WEEKEND STORYLINES

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- Northern enters the weekend with a 13-3 record overall and 9-1 mark in the NSIC, sitting atop the overall and north division standings
- The Wolves are shooting 47.3% from the floor, 37.9% from the 3-point line, and 78.9% from the foul line this season
- They are averaging 81.1 points, 36.1 rebounds, 16.8 assists, 9.9 turnovers, 5.3 steals, and 3.6 blocks per game; out-scoring and out-rebounding their opponents by 10.5 points and 2.9 boards per game
- Sam Masten leads four Wolves averaging double figures, notching 17.6 points, as well as a team best 7.3 rebounds and 6.6 assists
- Masten is also shooting a team best 55.3% from the floor, while Augustin Reede is shooting a team leading 45.9% from the 3-point line
- Jackson Moni and Jordan Belka are averaging 16.2 and 12.8 points per game, as well as 4.5 and 6.8 rebounds per game respectively
- Josh Dilling is the team's spark off the bench adding 9.9 points and 2.8 rebounds per game, with a team second best 42 assists
- Against league opponents, the Wolves lead the NSIC in 3-point field goals (11.4/gm), assist/turnover ratio (2.0), blocked shots (3.8), and assists (16.5)
- Masten leads the NSIC in assists (7.0/gm) and assist/turnover ratio (4.1)

MINNESOTA STATE MAVERICKS

- The Mavericks hold a 13-5 record on the year and 7-5 mark in the NSIC
- Minnesota State is averaging 80.0 points, 39.4 rebounds, 14.0 assists, 13.3 turnovers, 5.2 steals, and 3.7 blocks per game this season; out-scoring and out-rebounding their foes by 7.1 points and 4.1 boards
- They are shooting 46.2% from the floor, 37.4% from the 3-point line, and 71.0% from the free throw line this season
- Malik Willingham leads four averaging double figures, notching 18.3 points and 5.2 rebounds per game with a team high 68 assists
- Kyrese Willingham and Trevor Moore follow notching 13.9 and 13.7 points per game respectively, while Harrison Braudis leads the team off the bench notching 12.3 points and 3.0 rebounds
- Kelby Kramer is the team leader at the rim notching 6.6 rebounds per game

- Northern is 10-9 all-time against Minnesota State

CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL GOLDEN BEARS

- The Golden Bears enter the weekend with a 4-14 record overall and 2-10 mark in the NSIC
- CSP is averaging 72.9 points, 30.3 rebounds, 11.9 assists, 15.2 turnovers, 5.8 steals, and 1.9 blocks per game
- They are shooting 45.7% from the floor, 35.9% from the 3-point line, and 72.0% from the foul line in 2022-23
- Antwan Kimmons leads the team averaging 21.0 points per game, shooting 54.6% from the floor and adding a team high 76 assists
- Marcus Skeete is second on the team averaging 13.6 points and leads CSP averaging 6.2 rebounds per game; he is also shooting 51.8% from the floor with a team leading 29 made 3-pointers
- Jacob Everson follows Kimmons and Skeete notching 6.8 points and 3.4 rebounds per contest

- Northern is 30-6 all-time against CSP and on a 7-game win streak

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THE NORTHERN STATE COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH - SAUL PHILLIPS



Saul Phillips enters his fourth year at the helm in the fall of 2022, as the 22nd head men's basketball coach in program history. Phillips came to Northern State after Division I head coaching stops at North Dakota State University and Ohio University. He is just the sixth head coach for the Wolves since 1946.

Northern State went 20-12 overall and 13-9 in the NSIC in the 2021-22 season. The Wolves season ended in the quarterfinal round of the NSIC/Sanford Health Basketball Tournament. The trio of Sam Masten, Jordan Belka, and Jackson Moni were named to the NSIC All-Conference second team for the Wolves.

Northern went 19-2 overall en route to their fourth straight NSIC North Division and NSIC Tournament Championships in 2021. NSU earned the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Central Region, reaching the regional championship, where they ultimately fell to the National Champions, Northwest Missouri State. Phillips was named the NSIC North Division Coach of the Year, while

four Wolves were named to the All-Conference teams. Fox was both the North Division Overall and Defensive Player of the Year and went on to be the program's first NABC All-American since 2009.

Northern did not miss a beat in Phillips first season at the helm (2019-20), winning their third straight NSIC Overall and Tournament Championships with a 26-6 record. NSU earned a berth in the NCAA Central Region Tournament as the fourth seed. Three Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference honors, with Parker Fox being named the NSIC Defensive Player of the Year. Fox garnered All-Region accolades from both the D2CCA and NABC.

