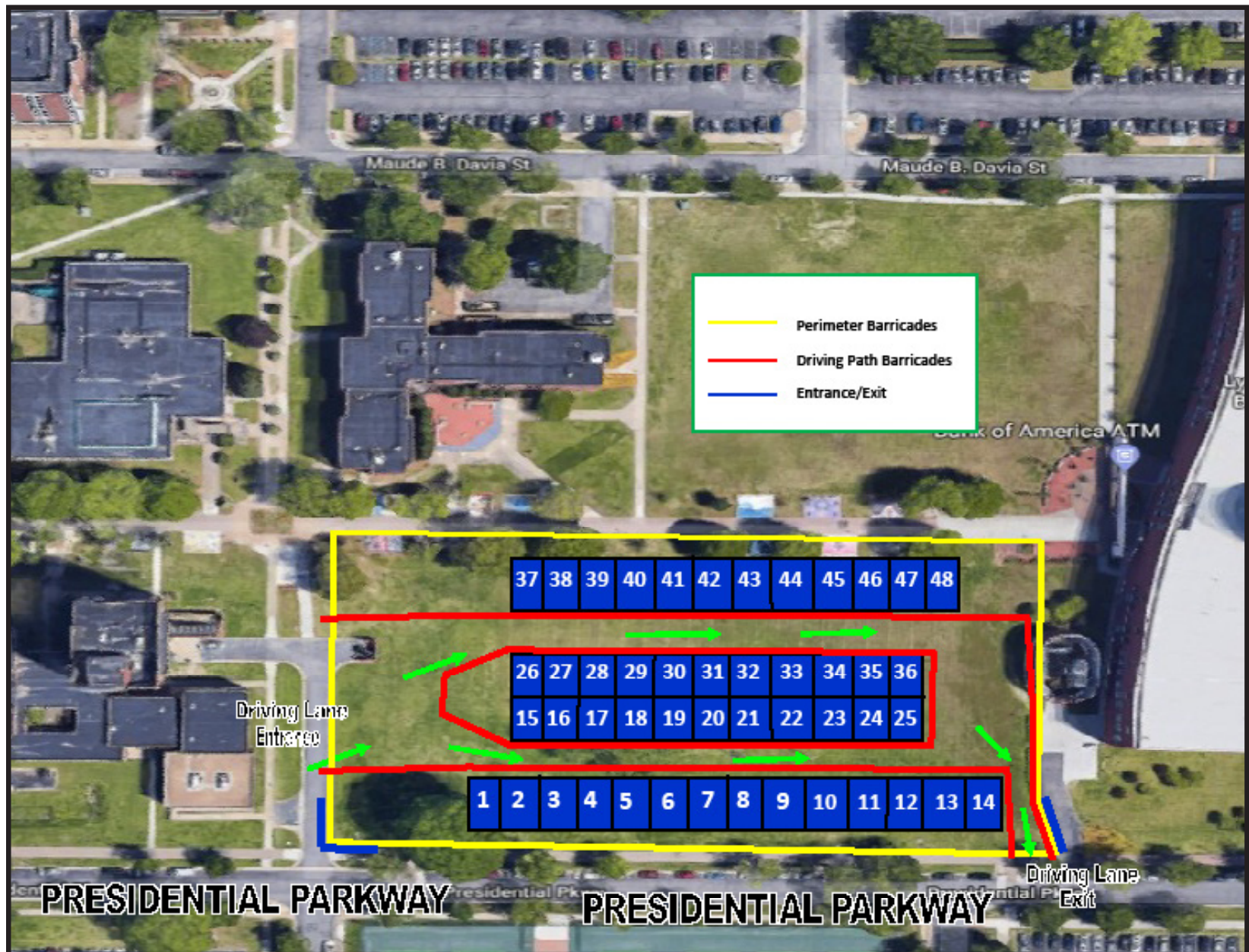
