GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- Northern returns home with a 3-4 record overall and in the league
- The Wolves are averaging 26.7 points, 158.4 yards rushing, 250.0 yards passing, and 408.4 yards of total offense this season
- They are converting 40.0% of the time on third down and 45.8% of the time on fourth down, scoring 20-of-27 times they have entered the red-zone
- The defense has 13 sacks and four interceptions this season, as well as 11 forced fumbles
- Brett Brenton tallied a career high 116 yards rushing last week and leads the team with 396 total yards and five touchdowns
- Colton Hackel is back in the saddle at QB, completing 50.5% of his passing for 912 yards and six touchdowns
- The Wolves main receivers are Dewaylon Ingram and Dakota Larson with 737 and 592 yards respectively, combining for 12 touchdowns in 2023
- Trey King leads the Northern State defense with 45.0 total tackles and 9.0 tackles for a loss of 26 yards
- Corey Scott leads the secondary with two interceptions, while Luke Gunderson, Logan Grossinger, and Ismael Kante each have 2.0 sacks
- Drew Smook is 6-of-9 in field goal attempts this season with a 47-yard long and is averaging 55.8 yards per kickoff
- Ethan Barnett has taken every punt for the Wolves this season, averaging 37.0 yards per boot with a 64-yard long

WAYNE STATE WILDCATS

- Wayne State heads into the weekend with a 5-2 record overall and 4-2 mark in the Northern Sun
- The Wildcats are averaging 33.0 points, 144.3 yards rushing, 274.7 yards passing, and 419.0 yards of total offense this season
- Defensively they have 13 forced fumbles, 11 interceptions, and eight sacks; holding their opponents to conversion rates of 44.0% on third down and 38.9% on fourth down
- Nick Bohn has 1,901 yards passing this season with 14 touchdowns and a 57.3 pass completion percentage
- The receiving core is led by Kendrick Watkins-Hogue and Ashten Schmaderer with 537 and 444 yards respectively, combining for nine touchdowns in 2023
- Latravious Boyd leads the rushers with 538 total yards and six touchdowns, averaging 8.0 yards per carry
- The WSC defense is led by Dexter Larsen and Alex Schall with 53.0 and 51.0 tackles respectively and a combined 10.0 tackles for a loss
- Four players have two interceptions apiece in 2023 led by Jacob Byrd and Tate Hinrichs with over 30 tackles each as well
- In the kicking front, Boston Hensley is 5-of-6 in field goal attempts
- The Wildcats are led by head coach Logan Masters in his second season

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE WILDCATS

- Northern fell 13-6 to Wayne State on the road in 2022
- NSU's six points came off two field goals from Payton Eue
- The Wolves led the contest with 17 first downs, 154 yards passing, and 270 yards of total offense; however went just 2-of-5 in red-zone score chances and threw three picks
- The NSU defense held WSC to 4-of-15 of third down and 0-of-2 on fourth down, adding two sacks
- The Wolves are 18-11 all-time versus the Wildcats

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fourth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2023. He joined the Wolves after spending four seasons as head coach at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse (UWL), where he posted a 27-13 record overall.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall

also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. UWL won 15 league games over the past three seasons, matching the most league victories in a three-year span since 2004-06. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh. UWL was ranked 25th in the final regular-season D3football.com Top-25 Poll while receiving votes in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top-25 Poli.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville in 2015. Prior to arriving at UW-Platteville, Schmidt was the defensive coordinator and coached the linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa) from 2011-14. He also served as the recruiting coordinator from 2009-14. Named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year, Schmidt coached running backs (2009-10), defensive backs (2009) and offensive line (2010) at Dubuque (Iowa). He served as a graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University Mankato in 2008, coaching the defensive line.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