Phillips spent the previous five seasons at Ohio University and seven at North Dakota State. He went 81-77 overall leading the Bobcats and 134-84 with the Bison. Phillips will look to continue the strong tradition of Northern State basketball, as the Wolves have won back-to-back NSIC Conference Championships and are the NCAA Division II National Attendance leaders for the last 11 seasons, averaging well over 3,000 fans per game.

Phillips led the Ohio University Bobcats to the CBI semifinal round in his tenure with the program. OU saw 11 all-conference performances in five seasons under Phillips including one MAC Player of the Year honor (Antonio Campbell) and one MAC Freshman of the Year award (Jordan Dartis). Jaaron Simmons broke the single season Ohio University and MAC assist records in 2015-16, dishing out 275 on the year. Campbell was an Associated Press All-America selection following a stellar 2015-16 campaign, where the Bobcats tallied their best season under Phillips going 23-12 overall.

In his seven seasons at North Dakota State, Phillips led the Bison to two Summit League Championships, two Summit League Tournament Championships, and two appearances in the NCAA Tournament. A total of 14 Bison earned all-conference accolades in his seven seasons, while four were named to the NABC All-District team and two tallied All-American accolades.

Phillips directed NDSU to their first Summit League crown and NCAA Division I Championship appearance in 2009; he was named the Summit League Coach of the Year and was one of ten finalists for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year award. Senior Ben Woodside received Summit League Player of the Year honors that season, the first in NDSU program history. The 2013-14 campaign brought similar honors for the program winning their second Summit League Championship and a berth to the NCAA Tournament. In addition to being named the league coach of the year, senior Taylor Braun earned the league player of the year award.

The Bison advanced to the third round of the NCAA Tournament in his final season with the program, posting a 26-7 record overall, and 12-2 mark in Summit League action. The No. 12-seeded Bison knocked off No. 5-seeded Oklahoma in overtime, 80-75 in the Second Round. He left his legacy on the program as the fourth winningest coach in school history.

Phillips began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at NSIC counterpart Wayne State College as a member of Greg McDermott's staff. From there he made assistant coaching stops at Lake Superior and Milwaukee, before taking the Director of Basketball Operations post at Wisconsin. With the Badgers, Phillips handled the day-to-day scheduling, coordinated travel, budgeting and on-campus recruiting for Bo Ryan's staff. Phillips then joined former Northern State assistant, Tim Miles as an assistant at NDSU. He spent three years on Miles' staff before being elevated into his first head-coaching role in 2007.

A native of Reedsburg, Wis., Phillips graduated from Wisconsin-Platteville with a degree in business and psychology in 1996. He played basketball for four seasons at UWP under Bo Ryan and was captain of the Pioneers' undefeated national championship team in 1995.

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH - JOSH VAUGHAN



Josh Vaughan begins his third season at Northern State and first as the associate head coach in the fall of 2022. He joined the Northern State staff after spending the previous three seasons as the head coach at NAIA Dickinson State University.

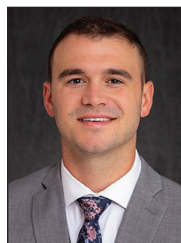
In his three seasons with the Blue Hawks, Dickinson State went 40-43 making it to the NSAA Tournament Championship game in 2017-18. He coached five all-conference student-athletes, including the 2019 NSAA Defensive Player and Newcomer of the Year, as well as one All-American.

Prior to his first head coaching position, Vaughan made stops at the University of Mary (2015-17) and MSU Moorhead (2011-13) as an assistant coach, and North Dakota State (2013-15) and Wofford College (2010-11) as the director of operations. In his time at NDSU, the Bison won back-to-back Summit League Championships and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

Vaughan's teams at both MSU Moorhead and Wofford College also made appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Vaughan was a 2-year starter at North Dakota State University, under Phillips. He was a member of the 2009 NCAA Tournament qualifying team that won the Summit League regular season and tournament championships. Vaughan received his Bachelor of Science in Sport Recreation Leadership from North Dakota State and Master of Science in Educational Leadership with an emphasis in Higher Education Administration from MSU Moorhead.

ASSISTANT COACH - GAVIN BLOCK



Gavin Block enters his first season with the men's basketball program in the fall of 2021 as an assistant coach. A former student-athlete of Phillips, Block joins the Wolves after two seasons at Duquesne University.

From 2019-21, Block was the assistant director of basketball operations for the Dukes. He handled the day-to-day operations of the program include practice and game day organization, travel planning, recruiting, game film management, and social media promotion. The Dukes went 30-18 in his two seasons on staff.

Block played collegiately at Ohio University, earning a bachelor's of business in specialized studies in 2019 and masters in leadership management in 2021. He appeared in 121 contests, racking up nearly 850 points and 300 assists. Block was a 4-time All-MAC Academic team honoree and Ohio SAAC member.
